- Romans 1:15 (AV) So, as much as in me is, I am ready to preach the gospel to you that are at Rome also.
- Romans 1:15 (NKJV) So, as much as is in me, *I am* ready to preach the gospel to you who are in Rome also.
- Acts 9:26,27 And when Saul was come to Jerusalem, he assayed to join himself to the disciples: but they were all afraid of him, and believed not that he was a disciple. 27 But Barnabas took him, and brought him

- to the apostles, and declared unto them how he had seen the Lord in the way, and that he had spoken to him, and how he had preached boldly at Damascus in the name of Jesus.

- from 1, let 1, not suffer 1; 23 1) to hinder, prevent forbid 2) to withhold a thing from anyone 3) to deny or refuse one a thing.
- Matthew 19:14 (AV) But Jesus said, Suffer little children, and forbid <2967> them not, to come unto Me: for of such is the kingdom of heaven.
- Matthew 19:14 (NKJV) But Jesus said, Let the little children come to Me, and do not forbid <2967> them; for of such is the kingdom of heaven.
- Mark 9:38,39 (AV) And John answered Him, saying, Master, we saw one casting out devils in Thy Name, and he followeth not us: and we forbad <2967> him, because he followeth not us.
- Mark 9:38 (NKJV) Now John answered Him, saying, Teacher, we saw someone who does not follow us casting out demons in Your Name, and we forbade <2967> him because he does not follow us.
- Mark 9:39 (AV) But Jesus said, Forbid <2967> him not: for there is no man which shall do a miracle in My Name, that can lightly speak evil of Me.
- Mark 9:39 (NKJV) But Jesus said, Do not forbid <2967> him, for no one who works a miracle in My Name can soon afterward speak evil of Me.
- Mark 10:14 (AV) But when Jesus saw *it*, He was much displeased, and said unto them, Suffer the little children to come unto Me, and forbid <2967> them not: for of such is the kingdom of God.
- Luke 6:29 (AV) And unto him that smiteth thee on the *one* cheek offer also the other; and him that taketh away thy cloke forbid <2967> not to take thy coat also.
- Leviticus 24:20 Breach for breach, eye for eye, tooth for tooth: as he hath caused a blemish in a man, so shall it be done to him again.
- Luke 6:29 (NKJV) To him who strikes you on the one cheek, offer the other also. And from him who takes away your cloak, do not withhold <2967> your tunic either.
- Luke 9:49,50 (AV) And John answered and said, Master, we saw one casting out devils in Thy Name; and we forbad <2967> him, because he followeth not with us. 50 And Jesus said unto him, Forbid <2967> him not: for he that is not against us is for us.
- Luke 11:52 (AV) Woe unto you, lawyers! for ye have taken away the key of knowledge: ye entered not in yourselves, and them that were entering in ye hindered <2967>.
- Luke 11:52 (NKJV) Woe to you lawyers! For you have taken away the key of knowledge. You did not enter in yourselves, and those who were entering in you hindered <2967>.
- Matthew 23:15 Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye

- compass sea and land to make one proselyte, and when he is made, ye make him twofold more the child of hell than yourselves.
- Luke 18:16 (AV) But Jesus called them *unto him*, and said, Suffer little children to come unto Me, and forbid <2967> them not: for of such is the kingdom of God.
- Luke 23:2 (AV) And they began to accuse Him, saying, We found this *fellow* perverting the nation, and forbidding <2967> to give tribute to Caesar, saying that He Himself is Christ a King.
- Luke 23:2 (NKJV) And they began to accuse Him, saying, We found this fellow perverting the nation, and forbidding <2967> to pay taxes to Caesar, saying that He Himself is Christ, a King.
- Matthew 17:27 Notwithstanding, lest we should offend them, go thou to the sea, and cast an hook, and take up the fish that first cometh up; and when thou hast opened his mouth, thou shalt find a piece of money: that take, and give unto them for me and thee.
- Acts 8:36 (AV) And as they went on *their* way, they came unto a certain water: and the eunuch said, See, *here is* water; what doth hinder <2967> me to be baptized? 37 And Philip said, If thou believest with all thine heart, thou mayest. And he answered and said, I believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God. 39 And when they were come up out of the water, the Spirit of the Lord caught away Philip, that the eunuch saw him no more: and he went on his way rejoicing.
- Acts 10:47 (AV) Can any man forbid <2967> water, that these should not be baptized, which have received the Holy Ghost as well as we? Summarized of Baptism being the public profession of Christians.
- Acts 11:17 (AV) Forasmuch then as God gave them the like gift as *he did* unto us, who believed on the Lord Jesus Christ; what was I, that I could withstand <2967> God?
- Acts 16:6 (AV) Now when they had gone throughout Phrygia and the region of Galatia, and were forbidden <2967> of the Holy Ghost to preach the Word in Asia,
- Acts 24:23 (AV) And he commanded a centurion to keep Paul, and to let him have liberty, and that he should forbid <2967> none of his acquaintance to minister or come unto him.

- Jonah Summarized of God hindering Jonah from running away & then his preaching so Nineveh got saved.
- 1 Thessalonians 5:18 In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you.
- Exodus 14:13 And Moses said unto the people, Fear ye not, stand still, and see the salvation of the LORD, which He will shew to you to day: for the Egyptians whom ye have seen to day, ye shall see them again no more for ever.

More Service Notes:

- Romans 1:13 Now I would not have you ignorant, brethren, that oftentimes I purposed to come unto you, (but was let <2967> hitherto,) that I might have some fruit among you also, even as among other Gentiles.
- 1 Corinthians 14:39 Wherefore, brethren, covet to prophesy, and forbid <2967> not to speak with tongues.
- 1 Thessalonians 2:16 Forbidding <2967> us to speak to the Gentiles that they might be saved, to fill up their sins alway: for the wrath is come upon them to the uttermost.
- 1 Timothy 4:3 Forbidding <2967> to marry, and commanding to abstain from meats, which God hath created to be received with thanksgiving of them which believe and know the truth.
- Hebrews 7:23 And they truly were many priests, because they were not suffered <2967> to continue by reason of death:
- 2 Peter 2:16 But was rebuked for his iniquity: the dumb ass speaking with man's voice forbad <2967> the madness of the prophet.
- 3 John 1:10 Wherefore, if I come, I will remember his deeds which he doeth, prating against us with malicious words: and not content therewith, neither doth he himself receive the brethren, and forbiddeth <2967> them that would, and casteth *them* out of the church.
