Grace, Faith And Belief - Romans 4B

- John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by Me.
- Romans 4:3 For what does the Scripture say? Abraham believed God, and it was accounted to him for righteousness.
- Revelation 3:20 Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear My voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with Me.
- Romans 4:9-16 *Does* this blessedness then *come* upon the circumcised *only*, or upon the uncircumcised also? For we say that faith was accounted to Abraham for righteousness.
- Romans 4:10 How then was it accounted? While he was circumcised, or uncircumcised? Not while circumcised, but while uncircumcised.
- Acts 10 Summarized of Peter ministering to Cornelius. V44,45 While Peter yet spake these words, the Holy Ghost fell on all them which heard the Word. 45 And they of the circumcision which believed were astonished, as many as came with Peter, because that on the Gentiles also was poured out the gift of the Holy Ghost.
- Matthew 22 Referred to the parable of the ten virgins & the wedding feast. V12 And he saith unto him, Friend, how camest thou in hither not having a wedding garment? And he was speechless.
- Acts 17:30 And the times of this ignorance God winked at; but now commandeth all men every where to repent:
- Ephesians 1:13 In Whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the Word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in Whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that Holy Spirit of promise,
- Summarized of Salvation by Jesus.
- Luke 18:17 Verily I say unto you, Whosoever shall not receive the kingdom of God as a little child shall in no wise enter therein.
- Luke 18 Summarized of the account of the Publican & the Pharisee. V14 I tell you, this man (the Publican) went down to his house justified rather than the other (Pharisee): for every one that exalteth himself shall be abased; and he that humbleth himself shall be exalted.
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- Romans 10:9,10 That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised Him from the dead,

- thou shalt be saved. 10 For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.
- John 16:8 And when He is come, He will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment:
- 2 Corinthians 6:2 (For He saith, I have heard thee in a time accepted, and in the day of salvation have I succoured thee: behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation.)
- Romans 4:11 And he received the sign of circumcision, a seal of the righteousness of the faith which *he had while still* uncircumcised, that he might be the father of all those who believe, though they are uncircumcised, that righteousness might be imputed to them also,
- Romans 4:3 For what does the Scripture say? Abraham believed God, and it was accounted to him for righteousness.
- Jeremiah 4:4 Circumcise yourselves to the LORD, and take away the foreskins of your heart, ye men of Judah and inhabitants of Jerusalem: lest My fury come forth like fire, and burn that none can quench it, because of the evil of your doings.
- John 4:24 God is a Spirit: and they that worship Him must worship Him in spirit and in truth.
- Romans 4:12 and the father of circumcision to those who not only *are* of the circumcision, but who also walk in the steps of the faith which our father Abraham *had while still* uncircumcised.
- Luke 3:8 Bring forth therefore fruits worthy of repentance, and begin not to say within yourselves, We have Abraham to our father: for I say unto you, That God is able of these stones to raise up children unto Abraham.
- Summarized the blessings God gives Believers under the New Covenant.
- 2 Timothy 3:5 Having a form of godliness, but denying the power thereof: from such turn away.
- Matthew 24:24 For there shall arise false Christs, and false prophets, and shall shew great signs and wonders; insomuch that, if it were possible, they shall deceive the very elect.
- Romans 4:13 For the promise that he would be the heir of the world *was* not to Abraham or to his seed through the law, but through the righteousness of faith.
- Habakkuk 2:4 Behold, his soul which is lifted up is not upright in him: but the just shall live by his faith.
- Isaiah 64:6 But we are all as an unclean thing, and all our righteousnesses are as filthy rags; and we all do fade as a leaf; and our iniquities, like the wind, have taken us away.
- Matthew 11:28 Come unto Me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I

- will give you rest.
- 1 Timothy 1:2 Unto Timothy, my own son in the faith: Grace, mercy, and peace, from God our Father and Jesus Christ our Lord.
- Romans 4:14 For if those who are of the law *are* heirs, faith is made void and the promise made of no effect,
- Genesis 2 Summarized of God's instructions to Adam in the Garden of Eden.
- Romans 4:15 because the law brings about wrath; for where there is no law *there is* no transgression.
- Summarized of the devil testing Jesus often.
- Daniel 9:8 O Lord, to us belongeth confusion of face, to our kings, to our princes, and to our fathers, because we have sinned against Thee.
- 2 Chronicles 20 Summarized of satan tempting David to number Israel. V17 And David said unto God, Is it not I that commanded the people to be numbered? even I it is that have sinned and done evil indeed; but as for these sheep, what have they done? let Thine hand, I pray Thee, O LORD my God, be on me, and on my father's house; but not on Thy people, that they should be plagued.
- Romans 4:16 Therefore *it is* of faith that *it might be* according to grace, so that the promise might be sure to all the seed, not only to those who are of the law, but also to those who are of the faith of Abraham, who is the father of us all.
- John 16:23 And in that day ye shall ask Me nothing. Verily, verily, I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall ask the Father in My Name, He will give it you.
- John 5:30 I can of Mine Own self do nothing: as I hear, I judge: and My judgment is just; because I seek not Mine own will, but the will of the Father which hath sent Me.
- John 12:50 And I know that his commandment is life everlasting: whatsoever I speak therefore, even as the Father said unto Me, so I speak.
- Genesis 6:8 But Noah found grace in the eyes of the LORD.
- Genesis 12:1 Now the LORD had said unto Abram, Get thee out of thy country, and from thy kindred, and from thy father's house, unto a land that I will shew thee:
- Mark 7 Summarized of the Syrophenician daughter set free by Jesus. V29 And He said unto her, For this saying go thy way; the devil is gone out of thy daughter.

