The Pursuit Of Righteousness - Romans 9E

- Summarized Romans 9. V12 It was said unto her, The elder shall serve the younger.
- John 10:16 And other sheep I have, which are not of this fold: them also I must bring, and they shall hear My voice; and there shall be one fold, and one shepherd.
- Acts 17:30 And the times of this ignorance God winked at; but now commandeth all men every where to repent:
- 2 Corinthians 6:2 (For He saith, I have heard thee in a time accepted, and in the day of salvation have I succoured thee: behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation.)
- Romans 9:25 As He saith also in Osee, I will call them My people, which were not My people; and her beloved, which was not beloved.
- Romans 6:1,2 What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin, that grace may abound? 2 God forbid. How shall we, that are dead to sin, live any longer therein?
- Psalms 19:13 Keep back thy servant also from presumptuous sins; let them not have dominion over me: then shall I be upright, and I shall be innocent from the great transgression.
- Romans 9:30-33 (NKJV) What shall we say then? That Gentiles, who did not pursue righteousness, have attained to righteousness, even the righteousness of faith;
- 2 Timothy 2:15 Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.
- Acts 17:11 These (Bereans) were more noble than those in Thessalonica, in that they received the word with all readiness of mind, and searched the scriptures daily, whether those things were so.
- Summarized of the Israelites views of the Gentiles.
- Mark 7:2 And when they saw some of His disciples eat bread with defiled, that is to say, with unwashen, hands, they found fault.
- Acts 9 Summarized of Saul's conversion & God's work for Paul. V15 But the Lord said unto him, Go thy way: for he is a chosen vessel unto me, to bear my name before the Gentiles, and kings, and the children of Israel:
- Acts 27:24 Saying, Fear not, Paul; thou must be brought before Caesar: and, lo, God hath given thee all them that sail with thee.
- Deuteronomy 16:16 Three times in a year shall all thy males appear before the LORD thy God in the place which he shall choose; in the feast of unleavened bread, and in the feast of weeks, and in the feast of tabernacles: and they shall not appear before the LORD empty:

Romans 9:31 but Israel, pursuing the law of righteousness, has not attained to the law of righteousness.

Luke 8 Summarized of the types of seed growth vs the corresponding people. Mark 10:46-52 And they came to Jericho: and as He went out of Jericho with His disciples and a great number of people, blind Bartimaeus, the son of Timaeus, sat by the highway side begging. 47 And when he heard that it was Jesus of Nazareth, he began to cry out, and say, Jesus, Thou Son of David, have mercy on me. 48 And many charged him that he should hold his peace: but he cried the more a great deal, Thou Son of David, have mercy on me. 49 And Jesus stood still, and commanded him to be called. And they call the blind man, saying unto him, Be of good comfort, rise; He calleth thee. 50 And he, casting away his garment, rose, and came to Jesus. 51 And Jesus answered and said unto him, What wilt thou that I

