There Is No Partiality With God 2 - Romans 2C

- Romans 2:11 (NKJV) For there is no partiality with God.
- Galatians 3:28 There is <u>neither Jew</u> nor <u>Greek</u>, there is <u>neither</u> bond nor free, there is <u>neither</u> male nor female: for ye are all one in Christ Jesus.
- Colossians 3:11 Where there is <u>neither Greek</u> nor <u>Jew</u>, circumcision nor uncircumcision, Barbarian, Scythian, bond (slave) *nor* free: but Christ *is* all, and in all.
- Mark15:38 the veil of the temple was rent in twain from the top to thebottom.
- Romans 2:11 (AV) For there is no respect of persons with God.
- Romans 2:11 (NKJV) For there is no partiality with God.
- Jesus received everyone who came to Him in simple faith.
- Romans 3:23 For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;
- Deuteronomy 10:17 For the LORD your God *is* God of gods & Lord of lords, the great God, mighty & awesome, Who shows <u>no partiality</u> nor takes a bribe.
- 2 Chronicles 19:7 Now therefore, let the fear of the LORD be upon you; take care and do *it*, for *there is* no iniquity with the LORD our God, <u>no partiality</u>, nor taking of bribes.
- 1 John 3:3 And every man that hath this hope in Him purifieth himself, even as He is pure. 1 Peter 1:16 it is written, Be ye Holy; for I am Holy.
- Job 37:24 Therefore men fear Him; He shows <u>no partiality</u> to any *who are* wise of heart.
- Acts 10:34 Then Peter opened *his* mouth and said: In truth I perceive that God shows <u>no partiality</u>.
- Romans 2:11 For there is no partiality with God.
- Ephesians 6:9 And you, masters, do the same things to them, giving up threatening, knowing that your own Master also is in heaven, and there is <u>no partiality</u> with Him.
- Colossians 3:25 But he who does wrong will be repaid for what he has done, and there is <u>no partiality</u>.
- Romans 2:13 (AV) (For not the hearers of the law *are* just before God, but the doers of the law shall be justified.
- Romans 2:13 (NKJV) (for not the hearers of the law *are* just in the sight of God, but the doers of the law will be justified;
- James 1:22 But be ye <u>doers</u> of the Word, and not <u>hearers</u> only, deceiving your own selves.
- Romans 2:24-29 (AV) & (NKJV)
- Romans 2:24 (AV) For the Name of God is blasphemed among the Gentiles through you, as it is written. Romans 2:24 (NKJV) For the Name of God is blasphemed among the Gentiles because of you, as it is written.
- Luke 12:1 In the mean time, when there were gathered together an innumerable multitude of people, insomuch that they trode one upon

- another, He began to say unto His disciples first of all, Beware ye of the leaven of the Pharisees, which is hypocrisy.
- Mark 7:13 Making the Word of God of none effect through your tradition, which ye have delivered: and many such like things do ye.
- 2 Samuel 12:14 Howbeit, because by this deed thou hast given great occasion to the enemies of the LORD to blaspheme, the child also *that is* born unto thee shall surely die.
- Isaiah 52:5 Now therefore, what have I here, saith the LORD, that My people is taken away for nought? they that rule over them make them to howl, saith the LORD; and My Name continually every day *is* blasphemed.
- Ezekiel 45:8 In the land shall be his possession in Israel: and My princes shall no more oppress My people; and the rest of the land shall they give to the house of Israel according to their tribes.
- Ezekiel 36:20 And when they entered unto the heathen, whither they went, they profaned My Holy Name, when they said to them, These *are* the people of the LORD, and are gone forth out of His land.
- Ezekiel 36:23 And I will sanctify My Great Name, which was profaned among the heathen, which ye have profaned in the midst of them; and the heathen shall know that I *am* the LORD, saith the Lord GOD, when I shall be sanctified in you before their eyes.
- Romans 2:25 (AV) For circumcision verily profiteth, if thou keep the law: but if thou be a breaker of the law, thy circumcision is made uncircumcision.
- Romans 2:25 (NKJV) For circumcision is indeed profitable if you keep the law; but if you are a breaker of the law, your circumcision has become uncircumcision.
- Galatians 2:4 And that because of false brethren unawares brought in, who came in privily to spy out our liberty which we have in Christ Jesus, that they might bring us into bondage:
- Acts 15:1,2 And certain men which came down from Judaea taught the brethren, and said, Except ye be circumcised after the manner of Moses, ye cannot be saved. 2 When therefore Paul and Barnabas had no small dissension and disputation with them, they determined that Paul and Barnabas, and certain other of them, should go up to Jerusalem unto the apostles and elders about this question.
- Galatians 2 Summarized of Paul addressing Peter. V11,12 But when Peter was come to Antioch, I withstood him to the face, because he was to be blamed. 12 For before that certain came from James, he did eat with the Gentiles: but when they were come, he withdrew and separated himself, fearing them which were of the circumcision.

