Prosperity - Godly Or Not - 2 Chronicles 24

- 1 John 4:1 Beloved, believe not every spirit, but try the spirits whether they are of God: because many false prophets are gone out into the world.
- 1 Kings 22:22 And the LORD said unto him, Wherewith? And he said, I will go forth, and I will be a lying spirit in the mouth of all his prophets. And He said, Thou shalt persuade him, and prevail also: go forth, and do so.
- 2 Chronicles 24:20 And the <u>Spirit</u> of God came upon Zechariah the son of Jehoiada the priest, which stood above the people, and said unto them, Thus saith God, Why transgress ye the commandments of the LORD, that <u>ye cannot prosper</u>? because ye have forsaken the LORD, He hath also forsaken you.
- Hebrews 5:14 But strong meat belongeth to them that are of full age, even those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.
- Genesis 24:21 And the man wondering at her held his peace, to wit <u>whether</u> the LORD had made his journey prosperous or not.
- Genesis 24:40 And he said unto me, <u>The LORD</u>, <u>before whom I walk</u>, <u>will send</u>
 <u>His angel with thee</u>, <u>and prosper thy way</u>; and thou shalt take a wife for my son of my kindred, and of my father's house:
- Genesis 24:42 And I came this day unto the well, and said, O LORD God of my master Abraham, if now <u>Thou do prosper my way</u> which I go:
- Genesis 24:56 And he said unto them, Hinder me not, seeing the LORD hath prospered my way; send me away that I may go to my master.
- Genesis 39:,3 And the LORD was with Joseph, and he was a <u>prosperous man</u>; and he was in the house of his master the Egyptian. 3 And his master saw that the LORD was with him, and that <u>the LORD made all that he did to prosper in his hand</u>.
- Genesis 39:23 The keeper of the prison looked not to any thing *that was* under his hand; because the LORD was with him, and *that* which he did, the <u>LORD</u> made *it* to prosper.
- Numbers 14:41 And Moses said, Wherefore now do ye <u>transgress the</u> <u>commandment of the LORD? but it shall not prosper</u>.
- Deuteronomy 23:6 Thou shalt not seek their peace nor their <u>prosperity</u> all thy days for ever.
- Deuteronomy 18:9-14 When thou art come into the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee, thou shalt not learn to do after the abominations of those nations. ...
- Romans 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

- 1 Corinthians 15:33 Be not deceived: evil communications corrupt good manners.
- Deuteronomy 28:29 And thou shalt grope at noonday, as the blind gropeth in darkness, and thou shalt not prosper in thy ways: and thou shalt be only oppressed and spoiled evermore, and no man shall save *thee*.
- 1 Samuel 15:22 And Samuel said, Hath the LORD as great delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices, as in obeying the voice of the LORD? Behold, to obey is better than sacrifice, and to hearken than the fat of rams.
- 1 Chronicles 10:13 So Saul died for his transgression which he committed against the LORD, even against the Word of the LORD, which he kept not, & also for asking counsel of one that had a familiar spirit, to enquire of it;
- Deuteronomy 29:9 Keep therefore the words of this covenant, and do them, that ye may <u>prosper</u> in all that ye do.
- Joshua 1:7 Only be thou strong and very courageous, that thou mayest observe to do according to all the law, which Moses My servant commanded thee: turn not from it *to* the right hand or *to* the left, that thou mayest <u>prosper</u> whithersoever thou goest.
- Hebrews 13:8 Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever.
- Matthew 24:35 Heaven and earth shall pass away, but My Words shall not pass away.
- Joshua 1:8 This <u>Book of the Law</u> shall not depart out of thy mouth; but thou shalt meditate therein day and night, that thou mayest observe to do according to all that is written therein: for then thou shalt <u>make thy way prosperous</u>, and then thou shalt have good success.
- James 1:22 But be ye doers of the Word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves.
