## God Is Love - 1 John 4C

- 1 John 4:1 Beloved, believe not every spirit, but try the spirits whether they are of God: because many false prophets are gone out into the world.
- John 19:26 When Jesus therefore saw His mother, and <u>the disciple whom Heloved</u> standing by, He said to His mother, Woman, behold your son!
- 1 John 4:7-21 (AV) & (NKJV)
- 1 John 4:7 (AV) Beloved, let us love one another: for love is of God; and every one that loveth is born of God, and knoweth God.
- 1 John 4:7 (NKJV) Beloved, let us love one another, for love is of God; and everyone who loves is born of God and knows God.
- Leviticus 24:20 Breach for breach, eye for eye, tooth for tooth: as he hath caused a blemish in a man, so shall it be done to him again.
- Matthew 5:39 But I say unto you, That ye resist not evil: but whosoever shall smite thee on thy right cheek, turn to him the other also.
- Summarized of the ungodly trial of Jesus.
- 1 Corinthians 13 Referred to the Love chapter. V2 & though I have the gift of prophecy, & understand all mysteries & all knowledge, & though I have all faith, so that I could remove mountains, but have not love, I am nothing.
- Strongs #25 agapao ag-ap-ah'-o God's agape love.
- Genesis 18 Summarized of Jesus listening to Abraham intercede for Sodom. V32 And he said, Oh let not the Lord be angry, and I will speak yet but this once: Peradventure ten shall be found there. And He said, I will not destroy it for ten's sake.
- Genesis 6:8 But Noah found grace in the eyes of the LORD.
- Jesus loved the sinner but hated the sin as He ministered to unclean people.
- Mark 10:14 But when Jesus saw it, He was much displeased, and said unto them, Suffer the little children to come unto Me, and forbid them not: for of such is the kingdom of God.
- Matthew 11:28 Come unto Me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.
- 1 John 4:8 (AV) He that loveth not knoweth not God; for God is love.
- 1 John 4:8 (NKJV) He who does not love does not know God, for God is love.
- Romans 3:23 For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;
- Romans 6:23 For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.
- Mark 2:17 When Jesus heard it, He saith unto them, They that are whole have no need of the physician, but they that are sick: I came not to call the righteous, but sinners to repentance.
- 1 John 4:9 (AV) In this was manifested the love of God toward us, because

- that God sent His only begotten Son into the world, that we might live through Him.
- 1 John 4:9 (NKJV) In this the love of God was manifested toward us, that God has sent His only begotten Son into the world, that we might live through Him.
- Summarized of Jesus coming as the Suffering Servant.
- John 14:1-3 Let not your heart be troubled: ye believe in God, believe also in Me. 2 In My Father's house are many mansions: if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. 3 And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto Myself; that where I am, there ye may be also.
- Revelation 11:19 Summarized of Jesus coming as the Conquering King.
- John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by Me.
- 2 Peter 3:9 The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance.
- Exodus 32 Summarized of Israelites' sin with the golden calf & God's judgment on them.
- Acts 17:30 And the times of this ignorance God winked at; but now commandeth all men every where to repent:
- 1 John 4:10 (AV) Herein is love, not that we loved God, but that He loved us, and sent His Son *to be* the propitiation for our sins.
- 1 John 4:10 (NKJV) In this is love, not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son *to be* the propitiation for our sins.
- Matthew 21:9 And the multitudes that went before, and that followed, cried, saying, Hosanna to the Son of David: Blessed is He that cometh in the Name of the Lord; Hosanna in the highest.
- Matthew 4:23-25 And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing all manner of sickness and all manner of disease among the people. 24 And His fame went throughout all Syria: and they brought unto Him all sick people that were taken with divers diseases and torments, and those which were possessed with devils, and those which were lunatick, and those that had the palsy; and He healed them. 25 And there followed Him great multitudes of people from Galilee, and from Decapolis, and from Jerusalem, and from Judaea, and from beyond Jordan.
- 1 John 4:11 (AV) Beloved, if God so loved us, we ought also to love one another.
- 1 John 4:11 (NKJV) Beloved, if God so loved us, we also ought to love one another.
- John 3:16 For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son,

