Defiling - Godly Or Not - Daniel 1

- Genesis 2&3 Summarized of pure innocent Adam & Eve being deceived & the fall of Mankind.
- Referred to the devil tempting Jesus Who resisted with the Word of God.
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- Isaiah 35:8 And an highway shall be there, and a way, and it shall be called The way of Holiness; the unclean shall not pass over it; but it shall be for those: the wayfaring men, though fools, shall not err therein.
- Luke 18:8 I tell you that he will avenge them speedily. Nevertheless when the Son of man cometh, shall he find faith on the earth?
- Revelation 13:8 And all that dwell upon the earth shall worship him, whose names are not written in the book of life of the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world.
- Matthew 12:31 Wherefore I say unto you, All manner of sin and blasphemy shall be forgiven unto men: but the blasphemy against the Holy Ghost shall not be forgiven unto men.
- Matthew 7:13,14 Enter ye in at the strait gate: for wide is the gate, and broad is the way, that leadeth to destruction, and many there be which go in thereat: 14 Because strait is the gate, and narrow is the way, which leadeth unto life, and few there be that find it.
- Exodus 19 Referred to God wanting the people sanctified for 3 days before He came to Mount Sinai.
- Referred to Jeremiah warning the Isrealites to repent or judgment. Then Nebuchadnezzar sacked Israel 3 times.
- Daniel 1:8-17 (AV) V8 But Daniel purposed in his heart that he would <u>not</u> <u>defile himself</u> with the portion of the king's meat, nor with the wine which he drank: therefore he requested of the prince of the eunuchs that he might not defile himself.
- James 1:6 But let him ask in faith, nothing wavering. For he that wavereth is like a wave of the sea driven with the wind and tossed.
- Genesis 39:9,12 There is none greater in this house than I; neither hath he kept back any thing from me but thee, because thou art his wife: how then can I do this great wickedness, and sin against God? 12 And she caught him by his garment, saying, Lie with me: and he left his garment in her hand, and fled, and got him out.
- Hebrews 13:5 Let your conversation be without covetousness; and be content with such things as ye have: for He hath said, I will never leave

thee, nor forsake thee.

- Luke 4 Referred to the devil testing Jesus.
- 1 John 2:16 For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world.
- Proverbs 21:23 Whoso keepeth his mouth and his tongue keepeth his soul from troubles.
- Daniel 1:9-17 Now God had brought Daniel into favour and tender love with the prince of the eunuchs. 10 And the prince of the eunuchs said unto Daniel, I fear my lord the king, who hath appointed your meat and your drink: for why should he see your faces worse liking than the children which *are* of your sort? then shall ye make *me* endanger my head to the king. 11 Then said Daniel to Melzar, whom the prince of the eunuchs had set over Daniel, Hananiah, Mishael, and Azariah, 12 Prove thy servants, I beseech thee, ten days; and let them give us pulse to eat, and water to drink. 13 Then let our countenances be looked upon before thee, and the countenance of the children that eat of the portion of the king's meat: and as thou seest, deal with thy servants. 14 So he consented to them in this matter, and proved them ten days. 15 And at the end of ten days their countenances appeared fairer and fatter in flesh than all the children which did eat the portion of the king's meat. 16 Thus Melzar took away the portion of their meat, and the wine that they should drink; and gave them pulse. 17 As for these four children, God gave them knowledge and skill in all learning and wisdom: and Daniel had understanding in all visions and dreams.
- Matthew 11:28 Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.
- Luke 8 & Mark 5 Summarized of the Gadarene Demoniac set free by Jesus. Strongs #01351 ga'al *gaw-al'* AV-pollute 7, defile 3, stain 1; 11 1) to defile, pollute, desecrate 1a) (Niphal) to be defiled, be polluted 1b) (Piel) to pollute, desecrate 1c) (Pual) to be desecrated (of removal from priesthood) 1d) (Hiphil) to pollute, stain 1e) (Hithpael) to defile oneself.
- 1 Corinthians 6:19 What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own?
- Daniel 3:8 Wherefore at that time certain Chaldeans came near, and accused the Jews.
- Summarized of the image of Nebuchadnezzar.
- Daniel 3:14,15 Nebuchadnezzar spake and said unto them, *Is it* true, O Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, do not ye serve my gods, nor worship the golden image which I have set up? 15 Now if ye be ready that at what time ye hear the sound of the cornet, flute, harp, sackbut, psaltery, and

dulcimer, and all kinds of musick, ye fall down and worship the image which I have made; well: but if ye worship not, ye shall be cast the same hour into the midst of a burning fiery furnace; and who is that God that shall deliver you out of my hands?

