- 1 John 4:1 Beloved, believe not every spirit, but try the spirits whether they are of God: because many false prophets are gone out into the world.
- 1 John 2:28 & now, little children, abide in Him; that, when He shall appear, we may have confidence, & not be ashamed before Him at His coming.

Romans 14:12 So then every one of us shall give account of himself to God.

Daniel 10 Referred to the battle in Heavenlies.