- that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life.
- 1 John 4:12 (AV) No man hath seen God at any time. If we love one another, God dwelleth in us, and His love is perfected in us.
- 1 John 4:12 (NKJV) No one has seen God at any time. If we love one another, God abides in us, and His love has been perfected in us.
- Judges 13:22 And Manoah said unto his wife, We shall surely die, because we have seen God.
- Ephesians 1:13 In whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that holy Spirit of promise,
- Acts 1 & 2 Referred to the change in believers with the baptism or indwelling of the Holy Spirit.
- Matthew 5:41 And whosoever shall compel thee to go a mile, go with him twain.
- Matthew 18:18 Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.
- Luke 15:17 And when he came to himself, he said, How many hired servants of my father's have bread enough and to spare, and I perish with hunger!
- Daniel 4:34 And at the end of the days I Nebuchadnezzar lifted up mine eyes unto heaven, and mine understanding returned unto me, and I blessed the Most High, and I praised and honoured Him that liveth for ever, Whose dominion is an everlasting dominion, and His kingdom is from generation to generation:
- Daniel 4:16 Let his <u>heart</u> be changed from man's, and let a <u>beast</u>'s <u>heart</u> be given unto him; and let seven times pass over him.

- Matthew 11:28-30 Come unto Me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. 29 Take My yoke upon you, and learn of Me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls. 30 For My yoke is easy, and My burden is light.
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- Jude 1:9 Yet Michael the archangel, when contending with the devil he disputed about the body of Moses, durst not bring against him a railing accusation, but said, The Lord rebuke thee.
- James 4:7 Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.
- Summarized of Elijah (Fire from heaven) & Elisha (temporary blindness).

- Acts 8:9 But there was a certain man, called Simon, which beforetime in the same city used sorcery, and bewitched the people of Samaria, giving out that himself was some great one:
- Mark 16:17,18 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.
- 1 John 4:13 (AV) Hereby know we that we dwell in Him, and He in us, because He hath given us of His Spirit.
- 1 John 4:13 (NKJV) By this we know that we abide in Him, and He in us, because He has given us of His Spirit.
- Romans 8:13 For if ye live after the flesh, ye shall die: but if ye through the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body, ye shall live.

Compaired God's love in Christians verses hatred in the world.

## NKJV

- Matthew 5:43,44 You have heard that it was said, You shall <u>love</u> your neighbor and hate your enemy. 44 But I say to you, <u>love your enemies</u>, bless those who curse you, do good to those who hate you, and pray for those who spitefully use you and persecute you,
- Matthew 5:46 For if you <u>love</u> those who <u>love</u> you, what reward have you? Do not even the tax collectors do the same?
- Matthew 6:5 And when you pray, you shall not be like the hypocrites. For they <u>love</u> to pray standing in the synagogues and on the corners of the streets, that they may be <u>seen by men</u>. Assuredly, I say to you, they have their reward.
- Luke 18:14 I tell you, this man (Publican) went down to his house justified rather than the other (Pharisee): for every one that exalteth himself shall be abased; and he that humbleth himself shall be exalted.
- Matthew 6:24 No one can serve two masters; for either he will hate the one and <u>love</u> the other, or else he will be loyal to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and mammon.
- Deuteronomy 18:9-14 When thou art come into the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee, thou shalt not learn to do after the abominations of those nations. 10 There shall not be found among you any one that maketh his son or his daughter to pass through the fire, or that useth divination, or an observer of times, or an enchanter, or a witch, 11 Or a charmer, or a consulter with familiar spirits, or a wizard, or a necromancer. ...
- Luke 4:8 And Jesus answered and said unto him, Get thee behind Me, Satan: for it is written, Thou shalt worship the Lord thy God, and Him only shalt thou serve.
- Matthew 10:37 He who <u>loves</u> father or mother more than Me is not worthy of Me. And he who <u>loves</u> son or daughter more than Me is not worthy of Me.