- Judges 4:24 the hand of the <u>children of Israel prospered</u>, & prevailed against Jabin the king of Canaan, until they had destroyed Jabin king of Canaan.
- Judges 4 Summarized of God winning over Sisera for Deborah.
- Judges 18:5 And they said unto him, Ask counsel, we pray thee, of God, that we may know whether our way which we go shall be <u>prosperous</u>.
- 1 Samuel 25:6 And thus shall ye say to him that <u>liveth in prosperity</u>, Peace be both to thee, & peace be to thine house, & peace be unto all that thou has.
- 1 Samuel 25 Summarized of David & Nabal.
- 2 Samuel 11:7 And when Uriah was come unto him, David demanded *of him* how Joab did, and how the people did, and <u>how the war prospered</u>.
- 1 Kings 2:3 And keep the charge of the LORD thy God, to walk in His ways, to keep His statutes, and His commandments, and His judgments, and His testimonies, as it is written in the Law of Moses, that thou mayest prosper in all that thou doest, and whithersoever thou turnest thyself:
- Deuteronomy 17:17-19 Neither shall he multiply wives to himself, that his heart turn not away: neither shall he greatly multiply to himself silver and

- gold. 18 And it shall be, when he sitteth upon the throne of his kingdom, that he shall write him a copy of this law in a book out of that which is before the priests the Levites: 19 And it shall be with him, and he shall read therein all the days of his life: that he may learn to fear the LORD his God, to keep all the words of this law and these statutes, to do them:
- 1 Kings 10:7 Howbeit I believed not the words, until I came, and mine eyes had seen *it*: and, behold, the half was not told me: <u>thy wisdom and prosperity exceedeth</u> the fame which I heard.
- Acts 13:22 And when He had removed him, He raised up unto them David to be their king; to whom also He gave testimony, & said, I have found David the son of Jesse, a man after Mine own heart, which shall fulfil all My will.
- 1 Kings 3:12 Behold, I have done according to thy words: lo, I have given thee a wise and an understanding heart; so that there was none like thee before thee, neither after thee shall any arise like unto thee.
- 1 Kings 22:12 And all the prophets prophesied so, saying, Go up to Ramothgilead, and <u>prosper</u>: for the LORD shall deliver *it* into the king's hand.
- 1 Kings 18:4 For it was so, when Jezebel cut off the prophets of the LORD, that Obadiah took an hundred prophets, and hid them by fifty in a cave, and fed them with bread and water.)
- 1 Kings 22:15 So he came to the king. & the king said unto him, Micaiah, shall we go against Ramothgilead to battle, or shall we forbear? & he answered him, Go, and <u>prosper</u>: for the LORD shall deliver *it* into the hand of the king.
- 1 Kings 22:22 And the LORD said unto him, Wherewith? And he said, I will go forth, and I will be a lying spirit in the mouth of all his prophets. And He said, Thou shalt persuade him, and prevail also: go forth, and do so.
- 2 Kings 18:7 And the LORD was with him; and he prospered whithersoever he went forth: & he rebelled against the king of Assyria, & served him not.
- 1 Chronicles 22:11 Now, my son, the LORD be with thee; and prosper thou, and build the house of the LORD thy God, as He hath said of thee.
- 1 Chronicles 22:13 Then shalt thou <u>prosper</u>, if thou takest heed to fulfil the statutes and judgments which the LORD charged Moses with concerning Israel: be strong, and of good courage; dread not, nor be dismayed.
- Joshua 1:9 Have not I commanded thee? Be strong and of a good courage; be not afraid, neither be thou dismayed: for the LORD thy God is with thee whithersoever thou goest.
- 1 Chronicles 29:23 Then Solomon sat on the throne of the LORD as king instead of David his father, and <u>prospered</u>; and all Israel obeyed him.
- Joshua 3:7 And the LORD said unto Joshua, This day will I begin to magnify thee in the sight of all Israel, that they may know that, as I was with Moses, so I will be with thee.