Genesis 3 Referred to the devil deceiving Eve & the fall of Mankind.

John 6:63 It is the spirit that quickeneth; the flesh profiteth nothing: the words that I speak unto you, they are spirit, and they are life.

Referred to many Scriptures miss-used.

- Romans 3:22 even the <u>righteousness of God, through faith in Jesus Christ, to</u> <u>all and on all who believe</u>. For there is no difference;
- Hebrews 7:25 Wherefore He is able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by Him, seeing He ever liveth to make intercession for them.
- Romans 4:5 But to him who does not work but <u>believes</u> on Him who justifies the ungodly, his <u>faith</u> is accounted for righteousness,
- Romans 4:11 And he received the sign of circumcision, a seal of the righteousness of the <u>faith</u> which *he had while still* uncircumcised, that he might be the father of all those who <u>believe</u>, though they are uncircumcised, that righteousness might be imputed to them also,
- 2 Corinthians 4:13 And since we have the same spirit of <u>faith</u>, according to what is written, I <u>believed</u> and therefore I spoke, we also <u>believe</u> and therefore speak,
- 1 Corinthians 2:2 For I determined not to know any thing among you, save Jesus Christ, and him crucified.
- Galatians 2:16 knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the law but by <u>faith</u> in Jesus Christ, even we have <u>believed in Christ Jesus</u>, that we might be <u>justified by faith in Christ</u> and not by the works of the law; for <u>by the works of the law no flesh shall be justified</u>.
- James 4:17 Therefore to him that knoweth to do good, and doeth it not, to him it is sin.
- Luke 18:14 I tell you, this man (the Publican) went down to his house justified rather than the other (Pharisee): for every one that exalteth himself shall be abased; and he that humbleth himself shall be exalted.
- Galatians 3:9 So then those who *are* of <u>faith</u> are blessed with <u>believing</u>

 Abraham.
- Acts 16:31 And they said, Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be

- saved, and thy house.
- Galatians 3:22 But the Scripture has confined all under sin, that the promise by <u>faith</u> in Jesus Christ might be given to those who <u>believe</u>.
- 1 Timothy 4:12 Let no one despise your youth, but be an example to the believers in word, in conduct, in love, in spirit, in faith, in purity.
- Hebrews 11:6 But without <u>faith</u> *it is* impossible to please *Him*, for he who comes to God must <u>believe</u> that He is, and *that* He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.
- Hebrews 11:31 By <u>faith</u> the harlot Rahab did not perish with those who did not believe, when she had received the spies with peace.
- 1 Peter 1:21 who through Him <u>believe</u> in God, Who raised Him from the dead and gave Him glory, so that your <u>faith</u> and hope are in God.
- Luke 24:6 He is not here, but is risen: remember how He spake unto you when He was yet in Galilee,
- John 14:3 And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, there ye may be also.
- Revelation 22:20 He which testifieth these things saith, Surely I come quickly. Amen. Even so, come, Lord Jesus.
- Romans 1:5 Through Him we have received grace and apostleship for obedience to the <u>faith</u> among all nations for His Name,
- Exodus 22:29 You shall not delay to offer the first of your ripe produce and your juices. The firstborn of your sons you shall give to Me.
- Romans 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.
- Romans 4:16 Therefore *it is* of <u>faith</u> that *it might be* according to <u>grace</u>, so that the promise might be sure to all the seed, not only to those who are of the law, but also to those who are of the <u>faith</u> of Abraham, who is the father of us all.

- Luke 17:5 And the apostles said unto the Lord, Increase our faith.
- Mark 9:24 And straightway the father of the child cried out, and said with tears, Lord, I believe; help thou mine unbelief.
- Luke 17:6 And the Lord said, If ye had faith as a grain of mustard seed, ye might say unto this sycamine tree, Be thou plucked up by the root, and be thou planted in the sea; and it should obey you.

- Romans 12:6 Having then gifts differing according to the <u>grace</u> that is given to us, *let us use them*: if prophecy, *let us prophesy* in proportion to our faith;
- Luke 12:48 But he that knew not, and did commit things worthy of stripes, shall be beaten with few stripes. For unto whomsoever much is given, of him shall be much required: and to whom men have committed much, of him they will ask the more.
- 2 Corinthians 8:7 But as you abound in everything in <u>faith</u>, in speech, in knowledge, in all diligence, and in your love for us *see* that you abound in this grace also.
- Ephesians 2:8 For by grace you have been saved through <u>faith</u>, and that not of yourselves; *it is* the gift of God, 9 Not of works, lest any man should boast.

- 1 Timothy 1:2 To Timothy, a true son in the <u>faith</u>: <u>Grace</u>, mercy, *and* peace from God our Father and Jesus Christ our Lord.
- 1 Timothy 1:14 And the <u>grace</u> of our Lord was exceedingly abundant, with faith and love which are in Christ Jesus.
- 1 Timothy 6:21 by professing it some have strayed concerning the <u>faith</u>. Grace *be* with you. Amen.
- Isaiah 35:8 And an highway shall be there, and a way, and it shall be called The way of holiness; the unclean shall not pass over it; but it shall be for those: the wayfaring men, though fools, shall not err therein.
- Titus 1:4 To Titus, a true son in *our* common <u>faith</u>: <u>Grace</u>, mercy, *and* peace from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ our Savior.
- Titus 3:15 All who *are* with me greet you. Greet those who love us in the <u>faith</u>. <u>Grace</u> be with you all. Amen.
- Acts 9:6 And he trembling and astonished said, Lord, what wilt Thou have me to do? And the Lord said unto him, Arise, and go into the city, and it shall be told thee what thou must do.
