Walk In Truth - 3 John 1A

- John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by Me.
- Referred to God's instructions in Titus 1.
- 3 John 1:1-14 (AV) & (NKJV)
- 3John 1:1(AV) The elder unto the wellbeloved Gaius, whom I love in the truth.
- 3 John 1:1 (NKJV) THE ELDER, To the beloved Gaius, whom I love in truth:
- 3 John 1:2 (AV) Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth.
- 3 John 1:2 (NKJV) Beloved, I pray that you may prosper in all things and be in health, just as your soul prospers.
- James 4:3 Ye ask, and receive not, because ye ask amiss, that ye may consume it upon your lusts.
- Exodus 20:17 Thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's house, thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's wife, nor his manservant, nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his ass, nor any thing that is thy neighbour's.
- Matthew 10:37 He that loveth father or mother more than Me is not worthy of Me: and he that loveth son or daughter more than Me is not worthy of Me.
- Referred to Godly Rich men Abraham & Lot, Job, & R.G. LeTourneau.
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- Daniel 9:8 (AV) O Lord, to us belongeth confusion of face, to our kings, to our princes, and to our fathers, because we have sinned against Thee.
- Mark 3:27 No man can enter into a strong man's house, and spoil his goods, except he will first bind the strong man; and then he will spoil his house.
- Matthew 18:18 Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.
- Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;

- 3 John 1:3 (NKJV) For I rejoiced greatly when brethren (Believers) came and testified of the truth *that is* in you, just as <u>you walk in the truth</u>.
- Matthew 13:23 But he that received seed into the good ground is he that heareth the Word, and understandeth it; which also beareth fruit, and bringeth forth, some an hundredfold, some sixty, some thirty.
- Luke 16:13 No servant can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one.

- and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. Ye cannot serve God and mammon.
- Romans 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.
- Ephesians 4:28 Let him that stole steal no more: but rather let him labour, working with his hands the thing which is good, that he may have to give to him that needeth.
- John 8:36 If the Son therefore shall make you free, ye shall be free indeed.
- 3 John 1:4 (AV) I have no greater joy than to hear that my <u>children walk in</u>

 <u>truth.</u>
 3 John 1:4 (NKJV) I have
 no greater joy than to hear that my <u>children walk in truth.</u>
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents & scorpions, & over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- Romans 16:20 And the God of peace shall bruise Satan under your feet shortly. The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you. Amen.
- Isaiah 35:8 And an highway shall be there, and a way, and it shall be called The way of holiness; the unclean shall not pass over it; but it shall be for those: the wayfaring men, though fools, shall not err therein.
- 3 John 1:5 (AV) Beloved, thou doest faithfully whatsoever thou doest to the brethren, and to strangers;
 3 John 1:5 (NKJV) Beloved, you do faithfully whatever you do for the brethren and for strangers,
- 1 Corinthians 16:15 I beseech you, brethren, (ye know the house of Stephanas, that it is the firstfruits of Achaia, and that they have addicted themselves to the ministry of the saints,)
- 1 Thesalonians 2:9 For ye remember, brethren, our labour and travail: for labouring night and day, because we would not be chargeable unto any of you, we preached unto you the gospel of God.
- 1 Timothy 5:18 For the scripture saith, Thou shalt not muzzle the ox that treadeth out the corn. And, The labourer is worthy of his reward.
- 1 Corinthians 8:9 But take heed lest by any means this liberty of yours become a stumblingblock to them that are weak.
- Acts 4-6 Referred to Christians sharing all.
- 1 Timothy 5:8 But if any provide not for his own, and specially for those of his own house, he hath denied the faith, and is worse than an infidel.
- Mark 14:7 For ye have the poor with you always, and whensoever ye will ye may do them good: but me ye have not always.
- Referred to Jesus ministering in the Gospel of John how Jesus reveals Himself first as a Good Man, then as a Prophet, then as the Messiah.
- John 6:15 When Jesus therefore perceived that they would come and take Him by force, to make Him a king, He departed again into a mountain Himself alone.

- 3 John 1:6 (AV) Which have borne witness of thy charity before the church: whom if thou bring forward on their journey after a Godly sort, thou shalt do well:

 3 John 1:6 (NKJV) who have borne witness of your love before the church. If you send them forward on their journey in a manner worthy of God, you will do well,
- 3 John 1:7 (AV) Because that for his name's sake they went forth, taking nothing of the Gentiles.

 3 John 1:7 (NKJV) because they went forth for His Name's sake, taking nothing from the Gentiles.
- 3 John 1:8 (AV) We therefore ought to receive such, that we might be fellowhelpers to the truth.

