

The Sorrow Of Paul - Romans 9A

2 Corinthians 11 Referred to Paul's "In Perils" list.

Acts 9 Referred to Saul's conversion to Paul the apostle.

Matthew 7:20 Wherefore by their fruits ye shall know them.

1 Samuel 3:10 And the LORD came, and stood, and called as at other times, Samuel, Samuel. Then Samuel answered, Speak; for thy servant heareth.

Romans 8:1 There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.

Romans 8:38,39 For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, 39 Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Romans 8:28 And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose.

Romans 9:1-5 (NKJV) - V1 I tell the truth in Christ, I am not lying, my conscience also bearing me witness in the Holy Spirit,

Romans 6:1,2 What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin, that grace may abound? 2 God forbid. How shall we, that are dead to sin, live any longer therein?

John 14:6 Jesus said unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man comes unto the Father, but by Me.

Acts 5 Summarized to Ananias & Sapphira. V3 But Peter said, Ananias, why hath Satan filled thine heart to lie to the Holy Ghost, and to keep back part of the price of the land?

John 4:24 God is a Spirit: and they that worship Him must worship Him in spirit and in truth.

Romans 9:2 that I have great sorrow and continual grief in my heart.

Luke 8 Referred to the Gadarene Demoniac set free by Jesus.

Mark 5:6 But when he (the Gadarene Demoniac) saw Jesus afar off, he ran and worshipped Him,

2 Corinthians 5:14 For the love of Christ compels us, because we judge thus: that if One died for all, then all died;

Luke 17:9,10 Doth he thank that servant because he did the things that were commanded him? I trow not. 10 So likewise ye, when ye shall have done all those things which are commanded you, say, We are unprofitable servants: we have done that which was our duty to do.

Romans 9:3 For I could wish that I myself were accursed from Christ for my brethren, my countrymen according to the flesh,

John 3 Referred to Jesus talking to Nicodemus. V7 Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again.

Luke 16 Referred to the parable of Lazarus & the rich man. V23 And in hell he lift up his eyes, being in torments, and seeth Abraham afar off, and Lazarus in his bosom.

Genesis 12:1 Now the LORD had said unto Abram, Get thee out of thy country, and from thy kindred, and from thy father's house, unto a land that I will shew thee:

Genesis 17:11 And ye shall circumcise the flesh of your foreskin; and it shall be a token of the covenant betwixt me and you.

Summarized of many miracles God did for the Israelites.

Leviticus 26 Referred to God's promises & His 7 times more judgements as Israel sined more.

Genesis 25:23 And the LORD said unto her, Two nations are in thy womb, and two manner of people shall be separated from thy bowels; and the one people shall be stronger than the other people; and the elder shall serve the younger.

Genesis 14:18 And Melchizedek king of Salem brought forth bread and wine: and he was the priest of the Most High God.

Genesis 29:35 she conceived again, and bare a son: and she said, Now will I praise the LORD: therefore she called his name Judah; and left bearing.

Matthew 1 & Luke 3 show Jesus descended from the tribe of Judah.

Matthew 1:1,2 The book of the generation of Jesus Christ, the son of David, the son of Abraham. 2 Abraham begat Isaac; and Isaac begat Jacob; and Jacob begat Judah and his brethren;

Micah 5:2 But thou, Bethlehem Ephratah, though thou be little among the thousands of Judah, yet out of thee shall he come forth unto me that is to be ruler in Israel; whose goings forth have been from of old, from everlasting.

Acts 13:22 And when He had removed him, He raised up unto them David to be their king; to whom also He gave testimony, and said, I have found David the son of Jesse, a man after Mine own heart, which shall fulfil all My will.

Romans 9:4,5 who are Israelites, to whom *pertain* the adoption, the glory, the covenants, the giving of the law, the service *of God*, and the promises; 5 of whom *are* the fathers and from whom, according to the flesh, Christ *came*, who is over all, *the* eternally blessed God. Amen.

2 Timothy 3:5 Having a form of godliness, but denying the power thereof: from such turn away.

Luke 18 Pharisee & the Publican V11,13,14 The Pharisee stood and prayed thus with himself, God, I thank thee, that I am not as other men are, extortioners, unjust, adulterers, or even as this publican. 13 And the publican, standing afar off, would not lift up so much as his eyes unto heaven, but smote upon his breast, saying, God be merciful to me a sinner.

14 I tell you, this man went down to his house justified rather than the other: for every one that exalteth himself shall be abased; and he that humbleth himself shall be exalted.

John 16:8 And when He is come, He will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment: Summarized of Salvation by Jesus.