- 1 Samuel 2:29 Wherefore kick ye at My sacrifice and at Mine offering, which I have commanded in My habitation; and honourest thy sons above Me, to make yourselves fat with the chiefest of all the offerings of Israel My people? (Summarized of their sins.)
- Matthew 19:19 Honor your father and *your* mother, and, You shall <u>love</u> your neighbor as yourself.
- Leviticus 19:18 Thou shalt not avenge, nor bear any grudge against the children of thy people, but thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself: I am the LORD.
- Matthew 22:37 Jesus said to him, You shall <u>love</u> the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind.
- Romans 10:9,10,13 That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised Him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. 10 For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. 13 For whosoever shall call upon the Name of the Lord shall be saved.
- John 11:39,43,44 Jesus said, Take ye away the stone. Martha, the sister of him that was dead, saith unto Him, Lord, by this time he stinketh: for he hath been dead four days. 43 And when He thus had spoken, He cried with a loud voice, Lazarus, come forth. 44 And he that was dead came forth, bound hand and foot with graveclothes: and his face was bound about with a napkin. Jesus saith unto them, Loose him, and let him go.
- Exodus 23:29,30 I will not drive them out from before thee in one year; lest the land become desolate, and the beast of the field multiply against thee. 30 By little and little I will drive them out from before thee, until thou be increased, and inherit the land.
- Acts 2:33 Therefore being by the right hand of God exalted, and having received of the Father the promise of the Holy Ghost, he hath shed forth this, which ye now see and hear.
- Matthew 25:21 His lord said unto him, Well done, thou good and faithful servant: thou hast been faithful over a few things, I will make thee ruler over many things: enter thou into the joy of thy lord.

- Matthew 22:39 And *the* second *is* like it: You shall <u>love</u> your neighbor as vourself.
- Matthew 23:6 They <u>love</u> the best places at feasts, the best seats in the synagogues,
- Matthew 24:12 And because lawlessness will abound, the <u>love</u> of many will grow cold.
- Mark 10:21 Then Jesus, looking at him, <u>loved</u> him, and said to him, One thing you lack: Go your way, sell whatever you have and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven; & come, take up the cross, & follow Me.

- Mark 12:30,31,33 And you shall <u>love</u> the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your mind, and with all your strength. This *is* the first commandment. 31 And the second, like *it*, *is* this: You shall <u>love</u> your neighbor as yourself. There is no other commandment greater than these. 33 And to <u>love</u> Him with all the heart, with all the understanding, with all the soul, and with all the strength, and to <u>love</u> one's neighbor as oneself, is more than all the whole burnt offerings and sacrifices.
- Mark 12:38 Then He said to them in His teaching, Beware of the scribes, who desire to go around in long robes, *love* greetings in the marketplaces,
- Luke 6:27 But I say to you who hear: <u>Love</u> your enemies, do good to those who hate you,
- Luke 6:32 But if you <u>love</u> those who <u>love</u> you, what credit is that to you? For even sinners love those who love them.
- Luke 6:35 But <u>love</u> your enemies, do good, and lend, hoping for nothing in return; and your reward will be great, and you will be sons of the Most High. For He is kind to the unthankful and evil.
- Luke 7:5 for he <u>loves</u> our nation, and has built us a synagogue.
- Luke 7:42 And when they had nothing with which to repay, he freely forgave them both. Tell Me, therefore, which of them will <u>love</u> him more?
- Luke 7:47 Therefore I say to you, her sins, which are many, are forgiven, for she <u>loved</u> much. But to whom little is forgiven, *the same* <u>loves</u> little.
- Luke 10:27 So he answered and said, You shall <u>love</u> the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your strength, and with all your mind, and your neighbor as yourself.
- Luke 11:42,43 But woe to you Pharisees! For you tithe mint and rue and all manner of herbs, and pass by justice and the <u>love</u> of God. These you ought to have done, without leaving the others undone. 43 Woe to you Pharisees! For you <u>love</u> the best seats in the synagogues and greetings in the marketplaces.
- Luke 16:13,14 No servant can serve two masters; for either he will hate the one and <u>love</u> the other, or else he will be loyal to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and mammon. 14 Now the Pharisees, who were <u>lovers</u> of money, also heard all these things, and they derided Him.
- Luke 20:46 Beware of the scribes, who desire to go around in long robes, <u>love</u> greetings in the marketplaces, the best seats in the synagogues, and the best places at feasts,
- John 3:16 For God so <u>loved</u> the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.
- John 3:19 And this is the condemnation, that the Light has come into the world, and men <u>loved</u> darkness rather than Light, because their deeds were evil.
- John 3:35 The Father loves the Son, and has given all things into His hand.

