## In The Last Days Perilous Times Shall Come - 2 Timothy 3A

- Matthew 24 Referred to Jesus' warnings on the End Times.
- Mark 13:14 But when ye shall see the abomination of desolation, spoken of by Daniel the prophet, standing where it ought not, (let him that readeth understand,) then let them that be in Judaea flee to the mountains:
- John 15:20 Remember the word that I said unto you, The servant is not greater than his lord. If they have persecuted me, they will also persecute you; if they have kept my saying, they will keep yours also.
- Luke 22:31,32 And the Lord said, Simon, Simon, behold, Satan hath desired to have you, that he may sift you as wheat: 32 But I have prayed for thee, that thy faith fail not: and when thou art converted, strengthen thy brethren.
- 2 Timothy 3:1-14 (AV) & (NKJV)
- 2 Timothy 3:1 (AV) This know also, that in the last days perilous times shall come.

  2 Timothy 3:1 (NKJV) But know this, that in the last days perilous times will come:
- Strongs #5467 chalepos khal-ep-os' AV-fierce 1, perilous 1; 2 1) hard to do, to take, to approach 2) hard to bear, troublesome, dangerous 2a) harsh, fierce, savage.
- 2 Corinthians 10:4 (For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;)
- Ephesians 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.
- 2 Timothy 3:2 (AV) For men shall be lovers of their own selves, covetous, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy,
- 2 Timothy 3:2 (NKJV) For men will be lovers of themselves, lovers of money, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy,
- 1 Timothy 6:10 For the love of money is the root of all evil: which while some coveted after, they have erred from the faith, and pierced themselves through with many sorrows.
- Proverbs 16:18 Pride goes before destruction, & a haughty spirit before a fall. Isaiah 14 & Ezekiel 28 Referred to satan's pride dealt with.
- Luke 12:10 And whosoever shall speak a word against the Son of Man, it shall be forgiven him: but unto him that blasphemeth against the Holy Ghost it shall not be forgiven.
- Romans 1:21 Because that, when they knew God, they glorified Him not as God, neither were thankful; but became vain in their imaginations, and their foolish heart was darkened.
- Matthew 5:15 Neither do men light a candle, and put it under a bushel, but on

- a candlestick; and it giveth light unto all that are in the house.
- Daniel 1:8 But Daniel purposed in his heart that he would not defile himself with the portion of the king's meat, nor with the wine which he drank: therefore he requested of the prince of the eunuchs that he might not defile himself.
- 2 Timothy 3:3 (AV) Without natural affection, trucebreakers, false accusers, incontinent, fierce, despisers of those that are good,
- 2 Timothy 3:3 (NKJV) unloving, unforgiving, slanderers, without self-control, brutal, despisers of good,
- Luke 8 Referred to the Gadarene Demoniac. V28,35 When he saw Jesus, he cried out, and fell down before him, and with a loud voice said, What have I to do with Thee, Jesus, Thou Son of God most high? I beseech Thee, torment me not. 35 Then they went out to see what was done; and came to Jesus, & found the man, out of whom the devils were departed, sitting at the feet of Jesus, clothed, & in his right mind: & they were afraid.
- Ephesians 4:26 Be ye angry, and sin not: let not the sun go down upon your wrath:
- 2 Timothy 3:4 (AV) Traitors, heady, highminded, lovers of pleasures more than lovers of God;
  2 Timothy 3:4 (NKJV) traitors, headstrong, haughty, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God,
- Matthew 18:18 Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.
- Daniel 4 Referred to Nebuchadnezzar's pride dealt with.
- 2 Corinthians 13:5 Examine yourselves, whether ye be in the faith; prove your own selves. Know ye not your own selves, how that Jesus Christ is in you, except ye be reprobates?
- 2 Timothy 3:5 (AV) Having a form of godliness, but denying the power thereof: from such turn away.
- 2 Timothy 3:5 (NKJV) having a form of godliness but denying its power. And from such people turn away!
- Ephesians 4:30 And grieve not the Holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption.
- 1 Thessalonians 5:19 Quench not the Spirit.
- Proverbs 15:5 A fool despiseth his father's instruction: but he that regardeth reproof is prudent.
- 1 Kings 18:37 Hear me, O LORD, hear me, that this people may know that Thou art the LORD God, and that Thou hast turned their heart back again.
- 2 Timothy 3:6 (AV) For of this sort are they which creep into houses, and lead captive silly women laden with sins, led away with divers lusts,
- 2 Timothy 3:6 (NKJV) For of this sort are those who creep into households and make captives of gullible women loaded down with sins, led away by

