

Spirit Of Adoption Or Spirit Of Bondage - Romans 8B

2 Corinthians 13:5 Examine yourselves as to whether you are in the faith.

**Test yourselves. Do you not know yourselves, that Jesus Christ is in you?
— unless indeed you are disqualified.**

Romans 8:6 For to be carnally minded is death, but to be spiritually minded is life and peace.

Romans 8:10-16 (NKJV) - V10 And if Christ *is* in you, the body *is* dead because of sin, but the Spirit *is* life because of righteousness.

Summarized of the symbolism of Baptism.

2 Corinthians 5:17 Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.

Hebrews 12:2 Looking unto Jesus the Author and Finisher of *our* faith; Who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God.

James 4:7 Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.

Ephesians 1:13 In whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that holy Spirit of promise,

John 4:14 But whosoever drinketh of the water that I shall give him shall never thirst; but the water that I shall give him shall be in him a well of water springing up into everlasting life.

2 Timothy 3:5 Having a form of godliness, but denying the power thereof: from such turn away.

John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.

John 18:38; 19:4; 19:6 Pilate said 3 X " I find no fault in him."

Romans 8:11 But if the Spirit of Him Who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, He Who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit Who dwells in you.

John 14:26 But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost, Whom the Father will send in My Name, He shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you.

Mark 16:20 And they went forth, and preached every where, the Lord working with them, and confirming the word with signs following. Amen.

John 14:12 Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on Me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto My Father.

Exodus 30:21 So they shall wash their hands and their feet, that they die not: and it shall be a statute for ever to them, even to him and to his seed throughout their generations.

Exodus 19:10,11 And the LORD said unto Moses, Go unto the people, and sanctify them to day and to morrow, and let them wash their clothes, 11 And be ready against the third day: for the third day the LORD will come down in the sight of all the people upon mount Sinai.

Psalms 24:4 He that hath clean hands, and a pure heart; who hath not lifted up his soul unto vanity, nor sworn deceitfully.

Romans 8:12 Therefore, brethren, we are debtors — not to the flesh, to live according to the flesh.

1 Corinthians 6:19,20 What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own? 20 For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's.

Summarized of many miraculous healings Jesus did.

Luke 17 Summarized of the 10 lepers cleansed & the 1 who thanked Jesus.

Romans 8:13 For if you live according to the flesh you will die; but if by the Spirit you put to death the deeds of the body, you will live.

1 Peter 4:4 Wherein they think it strange that ye run not with them to the same excess of riot, speaking evil of you:

Ephesians 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.

Ezekiel 13:17-23 Summarized of ungodly spiritual warfare against God's people. V23 Therefore ye shall see no more vanity, nor divine divinations: for I will deliver My people out of your hand: and ye shall know that I am the LORD.

Romans 8:14 For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, these are sons of God.

John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by Me.

Galatians 3:26 For you are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus.

Hebrews 1:14 Are they not all ministering spirits, sent forth to minister for them who shall be heirs of salvation?

Romans 8:15 For you did not receive the spirit of bondage again to fear, but you received the Spirit of Adoption by Whom we cry out, Abba, Father.

1 John 4:8 He that loveth not knoweth not God; for God is love.

John 13:34,35 A new commandment I give unto you, That ye love one another; as I have loved you, that ye also love one another. 35 By this shall all men know that ye are my disciples, if ye have love one to another.

John 3:16 For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son,

that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life.

Hebrews 12:7,8 If ye endure chastening, God deals with you as with sons; for what son is he whom the father chastens not? 8 But if ye be without chastisement, whereof all are partakers, then are ye bastards, & not sons.

Romans 8:16 The Spirit Himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God,

Exodus 8:1 And the LORD spake unto Moses, Go unto Pharaoh, and say unto him, Thus saith the LORD, Let My people go, that they may serve Me.

2 Thessalonians 3:10 For even when we were with you, this we commanded you, that if any would not work, neither should he eat.

1 Timothy 5:8 But if any provide not for his own, and specially for those of his own house, he hath denied the faith, and is worse than an infidel.

Exodus 6:9 So Moses spoke thus to the children of Israel; but they did not heed Moses, because of anguish of spirit and cruel bondage.

Romans 8:15 For you did not receive the spirit of bondage again to fear, but you received the Spirit of Adoption by Whom we cry out, Abba, Father.

Mark 5:6 But when he saw Jesus afar off, he ran and worshipped Him,

Genesis 3:10 And he said, I heard Thy voice in the garden, and I was afraid, because I was naked; and I hid myself.

Strong's #1397 *doo-li'-ah* AV-bondage 5; 1) slavery, bondage, the condition of a slave.