 3 John 1:8 (NKJV) We therefore ought to receive such, that we may become fellow workers for the truth.
- 1 Timothy 5:10 (Elder widows) Well reported of for good works; if she have brought up children, if she have lodged strangers, if she have washed the saints' feet, if she have relieved the afflicted, if she have diligently followed every good work.
- 3 John 1:9 (AV) I wrote unto the church: but Diotrephes, who loveth to have the preeminence among them, receiveth us not.
- 3 John 1:9 (NKJV) I wrote to the church, but Diotrephes, who loves to have the preeminence among them, does not receive us.
- Luke 14:8.9 When thou art bidden of any man to a wedding, sit not down in the highest room; lest a more honourable man than thou be bidden of him; 9 And he that bade thee and him come and say to thee, Give this man place; and thou begin with shame to take the lowest room.
- Matthew 7:15 Beware of false prophets, which come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravening wolves.
- 3 John 1:10 (AV) Wherefore, if I come, I will remember his deeds which he doeth, prating against us with malicious words: and not content therewith, neither doth he himself receive the brethren, and forbiddeth them that would, and casteth *them* out of the church.
- 3 John 1:10 (NKJV) Therefore, if I come, I will call to mind his deeds which he does, prating against us with malicious words. And not content with that, he himself does not receive the brethren, and forbids those who wish to, putting *them* out of the church.
- 1 Timothy 3 Referred to God's requirements for Pastors.
- Galatians 2:11-14 But when Peter was come to Antioch, I withstood him to the face, because he was to be blamed. 12 For before that certain came from James, he did eat with the Gentiles: but when they were come, he withdrew and separated himself, fearing them which were of the circumcision. 13 And the other Jews dissembled likewise with him; insomuch that Barnabas also was carried away with their dissimulation. 14 But when I saw that they walked not uprightly according to the truth of

- the gospel, I said unto Peter before them all, If thou, being a Jew, livest after the manner of Gentiles, and not as do the Jews, why compellest thou the Gentiles to live as do the Jews?
- Titus 3:10 A man that is an heretick after the first and second admonition reject;
- Matthew 7:21 Not every one that saith unto Me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of My Father which is in heaven.
- 3 John 1:11 (AV) Beloved, follow not that which is evil, but that which is good. He that doeth good is of God: but he that doeth evil hath not seen God.
- 3 John 1:11 (NKJV) Beloved, do not imitate what is evil, but what is good. He who does good is of God, but he who does evil has not seen God.
- Titus 2:3-5 The aged women likewise, that they be in behaviour as becometh holiness, not false accusers, not given to much wine, teachers of good things; 4 That they may teach the young women to be sober, to love their husbands, to love their children, 5 To be discreet, chaste, keepers at home, good, obedient to their own husbands, that the Word of God be not blasphemed.
- 3 John 1:12 (AV) Demetrius hath good report of all *men*, and of the truth itself: yea, and we *also* bear record; and ye know that our record is true.
- 3John 1:12 (NKJV) Demetrius has a *good* testimony from all, & from the truth itself. And we also bear witness, and you know that our testimony is true.
- Acts 11:23 Who, when he came, and had seen the grace of God, was glad, and exhorted them all, that with purpose of heart they would cleave unto the Lord.
- 3 John 1:13 (AV) I had many things to write, but I will not with ink and pen write unto thee:

 3 John 1:13 (NKJV) I had many things to write, but I do not wish to write to you with pen and ink;
- 3 John 1:14 (AV) But I trust I shall shortly see thee, & we shall speak face to face. Peace be to thee. Our friends salute thee. Greet the friends by name.
- 3 John 1:14 (NKJV) but I hope to see you shortly, and we shall speak face to face. Peace to you. Our friends greet you. Greet the friends by name.

Referred to Paul's missionary journeys.

- 3 John 1:2 (NKJV) Beloved, I pray that you may prosper in all things and be in health, just as your soul prospers.
- Philippians 2:12 Wherefore, my beloved, as ye have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your own <u>salvation</u> with <u>fear</u> and <u>trembling</u>.

Referred to the false doctrine of loss of salvation.

1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

- John 8:11 She said, No man, Lord. And Jesus said unto her, Neither do I condemn thee: go, and sin no more.
- John 5:14 Afterward Jesus findeth him in the temple, and said unto him, Behold, thou art made whole: sin no more, lest a worse thing come unto thee.
- John 9:2,3 And his disciples asked him, saying, Master, who did sin, this man, or his parents, that he was born blind? 3 Jesus answered, Neither hath this man sinned, nor his parents: but that the works of God should be made manifest in him.
- John 8:7,10,11 So when they continued asking him, he lifted up himself, and said unto them, He that is without sin among you, let him first cast a stone at her. 10 When Jesus had lifted up himself, and saw none but the woman, he said unto her, Woman, where are those thine accusers? hath no man condemned thee? 11 She said, No man, Lord. And Jesus said unto her, Neither do I condemn thee: go, and sin no more.
- Psalms 23:3 He restoreth my soul: He leadeth me in the paths of righteousness for His Name's sake.
- 2 Peter 2:8 (For that righteous man (Lot) dwelling among them, in seeing and hearing, vexed his righteous soul from day to day with their unlawful deeds;)
- Matthew 11:28-30 Come unto Me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. 29 Take My yoke upon you, and learn of Me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls. 30 For My yoke is easy, and My burden is light.
- Referred to the Judges of Israelites turning from God & being judged longer each time, then repenting & God freeing them, etc.
- 1 Chronicles 4:9,10 And Jabez was more honourable than his brethren: and his mother called his name Jabez, saying, Because I bare him with sorrow. 10 And Jabez called on the God of Israel, saying, Oh that Thou wouldest bless me indeed, and enlarge my coast, and that Thine hand might be with me, and that Thou wouldest keep *me* from evil, that it may not grieve me! And God granted him that which he requested.
- 1 Kings 3:9 Give therefore thy servant an understanding heart to judge thy people, that I may discern between good and bad: for who is able to judge this thy so great a people?
- John 17:15 I pray not that thou shouldest take them out of the world, but that thou shouldest keep them from the evil.
