## **Abraham Believed God - Romans 4A**

- John 3:16 For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.
- Luke 24:45 And He opened their understanding, that they might comprehend the Scriptures.
- Habakkuk 2:4 Behold the proud, His soul is not upright in him; But the just shall live by his faith.
- Romans 4:1-8 (NKJV) What then shall we say that Abraham our father has found according to the flesh?
- Romans 3:28 Therefore we conclude that a man is justified by faith apart from the deeds of the law.
- Genesis 15:6 And he (Abraham) believed in the LORD; and he counted it to him for righteousness.
- Acts 17:30 Truly, these times of ignorance God overlooked, but now commands all men everywhere to repent,
- John 14:1-3 Let not your heart be troubled; you believe in God, believe also in Me. 2 In My Father's house are many mansions; if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. 3 And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am, there you may be also.
- John 14:6 Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.
- Luke 1:73 The oath which He swore to our father Abraham:
- Luke 16 Summarized the parable of the Rich Man & Lazarus.
- Luke 16:24 Then he (the Rich Man) cried and said, Father Abraham, have mercy on me, and send Lazarus that he may dip the tip of his finger in water and cool my tongue; for I am tormented in this flame.
- Revelation 20:15 And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire.
- Luke 16:30,31 And he said, No, father Abraham; but if one goes to them from the dead, they will repent. 31 But he said to him, If they do not hear Moses and the prophets, neither will they be persuaded though one rise from the dead.
- John 11 Referred to Lazarus raised from the dead.
- John 12:10 But the chief priests consulted that they might put Lazarus also to death;

- John 8 Referred to the account of the woman taken in adultery.
- John 8:53 Are You greater than our father Abraham, who is dead? And the prophets are dead. Whom do You make Yourself out to be?
- John 8:56 Your father Abraham rejoiced to see My day, and he saw *it* and was glad.
- Acts 7:2 And he said, Brethren and fathers, listen: The God of glory appeared to our father Abraham when he was in Mesopotamia, before he dwelt in Haran,
- Romans 4:12 and the father of circumcision to those who not only *are* of the circumcision, but who also walk in the steps of the faith which our father Abraham *had while still* uncircumcised.
- Romans 4:2 For if Abraham was justified by works, he has *something* to boast about, but not before God.
- Genesis 22 Referred to when Abraham was willing to offer son to God.
- Isaiah 35:8 And an highway shall be there, and a way, and it shall be called The way of holiness; the unclean shall not pass over it; but it shall be for those: the wayfaring men, though fools, shall not err therein.
- Matthew 25:26 His lord answered and said unto him, Thou wicked and slothful servant, thou knewest that I reap where I sowed not, and gather where I have not strawed:
- Isaiah 64:6 But we are all as an unclean thing, and all our righteousnesses are as filthy rags; and we all do fade as a leaf; and our iniquities, like the wind, have taken us away.
- John 14:6 Jesus said to him, I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.
- Romans 4:3 For what does the Scripture say? Abraham believed God, and it was accounted to him for righteousness.
- Luke 24:32 And they said one to another, Did not our heart burn within us, while He talked with us by the way, and while He opened to us the scriptures?
- Luke 8:11 Now the parable is this: The seed is the Word of God. (mis-used) Genesis 3 Referred to Adam not believing God.
- Numbers 13:33 And there we saw the giants, the sons of Anak, which come of the giants: and we were in our own sight as grasshoppers, and so we were in their sight.
- Numbers 14:4 And they said one to another, Let us make a captain, and let us return into Egypt.
- Exodus 14:13 And Moses said unto the people, Fear ye not, stand still, and

see the salvation of the LORD, which he will shew to you to day: for the Egyptians whom ye have seen to day, ye shall see them again no more for ever.

Exodus 32:11,12 Then Moses pleaded with the LORD his God, and said: LORD, why does Your wrath burn hot against Your people whom You have brought out of the land of Egypt with great power and with a mighty hand? 12 Why should the Egyptians speak, and say, He brought them out to harm them, to kill them in the mountains, and to consume them from the face of the earth? Turn from Your fierce wrath, and relent from this harm to Your people.

Genesis 22 Summarized to when Abraham was willing to offer son to God. Genesis 15:6 And he believed in the LORD; and He counted it to him for righteousness.

Summarized of Salvation by Jesus.

Acts 7:55 But he, being full of the Holy Spirit, gazed into heaven and saw the glory of God, and Jesus standing at the right hand of God,

Ephesians 1:13 In Him you also trusted, after you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation; in whom also, having believed, you were sealed with the Holy Spirit of promise,

1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

- Romans 4:4 Now to him who works, the wages are not counted as grace but as debt.
- Ephesians 2:8,9 For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: 9 Not of works, lest any man should boast.
- Genesis 6:8 But Noah found grace in the eyes of the LORD. Summarized of Noah building the ark for 100 years.
- Romans 4:5 But to him who does not work but believes on Him who justifies the ungodly, his faith is accounted for righteousness,
- Hebrews 10:17 And their sins and iniquities will I remember no more.
- James 4:7 Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.
- Romans 4:6 just as David also describes the blessedness of the man to whom God imputes righteousness apart from works:
- Acts 13:22 And when He had removed him, He raised up for them David as king, to whom also He gave testimony and said, I have found David the son of Jesse, a man after My own heart, who will do all My will.
- John 10:28,29 And I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; neither shall anyone snatch them out of My hand. 29 My Father, who has given them to Me, is greater than all; and no one is able to snatch them out of My Father's hand.

- Psalms 32:1,2 « *A Psalm* of David, Maschil. » Blessed *is he whose* transgression *is* forgiven, *whose* sin *is* covered.
- Matthew 5:3 Blessed are the poor in spirit, For theirs is the kingdom of heaven.
- Hebrews 12:2 looking unto Jesus, the Author and Finisher of our faith, Who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.
- Matthew 24:12 (AV) And because iniquity shall abound, the love of many shall wax cold.
- Matthew 24:12 (NKJV) And because lawlessness will abound, the love of many will grow cold.
- Romans 1:21 because, although they knew God, they did not glorify Him as God, nor were thankful, but became futile in their thoughts, and their foolish hearts were darkened.
- Romans 4:7 Blessed *are those* whose lawless deeds are forgiven, And whose sins are covered;
- Hebrews 9:22 And almost all things are by the law purged with blood; and without shedding of blood is no remission.
- Matthew 26:28 For this is my blood of the new testament, which is shed for many for the remission of sins.
- Psalms 32:2 Blessed *is* the man unto whom the LORD imputeth not iniquity, and in whose spirit *there is* no guile.
- Romans 4:8 Blessed is the man to whom the LORD shall not impute sin.
- Mark 16:17 And these signs will follow those who believe: In My name they will cast out demons; they will speak with new tongues;
- Luke 8 Summarized of the Gadarene demoniac set free by Jesus.
- John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.
- Matthew 11:28 Come to Me, all you who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.
- Hebrews 13:8 Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever.