- John 5:20 For the Father <u>loves</u> the Son, and shows Him all things that He Himself does; and He will show Him greater works than these, that you may marvel.
- John 5:42 But I know you, that you do not have the <u>love</u> of God in you.
- John 8:42 Jesus said to them, If God were your Father, you would <u>love</u> Me, for I proceeded forth and came from God; nor have I come of Myself, but He sent Me.
- John 10:17 Therefore My Father <u>loves</u> Me, because I lay down My life that I may take it again.
- John 11:3 Therefore the sisters sent to Him, saying, Lord, behold, he whom You love is sick.
- John 11:5 Now Jesus <u>loved</u> Martha and her sister and Lazarus.
- John 11:36 Then the Jews said, See how He loved him!
- John 12:25 He who <u>loves</u> his life will lose it, and he who hates his life in this world will keep it for eternal life.
- John 12:43 for they <u>loved</u> the praise of men more than the praise of God.
- John 13:1 Now before the feast of the Passover, when Jesus knew that His hour had come that He should depart from this world to the Father, having <u>loved</u> His own who were in the world, He <u>loved</u> them to the end.
- John 13:23 Now there was leaning on Jesus' bosom one of His disciples, whom Jesus loved.
- John 13:34,35 A new commandment I give to you, that you <u>love</u> one another; as I have <u>loved</u> you, that you also <u>love</u> one another. 35 By this all will know that you are My disciples, if you have <u>love</u> for one another.
- John 14:15 If you love Me, keep My commandments.
- John 14:21 He who has My commandments and keeps them, it is he who <u>loves</u> Me. And he who <u>loves</u> Me will be <u>loved</u> by My Father, and I will <u>love</u> him and manifest Myself to him.
- John 14:23,24 Jesus answered and said to him, If anyone <u>loves</u> Me, he will keep My Word; and My Father will <u>love</u> him, and We will come to him and make Our home with him. 24 He who does not <u>love</u> Me does not keep My Words; and the Word which you hear is not Mine but the Father's Who sent Me.
- John 14:28 You have heard Me say to you, I am going away and coming *back* to you. If you <u>loved</u> Me, you would rejoice because I said, I am going to the Father, for My Father is greater than I.
- John 14:31 But that the world may know that I <u>love</u> the Father, and as the Father gave Me commandment, so I do. Arise, let us go from here.
- John 15:9,10 As the Father <u>loved</u> Me, I also have <u>loved</u> you; abide in My <u>love</u>.

  10 If you keep My commandments, you will abide in My <u>love</u>, just as I have kept My Father's commandments and abide in His <u>love</u>.
- John 15:12,13 This is My commandment, that you love one another as I have

- <u>loved</u> you. 13 Greater <u>love</u> has no one than this, than to lay down one's life for his friends.
- John 15:17 These things I command you, that you love one another.
- John 15:19 If you were of the world, the world would <u>love</u> its own. Yet because you are not of the world, but I chose you out of the world, therefore the world hates you.
- John 16:27 for the Father Himself <u>loves</u> you, because you have <u>loved</u> Me, and have believed that I came forth from God.
- John 17:23,24,26 I in them, and You in Me; that they may be made perfect in one, and that the world may know that You have sent Me, and have <u>loved</u> them as You have <u>loved</u> Me. 24 Father, I desire that they also whom You gave Me may be with Me where I am, that they may behold My glory which You have given Me; for You <u>loved</u> Me before the foundation of the world. 26 And I have declared to them Your Name, and will declare *it*, that the love with which You loved Me may be in them, and I in them.
- John 19:26 When Jesus therefore saw His mother, and the disciple whom He <u>loved</u> standing by, He said to His mother, Woman, behold your son!
- John 20:2 Then she ran and came to Simon Peter, and to the other disciple, whom Jesus <u>loved</u>, and said to them, They have taken away the Lord out of the tomb, and we do not know where they have laid Him.
- John 21:7 Therefore that disciple whom Jesus <u>loved</u> said to Peter, It is the Lord! Now when Simon Peter heard that it was the Lord, he put on *his* outer garment (for he had removed it), and plunged into the sea.
- John 21:15-17 So when they had eaten breakfast, Jesus said to Simon Peter, Simon, son of Jonah, do you love Me more than these? He said to Him, Yes, Lord; You know that I love You. He said to him, Feed My lambs. 16 He said to him again a second time, Simon, son of Jonah, do you love Me? He said to Him, Yes, Lord; You know that I love You. He said to him, Tend My sheep. 17 He said to him the third time, Simon, son of Jonah, do you love Me? Peter was grieved because He said to him the third time, Do you love Me? And he said to Him, Lord, You know all things; You know that I love You. Jesus said to him, Feed My sheep.
- John 21:20 Then Peter, turning around, saw the disciple whom Jesus <u>loved</u> following, who also had leaned on His breast at the supper, and said, Lord, who is the one who betrays You?
