- 1 John 5:1 (NKJV) Whoever believes that Jesus is the Christ is born of God, and everyone who loves Him Who begot also loves Him Who is begotten of Him.
- Matthew 5:44 But I say unto you, Love your enemies, bless them that curse you, do good to them that hate you, and pray for them which despitefully use you, and persecute you;

- Acts 19 Summarized of the 7 Sons of Sceva false exorcists. - 1 John 5:8 (AV) And there are three that bear witness in earth, the Spirit, and the water, and the Blood: and these three agree in one.
- 1 John 5:8 (NKJV) And there are three that bear witness on earth: the Spirit, the water, and the Blood; and these three agree as one.
- Compaired how the Holy Spirit was given to a few special people in the Old Testament verses in the New Testament it is in all Believers.
- 1 Samuel 16:14 But the Spirit of the LORD departed from Saul, and an evil spirit from the LORD troubled him.
- Ephesians 1:13,14 In Whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the Word of

- Truth, the gospel of your salvation: in Whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that Holy Spirit of promise, 14 Which is the earnest of our inheritance until the redemption of the purchased possession, unto the praise of His glory.
- Ephesians 4:30 And grieve not the Holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption.
