

Pretending Not To Know God - Romans 1D

Luke 9:26 For whosoever shall be ashamed of Me and of My Words, of him shall the Son of Man be ashamed, when He shall come in His own glory, and in His Father's, and of the Holy angels.

Matthew 10:37 He that loveth father or mother more than Me is not worthy of Me: and he that loveth son or daughter more than Me is not worthy of Me.

1 Samuel 2:29 Wherefore kick ye (Eli) at My sacrifice and at Mine offering, which I have commanded in My habitation; and honourest thy sons above Me, to make yourselves fat with the chiefest of all the offerings of Israel My people?

Romans 1:20 (NKJV) For since the creation of the world His invisible *attributes* are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, *even* His eternal power and Godhead, so that they are without excuse,

Habakkuk 2:4 Behold, his soul which is lifted up is not upright in him: but the just shall live by his faith.

Strong's #517 aoratos *ah-or'-at-os* AV-invisible 4, invisible things 1; 5 1) unseen, or that which can not be seen, e.g. invisible.

Colossians 1:15 Who is the Image of the invisible <517> God, the Firstborn of every creature:

Mark 9 Summarized of the Transfiguration of Jesus on the Mount.

Colossians 1:16 For by Him were all things created, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible <517>, whether *they be* thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: all things were created by Him, and for Him:
