The Holy Spirit Helps In Our Weaknesses - Romans 8D

- Romans 8:1 There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.
- Romans 8:14 For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God.
- John 4:24 God is a Spirit: and they that worship Him must worship Him in spirit and in truth.
- Galatians 3:28 There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither bond nor free, there is neither male nor female: for ye are all one in Christ Jesus.
- Romans 8:26-28 (NKJV) V26 Likewise the Spirit also helps in our weaknesses. For we do not know what we should pray for as we ought, but the Spirit Himself makes intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered.
- Summarized of many men that the Spirit of God was upon, including Samson.
- Acts 8:9,20 But there was a certain man, called Simon, which beforetime in the same city used sorcery, and bewitched the people of Samaria, giving out that himself was some great one: 20 But Peter said unto him, Thy money perish with thee, because thou hast thought that the gift of God may be purchased with money.
- Acts 19:13-16 Then certain of the vagabond Jews, exorcists, took upon them to call over them which had evil spirits the Name of the Lord Jesus, saying, We adjure you by Jesus Whom Paul preacheth. 14 And there were seven sons of one Sceva, a Jew, and chief of the priests, which did so. 15 And the evil spirit answered and said, Jesus I know, and Paul I know; but who are ye? 16 And the man in whom the evil spirit was leaped on them, and overcame them, and prevailed against them, so that they fled out of that house naked and wounded.
- Matthew 12:28 But if I cast out devils by the Spirit of God, then the kingdom of God is come unto you.
- Romans 8:13 For if ye live after the flesh, ye shall die: but if ye through the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body, ye shall live.
- Judges 16:30 And Samson said, Let me die with the Philistines. And he bowed himself with all his might; and the house fell upon the lords, and upon all the people that were therein. So the dead which he slew at his death were more than they which he slew in his life.
- Acts 19:6 And when Paul had laid his hands upon them, the Holy Ghost came on them; and they spake with tongues, and prophesied.

- Acts 15:1 And certain men which came down from Judaea taught the brethren, and said, Except ye be circumcised after the manner of Moses, ye cannot be saved.

- Mark 16:20 And they went forth, and preached every where, the Lord working with them, and confirming the word with signs following. Amen. Summarized of many miracles by God's prophets.
- 2 Kings 2:9 And it came to pass, when they were gone over, that Elijah said unto Elisha, Ask what I shall do for thee, before I be taken away from thee. And Elisha said, I pray thee, let a double portion of thy Spirit be upon me.
- James 4:3 Ye ask, and receive not, because ye ask amiss, that ye may consume it upon your lusts.
- Mark 16:18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.
- Matthew 3:16 And Jesus, when He was baptized, went up straightway out of the water: and, lo, the heavens were opened unto Him, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove, and lighting upon Him:
- Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;
- Hebrews 7:25 Wherefore He is able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by Him, seeing He ever liveth to make intercession for them.
- Ephesians 4:30 And grieve not the Holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption.
- 1 Thessalonians 5:19 Quench not the Spirit.
- Matthew 11:16 But whereunto shall I liken this generation? It is like unto children sitting in the markets, and calling unto their fellows,
- 1 Corinthians 14:15 What is it then? I will pray with the spirit, and I will pray with the understanding also: I will sing with the spirit, and I will sing with the understanding also.
- Romans 8:27 Now He who searches the hearts knows what the mind of the Spirit *is*, because He makes intercession for the saints according to *the will of* God.
- 1 Chronicles 4:10 And Jabez called on the God of Israel, saying, Oh that

- thou wouldest bless me indeed, and enlarge my coast, and that thine hand might be with me, and that thou wouldest keep me from evil, that it may not grieve me! And God granted him that which he requested. (missused)
- Matthew 6:10 Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven.
- Galatians 2:20 I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, Who loved me, and gave Himself for me.
- Acts 16:6,9,10 Now when they had gone throughout Phrygia and the region of Galatia, and were forbidden of the Holy Ghost to preach the word in Asia, 9 And a vision appeared to Paul in the night; There stood a man of Macedonia, and prayed him, saying, Come over into Macedonia, and help us. 10 And after he had seen the vision, immediately we endeavoured to go into Macedonia, assuredly gathering that the Lord had called us for to preach the gospel unto them.
- Jonah Summarized of God dealing with Jonah. V2:9 But I will sacrifice unto thee with the voice of thanksgiving; I will pay that that I have vowed. Salvation is of the LORD.
- Romans 8:28 And we know that all things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are the called according to *His* purpose.
- Matthew 10:37 He that loveth father or mother more than Me is not worthy of Me: and he that loveth son or daughter more than Me is not worthy of Me.
- Summarized of the Rich young ruler. V21,22 Then Jesus beholding him loved him, and said unto him, One thing thou lackest: go thy way, sell whatsoever thou hast, and give to the poor, and thou shalt have treasure in heaven: and come, take up the cross, and follow me. 22 And he was sad at that saying, and went away grieved: for he had great possessions.
- Mark 12:29-31 And Jesus answered him, The first of all the commandments is, Hear, O Israel; The Lord our God is one Lord: 30 And thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind, and with all thy strength: this is the first commandment. 31 And the second is like, namely this, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. There is none other commandment greater than these.
- Deuteronomy 6:5 And thou shalt love the LORD thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy might.
- Leviticus 19:18 Thou shalt not avenge, nor bear any grudge against the children of thy people, but thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself: I am the LORD.

- 1 Thessalonians 5:18 In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you.
- Acts 7,8 Referred to Stephen martyred. V60 And he kneeled down, and cried with a loud voice, Lord, lay not this sin to their charge.
- Luke 23:34 Then said Jesus, Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do. And they parted his raiment, and cast lots.
- Luke 17:9 Doth he thank that servant because he did the things that were commanded him? I trow not.
- Leviticus 26:30 And I will destroy your high places, and cut down your images, and cast your carcases upon the carcases of your idols, and my soul shall abhor you.
- Deuteronomy 18:14 For these nations, which thou shalt possess, hearkened unto observers of times, and unto diviners: but as for thee, the LORD thy God hath not suffered thee so to do.
- Exodus 32:20 And he took the calf which they had made, and burnt it in the fire, and ground it to powder, and strawed it upon the water, and made the children of Israel drink of it.
- Exodus 32:26 Then Moses stood in the gate of the camp, and said, Who is on the LORD'S side? let him come unto me. And all the sons of Levi gathered themselves together unto him.

- 1 Samuel 14 Summarized of Jonathan eating honey & refreshed.
- Matthew 8:17 that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Isaiah the prophet, saying: He Himself took our infirmities <769> And bore our sicknesses.
- Luke 5:15 However, the report went around concerning Him all the more; and great multitudes came together to hear, and to be healed by Him of their infirmities <769>.
- 1 Corinthians 12:31 But covet earnestly the best gifts: and yet shew I unto you a more excellent way.
- Luke 8:2 and certain women who had been healed of evil spirits and infirmities <769> Mary called Magdalene, out of whom had come seven demons,
- Luke 13:11,12 And behold, there was a woman who had a spirit of infirmity <769> eighteen years, and was bent over and could in no way raise

- herself up. 12 But when Jesus saw her, He called her to Him and said to her, Woman, you are loosed from your infirmity <769>.
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- Romans 8:13 For if ye live after the flesh, ye shall die: but if ye through the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body, ye shall live.
- Exodus 19:10 And the LORD said unto Moses, Go unto the people, and sanctify them to day and to morrow, and let them wash their clothes, 11 And be ready against the third day: for the third day the LORD will come down in the sight of all the people upon mount Sinai.
- Isaiah 52:11 Depart ye, depart ye, go ye out from thence, touch no unclean thing; go ye out of the midst of her; be ye clean, that bear the vessels of the LORD.
- Leviticus 4 Referred to sins that cause all to be punished.
- Joshua 7 Referred tpo all punished for Achan's sin.
- John 5:5 Now a certain man was there who had an infirmity <769> thirty-eight years.
- John 11:4 When Jesus heard *that*, He said, This sickness <769> is not unto death, but for the glory of God, that the Son of God may be glorified through it.
- Acts 28:9 So when this was done, the rest of those on the island who had diseases <769> also came and were healed.
- Romans 8:28 And we know that all things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are the called according to *His* purpose.
- Mark 16:18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover. (miss-used)
- Romans 6:19 I speak in human *terms* because of the weakness <769> of your flesh. For just as you presented your members *as* slaves of uncleanness, and of lawlessness *leading* to *more* lawlessness, so now present your members *as* slaves *of* righteousness for holiness.
- Romans 8:26 Likewise the Spirit also helps in our weaknesses <769>. For we do not know what we should pray for as we ought, but the Spirit Himself makes intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered.
- 1 Corinthians 2:3 I was with you in weakness <769>, in fear, and in much trembling.
- 2 Corinthians 12:7-9 And lest I should be exalted above measure through the abundance of the revelations, there was given to me a thorn in the