- 2 Chronicles 7:11 Thus Solomon finished the house of the LORD, and the king's house: and all that came into Solomon's heart to make in the house

- of the LORD, and in his own house, he prosperously effected.
- 2Chronicles 13:12 behold, God himself *is* with us for *our* Captain, & His priests with sounding trumpets to cry alarm against you. O children of Israel, fight ye not against the LORD God of your fathers; for ye shall not <u>prosper</u>.
- 2 Chronicles 14:7 Therefore he said unto Judah, Let us build these cities, and make about *them* walls, and towers, gates, and bars, *while* the land *is* yet before us; because we have sought the LORD our God, we have sought *Him*, and He hath given us rest on every side. So they built and <u>prospered</u>. Genesis 3 Referred to the fall of mankind.
- Psalms 147:14 He maketh peace in thy borders, and filleth thee with the finest of the wheat.
- 2 Chronicles 18:11 all the prophets prophesied so, saying, Go up to Ramothgilead, and <u>prosper</u>: for the LORD shall deliver *it* into the hand of the king.
- 2 Chronicles 18:14 And when he was come to the king, the king said unto him, Micaiah, shall we go to Ramothgilead to battle, or shall I forbear? And he said, Go ye up, and prosper, and they shall be delivered into your hand.
- 2 Chronicles 20:20 they rose early in the morning, & went forth into the wilderness of Tekoa: & as they went forth, Jehoshaphat stood & said, Hear me, O Judah, and ye inhabitants of Jerusalem; Believe in the LORD your God, so shall ye be established; believe His prophets, so shall ye prosper.
- 2 Chronicles 20:17 Ye shall not need to fight in this battle: set yourselves, stand ye still, and see the salvation of the LORD with you, O Judah and Jerusalem: fear not, nor be dismayed; to morrow go out against them: for the LORD will be with you.
- 2 Chronicles 24:20 the Spirit of God came upon Zechariah the son of Jehoiada the priest, which stood above the people, and said unto them, Thus saith God, Why transgress ye the commandments of the LORD, that ye cannot prosper? because ye have forsaken the LORD, He hath also forsaken you.
- 2 Chronicles 26:5 And he sought God in the days of Zechariah, who had understanding in the visions of God: and as long as he sought the LORD, God made him to <u>prosper</u>.
- 2 Chronicles 31:21 And in every work that he began in the service of the house of God, and in the law, and in the commandments, to seek his God, he did *it* with all his heart, and prospered.
- 2 Chronicles 32:30 This same Hezekiah also stopped the upper watercourse of Gihon, and brought it straight down to the west side of the city of David. And Hezekiah <u>prospered</u> in all his works.
- Ezra 5:8 Be it known unto the king, that we went into the province of Judea, to the house of the great God, which is built with great stones, & timber is laid in the walls, and this work goeth fast on, and <u>prospereth</u> in their hands.
- Ezra 1:2 Thus saith Cyrus king of Persia, The LORD God of heaven hath given me all the kingdoms of the earth; and He hath charged me to build Him an

- house at Jerusalem, which is in Judah.
- Ezra 6:14 And the elders of the Jews builded, and they <u>prospered</u> through the prophesying of Haggai the prophet and Zechariah the son of Iddo. And they builded, and finished *it*, according to the commandment of the God of Israel, and according to the commandment of Cyrus, and Darius, and Artaxerxes king of Persia.
- Nehemiah 1:11 O Lord, I beseech thee, let now Thine ear be attentive to the prayer of Thy servant, and to the prayer of Thy servants, who desire to fear Thy Name: and prosper, I pray thee, Thy servant this day, and grant him mercy in the sight of this man. For I was the king's cupbearer.
- 2 Corinthians 9:7 Every man according as he purposeth in his heart, so let him give; not grudgingly, or of necessity: for God loveth a cheerful giver.