Acts 14:19 And there came thither certain Jews from Antioch and Iconium, who persuaded the people, and, having stoned Paul, drew him out of the city, supposing he had been dead. 20 Howbeit, as the disciples stood round about him, he rose up, and came into the city: and the next day he departed with Barnabas to Derbe.

John 3:17 For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved.

Mark 16:15,16 And He said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. 16 He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned.

John 15:26 But when the Comforter is come, Whom I will send unto you from the Father, even the Spirit of Truth, which proceedeth from the Father, he shall testify of Me:

Romans 9:2 that I have great sorrow and continual grief in my heart.

Strong's #3076 lupeo *loo-peh'-o* AV-be sorrowful 6, grieve 6, make sorry 6, be sorry 3, sorrow 3, cause grief 1, be in heaviness 1; 26 1) to make sorrowful 2) to affect with sadness, cause grief, to throw into sorrow 3) to grieve, offend 4) to make one uneasy, cause him a scruple.

Strong's #5604 odin *o-deen'* AV-sorrow 2, pain 1, travail 1; 4 1) the pain of childbirth, travail pain, birth pangs 2) intolerable anguish, in reference to the dire calamities precede the advent of the Messiah.

Strong's #4036 perilupos *per-il'-oo-pos* AV-exceeding sorrowful 2, very sorrowful 2, exceeding sorry 1; 5 1) very sad, exceedingly sorrowful 2) overcome with sorrow so much as to cause one's death.

Strong's #3077 lupe *loo'-pay* AV-sorrow 11, heaviness 2, grievous 1, grudging + 1537 1, grief 1, 16 1) sorrow, pain, grief, annoyance, affliction 1a) of persons mourning.

Strong's #3600 odunao *od-oo-nah'-o* AV-sorrow 2, torment 2; 4 1) to cause intense pain 2) to be in anguish, be tormented 3) to torment or distress one's self. Strong's #3601 odune *od-oo'-nay* AV-sorrow 2; 1) consuming grief, pain, sorrow.

Strong's #253 alupoteros *al-oo-pot'-er-os* or alupos *al'-oo-pos* AV-less sorrowful 1; 1) free from pain or grief.

Strong's #3997 penthos *pen'-thos* AV-sorrow 3, mourning 2; 5 1) mourning.

Matthew 17:23 and they will kill Him, and the third day He will be raised up. And they were exceedingly sorrowful.

Matthew 19:22,23 But when the young man heard that saying, he went away

sorrowful, for he had great possessions. (the Rich Young Ruler) 23 Then said Jesus unto his disciples, Verily I say unto you, That a rich man shall hardly enter into the kingdom of heaven.

Mark 10:52 And Jesus said unto him (Blind Bart), Go thy way; thy faith hath made thee whole. And immediately he received his sight, and followed Jesus in the way.

Matthew 24:8,12 All these *are* the **beginning of sorrows**. 12 And because iniquity shall abound, the love of many shall wax cold.

Matthew 26:22,37 And they were **exceedingly sorrowful**, and each of them began to say to Him, Lord, is it I? 37 And He took with Him Peter and the two sons of Zebedee, and He began to be **sorrowful and deeply distressed**.

Mark 14:50 And they all forsook Him, and fled.

Matthew 26:38 Then He said to them, **My soul is exceedingly sorrowful, even to death**. Stay here and watch with Me.

Luke 22:44 And being in an agony he prayed more earnestly: and his sweat was as it were great drops of blood falling down to the ground.

Luke 4:13 And when the devil had ended all the temptation, he departed from him for a season.

Mark 10:22 But he was sad at this Word, and **went away sorrowful**, for he had great possessions.

Mark 13:8 For nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom. And there will be earthquakes in various places, and there will be famines and troubles. These *are* the **beginnings of sorrows**.

Luke 22:32 But I have prayed for thee, that thy faith fail not: and when thou art converted, strengthen thy brethren.

Mark 14:19 And they began to be **sorrowful**, and to say to Him one by one, *Is it I?* And another *said, Is it I?*

Mark 14:34 Then He said to them, **My soul is exceedingly sorrowful, even to death**. Stay here and watch.

Colossians 4:12 Epaphras, who is one of you, a servant of Christ, saluteth you, always labouring fervently for you in prayers, that ye may stand perfect and complete in all the will of God.

Luke 18:23,24 But when he heard this, he became **very sorrowful**, for he was very rich. 24 And when Jesus saw that he became **very sorrowful**, He said, How hard it is for those who have riches to enter the kingdom of God!

Matthew 10:37 He that loveth father or mother more than Me is not worthy of Me: and he that loveth son or daughter more than Me is not worthy of Me.

Luke 22:45 When He rose up from prayer, and had come to His disciples, He found them **sleeping from sorrow**.

John 16:6 because I said these things to you, **sorrow has filled your heart**.

John 16:20 Most assuredly, I say to you that you will weep and lament, but the world will rejoice; and you will be **sorrowful**, but your **sorrow** will be

turned into joy.

Nehemiah 8:10B for the joy of the LORD is your strength.

1 Thessalonians 5:18 In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you.

Acts 16 Referred to Paul in Jail at Philippi.

John 16:21,22 A woman, when she is in labor, has sorrow because her hour has come; but as soon as she has given birth to the child, she no longer remembers the anguish, for joy that a human being has been born into the world. 22 Therefore you now have sorrow; but I will see you again and your heart will rejoice, and your joy no one will take from you.

John 10:28,29 And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of My hand. 29 My Father, which gave them me, is greater than all; and no man is able to pluck them out of my Father's hand.

Romans 8:38,39 For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, 39 Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Acts 20:38 sorrowing most of all for the words which he spoke, that they would see his face no more. And they accompanied him to the ship.

Mark 14:27 And Jesus saith unto them, All ye shall be offended because of me this night: for it is written, I will smite the shepherd, and the sheep shall be scattered.

Romans 9:2 that I have great sorrow and continual grief in my heart.

2 Corinthians 2:1 But I determined this within myself, that I would not come again to you in sorrow.

1 Corinthians 5:1 It is reported commonly that there is fornication among you, and such fornication as is not so much as named among the Gentiles, that one should have his father's wife.

2 Corinthians 2:2 For if I make you sorrowful, then who is he who makes me glad but the one who is made sorrowful by me?

Leviticus 18&20 Referred to God's laws on Morality.

2 Corinthians 2:3 And I wrote this very thing to you, lest, when I came, I should have sorrow over those from whom I ought to have joy, having confidence in you all that my joy is *the joy* of you all.

2 Corinthians 2:7 so that, on the contrary, you *ought* rather to forgive and comfort *him*, lest perhaps such a one be swallowed up with too much sorrow.

2 Corinthians 6:10 as sorrowful, yet always rejoicing; as poor, yet making many rich; as having nothing, and yet possessing all things.

2 Corinthians 7:9-11 Now I rejoice, not that you were made sorry, but that your sorrow led to repentance. For you were made sorry in a godly

manner, that you might suffer loss from us in nothing. 10 For godly sorrow produces repentance leading to salvation, not to be regretted; but the sorrow of the world produces death.

Referred to Peter versus Judas Iscariot.

1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Ephesians 4:30 And grieve not the Holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption.

1 Thessalonians 5:19 Quench not the Spirit.

2 Corinthians 7:11 For observe this very thing, that you sorrowed in a godly manner: What diligence it produced in you, *what* clearing of yourselves, *what* indignation, *what* fear, *what* vehement desire, *what* zeal, *what* vindication! In all *things* you proved yourselves to be clear in this matter.

Philippians 2:27,28 For indeed he was sick almost unto death; but God had mercy on him, and not only on him but on me also, lest I should have sorrow upon sorrow. 28 Therefore I sent him the more eagerly, that when you see him again you may rejoice, and I may be less sorrowful.

1 Thessalonians 4:13 But I do not want you to be ignorant, brethren, concerning those who have fallen asleep, lest you sorrow as others who have no hope.

2 Corinthians 5:8 We are confident, I say, and willing rather to be absent from the body, and to be present with the Lord.

1 Timothy 6:10 For the love of money is a root of all *kinds of* evil, for which some have strayed from the faith in their greediness, and pierced themselves through with many sorrows.

Matthew 18:9 And if thine eye offend thee, pluck it out, and cast it from thee: it is better for thee to enter into life with one eye, rather than having two eyes to be cast into hell fire.

John 6:63 It is the spirit that quickeneth; the flesh profiteth nothing: the words that I speak unto you, they are spirit, and they are life.

Revelation 18:7 In the measure that she glorified herself and lived luxuriously, in the same measure give her torment and sorrow; for she says in her heart, I sit as queen, and am no widow, and will not see sorrow.

Revelation 21:4 And God will wipe away every tear from their eyes; there shall be no more death, nor sorrow, nor crying. There shall be no more pain, for the former things have passed away.

Nehemiah 8:10B for the joy of the LORD is your strength.