Luke 18 Summarized of the account of the Pharisee & the Publican.

Matthew 23 Referred to Jesus dealing with the religious leaders.

Romans 2:26 (AV) Therefore if the uncircumcision keep the righteousness of

- the law, shall not his uncircumcision be counted for circumcision?
- Romans 2:26 (NKJV) Therefore, if an uncircumcised man keeps the righteous requirements of the law, will not his uncircumcision be counted as circumcision?
- John 4:24 God is a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth.
- Romans 2:27 (AV) And shall not uncircumcision which is by nature, if it fulfil the law, judge thee, who by the letter and circumcision dost transgress the law?

 Romans 2:27 (NKJV) And will not the physically uncircumcised, if he fulfills the law, judge you who, even with your written code and circumcision, are a transgressor of the law?
- Luke 16 Summarized of Lazarus & the rich man. V23 And in hell he lift up his eyes, being in torments, & seeth Abraham afar off, & Lazarus in his bosom.
- Romans 2:28 (AV) For he is not a Jew, which is one outwardly; neither *is* that circumcision, which is outward in the flesh:
- Romans 2:28 (NKJV) For he is not a Jew who *is one* outwardly, nor *is* circumcision that which *is* outward in the flesh;
- Acts 7 Summarized of Stephen stoned. V60 And he kneeled down, and cried with a loud voice, Lord, lay not this sin to their charge. And when he had said this, he fell asleep.
- Luke 23:34 Then said Jesus, Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do. And they parted His raiment, and cast lots.
- Acts 7:56 And said, Behold, I see the heavens opened, and the Son of Man standing on the right hand of God.
- John 20:23 Whose soever sins ye remit, they are remitted unto them; and whose soever sins ye retain, they are retained.
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- Matthew 27:51 And, behold, the veil of the temple was rent in twain from the top to the bottom; and the earth did quake, and the rocks rent;
- Joshua 6 Referred to Jericho's wall falling down by God.
- 1 Kings 18:37 Hear me, O LORD, hear me, that this people may know that Thou art the LORD God, and that Thou hast turned their heart back again.
- Daniel 4:16 Let his heart be changed from man's, and let a beast's heart be given unto him; and let seven times pass over him.
- Romans 2:29 (AV) But he *is* a Jew, which is one inwardly; and circumcision *is that* of the heart, in the spirit, *and* not in the letter; whose praise *is* not of men, but of God.

 Romans 2:29 (NKJV) but *he is* a Jew who *is one* inwardly; and circumcision *is that* of the heart, in the Spirit, not in the letter; whose praise *is* not from men but from God.
- John 15:25 But this cometh to pass, that the word might be fulfilled that is written in their law, They hated me without a cause.