- flesh, the messenger of Satan to buffet me, lest I should be exalted above measure. 8 For this thing I besought the Lord thrice, that it might depart from me. 9 And He said unto me, My grace is sufficient for thee: for My strength is made perfect in weakness. Most gladly therefore will I rather glory in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me.
- 1 Corinthians 15:43 It is sown in dishonor, it is raised in glory. It is sown in weakness <769>, it is raised in power.
- 2 Corinthians 11:30 If I must boast, I will boast in the things which concern my infirmity <769>. (Referred to Pauls pedigree laid aside for Jesus.)
- 2 Corinthians 12:5 Of such a one I will boast; yet of myself I will not boast, except in my infirmities <769>.
- 2 Corinthians 12:9 And He said to me, My grace is sufficient for you, for My strength is made perfect in weakness <769>. Therefore most gladly I will rather boast in my infirmities <769>, that the power of Christ may rest upon me.
- Luke 4 Referred to the devil trying to knock off Jesus as he did to Adam.
- 2 Corinthians 12:10 Therefore I take pleasure in infirmities <769>, in reproaches, in needs, in persecutions, in distresses, for Christ's sake. For when I am weak, then I am strong.
- Luke 4:13 And when the devil had ended all the temptation, he departed from Him for a season.
- Mark 8:32,33 And He spake that saying openly. And Peter took Him, and began to rebuke Him. 33 But when He had turned about and looked on His disciples, He rebuked Peter, saying, Get thee behind Me, Satan: for thou savourest not the things that be of God, but the things that be of men.
- 2 Corinthians 13:4 For though He was crucified in weakness <769>, yet He lives by the power of God. For we also are weak in Him, but we shall live with Him by the power of God toward you.
- Galatians 4:13 You know that because of physical infirmity <769> I preached the gospel to you at the first.
- 1 Timothy 5:23 No longer drink only water, but use a little wine for your stomach's sake and your frequent infirmities <769>.
- John 14:26 But the <u>Helper</u>, the Holy <u>Spirit</u>, Whom the Father will send in My Name, He will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all things that I said to you.
- John 16:13 Howbeit when He, the Spirit of Truth, is come, He will guide you into all Truth: for He shall not speak of Himself; but whatsoever He shall hear, *that* shall He speak: and He will shew you things to come.
- John 15:26 But when the <u>Helper</u> comes, Whom I shall send to you from the

- Father, the <u>Spirit of Truth</u> Who proceeds from the Father, He will testify of Me.
- Romans 8:26 Likewise the <u>Spirit</u> also <u>helps</u> in our weaknesses. For we do not know what we should pray for as we ought, but the <u>Spirit</u> Himself makes intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered.
- John 16:7- Nevertheless I tell you the truth; It is expedient for you that I go away: for if I go not away, the Comforter will not come unto you; but if I depart, I will send Him unto you. 8 And when He is come, He will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment:
- Ephesians 1:13 In Whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the Word of Truth, the gospel of your salvation: in Whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that Holy Spirit of promise,
- Acts 1&2 Referred to the difference with the baptism of the Holy Spirit. More Service Notes:
- John 16:9-15 Of sin, because they believe not on Me; 10 Of righteousness, because I go to My Father, and ye see Me no more; 11 Of judgment, because the prince of this world is judged. 12 I have yet many things to say unto you, but ye cannot bear them now. 13 Howbeit when He, the Spirit of Truth, is come, He will guide you into all Truth: for He shall not speak of Himself; but whatsoever He shall hear, that shall He speak: and He will shew you things to come. 14 He shall glorify Me: for He shall receive of Mine, and shall shew it unto you. 15 All things that the Father hath are Mine: therefore said I, that He shall take of Mine, and shall shew it unto you.
- Hebrews 4:15 For we do not have a High Priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses <769>, but was in all *points* tempted as *we are, yet* without sin.
- Hebrews 5:2 He can have compassion on those who are ignorant and going astray, since he himself is also subject to weakness <769>.
- Hebrews 7:28 For the law appoints as high priests men who have weakness <769>, but the word of the oath, which came after the law, *appoints* the Son Who has been perfected forever.
- Hebrews 11:34 quenched the violence of fire, escaped the edge of the sword, out of weakness <769> were made strong, became valiant in battle, turned to flight the armies of the aliens.