- Exodus 20:3-5 Thou shalt have no other gods before me. 4 Thou shalt not make unto thee any graven image, or any likeness of any thing that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth: 5 Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for I the LORD thy God am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation of them that hate me;
- Daniel 3:16-18 Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, answered and said to the king, O Nebuchadnezzar, we *are* not careful to answer thee in this matter. 17 If it be *so*, our God whom we serve is able to deliver us from the burning fiery furnace, and he will deliver *us* out of thine hand, O king. 18 But if not, be it known unto thee, O king, that we will not serve thy gods, nor worship the golden image which thou hast set up.
- Acts 5:29 Then Peter and the other apostles answered and said, We ought to obey God rather than men.
- Acts 5:41 And they departed from the presence of the council, rejoicing that they were counted worthy to suffer shame for his name.
- Daniel 3:26 Then Nebuchadnezzar came near to the mouth of the burning fiery furnace, *and* spake, and said, Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, ye servants of the most high God, come forth, and come *hither*. Then Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, came forth of the midst of the fire.

Genesis 6 Summarized of Noah & family walking with God.

Daniel 6:3-5 Then this Daniel was preferred above the presidents and princes, because an excellent spirit was in him; and the king thought to set him over the whole realm. 4 Then the presidents and princes sought to find occasion against Daniel concerning the kingdom; but they could find none occasion nor fault; forasmuch as he was faithful, neither was there any error or fault found in him. 5 Then said these men, We shall not find any occasion against this Daniel, except we find it against him concerning the law of his God.

Summarized of the scheem they made to get rid of Daniel.

- 1 Thessalonians 5:22 Abstain from all appearance of evil.
- Daniel 6:10 Now when Daniel knew that the writing was signed, he went into his house; and his windows being open in his chamber toward Jerusalem, he kneeled upon his knees three times a day, and prayed, and gave thanks before his God, as he did aforetime.
- 1 Thessalonians 5:18 In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in

Christ Jesus concerning you.

- Daniel 6:20-22 And when he came to the den, he cried with a lamentable voice unto Daniel: and the king spake and said to Daniel, O Daniel, servant of the living God, is thy God, whom thou servest continually, able to deliver thee from the lions? 21 Then said Daniel unto the king, O king, live for ever. 22 My God hath sent his angel, and hath shut the lions' mouths, that they have not hurt me: forasmuch as before him innocency was found in me; and also before thee, O king, have I done no hurt.
- Hebrews 1:14 Are they (God's angels) not all ministering spirits, sent forth to minister for them who shall be heirs of salvation?
- 1 Peter 5:8 Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour:
- Daniel 6:23 Then was the king exceeding glad for him, and commanded that they should take Daniel up out of the den. So Daniel was taken up out of the den, and no manner of hurt was found upon him, because he believed in his God.
- Revelation 13:17 And that no man might buy or sell, save he that had the mark, or the name of the beast, or the number of his name.
- Numbers 36:6 This is the thing which the LORD doth command concerning the daughters of Zelophehad, saying, Let them marry to whom they think best; only to the family of the tribe of their father shall they marry.
- 1 Corinthians 7:39 The wife is bound by the law as long as her husband liveth; but if her husband be dead, she is at liberty to be married to whom she will; only in the Lord.
- Nehemiah 13:29 Remember them, O my God, because they have defiled the priesthood, and the covenant of the priesthood, and of the Levites.
- Exodus 19:6 And ye shall be unto Me a kingdom of priests, and an Holy nation. These *are* the words which thou shalt speak unto the children of Israel.