- 1 Corinthians 6:19 What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, & ye are not your own?
- Exodus 6:7 And I will take you to me for a people, and I will be to you a God: and ye shall know that I *am* the LORD your God, which bringeth you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians.
- Hebrews 5:14 But strong meat belongeth to them that are of full age, even those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.
- Psalms 37:31 The <u>law</u> of his God *is* in his <u>heart</u>; none of his steps shall slide.
- Psalms 40:8 I delight to do Thy will, O my God:yea, Thy law is within my heart.
- Acts 13:22 And when He had removed him, He raised up unto them David to be their king; to whom also He gave testimony, & said, I have found David the son of Jesse, a man after Mine Own heart, which shall fulfil all My will.
- Psalms 119:34 Give me understanding, and I shall keep Thy <u>law;</u> yea, I shall observe it with *my* whole <u>heart</u>.
- Isaiah 51:7 Hearken unto Me, ye that know righteousness, the people in whose <u>heart is</u> My <u>law</u>; fear ye not the reproach of men, neither be ye afraid of their revilings.
- Isaiah 6 Referred to Isaiah's vision of God in heaven.
- Mark 16:17,18 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.
- 1 Samuel 8:7 And the LORD said unto Samuel, Hearken unto the voice of the people in all that they say unto thee: for they have not rejected thee, but they have rejected Me, that I should not reign over them.
- Jeremiah 31:33 But this *shall be* the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel; After those days, saith the LORD, I will put My <u>law</u> in their inward parts, and write it in their <u>hearts</u>; and will be their God, and they shall be My people.
- Genesis 17:10 This is My covenant, which ye (Abraham) shall keep, between Me and you and thy seed after thee; Every man child among you shall be circumcised.
- Genesis 2&3 Referred to Adam & Eve close to God & then sinning.
- Numbers 22:12 And God said unto Balaam, Thou shalt not go with them; thou shalt not curse the people: for they are blessed.
- Numbers 22-24 Summarized of Balaam showing Balak how to get at Israel.
- Romans 2:15 Which shew the work of the <u>law</u> written in their <u>hearts</u>, their conscience also bearing witness, and *their* thoughts the mean while accusing or else excusing one another;)
- Hebrews 8:10 For this *is* the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, saith the Lord; I will put My <u>laws</u> into their mind,

- and write them in their <u>hearts</u>: and I will be to them a God, and they shall be to Me a people:
- Hebrews 10:16 This *is* the covenant that I will make with them after those days, saith the Lord, I will put My <u>laws</u> into their <u>hearts</u>, and in their minds will I write them;
- Genesis 15:6 And he (Abraham) believed in the LORD; and He counted it to him for righteousness.
- Romans 4:3 For what saith the scripture? Abraham believed God, and it was counted unto him for righteousness.
- Galatians 3:6 Even as Abraham believed God, and it was accounted to him for righteousness.
- Hebrews 1:1,2 God, Who at sundry times and in divers manners spake in time past unto the fathers by the prophets, 2 Hath in these last days spoken unto us by His Son, Whom He hath appointed heir of all things, by Whom also We made the worlds;
- James 2:23 And the scripture was fulfilled which saith, Abraham believed God, and it was imputed unto him for righteousness: and he was called the Friend of God.
- James 1:25 But whoso looketh into the perfect law of liberty, and continueth therein, he being not a forgetful hearer, but a doer of the work, this man shall be blessed in his deed.
- Matthew 3:9 And think not to say within yourselves, We have <u>Abraham</u> to *our* father: for I say unto you, that God is able of these <u>stones</u> to raise up children unto Abraham.
- Luke 3:8 Bring forth therefore fruits worthy of repentance, and begin not to say within yourselves, We have <u>Abraham</u> to *our* father: for I say unto you, That God is able of these <u>stones</u> to raise up children unto <u>Abraham</u>.
- Matthew 3:2 And saying, Repent ye: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.
- Matthew 3:11 I indeed baptize you with water unto repentance: but he that cometh after me is mightier than I, whose shoes I am not worthy to bear: he shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost, and with fire:
- Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;
- Acts 19 Referred to the 7 Sons of Sceva false exorcists.
- Acts 9 Referred to saul called of Jesus to be Paul ministering to the Gentiles.
- 2 Corinthians 5:14 For the love of Christ constraineth us; because we thus judge, that if one died for all, then were all dead:
- Luke 7:47 Wherefore I say unto thee, Her sins, which are many, are forgiven; for she loved much: but to whom little is forgiven, the same loveth little.
