## **Elected To Be The Children Of God - Romans 9B**

- Romans 8:29 For whom He foreknew, He also predestined to be conformed to the image of His Son, that He might be the firstborn among many brethren.
- John 3:16 For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life.
- Acts 9 Referred to Saul saved to be Paul the Apostle.
- Jonah Summarized of Jonah running from God. V9 But I will sacrifice unto thee with the voice of thanksgiving; I will pay that that I have vowed. Salvation is of the LORD.
- Romans 9:6-13 (NKJV) But it is not that the Word of God has taken no effect. For they *are* not all Israel who *are* of Israel,
- Matthew 24:35 Heaven and earth shall pass away, but my words shall not pass away.
- Luke 4 Summarized of the using & miss-using the Word of God in the temptation of Christ.
- Ephesians 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.
- Job 1& 2 Referred to the devil testing Job.
- Luke 22:31,32 And the Lord said, Simon, Simon, behold, Satan hath desired to have you, that he may sift you as wheat: 32 But I have prayed for thee, that thy faith fail not: and when thou art converted, strengthen thy brethren.
- Matthew 24:12 And because iniquity shall abound, the love of many shall wax cold.
- 2 Corinthians 10:4 (For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;)
- 1 Timothy 5:8 But if any provide not for his own, and specially for those of his own house, he hath denied the faith, and is worse than an infidel.
- Romans 9:7 nor *are they* all children because they are the seed of Abraham; but, In Isaac your seed shall be called.
- Genesis 12:1 Now the LORD had said unto Abram, Get thee out of thy country, and from thy kindred, and from thy father's house, unto a land that I will shew thee:
- Summarized of King Saul versus King David. Acts 13:22 And when he had removed him, he raised up unto them David to be their king;

- to whom also he gave testimony, and said, I have found David the son of Jesse, a man after mine own heart, which shall fulfil all My will.
- Exodus 6:7 And I will take you to Me for a people, and I will be to you a God: and ye shall know that I am the LORD your God, which bringeth you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians.
- Genesis 25 Summarized of all Abraham's descendants & wives.
- Numbers 13&14 Summarized of Israel refusing to enter the promised land.
- 1 Samuel 17 Referred to David taking out Goliath.
- Romans 9:8 That is, those who *are* the children of the flesh, these *are* not the children of God; but the children of the promise are counted as the seed.
- Revelation 20:12,15 And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is the book of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works. 15 And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire.
- Luke 16 Summarized of the account of the Rich man & Lazarus.
- Luke 8 Summarized of the parable of the seeds.
- Romans 9:9 For this *is* the Word of promise: At this time I will come and Sarah shall have a son.
- 1 Samuel 1 Referred to Hannah provoked by the other wife.
- Romans 9:10 And not only *this*, but when Rebecca also had conceived by one man, *even* by our father Isaac
- Referred to Jacob having 4 wives & 12 sons & the discord in the family.
- Genesis 2:24 Therefore shall a man leave his father and his mother, and shall cleave unto his wife: and they shall be one flesh.
- Romans 9:11 (for *the children* not yet being born, nor having done any good or evil, that the purpose of God according to election might stand, not of works but of Him Who calls),
- Deuteronomy 21:16 Then it shall be, when he maketh his sons to inherit that which he hath, that he may not make the son of the beloved firstborn before the son of the hated, which is indeed the firstborn:
- John 9:2,3 And His disciples asked Him, saying, Master, who did sin, this man, or his parents, that he was born blind? 3 Jesus answered, Neither hath this man sinned, nor his parents: but that the works of God should be made manifest in him.
- Exodus 20:5 Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for I the LORD thy God am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third & fourth generation of them that hate me;
- John 17:12 While I was with them in the world, I kept them in Thy Name: those that thou gavest me I have kept, and none of them is lost, but the