- Mark 7:20 (AV) And He said, That which cometh out of the man, that defileth the man.
- Mark 7:20 (NKJV) And He said, What comes out of a man, that defiles a man. Strongs #2840 koinoo *koy-no'-o* AV-defile 11, call common 2, pollute 1,

- unclean 1; 15 1) to make common 1a) to make (Levitically) unclean, render unhallowed, defile, profane 1b) to declare or count unclean.
- Mark 7:21 (AV) For from within, out of the heart of men, proceed evil thoughts, adulteries, fornications, murders,
- Mark 7:21 (NKJV) For from within, out of the heart of men, proceed evil thoughts, adulteries, fornications, murders,
- Romans 10:9,10 That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. 10 For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.
- Isaiah 35:8 And an highway shall be there, and a way, and it shall be called The way of Holiness; the unclean shall not pass over it; but it shall be for those: the wayfaring men, though fools, shall not err therein.
- Romans 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.
- 2 Corinthians 10:5 Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;
- Matthew 19:5 And said, For this cause shall a man leave father and mother, and shall cleave to his wife: and they twain shall be one flesh?
- Mark 7:22 (AV) Thefts, covetousness, wickedness, deceit, lasciviousness, an evil eye, blasphemy, pride, foolishness:
- Mark 7:22 (NKJV) thefts, covetousness, wickedness, deceit, lewdness, an evil eye, blasphemy, pride, foolishness.
- Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;
- Genesis 6:5 And GOD saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually.
- 1 Timothy 2:9 In like manner also, that women adorn themselves in modest apparel, with shamefacedness and sobriety; not with broided hair, or gold, or pearls, or costly array;
- Mark 7:23 (AV) All these evil things come from within, and defile the man.
- Mark 7:23 (NKJV) All these evil things come from within and defile a man.
- Romans 7:15 For what I am doing, I do not understand. For what I will to do, that I do not practice; but what I hate, that I do.
- Revelation 2:14 But I have a few things against thee, because thou hast there them that hold the doctrine of Balaam, who taught Balac to cast a stumblingblock before the children of Israel, to eat things sacrificed unto idols, and to commit fornication. (Summarized Numbers 22-25)

- Judges 16:16 And it came to pass, when she pressed him daily with her words, and urged him, so that his soul was vexed unto death;
- Numbers 22:12 And God said unto Balaam, Thou shalt not go with them; thou shalt not curse the people: for they are blessed.
- Genesis 39:12 And she caught him by his garment, saying, Lie with me: and he left his garment in her hand, and fled, and got him out.
- Numbers 3:4 And Nadab and Abihu died before the LORD, when they offered strange fire before the LORD, in the wilderness of Sinai, and they had no children: and Eleazar and Ithamar ministered in the priest's office in the sight of Aaron their father.
- Acts 10 Summarized of Peter's vision & ministering to Cornelius.
- John 18:28 Then led they Jesus from Caiaphas unto the hall of judgment: and it was early; and they themselves went not into the judgment hall, lest they should be <u>defiled</u>; but that they might eat the passover.
- Mark 15:10 For he knew that the chief priests had delivered him for envy.
- 1 Corinthians 3:17 If any man <u>defile</u> the temple of God, him shall God destroy; for the temple of God is Holy, which *temple* ye are.
- 1 Corinthians 8:7,13 Howbeit *there is* not in every man that knowledge: for some with conscience of the idol unto this hour eat *it* as a thing offered unto an idol; and their conscience being weak is <u>defiled</u>. 13 Wherefore, if meat make my brother to offend, I will eat no flesh while the world standeth, lest I make my brother to offend.
- 1 Timothy 1:10 For whoremongers, for them that <u>defile</u> themselves with mankind, for menstealers, for liars, for perjured persons, and if there be any other thing that is contrary to sound doctrine;
- Leviticus 18&20 Referred to God's Laws on morality.
- Romans 1 Referred to mankind's road to depravity.
- Joshua 24:15 And if it seem evil unto you to serve the LORD, choose you this day whom ye will serve; whether the gods which your fathers served that were on the other side of the flood, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land ye dwell: but as for me and my house, we will serve the LORD.
- Luke 22:31,32 And the Lord said, Simon, Simon, behold, Satan hath desired to have you, that he may sift you as wheat: 32 But I have prayed for thee, that thy faith fail not: and when thou art converted, strengthen thy brethren.
- 2 Kings 23 Referred to Josiah burned ungodliness as he cleaned up from idol worship.
- Acts 19:19 Many of them also which used curious arts brought their books together, and burned them before all men: and they counted the price of them, and found it fifty thousand pieces of silver.