- various lusts,
- Psalms 23:3 He restoreth my soul: He leadeth me in the paths of righteousness for His Name's sake.
- 2 Timothy 3:7 (AV) Ever learning, and never able to come to the knowledge of the truth.
- 2 Timothy 3:7 (NKJV) always learning and never able to come to the knowledge of the truth.
- 2 Timothy 3:8 (AV) Now as Jannes & Jambres withstood Moses, so do these also resist the truth: men of corrupt minds, reprobate concerning the faith.
- 2 Timothy 3:8 (NKJV) Now as Jannes and Jambres resisted Moses, so do these also resist the truth: men of corrupt minds, disapproved concerning the faith:
- Exodus 7 Summarized of Aaron's rod to a serpent. V12 For they cast down every man his rod, and they became serpents: but Aaron's rod swallowed up their rods.
- Strongs #2389 lannes *ee'-an-nace* AV-Jannes 1; Janna = he vexed 1) He and Jambres, were two Egyptian magicians who in the presence of Pharaoh imitated the miracles of Aaron in order to destroy his influence with the king. The author of the epistle derived their names from the tradition of the Talmudists and the Rabbins.
- Acts 13 Referred to Elimas sorcerer withstanding Paul. V8,11,12 But Elymas the sorcerer (for so is his name by interpretation) withstood them, seeking to turn away the deputy from the faith. 11 And now, behold, the hand of the Lord is upon thee, and thou shalt be blind, not seeing the sun for a season. And immediately there fell on him a mist and a darkness; and he went about seeking some to lead him by the hand. 12 Then the deputy, when he saw what was done, believed, being astonished at the doctrine of the Lord.
- Strongs #2387 lambres *ee-am-brace'* AV-Jambres 1; Jambres = foamy healer 1) he and Jannes, were two Egyptian magicians who in the presence of Pharaoh imitated the miracles of Aaron in order to destroy his influence with the king. The author of the epistle derived their names from the tradition of the Talmudists and the Rabbins.
- 1 Kings 18 Referred to the shoot-out on Mount Carmel.
- Luke 11:24,26 When the unclean spirit is gone out of a man, he walketh through dry places, seeking rest; and finding none, he saith, I will return unto my house whence I came out. 26 Then goeth he, and taketh to him seven other spirits more wicked than himself; and they enter in, and dwell there: and the last state of that man is worse than the first.
- John 10:28,29 And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of My hand. 29 My Father, which gave them Me, is greater than all; and no man is able to pluck them out of

- My Father's hand.
- 2 Corinthians 11:14 And no marvel; for Satan himself is transformed into an angel of light.
- Exodus 7:11 Then Pharaoh also called the wise men and the sorcerers: now the magicians of Egypt, they also did in like manner with their enchantments.
- Exodus 7:22 And the magicians of Egypt did so with their enchantments: and Pharaoh's heart was hardened, neither did he hearken unto them; as the LORD had said.
- Exodus 8:7 And the magicians did so with their enchantments, and brought up frogs upon the land of Egypt.
- Exodus 8:18 And the magicians did so with their enchantments to bring forth lice, but they could not: so there were lice upon man, and upon beast.
- Daniel 2 Summarized of Nebuchadnezzar's dream & God sending the interpretation by Daniel.
- Genesis 18 & 19 Summarized of God dealing with the sins of Sodom & Gomorrah V32 And he said, Oh let not the Lord be angry, and I will speak yet but this once: Peradventure ten (righteous) shall be found there. And He said, I will not destroy it for ten's sake.
- 2 Timothy 3:9 (AV) But they shall proceed no further: for their folly shall be manifest unto all *men*, as theirs also was.
- 2 Timothy 3:9 (NKJV) but they will progress no further, for their folly will be manifest to all, as theirs also was.
- Acts 19 Summarized of the 7 sons of Sceva. V15,16 And the evil spirit answered and said, Jesus I know, and Paul I know; but who are ye? 16 And the man in whom the evil spirit was leaped on them, and overcame them, and prevailed against them, so that they fled out of that house naked and wounded.
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;
- 2 Timothy 3:10 (AV) But thou hast fully known my doctrine, manner of life, purpose, faith, longsuffering, charity, patience,
- 2 Timothy 3:10 (NKJV) But you have carefully followed my doctrine, manner of life, purpose, faith, longsuffering, love, perseverance,
- 2 Corinthians 11 Referred to Paul's Perils list. V26 In journeyings often, in perils of waters, in perils of robbers, in perils by mine own countrymen, in perils by the heathen, in perils in the city, in perils in the wilderness, in perils in the sea, in perils among false brethren;
- Acts 14:19,20 And there came thither certain Jews from Antioch and

- Iconium, who persuaded the people, and, having stoned Paul, drew him out of the city, supposing he had been dead. 20 Howbeit, as the disciples stood round about him, he rose up, and came into the city: and the next day he departed with Barnabas to Derbe.
- 3 John 1: I wrote unto the church: but Diotrephes, who loveth to have the preeminence among them, receiveth us not.
- 2 Timothy 3:11 (AV) Persecutions, afflictions, which came unto me at Antioch, at Iconium, at Lystra; what persecutions I endured: but out of *them* all the Lord delivered me.
- 2 Timothy 3:11 (NKJV) persecutions, afflictions, which happened to me at Antioch, at Iconium, at Lystra, what persecutions I endured. And out of *them* all the Lord delivered me.
- Acts 12 Referred to Peter freed from Prison by God's angel.
- 2 Timothy 3:12 (AV) Yea, and all that will live godly in Christ Jesus shall suffer persecution.
- 2 Timothy 3:12 (NKJV) Yes, and all who desire to live godly in Christ Jesus will suffer persecution.
- John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.
- Galatians 6:1 Brethren, if a man be overtaken in a fault, ye which are spiritual, restore such an one in the spirit of meekness; considering thyself, lest thou also be tempted.
- 2 Timothy 3:13 (AV) But evil men and seducers shall wax worse and worse, deceiving, and being deceived.
- 2 Timothy 3:13 (NKJV) But evil men and impostors will grow worse and worse, deceiving and being deceived.
- Genesis 6:5 And GOD saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually.
- 2 Timothy 3:14 (AV) But continue thou in the things which thou hast learned and hast been assured of, knowing of whom thou hast learned *them*;
- 2 Timothy 3:14 (NKJV) But you must continue in the things which you have learned and been assured of, knowing from whom you have learned *them*,
- 2 Corinthians 10:4 (For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;)
- Ephesians 6:10-18 Referred to using the Gospel Armour.
- Luke 4 Jesus rebuked the devil's temptations with "it is written".