- Nehemiah 2:20 Then answered I them, and said unto them, The God of heaven, He will <u>prosper</u> us; therefore we His servants will arise and build: but ye have no portion, nor right, nor memorial, in Jerusalem.
- Job 8:6 If thou *wert* pure and upright; surely now He would awake for thee, and make the habitation of thy righteousness <u>prosperous</u>.
- Job 1:21 And said, Naked came I out of my mother's womb, and naked shall I return thither: the <u>LORD</u> gave, and the LORD hath taken away; blessed be the Name of the LORD.
- Job 42:10 And the LORD turned the captivity of Job, when he prayed for his friends: also the LORD gave Job twice as much as he had before.
- Job 9:4 *He is* wise in heart, and mighty in strength: who hath hardened *himself* against Him, and hath prospered?
- Job 12:6 The tabernacles of robbers <u>prosper</u>, and they that provoke God are secure; into whose hand God bringeth *abundantly*.
- Job 15:21 A dreadful sound *is* in his ears: in <u>prosperity</u> the destroyer shall come upon him.
- Job 36:11 If they obey and serve *Him*, they shall spend their days in prosperity, and their years in pleasures.
- Psalms 1:3 And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper.
- Psalms 30:6 And in my <u>prosperity</u> I said, I shall never be moved.
- Psalms 35:27 Let them shout for joy, and be glad, that favour my righteous cause: yea, let them say continually, Let the LORD be magnified, Which hath pleasure in the prosperity of his servant.
- Psalms 37:7 Rest in the LORD, and wait patiently for Him: fret not thyself because of him who <u>prospereth</u> in his way, because of the man who bringeth wicked devices to pass.
- Psalms 45:4 And in <u>Thy majesty ride prosperously</u> because of truth & meekness & righteousness; and Thy right hand shall teach thee terrible things.

- Revelation 19:11 Referred to Jesus' return.
- Psalms 73:3 For I was envious at the foolish, *when* I saw the <u>prosperity</u> of the wicked.
- Revelation 20:15 And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire.
- Psalms 73:12 Behold, these *are* the ungodly, who <u>prosper</u> in the world; they increase *in* riches.
- Matthew 6:20 But lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust doth corrupt, & where thieves do not break through nor steal:
- Psalms 118:25 Save now, I beseech Thee, O LORD: O LORD, I beseech Thee, send now <u>prosperity</u>.
- James 4:3 Ye ask, and receive not, because ye ask amiss, that ye may consume it upon your lusts.
- Psalms 122:6,7 Pray for the peace of Jerusalem: they shall <u>prosper</u> that love thee. 7 <u>Peace</u> be within thy walls, <u>and prosperity</u> within thy palaces.
- Proverbs 1:32 For the turning away of the simple shall slay them, and the prosperity of fools shall destroy them.
- Proverbs 17:8 A gift *is as* a precious stone in the eyes of him that hath it: whithersoever it turneth, it prospereth.
- 1 Kings 10:10 And she gave the king an 120 talents of gold, and of spices very great store, and precious stones: there came no more such abundance of spices as these which the queen of Sheba gave to king Solomon.
- 1 Kings 10:13 And king Solomon gave unto the queen of Sheba all her desire, whatsoever she asked, beside that which Solomon gave her of his royal bounty. So she turned and went to her own country, she and her servants.
- Proverbs 28:13 <u>He that covereth his sins shall not prosper</u>: but whoso confesseth and forsaketh *them* shall have mercy.
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- Ecclesiastes 7:14 In the day of <u>prosperity</u> be joyful, but in the day of adversity consider: God also hath set the one over against the other, to the end that man should find nothing after him.
- Ecclesiastes 11:6 In the morning sow thy seed, and in the evening withhold not thine hand: for thou knowest not whether shall <u>prosper</u>, either this or that, or whether they both *shall be* alike good.