- son of perdition; that the scripture might be fulfilled.
- John 6:70 Jesus answered them, Have not I chosen you twelve, and one of you is a devil?
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents & scorpions, & over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- Acts 8:21 Thou hast neither part nor lot in this matter: for thy heart is not right in the sight of God.
- Matthew 26:21 And as they did eat, he said, Verily I say unto you, that one of you shall betray me.
- Summarized of Peter versus Judas & how they repented.
- 2 Corinthians 7:10 For godly sorrow worketh repentance to salvation not to be repented of: but the sorrow of the world worketh death.
- John 16:8 And when He is come, He will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment:
- 1 Kings 18:37 Hear me, O LORD, hear me, that this people may know that Thou art the LORD God, and that Thou hast turned their heart back again.
- Revelation 3:20 Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear My voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with Me.
- 1 John 4:19 We love him, because he first loved us.
- Ephesians 2:8,9 For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: 9 Not of works, lest any man should boast.
- Isaiah 1:18 Come now, and let us reason together, saith the LORD: though your sins be as scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they be red like crimson, they shall be as wool.
- John 3:7 Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again.
- John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by Me.
- Jeremiah 18 Referred to the potter & the clay incident.
- Romans 9:12,13 it was said to her, The older shall serve the younger. 13 As it is written, Jacob I have loved, but Esau I have hated.
- Genesis 48:14 And Israel stretched out his right hand, and laid it upon Ephraim's head, who was the younger, and his left hand upon Manasseh's head, guiding his hands wittingly; for Manasseh was the firstborn.
- Matthew 10:37 He that loveth father or mother more than me is not worthy of me: and he that loveth son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me.
- 1 Samuel 2:29 Wherefore kick ye at My sacrifice and at Mine offering, which I have commanded in My habitation; and honourest thy sons above Me, to make yourselves fat with the chiefest of all the offerings of Israel My people?

- Genesis 21:12,13 And God said unto Abraham, Let it not be grievous in thy sight because of the lad, and because of thy bondwoman; in all that Sarah hath said unto thee, hearken unto her voice; for in Isaac shall thy seed be called. 13 And also of the son of the bondwoman will I make a nation, because he *is* thy seed.
- Genesis 17:20 And as for Ishmael, I have heard thee: Behold, I have blessed him, and will make him fruitful, and will multiply him exceedingly; twelve princes shall he beget, and I will make him a great nation.
- Galatians 3:26 For ye are all the children of God by faith in Christ Jesus. Summarized of God's call for repentance & salvation by Jesus.
- Acts 8:21-24 Thou hast neither part nor lot in this matter: for thy heart is not right in the sight of God. 22 Repent therefore of this thy wickedness, and pray God, if perhaps the thought of thine heart may be forgiven thee. 23 For I perceive that thou art in the gall of bitterness, and in the bond of iniquity. 24 Then answered Simon, and said, Pray ye to the Lord for me, that none of these things which ye have spoken come upon me.
- Acts 17:30 And the times of this ignorance God winked at; but now commandeth all men every where to repent:
- John 1:12 But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become <u>children of God</u>, to those who believe in His name:
- John 10:38 But if I do, though ye believe not me, believe the works: that ye may know, and believe, that the Father is in me, and I in him.
- John 10:8 All that ever came before me are thieves and robbers: but the sheep did not hear them. 9 I am the door: by me if any man enter in, he shall be saved, and shall go in and out, and find pasture.
- Matthew 7:13,14 Enter ye in at the strait gate: for wide is the gate, and broad is the way, that leadeth to destruction, and many there be which go in thereat: 14 Because strait is the gate, and narrow is the way, which leadeth unto life, and few there be that find it.
- Acts 9 Referred to Paul Saved.
- Matthew 7:21 Not every one that saith unto Me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of My Father which is in heaven.
- John 11:52 and not for that nation only, but also that He would gather together in one the <u>children</u> <u>of God</u> who were scattered abroad.
- John 10:16 And other sheep I have, which are not of this fold: them also I must bring, and they shall hear my voice; and there shall be one fold, and one shepherd.
- Romans 8:16 The Spirit Himself bears witness with our spirit that we are <u>children</u> of God,

- Romans 8:21 because the creation itself also will be delivered from the bondage of corruption into the glorious liberty of the <u>children of God</u>.
- Genesis 3 Referred to when sin entered the human race with the fall of mankind.
- Romans 9:8 That is, those who *are* the children of the flesh, these *are* not the <u>children of God</u>; but the children of the promise are counted as the seed.
- Philippians 2:15 that you may become blameless and harmless, <u>children</u> <u>of</u>

