## Zeal, Knowledge And Ignorance - Romans 10A

- 2 Timothy 2:15 Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the Word of Truth.
- 1 Kings 18:37 Hear me, O LORD, hear me, that this people may know that Thou art the LORD God, and that Thou hast turned their heart back again.
- Exodus 6:7 And I will take you to Me for a people, and I will be to you a God: and ye shall know that I am the LORD your God, which bringeth you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians.
- Isaiah 58 Referred to Isaiah's prophesy to get back to God.
- Philippians 3 Referred to Paul's pedigree.
- Galatians 1:17,18 Neither went I up to Jerusalem to them which were apostles before me; but I went into Arabia, and returned again unto Damascus. 18 Then after three years I went up to Jerusalem to see Peter, and abode with him fifteen days.
- 2 Corinthians 11:33 And through a window in a basket was I let down by the wall, and escaped his hands.
- Acts 14:19 And there came thither certain Jews from Antioch and Iconium, who persuaded the people, and, having stoned Paul, drew him out of the city, supposing he had been dead.
- 2 Corinthians 11 Referred to Paul's "In Perils" list.
- Romans 10:1-3 (NKJV) Brethren, my heart's desire and prayer to God for Israel is that they may be saved.
- Romans 8:13 For if ye live after the flesh, ye shall die: but if ye through the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body, ye shall live.
- 2 Corinthians 5:17 Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.
- Luke 23:34 Then said Jesus, Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do. And they parted His raiment, and cast lots.
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- Luke 18 Referred to the parable of the Pharisee & the Publican praying.
- Luke 6:28 Bless them that curse you, and pray for them which despitefully use you.
- Matthew 5:44 But I say unto you, Love your enemies, bless them that curse you, do good to them that hate you, and pray for them which despitefully

- use you, and persecute you;
- 1 Kings 18 & 2 Kings 1 Referred to Prophets calling down fire from Heaven.
- 2 Kings 6:18,22 And when they came down to him, Elisha prayed unto the LORD, and said, Smite this people, I pray thee, with blindness. And he smote them with blindness according to the word of Elisha. 22 And he answered, Thou shalt not smite them: wouldest thou smite those whom thou hast taken captive with thy sword and with thy bow? set bread and water before them, that they may eat and drink, and go to their master.
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- Hebrews 1:14 Are they (God's angels)not all ministering spirits, sent forth to minister for them who shall be heirs of salvation?
- Romans 10:2,3 For I bear them witness that they have a zeal for God, but not according to knowledge. 3 For they being ignorant of God's righteousness, and seeking to establish their own righteousness, have not submitted to the righteousness of God.
- Romans 10:2 For I bear them witness that they have a zeal for God, but not according to knowledge.
- Acts 22:5 As also the high priest doth bear me witness, and all the estate of the elders: from whom also I received letters unto the brethren, and went to Damascus, to bring them which were there bound unto Jerusalem, for to be punished.
- Matthew 22:17 Tell us therefore, What thinkest thou? Is it lawful to give tribute unto Caesar, or not?
- Referred to Jesus cleaning out the temple twice.
- Matthew 21:13 And said unto them, It is written, My house shall be called the house of prayer; but ye have made it a den of thieves.
- Luke 24:45 Then opened He their understanding, that they might understand the scriptures,
- James 1:25 But whoso looketh into the perfect law of liberty, and continueth therein, he being not a forgetful hearer, but a doer of the work, this man shall be blessed in his deed.
- John 3:16 For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life.
- Isaiah 55:9 For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are My ways higher than your ways, and My thoughts than your thoughts.
- Galatians 3:1 O foolish Galatians, who hath bewitched you, that ye should