More Service Notes:

- Matthew 15:11 Not that which goeth into the mouth <u>defileth</u> a man; but that which cometh out of the mouth, this <u>defileth</u> a man.
- Matthew 15:18 But those things which proceed out of the mouth come forth from the heart; and they <u>defile</u> the man.
- Matthew 15:20 These are *the things* which <u>defile</u> a man: but to eat with unwashen hands defileth not a man.
- Mark 7:2 And when they saw some of his disciples eat bread with <u>defiled</u>, that is to say, with unwashen, hands, they found fault.
- Mark 7:15 There is nothing from without a man, that entering into him can <u>defile</u> him: but the things which come out of him, those are they that <u>defile</u> the man.
- Mark 7:18 And He saith unto them, Are ye so without understanding also? Do ye not perceive, that whatsoever thing from without entereth into the man, *it* cannot <u>defile</u> him;
- Mark 7:20 And He said, That which cometh out of the man, that <u>defileth</u> the man.
- Mark 7:23 All these evil things come from within, and defile the man.
- Titus 1:15 Unto the pure all things *are* pure: but unto them that are <u>defiled</u> and unbelieving *is* nothing pure; but even their mind and conscience is defiled.
- Hebrews 12:15 Looking diligently lest any man fail of the grace of God; lest any root of bitterness springing up trouble *you*, and thereby many be defiled;
- James 3:6 And the tongue *is* a fire, a world of iniquity: so is the tongue among our members, that it <u>defileth</u> the whole body, and setteth on fire the course of nature; and it is set on fire of hell.
- Jude 1:8 Likewise also these *filthy* dreamers <u>defile</u> the flesh, despise dominion, and speak evil of dignities.
- Revelation 3:4 Thou hast a few names even in Sardis which have not <u>defiled</u> their garments; and they shall walk with me in white: for they are worthy.
- Revelation 14:4 These are they which were not <u>defiled</u> with women; for they are virgins. These are they which follow the Lamb whithersoever He goeth. These were redeemed from among men, *being* the firstfruits unto God and to the Lamb.
- Revelation 21:27 And there shall in no wise enter into it any thing that <u>defileth</u>, neither *whatsoever* worketh abomination, or *maketh* a lie: but they which are written in the Lamb's book of life.
- Ezekiel 4:13 And the LORD said, Even thus shall the children of Israel eat their <u>defiled</u> bread among the Gentiles, whither I will drive them.
- Ezekiel 5:11 Wherefore, as I live, saith the Lord GOD; Surely, because thou hast <u>defiled</u> My sanctuary with all thy detestable things, and with all thine