  <u>God</u> without fault in the midst of a crooked and perverse generation, among whom you shine as lights in the world,
- Matthew 5:15 Neither do men light a candle, and put it under a bushel, but on a candlestick; and it giveth light unto all that are in the house.
- 1 Peter 4:4 Wherein they think it strange that ye run not with them to the same excess of riot, speaking evil of you:
- 1 John 3:1,2 Behold what manner of love the Father has bestowed on us, that we should be called <u>children of God!</u> Therefore the world does not know us, because it did not know Him. 2 Beloved, now we are <u>children of God;</u> and it has not yet been revealed what we shall be, but we know that when He is revealed, we shall be like Him, for we shall see Him as He is.
- 1 John 3:10 In this the <u>children of God</u> and the children of the devil are manifest: Whoever does not practice righteousness is not of God, nor *is* he who does not love his brother.
- Strongs #1228 diabolos *dee-ab'-ol-os* AV-devil 35, false accuser 2, slanderer 1; 38 1) prone to slander, slanderous, accusing falsely 1a) a calumniator, false accuser, slanderer, 2) metaph. applied to a man who, by opposing the cause of God, may be said to act the part of the devil or to side with him. Satan the prince of the demons, the author of evil, persecuting good men, estranging mankind from God and enticing them to sin, afflicting them with diseases by means of demons who take possession of their bodies at his bidding.
- 1 John 5:2 By this we know that we love the <u>children</u> of <u>God</u>, when we love God and keep His commandments.
- John 13:34,35 A new commandment I give unto you, That ye love one another; as I have loved you, that ye also love one another. 35 By this shall all men know that ye are my disciples, if ye have love one to another.
- Strongs #1589 ekloge *ek-log-ay'* AV-election 6, chosen 1; 7 1) the act of picking out, choosing 1a) of the act of God's free will by which before the foundation of the world he decreed his blessings to certain persons 1b) the decree made from choice by which He determined to bless certain persons through Christ by grace alone 2) a thing or person chosen 2a) of persons: God's elect.

- Genesis 25:22,23 But the children struggled together within her; and she said, If *all is* well, why *am I like* this? So she went to inquire of the LORD. 23 And the LORD said to her: Two nations *are* in your womb, Two peoples shall be separated from your body; *One* people shall be stronger than the other, And the older shall serve the younger.
- Malachi 1:2,3 I have loved you, saith the LORD. Yet ye say, Wherein hast thou loved us? *Was* not Esau Jacob's brother? saith the LORD: yet I loved Jacob, 3 And I hated Esau, and laid his mountains and his heritage waste for the dragons of the wilderness.

## **More Service Notes:**

- Genesis 17:21 But My covenant will I establish with Isaac, which Sarah shall bear unto thee at this set time in the next year.
- Genesis 18:10 And He said, I will certainly return unto thee according to the time of life; and, Io, Sarah thy wife shall have a son. And Sarah heard *it* in the tent door, which *was* behind him.
- Genesis 18:14 Is any thing too hard for the LORD? At the time appointed I will return unto thee, according to the time of life, and Sarah shall have a son.
- Genesis 21:2 For Sarah conceived, and bare Abraham a son in his old age, at the set time of which God had spoken to him.
- Acts 9:15 But the Lord said to him, Go, for he is a chosen <1589> vessel of Mine to bear My Name before Gentiles, kings, and the children of Israel.
- Romans 9:11 (for *the children* not yet being born, nor having done any good or evil, that the purpose of God according to election <1589> might stand, not of works but of Him who calls),
- Romans 11:5 Even so then, at this present time there is a remnant according to the election <1589> of grace.
- Romans 11:7 What then? Israel has not obtained what it seeks; but the elect <1589> have obtained it. and the rest were blinded.
- Romans 11:28 Concerning the gospel *they are* enemies for your sake, but concerning the election <1589> they are beloved for the sake of the fathers.
- 1 Thessalonians 1:4 knowing, beloved brethren, your election <1589> by God.
- 2 Peter 1:10 Therefore, brethren, be even more diligent to make your call and election <1589> sure, for if you do these things you will never stumble;