- should do unto thee? The blind man said unto Him, Lord, that I might receive my sight. 52 And Jesus said unto him, Go thy way; thy faith hath made thee whole. And immediately he received his sight, and followed Jesus in the way.
- Luke 17 Referred to the 10 lepers healed & just 1 returned to thank Jesus.
- Acts 5:29 Then Peter and the other apostles answered and said, We ought to obey God rather than men.
- Romans 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.
- **Exodus 20 Referred to the 10 Commandments.**
- Leviticus 11:45 For I am the LORD that bringeth you up out of the land of Egypt, to be your God: ye shall therefore be Holy, for I am Holy.
- 2 Corinthians 9:7 Every man according as he purposeth in his heart, so let him give; not grudgingly, or of necessity: for God loveth a cheerful giver.
- Psalms 51 Summarized of David's repentance from the heart.
- Referred to Jesus cleaning out the Temple at the beginning & end of His ministry.
- John 4 Jesus revealed Himself to the woman at the well first as a Good Man, then as a Prophet, then as the Messiah.
- John 4 Summarized of Jesus talking to the Woman at well. V29 Come, see a Man, which told me all things that ever I did: is not this the Christ?
- Romans 9:32 Why? Because *they did* not *seek it* by faith, but as it were, by the works of the law. For they stumbled at that stumbling stone.
- Acts 15:1,2 And certain men which came down from Judaea taught the brethren, and said, Except ye be circumcised after the manner of Moses, ye cannot be saved. 2 When therefore Paul and Barnabas had no small dissension and disputation with them, they determined that Paul and Barnabas, and certain other of them, should go up to Jerusalem unto the apostles and elders about this question.
- Revelation 3:20 Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear My voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with Me.
- Israel was watching for the Conquering King but they missed Him coming as the Suffering Servant.
- The Gospel of Matthew shows that Jesus was the fulfilment of prophesy.
- Isaiah 6:9,10 And He said, Go, and tell this people, Hear ye indeed, but understand not; and see ye indeed, but perceive not. 10 Make the heart of this people fat, and make their ears heavy, and shut their eyes; lest they see with their eyes, and hear with their ears, and understand with their heart, and convert, and be healed.
- John 8:7-11 So when they continued asking him, He lifted up Himself, and

- said unto them, He that is without sin among you, let him first cast a stone at her. 8 And again He stooped down, and wrote on the ground. 9 And they which heard it, being convicted by their own conscience, went out one by one, beginning at the eldest, even unto the last: and Jesus was left alone, and the woman standing in the midst. 10 When Jesus had lifted up Himself, and saw none but the woman, He said unto her, Woman, where are those thine accusers? hath no man condemned thee? 11 She said, No man, Lord. And Jesus said unto her, Neither do I condemn thee: go, and sin no more.
- 2 Corinthians 11:4 For if he that cometh preacheth another Jesus, whom we have not preached, or if ye receive another spirit, which ye have not received, or another gospel, which ye have not accepted, ye might well bear with him.
- John 10:9 I am the door: by Me if any man enter in, he shall be saved, and shall go in and out, and find pasture.
- John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by Me.
- Luke 16 Summarized of the parable of the rich man & Lazarus. V23 And in hell he lift up his eyes, being in torments, and seeth Abraham afar off, and Lazarus in his bosom.
- Romans 9:33 As it is written: Behold, I lay in Zion a stumbling stone and rock of offense, And whoever believes on Him will not be put to shame.
- Matthew 5:17 Think not that I am come to destroy the law, or the prophets: I am not come to destroy, but to fulfil.
- John 10:41 Ye do the deeds of your father. Then said they to Him, We be not born of fornication; we have one Father, even God.
- Isaiah 53:9 And He made His grave with the wicked, and with the rich in His death; because He had done no violence, neither was any deceit in His mouth.
- Matthew 26:52,53 Then said Jesus unto him, Put up again thy sword into his place: for all they that take the sword shall perish with the sword. 53 Thinkest thou that I cannot now pray to My Father, and He shall presently give Me more than twelve legions of angels?
- 1 Kings 18:37 Hear me, O LORD, hear me, that this people may know that Thou art the LORD God, and that Thou hast turned their heart back again.
- Daniel 4:16 Let his heart be changed from man's, and let a beast's heart be given unto him; and let seven times pass over him.
- John 14:2,3 In My Father's house are many mansions: if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. 3 And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto Myself; that where I am, there ye may be also.
- Ephesians 1:13 In Whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the Word of

