## Why Is Thine Heart Grieved - 1 Samuel 1A

Summarized of Israel from the Judges era transitioning into the Kings era.

- 1 Timothy 2:1 I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for all men; 2 For kings, and for all that are in authority; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty.
- Hebrews 13:5 Let your conversation be without covetousness; and be content with such things as ye have: for He hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee.
- 1 John 4:4 Ye are of God, little children, and have overcome them: because greater is he that is in you, than he that is in the world.
- 2 Corinthians 10:3,4 For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war after the flesh: 4 (For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;)
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

Summarized of Eli & his sons priests not following God's ways.

- 1 Samuel 1:1-8 (AV) & (NKJV)
- 1 Samuel 1:1 (AV) Now there was a certain man of Ramathaimzophim, of mount Ephraim, and his name *was* Elkanah, the son of Jeroham, the son of Elihu, the son of Tohu, the son of Zuph, an Ephrathite:
- 1 Samuel 1:1 (NKJV) Now there was a certain man of Ramathaim Zophim, of the mountains of Ephraim, and his name was Elkanah the son of Jeroham, the son of Elihu, the son of Tohu, the son of Zuph, an Ephraimite.
- Ezra 2:62,63 These sought their register among those that were reckoned by genealogy, but they were not found: therefore were they, as polluted, put from the priesthood. 63 And the Tirshatha said unto them, that they should not eat of the most holy things, till there stood up a priest with Urim and with Thummim.
- Exodus 12:38 And a mixed multitude went up also with them; and flocks, and herds, even very much cattle.
- Matthew 7:15 Beware of false prophets, which come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravening wolves.
- 2 Corinthians 11:26 In journeyings often, in perils of waters, in perils of

- robbers, in perils by mine own countrymen, in perils by the heathen, in perils in the city, in perils in the wilderness, in perils in the sea, in perils among false brethren;
- Strongs #0511 'Elqanah *el-kaw-naw'* AV-Elkanah 21; Elkanah= God has possessed or God has created 1) Samuel's father 2) a ruler in Jerusalem in the time of king Ahaz 3) one of David's mighty warriors 4) son of Korah 5) several Levites.
- 1 Samuel 1:2 (AV) And he had two wives; the name of the one *was* Hannah, and the name of the other Peninnah: and Peninnah had children, but Hannah had no children.
- 1 Samuel 1:2 (NKJV) And he had two wives: the name of one *was* Hannah, and the name of the other Peninnah. Peninnah had children, but Hannah had no children.
- Matthew 19:5 And said, For this cause shall a man leave father and mother, and shall cleave to his wife: and they twain shall be one flesh?
- Strongs #02584 Channah *khan-naw'* AV-Hannah 13; Hannah= grace 1) the mother of Samuel, one of the wives of Elkanah.
- Strongs #06444 Pninnah *pen-in-naw'* AV-Peninnah 3; Peninnah= jewel 1) the other wife of Elkanah besides Hannah.
- Summarized of many women in the Bible who did not bear children until later in life.
- Luke 1 Referred to Mary's magnificat. V48 For He hath regarded the low estate of His handmaiden: for, behold, from henceforth all generations shall call me blessed.
- 1 Samuel 1:3 (AV) And this man went up out of his city yearly to worship and to sacrifice unto the LORD of hosts in Shiloh. And the two sons of Eli, Hophni and Phinehas, the priests of the LORD, were there.
- 1 Samuel 1:3 (NKJV) This man went up from his city yearly to worship and sacrifice to the LORD of hosts in Shiloh. Also the two sons of Eli, Hophni and Phinehas, the priests of the LORD, were there.
- Exodus 23:17 Three times in the year all thy males shall appear before the Lord GOD.
- 2 Corinthians 9:7 Every man according as he purposeth in his heart, so let him give; not grudgingly, or of necessity: for God loveth a cheerful giver.
- Nehemiah 8:10 Then he said unto them, Go your way, eat the fat, and drink the sweet, and send portions unto them for whom nothing is prepared: for this day is holy unto our Lord: neither be ye sorry; for the joy of the LORD is your strength.
- 2 Corinthians 13:5 Examine yourselves, whether ye be in the faith; prove

- your own selves. Know ye not your own selves, how that Jesus Christ is in you, except ye be reprobates?
- Strongs #05941 'Eliy *ay-lee'* AV-Eli 33; Eli= ascension 1) descendant of Aaron through Ithamar and high priest and judge of Israel when Samuel entered service as a child.
- Strongs #02652 Chophniy *khof-nee'* AV-Hophni 5; Hophni= pugilist 1) one of the two sons of Eli who were priests at Shiloh and were noted for their brutality and lust; their sinfulness provoked a curse against their father's house and were judged by the Lord when they took the ark into battle; the ark was lost and both brothers were killed and Eli died when he heard the news.
- Strongs #06372 Piynchac *pee-nekh-aws'* AV-Phinehas 25; Phinehas= mouth of brass 1) son of Eleazar and grandson of Aaron; his zealousness for the Lord averted a plague on Israel and gained him the promise of the Lord of an everlasting priesthood in his family 2) a priest and the son of the priest Eli 3) the father of a helper of Ezra.
- Numbers 25 Summarized of Phinehas cleaning up sinful Israel.
- Matthew 16:4 A wicked and adulterous generation seeketh after a sign; and there shall no sign be given unto it, but the sign of the prophet Jonas.

  And He left them, and departed.
- John 17:12 While I was with them in the world, I kept them in thy name: those that thou gavest me I have kept, and none of them is lost, but the son of perdition; that the scripture might be fulfilled.
- 1 Samuel 1:4 (AV) And when the time was that Elkanah offered, he gave to Peninnah his wife, and to all her sons and her daughters, portions:
- 1 Samuel 1:4 (NKJV) And whenever the time came for Elkanah to make an offering, he would give portions to Peninnah his wife and to all her sons and daughters.
- Genesis 43:33 And they sat before him, the firstborn according to his birthright, and the youngest according to his youth: and the men marvelled one at another.
- 1 Samuel 1:5 (AV) But unto Hannah he gave a worthy portion; for he loved Hannah: but the LORD had shut up her womb.
- 1 Samuel 1:5 (NKJV) But to Hannah he would give a double portion, for he loved Hannah, although the LORD had closed her womb.
- Genesis 8 Referred to Noah's sons not having children until after the flood.
- Ephesians 6:4 And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.
- Summarized of God having plans as to when & what for certain men were

born.

- 1 Samuel 1:6 (AV) And her adversary also provoked her sore, for to make her fret, because the LORD had shut up her womb.
- 1 Samuel 1:6 (NKJV) And her rival also provoked her severely, to make her miserable, because the LORD had closed her womb.
- Genesis 16 Summarized of Sarah, Abraham, & Hagar. V4 And he went in unto Hagar, and she conceived: and when she saw that she had conceived, her mistress was despised in her eyes.
- Referred to the rivalry between Jacob's wives & sons.
- Matthew 18:18 Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.
- Psalms 23:3 He restoreth my soul: He leadeth me in the paths of righteousness for His name's sake.
- John 9:2,3 And his disciples asked him, saying, Master, who did sin, this man, or his parents, that he was born blind? 3 Jesus answered, Neither hath this man sinned, nor his parents: but that the works of God should be made manifest in him.
- 1 Samuel 1:7 (AV) And as he did so year by year, when she went up to the house of the LORD, so she provoked her; therefore she wept, and did not eat.
- 1 Samuel 1:7 (NKJV) So it was, year by year, when she went up to the house of the LORD, that she provoked her; therefore she wept and did not eat.
- Matthew 8; Luke 8; & Mark 5 Summarized of the Gadarene Demoniac set free by Jesus.
- Matthew 10:8 Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out devils: freely ye have received, freely give.
- 1 Samuel 1:8 (AV) Then said Elkanah her husband to her, Hannah, why weepest thou? and why eatest thou not? and why is thy heart grieved? *am* not I better to thee than ten sons?
- 1 Samuel 1:8 (NKJV) Then Elkanah her husband said to her, Hannah, why do you weep? Why do you not eat? And why is your heart grieved? *Am* I not better to you than ten sons?
- 1 Samuel 2:29 Wherefore kick ye at My sacrifice and at Mine offering, which I have commanded in My habitation; and honourest thy sons above Me, to make yourselves fat with the chiefest of all the offerings of Israel My people?
- 1 Kings 21 Summarized of Ahab & Jezebel & the incident with Naboth.