- Isaiah 48:15 I, even I, have spoken; yea, I have called him: I have brought him, and he shall make his way <u>prosperous</u>.
- Referred to God sending foreign invaders to judge sinful Israel.
- Isaiah 53:10 Yet it pleased the LORD to bruise Him; He hath put *Him* to grief: when Thou shalt make His soul an offering for sin, He shall see *His* seed, He shall prolong *His* days, and the <u>pleasure of the LORD shall prosper in</u> His hand.

- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents & scorpions, & over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;
- Isaiah 54:17 No weapon that is formed against thee shall <u>prosper</u>; and every tongue *that* shall rise against thee in judgment thou shalt condemn. <u>This is</u> the heritage of the servants of the LORD, and their righteousness *is* of Me, saith the LORD.
- Isaiah 55:11 So shall My Word be that goeth forth out of My mouth: it shall not return unto Me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper *in the thing* whereto I sent it.
- Psalms 109 Referred to bit being mis-used as witchcraft.
- Jeremiah 2:37 Yea, thou shalt go forth from him, and thine hands upon thine head: for the <u>LORD hath rejected thy confidences</u>, and thou shalt not prosper in them.
- Summarized of the false prophets versus God's prophet Jeremiah.
- Acts 19 Summarized of the seven sons of Sceva false exorcists. V13 Then certain of the vagabond Jews, exorcists, took upon them to call over them which had evil spirits the name of the Lord Jesus, saying, We adjure you by Jesus whom Paul preacheth.
- Jeremiah 5:28 They are waxen fat, they shine: yea, they overpass the deeds of the wicked: they judge not the cause, the cause of the fatherless, yet they <u>prosper</u>; and the right of the needy do they not judge.
- Jeremiah 10:21 the pastors are become brutish, and have not sought the Lord: therefore they shall not <u>prosper</u>, and all their flocks shall be scattered.
- Jeremiah 12:1 Righteous *art* Thou, O LORD, when I plead with Thee: yet let me talk with Thee of *Thy* judgments: Wherefore doth the way of the wicked prosper? *wherefore* are all they happy that deal very treacherously?
- Jeremiah 20:11 But the LORD *is* with me as a mighty terrible one: therefore my persecutors shall stumble, and they shall not prevail: they shall be greatly ashamed; for they shall not <u>prosper</u>: *their* everlasting confusion shall never be forgotten.
- Jeremiah 22:21 I spake to thee in thy <u>prosperity</u>; *but* thou said, I will not hear. This *has been* thy manner from thy youth, that thou obeyed not My voice.
- Jeremiah 22:30 Thus saith the LORD, Write ye this man childless, a man *that* shall not <u>prosper</u> in his days: for no man of his seed shall <u>prosper</u>, sitting upon the throne of David, and ruling any more in Judah.
- Jeremiah 23:5 Behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that I will raise unto David a righteous Branch, and a King shall reign and <u>prosper</u>, and shall execute judgment and justice in the earth.
- Jeremiah 32:5 And he shall lead Zedekiah to Babylon, and there shall he be until I visit him, saith the LORD: though ye fight with the Chaldeans, ye

- shall not <u>prosper</u>.
- Jeremiah 33:9 And it shall be to Me a name of joy, a praise and an honour before all the nations of the earth, which shall hear all the good that I do unto them: and they shall fear and tremble for all the goodness and for all the <u>prosperity</u> that I procure unto it.
- Lamentations 1:5 Her adversaries are the chief, her enemies <u>prosper</u>; for the LORD hath afflicted her for the multitude of her transgressions: her children are gone into captivity before the enemy.
- Lamentations 3:17 And thou hast removed my soul far off from peace: I forgat prosperity.
- Ezekiel 16:13 Thus wast thou decked with gold & silver; & thy raiment was of fine linen, & silk, & broidered work; thou didst eat fine flour, & honey, & oil: & thou wast exceeding beautiful, & thou didst <u>prosper</u> into a kingdom.