- Truth, the Gospel of your salvation: in Whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that Holy Spirit of promise,
- Ephesians 4:30 And grieve not the Holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption.
- Galatians 3:24 (AV) Wherefore the <u>law</u> was our <u>schoolmaster</u> to bring us unto Christ, that we might be justified by faith
- Galatians 3:24 (NKJV) Therefore the law was our tutor *to bring us* to Christ, that we might be justified by faith.
- Summarized of the religious leaders trying to trip up Jesus.
- Mark 12:24 And Jesus answering said unto them, Do ye not therefore err, because ye know not the scriptures, neither the power of God?
- Matthew 23:23 Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you pay tithe of mint and anise and cummin, and have neglected the weightier *matters* of the law: justice and mercy and faith. These you ought to have done, without leaving the others undone.
- Matthew 5:38,39 Ye have heard that it hath been said, An eye for an eye, and a tooth for a tooth: 39 But I say unto you, That ye resist not evil: but whosoever shall smite thee on thy right cheek, turn to him the other also.
- Matthew 23:24 Blind guides, who strain out a gnat and swallow a camel!
- Romans 9:30 What shall we say then? That Gentiles, who did not <u>pursue</u> <u>righteousness</u>, have attained to righteousness, even the righteousness of faith;
- 1 Timothy 6:11 But you, O man of God, flee these things and <u>pursue</u> <u>righteousness</u>, godliness, faith, love, patience, gentleness.
- Galatians 5:22,23 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, 23 Meekness, temperance: against such there is no law.
- 2 Timothy 2:22 Flee also youthful lusts; but <u>pursue</u> <u>righteousness</u>, faith, love, peace with those who call on the Lord out of a pure heart.
- Psalms 118:22 The stone *which* the builders refused is become the head *stone* of the corner.
- Isaiah 8:14,15 And He shall be for a sanctuary; but for a stone of stumbling and for a rock of offence to both the houses of Israel, for a gin and for a snare to the inhabitants of Jerusalem. 15 And many among them shall stumble, and fall, and be broken, and be snared, and be taken.
- Isaiah 28:16 Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD, Behold, I lay in Zion for a foundation a stone, a tried stone, a precious corner *stone*, a sure foundation: he that believeth shall not make haste.
- Matthew 21:42 Jesus saith unto them, Did ye never read in the scriptures,
 The stone which the builders rejected, the same is become the head of
 the corner: this is the Lord's doing, and it is marvellous in our eyes?

 Matthew 21:44 And whosoever shall fall on this stone shall be broken: but on

- whomsoever it shall fall, it will grind him to powder.
- Romans 10:11 For the scripture saith, Whosoever believeth on Him shall not be ashamed.
- 1 Peter 2:7,8 Unto you therefore which believe *He is* precious: but unto them which be disobedient, the stone which the builders disallowed, the same is made the head of the corner, 8 And a stone of stumbling, and a rock of offence, *even to them* which stumble at the Word, being disobedient: whereunto also they were appointed.
- 2 Corinthians 6:2 (For He saith, I have heard thee in a time accepted, and in the day of salvation have I succoured thee: behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation.)
- Luke 18:9-12 And He spake this parable unto certain which trusted in themselves that they were righteous, and despised others: 10 Two men went up into the temple to pray; the one a Pharisee, and the other a publican (tax collector). 11 The Pharisee stood and prayed thus with himself, God, I thank Thee, that I am not as other men *are*, extortioners, unjust, adulterers, or even as this publican. 12 I fast twice in the week, I give tithes of all that I possess.
- Matthew 6:16-18 Moreover when ye fast, be not, as the hypocrites, of a sad countenance: for they disfigure their faces, that they may appear unto men to fast. Verily I say unto you, They have their reward. 17 But thou, when thou fastest, anoint thine head, and wash thy face; 18 That thou appear not unto men to fast, but unto thy Father which is in secret: and thy Father, which seeth in secret, shall reward thee openly.
- Luke 18:13 And the publican, standing afar off, would not lift up so much as *his* eyes unto heaven, but smote upon his breast, saying, <u>God be merciful</u> to me a sinner.
- Isaiah 14 Referred to the devil's 5 "I will"'s.
- Luke 18:14 I tell you, this man went down to his house justified *rather* than the other: for every one that exalteth himself shall be abased; and he that humbleth himself shall be exalted.
- Matthew 23 Referred to Jesus addressing the religious leaders hypocracy. Romans 16:18 For they that are such serve not our Lord Jesus Christ, but their own belly; and by good words and fair speeches deceive the hearts of the simple.
- Matthew 11:28 Come unto Me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.
