Genesis 2:17 But of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, thou shalt not eat of it: for in the day that thou eatest thereof thou shalt surely die.

Genesis 3 Summarized of the fall of mankind.

- Romans 2:2 (NKJV) But we know that the judgment of God is according to truth against those who practice such things.
- John 7:24 Judge not according to the appearance, but judge righteous judgment. (no Partiality)
- John 8 Summarized of the account of the woman taken in adultery.
- Matthew 16:4 A wicked and adulterous generation seeketh after a sign; and there shall no sign be given unto it, but the sign of the prophet Jonas. And he left them, and departed.

- Ezekiel 11:19 & 36:26 And I will give them one <u>heart</u>, and I will put a new spirit within you; and I will take the stony <u>heart</u> out of their <u>flesh</u>, and will give them an <u>heart</u> of <u>flesh</u>:
- Acts 7:55 But he, being full of the Holy Ghost, looked stedfastly into heaven, and saw the glory of God, and Jesus standing on the right hand of God,
- Luke 13:34 O Jerusalem, Jerusalem, which killest the prophets, and stonest them that are sent unto thee; how often would I have gathered thy children together, as a hen doth gather her brood under her wings, and ye would not!
- Luke 11:50 That the blood of all the prophets, which was shed from the foundation of the world, may be required of this generation;

- Proverbs 22:24 Make no friendship with an angry man; and with a furious man thou shalt not go:
- Romans 2:9 (AV) Tribulation and anguish, upon every soul of man that doeth evil, of the Jew first, and also of the Gentile;
- Romans 2:9 (NKJV) tribulation and anguish, on every soul of man who does evil, of the Jew first and also of the Greek;
- Matthew 25:30 And cast ye the unprofitable servant into outer darkness: there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth.
- Luke 6 Referred to the parable of the Rich man & Lazarus. V24 And he cried and said, Father Abraham, have mercy on me, and send Lazarus, that he may dip the tip of his finger in water, and cool my tongue; for I am tormented in this flame.
- Acts 17:30 And the times of this ignorance God winked at; but now commandeth all men every where to repent:
