**Chaos - modern meaning - out of order; confusion**

**Chaos - archaic meaning - deep - hole.**

**2 Timothy 2:15 Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the Word of Truth.**

**John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.**

**Summarized of the world situation when Jesus was born.**

**Luke 2:14 Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace, good will toward men.**

**Isaiah 24:10 (Message) The chaotic cities are unlivable. Anarchy reigns. Every house is boarded up, condemned.**

**Isaiah 24:10 (NKJV) The city of confusion is broken down; Every house is shut up, so that none may go in.**

**Isaiah 34:11 (Message) Vultures and skunks will police the streets; owls and crows will feel at home there. God will reverse creation. Chaos! He will cancel fertility. Emptiness!**

**Isaiah 34:11 (NKJV) But the pelican and the porcupine shall possess it, Also the owl and the raven shall dwell in it. And He shall stretch out over it the line of confusion and the stones of emptiness.**

**Matthew 18:18 Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.**

**Jeremiah 4:23 (Message) I looked at the earth, it was back to pre-Genesis chaos and emptiness. I looked at the skies, and not a star to be seen.**

**Jeremiah 4:23 (NKJV) I beheld the earth, and indeed *it was* without form, and void; And the heavens, they *had* no light.**

**Genesis 1:1-5 (AV)** In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth. 2 And the earth was without form, and void; and darkness *was* upon the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters. 3 And God said, Let there be light: and there was light. 4 And God saw the light, that *it was* good: and God divided the light from the darkness. 5 And God called the light Day, and the darkness He called Night. And the evening and the morning were the first day.

**Mark 16:15-18** 15 And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. 16 He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned. 17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.

**Genesis 1:2** And the earth was without form <08414>, and void; and darkness *was* upon the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters.

**Deuteronomy 32:10** He found him in a desert land, and in the waste <08414> howling wilderness; He led him about, He instructed him, He kept him as the apple of His eye.

**Acts 9:6** And he trembling and astonished said, Lord, what wilt Thou have me to do? And the Lord said unto him, Arise, and go into the city, and it shall be told thee what thou must do.

**Exodus 6:7** And I will take you to me for a people, and I will be to you a God: and ye shall know that I am the LORD your God, which bringeth you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians.

**1 Samuel 12:21** And turn ye not aside: for *then should ye go* after vain <08414> things, which cannot profit nor deliver; for they *are* vain <08414>.

**Luke 19:46** Saying unto them, It is written, My house is the house of prayer: but ye have made it a den of thieves.

**Job 6:18** The paths of their way are turned aside; they go to nothing <08414>, and perish.

**Job 12:24** He taketh away the heart of the chief of the people of the earth, and causeth them to wander in a wilderness <08414> *where there is no way*.

**Genesis 3:10** And he said, I heard Thy voice in the garden, and I was afraid, because I was naked; and I hid myself.

**Job 26:7** He stretcheth out the north over the empty place <08414>, and hangeth the earth upon nothing.

**Psalms 107:40** He poureth contempt upon princes, and causeth them to wander in the wilderness <08414>, *where there is no way*.

**Isaiah 24:10** The city of confusion <08414> is broken down: every house is shut up, that no man may come in.

**Matthew 16:19** And I will give unto thee the keys of the kingdom of heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.

**Isaiah 29:21** That make a man an offender for a word, and lay a snare for him that reproveth in the gate, and turn aside the just for a thing of nought <08414>.

**Isaiah 34:11** But the cormorant and the bittern shall possess it; the owl also and the raven shall dwell in it: and He shall stretch out upon it the line of confusion <08414>, and the stones of emptiness.

**Isaiah 40:17** All nations before Him *are* as nothing; and they are counted to Him less than nothing, and vanity <08414>.

**Isaiah 40:23** That bringeth the princes to nothing; He maketh the judges of the earth as vanity <08414>.

**Isaiah 1:26** And I will restore thy judges as at the first, and thy counsellors as at the beginning: afterward thou shalt be called, The city of righteousness, the faithful city.

**Isaiah 41:29** Behold, they *are* all vanity; their works *are* nothing: their molten images *are* wind and confusion <08414>.

**Psalms 115:4-7** Their idols are silver and gold, the work of men's hands. 5 They have mouths, but they speak not: eyes have they, but they see not: 6 They have ears, but they hear not: noses have they, but they smell not: 7 They have hands, but they handle not: feet have they, but they walk not: neither speak they through their throat. 8 They that make them are like unto them; so is every one that trusteth in them. 8 **Isaiah 44:9** They that make a graven image *are* all of them vanity <08414>; and their delectable

things shall not profit; and they *are* their own witnesses; they see not, nor know; that they may be ashamed.

**Isaiah 45:18** For thus saith the LORD that created the heavens; God Himself that formed the earth and made it; He hath established it, He created it not in vain <08414>, He formed it to be inhabited: I *am* the LORD; and *there is* none else.

**Genesis 3:1** Now the serpent was more subtil than any beast of the field which the LORD God had made. And he said unto the woman, Yea, hath God said, Ye shall not eat of every tree of the garden?

**Isaiah 45:19** I have not spoken in secret, in a dark place of the earth: I said not unto the seed of Jacob, Seek ye Me in vain <08414>: I the LORD speak righteousness, I declare things that are right.

