- Romans 3:10 (AV) As it is written, There is none righteous, no, not one:
- Romans 3:10 (NKJV) As it is written: There is none righteous, no, not one;
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents & scorpions, & over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- Romans 3:23 For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;
- Romans 3:11 (AV) There is none that understandeth, there is none that seeketh after God.
- Romans 3:11 (NKJV) There is none who understands; There is none who seeks after God.
- Acts 9 Summarized Saul's conversion meeting Jesus to be Paul.
- Isaiah 55:9 For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are My ways higher than your ways, and My thoughts than your thoughts.
- Acts 17:30 And the times of this ignorance God winked at; but now commandeth all men every where to repent:
- Ezekiel 36:26 A new heart also will I give you, and a new spirit will I put within you: and I will take away the stony heart out of your flesh, and I will give you an heart of flesh.
- Daniel 4:16 Let his heart be changed from man's, and let a beast's heart be given unto him; and let seven times pass over him.

Leviticus 19:31 Regard <u>not</u> them that have familiar spirits, neither <u>seek</u> after wizards, to be defiled by them: I *am* the LORD your <u>God</u>. ( also Isaiah 8:19)

Deuteronomy 18:9-14 (Paraphrased) When thou art come into the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee, thou shalt not learn to do after the abominations of those nations. 10 There shall not be found among you any one that maketh his son or his daughter to pass through the fire, or that useth divination, or an observer of times, or an enchanter, or a witch, 11 Or a charmer, or a consulter with familiar spirits, or a wizard, or a necromancer. 12 For all that do these things are an abomination unto the LORD: and because of these abominations the LORD thy God doth drive

- them out from before thee. 13 Thou shalt be perfect with the LORD thy God. 14 For these nations, which thou shalt possess, hearkened unto observers of times, and unto diviners: but as for thee, the LORD thy God hath not suffered thee so to do.
- Exodus 34:14 For thou shalt worship no other god: for the LORD, whose Name is Jealous, is a jealous God:
- 1 Chronicles 15:11-13 And David called for Zadok and Abiathar the priests, and for the Levites, for Uriel, Asaiah, and Joel, Shemaiah, and Eliel, and Amminadab, 12 And said unto them, Ye are the chief of the fathers of the Levites: sanctify yourselves, both ye and your brethren, that ye may bring up the ark of the LORD God of Israel unto the place that I have prepared for it. 13 For because ye *did it* not at the first, the LORD our <u>God</u> made a breach upon us, for that we <u>sought</u> Him <u>not</u> after the due order.
- Numbers 3:4 And Nadab and Abihu died before the LORD, when they offered strange fire before the LORD, in the wilderness of Sinai, and they had no children: and Eleazar and Ithamar ministered in the priest's office in the sight of Aaron their father.
- 2 Chronicles 15:13 (Asa) That whosoever <u>would not seek the LORD God</u> of Israel should be put to death, whether small or great, whether man or woman.
- Joshua 24:15 And if it seem evil unto you to serve the LORD, choose you this day whom ye will serve; whether the gods which your fathers served that were on the other side of the flood, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land ye dwell: but as for me and my house, we will serve the LORD.
- 2 Chronicles 17:4 But sought to the *LORD* God of his father, and walked in His commandments, and not after the doings of Israel.
- 2 Chronicles 25:20 But Amaziah would <u>not</u> hear; for it *came* of <u>God</u>, that He might deliver them into the hand *of their enemies*, because they <u>sought</u> <u>after the gods of Edom.</u>
- Referred to the Judges of Israelites turning from God & being judged, then repenting & God freeing them, etc. increasing the punishment each time.
- 2 Chronicles 30:19 *That* prepareth his heart to seek God, the LORD God of his fathers, though he be not cleansed according to the purification of the sanctuary.
- Psalms 10:4 The wicked, through the pride of his countenance, <u>will not seek</u> <u>after God</u>: <u>God is not in all his thoughts.</u>
- Psalms 54:3 For strangers are risen up against me, and oppressors <u>seek</u> after my soul: <u>they have not set God before them</u>. Selah.
- Psalms 63:1 « A Psalm of David, when he was in the wilderness of Judah. » O God, thou art my God; early will I seek Thee: my soul thirsteth for Thee, my flesh longeth for thee in a dry and thirsty land, where no water is;
- Psalms 69:6 Let not them that wait on Thee, O Lord GOD of hosts, be

- ashamed for my sake: let <u>not</u> those that <u>seek Thee</u> be confounded for my sake, O <u>God</u> of Israel.
- Exodus 22:29 You shall not delay to offer the first of your ripe produce and your juices. The firstborn of your sons you shall give to Me.
- Hebrews 11:16 But now they desire a better country, that is, an heavenly: wherefore God is not ashamed to be called their God: for he hath prepared for them a city.
- 2 Samuel 12:14 Howbeit, because by this deed thou hast given great occasion to the enemies of the LORD to blaspheme, the child also *that is* born unto thee shall surely die.
- Psalms 86:14 O <u>God</u>, the proud are risen against me, and the assemblies of violent *men* have <u>sought</u> after my soul; and have <u>not</u> set Thee before them.
- Isaiah 8:19 And when they shall say unto you, <u>Seek</u> unto them that have familiar spirits, and unto wizards that peep, and that mutter: should <u>not</u> a people <u>seek</u> unto their <u>God</u>? for the living to the dead?
- Exodus 8:1 And the LORD spake unto Moses, Go unto Pharaoh, and say unto him, Thus saith the LORD, Let My people go, that they may serve Me.
- 1 Corinthians 6:19,20 What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own? 20 For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's.
- 2 Corinthians 6:15 And what concord hath Christ with Belial? or what part hath he that believeth with an infidel?
- Isaiah 58:2 Yet they <u>seek</u> Me daily, and delight to know My ways, as a nation that did righteousness, & forsook <u>not</u> the ordinance of their <u>God</u>: they ask of Me the ordinances of justice; they take delight in approaching to God.
- Hosea 7:10 And the pride of Israel testifieth to his face: and they do <u>not</u> return to the LORD their <u>God</u>, <u>nor seek</u> Him for all this.
- Amos 5:14 <u>Seek</u> good, and <u>not</u> evil, that ye may live: and so the LORD, the <u>God</u> of hosts, shall be with you, as ye have spoken.
- Proverbs 9:10 The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom: and the knowledge of the holy is understanding.
- Job 27:5 God forbid that I should justify you: till I die I will not remove mine integrity from me.
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents & scorpions, & over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- 2 Corinthians 10:4 (For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;)