- Ezekiel 17:9,10 Say thou, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Shall it <u>prosper</u>? shall he not pull up the roots thereof, and cut off the fruit thereof, that it wither? it shall wither in all the leaves of her spring, even without great power or many people to pluck it up by the roots thereof. 10 Yea, behold, *being* planted, shall it <u>prosper</u>? shall it not utterly wither, when the east wind toucheth it? it shall wither in the furrows where it grew.
- Ezekiel 17:15 But he rebelled against him in sending his ambassadors into Egypt, that they might give him horses and much people. Shall he <u>prosper</u>? shall he escape that doeth such *things*? or shall he break the covenant, and be delivered?
- Daniel 6:28 So this Daniel <u>prospered</u> in the reign of Darius, and in the reign of Cyrus the Persian.
- Daniel 8:12 And an host was given *him* against the daily *sacrifice* by reason of transgression, and it cast down the truth to the ground; and it practised, and prospered.
- Daniel 8:24,25 And his power shall be mighty, but not by his own power: and he shall destroy wonderfully, and shall <u>prosper</u>, and practise, and shall destroy the mighty and the Holy people. 25 And through his policy also He shall cause craft to <u>prosper</u> in his hand; and he shall magnify *himself* in his heart, and by peace shall destroy many: he shall also stand up against the Prince of princes; but he shall be broken without hand.
- Daniel 11:27 And both these kings' hearts *shall be* to do mischief, and they shall speak lies at one table; but it shall not <u>prosper</u>: for yet the end *shall be* at the time appointed.
- Daniel 11:36 And the king shall do according to his will; and he shall exalt himself, and magnify himself above every god, and shall speak marvellous things against the God of gods, and shall <u>prosper</u> till the indignation be accomplished: for that that is determined shall be done.
- Zechariah 1:17 Cry yet, saying, Thus saith the LORD of hosts; My cities

- through <u>prosperity</u> shall yet be spread abroad; and the LORD shall yet comfort Zion, and shall yet choose Jerusalem.
- Zechariah 7:7 Should ye not hear the Words which the LORD hath cried by the former prophets, when Jerusalem was inhabited & in prosperity, & the cities thereof round about her, when men inhabited the South & the Plain?
- Zechariah 8:12 For the seed *shall be* <u>prosperous</u>; the vine shall give her fruit, & the ground shall give her increase, & the heavens shall give their dew; and I will cause the remnant of this people to possess all these *things*.
- Romans 1:10 Making request, if by any means now at length I might have a <u>prosperous journey by the will of God</u> to come unto you.
- Romans 16:20 And the God of peace shall bruise Satan under your feet shortly. The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you. Amen.
- 1 Corinthians 16:2 Upon the first *day* of the week let every one of you lay by him in store, <u>as *God* hath prospered him</u>, that there be no gatherings when I come.
- Malachi 3:10 Bring ye all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be meat in Mine house, and prove Me now herewith, saith the LORD of hosts, if I will not open you the windows of heaven, and pour you out a blessing, that there shall not be room enough to receive it.
- 3 John 1:2 Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth.
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;
- Psalms 23:3 He restoreth my soul: He leadeth me in the paths of righteousness for His Name's sake.
- Isaiah 58:8 Then shall thy light break forth as the morning, and thine health shall spring forth speedily: and thy righteousness shall go before thee; the glory of the LORD shall be thy rereward.
- Deuteronomy 7:15 And the LORD will take away from thee all sickness, and will put none of the evil diseases of Egypt, which thou knowest, upon thee; but will lay them upon all them that hate thee.
- Exodus 15:26 And said, If thou wilt diligently hearken to the voice of the LORD thy God, and wilt do that which is right in His sight, and wilt give ear to His commandments, and keep all His statutes, I will put none of these diseases upon thee, which I have brought upon the Egyptians: for I am the LORD that healeth thee.