- Daniel 2:21 And He changeth the times and the seasons: He removeth kings, and setteth up kings: He giveth wisdom unto the wise, and knowledge to them that know understanding:
- 1 Samuel 17 Referred to David winning over Goliath.
- Luke 8:27,35 And when He went forth to land, there met Him out of the city a certain man, which had devils long time, and ware no clothes, neither abode in any house, but in the tombs. 35 Then they went out to see what was done; and came to Jesus, and found the man, out of whom the devils were departed, sitting at the feet of Jesus, clothed, and in his right mind: and they were afraid.
- Genesis 6:5,6 And GOD saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually. 6 And it repented the LORD that He had made man on the earth, and it grieved Him at His heart.
- Genesis 9:20-23 And Noah began to be an husbandman, and he planted a vineyard: 21 And he drank of the wine, and was drunken; and he was uncovered within his tent. 22 And Ham, the father of Canaan, saw the nakedness of his father, and told his two brethren without.
- Deuteronomy 15:10 Thou shalt surely give him, and thine heart shall not be grieved when thou givest unto him: because that for this thing the LORD thy God shall bless thee in all thy works, and in all that thou puttest thine hand unto.
- Luke 18 Summarized of the account of the rich young ruler. V22 Now when Jesus heard these things, He said unto him, Yet lackest thou one thing: sell all that thou hast, and distribute unto the poor, and thou shalt have treasure in heaven: and come, follow Me. 23 And when he heard this, he was very sorrowful: for he was very rich.
- 1 Samuel 1:8 Then said Elkanah her husband to her, Hannah, why weepest thou? and why eatest thou not? and why is thy <u>heart grieved</u>? *am* not I better to thee than ten sons?
- 1 Samuel 2:33 And the man of thine, *whom* I shall not cut off from mine altar, *shall be* to consume thine eyes, and to <u>grieve thine heart</u>: and all the increase of thine house shall die in the flower of their age.
- 1 Peter 1:16 Because it is written, Be ye Holy; for I am Holy.
- Matthew 5:48 Be ye therefore perfect, even as your Father which is in heaven is perfect.
- 1 Samuel 25:31 That this shall <u>be no grief unto thee, nor offence of heart</u> unto my lord, either that thou hast shed blood causeless, or that my lord hath avenged himself: but when the LORD shall have dealt well with my

lord, then remember thine handmaid.

Summarized of Abigail interceded to save her family.

Strongs #05037 Nabal naw-bawl' AV-Nabal 22; Nabal = "fool".

Psalms 73:21 Thus My heart was grieved, and I was pricked in My reins.

Referred to Psalm 78 a Summary of sinful Israel in the wilderness.

- Psalms 95:10 Forty years long was I <u>grieved</u> with *this* generation, and said, It *is* a people that do err in their <u>heart</u>, and they have not known My ways:
- Isaiah 19:1 The burden of Egypt. Behold, the LORD rideth upon a swift cloud, and shall come into Egypt: and the idols of Egypt shall be moved at his presence, and the heart of Egypt shall melt in the midst of it.
- 1 John 2:15 Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him.
- Luke 16:13 No servant can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. Ye cannot serve God and mammon.
- Ecclesiastes 2:23 For all his days *are* sorrows, and his travail <u>grief</u>; yea, his <u>heart</u> taketh not rest in the night. This is also vanity.
- Proverbs 3:24 When thou liest down, thou shalt not be afraid: yea, thou shalt lie down, and thy sleep shall be sweet.
- Lamentations 1:20 Behold, O LORD; for I *am* in distress: my bowels are troubled; mine <u>heart</u> is turned within me; for I have <u>grievously</u> rebelled: abroad the sword bereaveth, at home *there is* as death.
- Mark 3:5 And when He had looked round about on them with anger, <u>being</u> <u>grieved for the hardness of their hearts</u>, He saith unto the man, Stretch forth thine hand. And he stretched *it* out: and his hand was restored whole as the other.
- 2 Corinthians 2:4 For <u>out of much affliction and anguish of heart</u> I wrote unto you with many tears; not that ye should be <u>grieved</u>, but that ye might know the love which I have more abundantly unto you.

Referred to Moses grieved & interceding for sinful Israel many times.

Hebrews 3:10 Wherefore I was grieved with that generation, and said, They do alway err in *their* heart; and they have not known My ways.