**Psalms 91:15** He shall call upon me, and I will answer him: I will be with him in trouble; I will deliver him, and honour him.

**John 14:13** And whatsoever ye shall ask in my name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son.

**Matthew 21:22** And all things, whatsoever ye shall ask in prayer, believing, ye shall receive.

**Isaiah 49:4** Then I said, I have laboured in vain, I have spent my strength for nought <08414>, and in vain: yet surely my judgment *is* with the LORD, and my work with my God.

**Isaiah 59:4** None calleth for justice, nor *any* pleadeth for truth: they trust in vanity <08414>, and speak lies; they conceive mischief, and bring forth iniquity.

**Genesis 6:5** And GOD saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually.

**Jeremiah 4:23** I beheld the earth, and, lo, *it was* without form <08414>, and void; and the heavens, and they *had* no light.

**Mark 4:39** And he arose, and rebuked the wind, and said unto the sea, Peace, be still. And the wind ceased, and there was a great calm.

**Luke 8:26-40 - 26-28** And they arrived at the country of the Gadarenes, which is over against Galilee. 27 And when He went forth to land, there met Him out of the city a certain man, which had devils (demons) long time, and ware no clothes, neither abode in *any* house, but in the tombs. 28 When he saw Jesus, he cried out, and fell down before Him, and with a loud voice said, What have I to do with Thee, Jesus, *Thou* Son of God Most High? I beseech Thee, torment me not.

**Galatians 2:20** I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the

**faith of the Son of God, Who loved me, and gave Himself for me.**

**Acts 19:15 And the evil spirit answered and said, Jesus I know, and Paul I know; but who are ye?**

**Luke 8:29 (For He had commanded the unclean spirit to come out of the man. For oftentimes it had caught him: and he was kept bound with chains and in fetters; and he brake the bands, and was driven of the devil into the wilderness.)**

**Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.**

**Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;**

**1 Samuel 17:45 Then said David to the Philistine, Thou comest to me with a sword, and with a spear, and with a shield: but I come to thee in the Name of the LORD of hosts, the God of the armies of Israel, Whom thou hast defied.**

**Luke 8:30 And Jesus asked him, saying, What is thy name? And he said, Legion: because many devils (demons) were entered into him.**

**Mark 9:25 When Jesus saw that the people came running together, He rebuked the foul spirit, saying unto him, Thou dumb and deaf spirit, I charge thee, come out of him, and enter no more into him.**

**Luke 8:31 And they besought Him that He would not command them to go out into the deep.**

**2 Peter 2:4 For if God spared not the angels that sinned, but cast them down to hell, and delivered them into chains of darkness, to be reserved unto judgment;**

**Strong's #5020 tartaroo tar-tar-o'-o from Tartaros (the deepest abyss of Hell); ; AV-cast down to hell 1; 1) the name of the subterranean region, doleful and dark, regarded by the ancient Greeks as the abode of the wicked dead, where they suffer punishment for their evil deeds; it answers to Gehenna of the Jews 2) to thrust down to Tartarus, to hold captive in Tartarus.**

**Luke 8:32 And there was there an herd of many swine feeding on the mountain: and they besought Him that He would suffer them to enter into them. And He suffered them.**

**Matthew 18:18 Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.**

**Luke 8:33 Then went the devils out of the man, and entered into the swine: and the herd ran violently down a steep place into the lake, and were**

choked. 34 When they that fed *them* saw what was done, they fled, and went and told *it* in the city and in the country. 35 Then they went out to see what was done; and came to Jesus, and found the man, out of whom the devils were departed, sitting at the feet of Jesus, clothed, and in his right mind: and they were afraid.

**Matthew 11:28** Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.

**Luke 8:36-40** They also which saw *it* told them by what means he that was possessed of the devils was healed. 37 Then the whole multitude of the country of the Gadarenes round about besought Him to depart from them; for they were taken with great fear: and He went up into the ship, and returned back again. 38 Now the man out of whom the devils were departed besought Him that he might be with Him: but Jesus sent him away, saying, 39 Return to thine own house, and shew how great things God hath done unto thee. And he went his way, and published throughout the whole city how great things Jesus had done unto him. 40 And it came to pass, that, when Jesus was returned, the people gladly received Him: for they were all waiting for Him.

**John 4:29,30** Come, see a man, which told me all things that ever I did: is not this the Christ? 30 Then they went out of the city, and came unto him.

**Revelation 12:9** And the great dragon was cast out, that old serpent, called the Devil, and Satan, which deceiveth the whole world: he was cast out into the earth, and his angels were cast out with him.

**Revelation 12:14** And to the woman were given two wings of a great eagle, that she might fly into the wilderness, into her place, where she is nourished for a time, and times, and half a time, from the face of the serpent.

**Revelation 12:15** And the serpent cast out of his mouth water as a flood after the woman, that he might cause her to be carried away of the flood.

**Revelation 20:2** And he laid hold on the dragon, that old serpent, which is the Devil, and Satan, and bound him a thousand years,

**Strong's #3789** ophis *of-is* AV-serpent 14; 1) snake, serpent 2) with the ancients, the serpent was an emblem of cunning and wisdom. The serpent who deceived Eve was regarded by the Jews as the devil.