- abominations, therefore will I also diminish *thee*; neither shall Mine eye spare, neither will I have any pity.
- Ezekiel 7:22 My face will I turn also from them, and they shall pollute My secret *place*: for the robbers shall enter into it, and defile it.
- Ezekiel 7:24 Wherefore I will bring the worst of the heathen, and they shall possess their houses: I will also make the pomp of the strong to cease; and their Holy places shall be <u>defiled</u>.
- Ezekiel 9:7 And he said unto them, <u>Defile</u> the house, and fill the courts with the slain: go ye forth. And they went forth, and slew in the city.
- Ezekiel 18:6 *And* hath not eaten upon the mountains, neither hath lifted up his eyes to the idols of the house of Israel, neither hath <u>defiled</u> his neighbour's wife, neither hath come near to a menstruous woman,
- Ezekiel 18:11 And that doeth not any of those *duties*, but even hath eaten upon the mountains, and <u>defiled</u> his neighbour's wife,
- Ezekiel 18:15 *That* hath not eaten upon the mountains, neither hath lifted up his eyes to the idols of the house of Israel, hath not <u>defiled</u> his neighbour's wife.
- Ezekiel 20:7 Then said I unto them, Cast ye away every man the abominations of his eyes, and <u>defile</u> not yourselves with the idols of Egypt: I *am* the LORD your God.
- Ezekiel 20:18 But I said unto their children in the wilderness, Walk ye not in the statutes of your fathers, neither observe their judgments, nor <u>defile</u> yourselves with their idols:
- Ezekiel 20:43 And there shall ye remember your ways, and all your doings, wherein ye have been <u>defiled</u>; and ye shall lothe yourselves in your own sight for all your evils that ye have committed.
- Ezekiel 22:3 Then say thou, Thus saith the Lord GOD, The city sheddeth blood in the midst of it, that her time may come, and maketh idols against herself to defile herself.
- Ezekiel 22:4 Thou art become guilty in thy blood that thou hast shed; and hast <u>defiled</u> thyself in thine idols which thou hast made; and thou hast caused thy days to draw near, and art come *even* unto thy years: therefore have I made thee a reproach unto the heathen, and a mocking to all countries.
- Ezekiel 22:11 And one hath committed abomination with his neighbour's wife; and another hath lewdly <u>defiled</u> his daughter in law; and another in thee hath humbled his sister, his father's daughter.
- Ezekiel 23:7 Thus she committed her whoredoms with them, with all them that were the chosen men of Assyria, and with all on whom she doted: with all their idols she defiled herself.
- Ezekiel 23:13 Then I saw that she was <u>defiled</u>, that they took both one way,

- Ezekiel 23:17 And the Babylonians came to her into the bed of love, and they <u>defiled</u> her with their whoredom, and she was polluted with them, and her mind was alienated from them.
- Ezekiel 23:38 Moreover this they have done unto Me: they have <u>defiled</u> My sanctuary in the same day, and have profaned My sabbaths.
- Ezekiel 28:7 Behold, therefore I will bring strangers upon thee, the terrible of the nations: and they shall draw their swords against the beauty of thy wisdom, and they shall <u>defile</u> thy brightness.
- Ezekiel 28:18 Thou hast <u>defiled</u> thy sanctuaries by the multitude of thine iniquities, by the iniquity of thy traffick; therefore will I bring forth a fire from the midst of thee, it shall devour thee, and I will bring thee to ashes upon the earth in the sight of all them that behold thee.
- Ezekiel 33:26 Ye stand upon your sword, ye work abomination, and ye <u>defile</u> every one his neighbour's wife: and shall ye possess the land?
- Ezekiel 36:17 Son of man, when the house of Israel dwelt in their own land, they <u>defiled</u> it by their own way and by their doings: their way was before me as the uncleanness of a removed woman.
- Ezekiel 37:23 Neither shall they <u>defile</u> themselves any more with their idols, nor with their detestable things, nor with any of their transgressions: but I will save them out of all their dwellingplaces, wherein they have sinned, and will cleanse them: so shall they be My people, and I will be their God.
- Ezekiel 43:7 And Me said unto me, Son of man, the place of My throne, and the place of the soles of My feet, where I will dwell in the midst of the children of Israel for ever, and My Holy Name, shall the house of Israel no more <u>defile</u>, *neither* they, nor their kings, by their whoredom, nor by the carcases of their kings in their high places.
- Ezekiel 43:8 In their setting of their threshold by My thresholds, and their post by My posts, and the wall between Me and them, they have even <u>defiled</u> My Holy Name by their abominations that they have committed: wherefore I have consumed them in Mine anger.
- Ezekiel 44:25 And they shall come at no dead person to <u>defile</u> themselves: but for father, or for mother, or for son, or for daughter, for brother, or for sister that hath had no husband, they may <u>defile</u> themselves.