Romans 8:15 For you did not receive the spirit of bondage <1397> again to fear, but you received the Spirit of Adoption by Whom we cry out, Abba, Father.

2 Timothy 1:7 For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.

Isaiah 11:2 And the spirit of the LORD shall rest upon him, the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the LORD;

Romans 8:21 because the creation itself also will be delivered from the bondage <1397> of corruption into the glorious liberty of the children of God.

Galatians 4:24 which things are symbolic. For these are the two covenants: the one from Mount Sinai which gives birth to bondage <1397>, which is Hagar —

Galatians 3:10 For as many as are of the works of the law are under the curse: for it is written, Cursed is every one that continueth not in all things which are written in the book of the law to do them.

Acts 15:1,2 And certain men which came down from Judaea taught the brethren, and said, Except ye be circumcised after the manner of Moses, ye cannot be saved. 2 When therefore Paul and Barnabas had no small

dissension and disputation with them, they determined that Paul and Barnabas, and certain other of them, should go up to Jerusalem unto the apostles and elders about this question.

Galatians 2:4,5 And that because of false brethren unawares brought in, who came in privily to spy out our liberty which we have in Christ Jesus, that they might bring us into bondage: 5 To whom we gave place by subjection, no, not for an hour; that the truth of the gospel might continue with you.

Ephesians 2:8,9 For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: 9 Not of works, lest any man should boast.

Romans 2:29 But he is a Jew, which is one inwardly; and circumcision is that of the heart, in the spirit, and not in the letter; whose praise is not of men, but of God.

Matthew 5:17 Think not that I am come to destroy the law, or the prophets: I am not come to destroy, but to fulfil.

Galatians 5:1 Stand fast therefore in the liberty by which Christ has made us free, and do not be entangled again with a yoke of bondage <1397>.

Romans 6:1,2 What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin, that grace may abound? 2 God forbid. How shall we, that are dead to sin, live any longer therein?

hebrews 5:14 But strong meat belongeth to them that are of full age, even those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.

Matthew 25 Summarized of the parable of the talents. V28 Take therefore the talent from him, and give it unto him which hath ten talents.

Romans 14:12 So then every one of us shall give account of himself to God.

Hebrews 2:15 and release those who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage <1397>.

John 8:32,36 And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free. 36 If the Son therefore shall make you free, ye shall be free indeed.

Strong's #5206 *huiothesia hwee-oth-es-ee'-ah* AV-adoption 3, adoption of children 1, adoption of sons 1; 5 1) adoption, adoption as sons 1a) that relationship which God was pleased to establish between Himself and the Israelites in preference to all other nations 1b) the nature and condition of the true disciples in Christ, who by receiving the Spirit of God into their souls become sons of God 1c) the blessed state looked for in the future life after the visible return of Christ from heaven.

Revelation 19:11 Referred to Jesus' return.

Romans 8:15 For you did not receive the spirit of bondage again to fear, but you received the Spirit of Adoption <5206> by Whom we cry out, Abba, Father.

Romans 8:23 Not only *that*, but we also who have the firstfruits of the Spirit, even we ourselves groan within ourselves, eagerly waiting for the

adoption <5206>, the redemption of our body.

Revelation 20 Referred to Jesus' 1000 year rule (the first resurrection) & the final resurrection.

Romans 9:4 who are Israelites, to whom *pertain* the adoption <5206>, the glory, the covenants, the giving of the law, the service *of God*, and the promises;

2 Corinthians 5:8 We are confident, I say, and willing rather to be absent from the body, and to be present with the Lord.

Galatians 4:5 to redeem those who were under the law, that we might receive the adoption as sons <5206>.

Romans 8:2 For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death.

Romans 8:1 There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.

Ephesians 1:5 having predestined us to adoption as sons <5206> by Jesus Christ to Himself, according to the good pleasure of His will,

Summarized of the fall of mankind & God calling people back to Him through the ages.

Acts 17:30 And the times of this ignorance God winked at; but now commandeth all men every where to repent:

2 Corinthians 6:2 (For he saith, I have heard thee in a time accepted, and in the day of salvation have I succoured thee: behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation.)

John 3:7 Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again.

Genesis 12:1 Now the LORD had said unto Abram, Get thee out of thy country, and from thy kindred, and from thy father's house, unto a land that I will shew thee:

Jeremiah 1:5 Before I formed thee in the belly I knew thee; and before thou camest forth out of the womb I sanctified thee, and I ordained thee a prophet unto the nations.

1 Kings 13 Referred to Josiah predicted centuries earlier.

Matthew 11:28-30 Come unto Me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. 29 Take My yoke upon you, and learn of Me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls. 30 For My yoke is easy, and My burden is light.

Luke 8 Referred to the Gadarene demoniac set free by Jesus.