- not obey the truth, before whose eyes Jesus Christ hath been evidently set forth, crucified among you? (modern versions omit part)
- Mark 16:9-20 Modern versions say not in Bible but was in most manuscripts.
- Romans 10:3 For they being ignorant of God's righteousness, and seeking to establish their own righteousness, have not submitted to the righteousness of God.
- **Exodus 20 Referred to the 10 Commandments.**
- Exodus 20 Summarized of the 10 Commandments. The first table was on their relationship with God. The second table was on their relationship with mankind.
- Isaiah 58 Summarized of Israel's ungodly fasting not God's way.
- Matthew 6:17,18 But thou, when thou fastest, anoint thine head, and wash thy face; 18 That thou appear not unto men to fast, but unto thy Father which is in secret: and thy Father, which seeth in secret, shall reward thee openly.
- Matthew 6:10 Thy kingdom come. <u>Thy will be done</u> in earth, as it is in heaven.
- 2 Corinthians 11:4 For if he that cometh preacheth another Jesus, whom we have not preached, or if ye receive another spirit, which ye have not received, or another gospel, which ye have not accepted, ye might well bear with him.
- Philippians 4:3 And I intreat thee also, true yokefellow, help those women which laboured with me in the gospel, with Clement also, and with other my fellowlabourers, whose names are in the book of life.
- Revelation 18:4 And I heard another voice from heaven, saying, Come out of her, My people, that ye be not partakers of her sins, and that ye receive not of her plagues.
- Strongs #2205 zelos *dzay'-los* AV-zeal 6, envying 5, indignation 2, envy 1, fervent mind 1, jealousy 1, emulation 1; 17 1) excitement of mind, ardour, fervour of spirit 1a) zeal, ardour in embracing, pursuing, defending anything 1a1) zeal in behalf of, for a person or thing 1a2) the fierceness of indignation, punitive zeal 1b) an envious and contentious rivalry, jealousy.
- 2 Corinthians 13:5 Examine yourselves, whether ye be in the faith; prove your own selves. Know ye not your own selves, how that Jesus Christ is in you, except ye be reprobates?
- Strongs #1922 epignosis *ep-ig'-no-sis* AV-knowledge 16, acknowledging 3, acknowledgement 1; 20 1) precise and correct knowledge 1a) used in

- the NT of the knowledge of things ethical and Divine.

- Strongs #50 agnoeo *ag-no-eh'-o* AV-be ignorant 7, ignorant 4, know not 4, understand not 3, ignorantly 2, unknown 2; 22 1) act. to be ignorant, not to know {Acts 13:27; 17:23; Rom 10:3; 2Pe 2:12} pass. not know or disregarded {1Cor 14:38} 2) not to understand, unknown {Mr 9:32 Luk 9:45} 3) to err or sin through mistake, to be wrong, spoken mildly of those who are not high handed or wilful transgressors {Heb 5:2}.
- Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; <u>In My Name</u> shall they cast out devils (demons); they shall speak with new tongues;
- Strongs #2208 Zelotes *dzay-lo-tace'* AV-Zelotes 2; 1) one burning with zeal, a zealot 2) used of God as jealous of any rival and sternly vindicating His control 3) most eagerly desirous of, zealous for, a thing 3a) to acquire a thing, (zealous of) 3b) to defend and uphold a thing, vehemently contending for a thing.
- From the time of the Maccabees there existed among the Jews a class of men, called Zealots, who vigorously adhered to the Mosaic law and endeavouring even by a resort to violence, after the example of Phinehas (Numbers 25), to prevent religion from being violated by others; but in the latter days of the Jewish commonwealth they used their holy zeal as a pretext for the basest criminal acts.
- Luke 11:23 He that is not with me is against me: and he that gathereth not with me scattereth.
- Revelation 2&3 Referred to our Lord chastising most of the churches.
- Numbers 11:29 Then Moses said to him, Are you <u>zealous</u> for my sake? Oh, that all the <u>LORD</u>'S people were prophets *and* that the <u>LORD</u> would put His Spirit upon them!
- Acts 1&2 Referred to before & after the infilling of the Holy Spirit.
- Numbers 25:13 and it shall be to him and his descendants after him a covenant of an everlasting priesthood, because he was <u>zealous for his God</u>, and made atonement for the children of Israel.
- **Exodus 22:18 Thou shalt not suffer a witch to live.**
- John 8:10,11 When Jesus had lifted up himself, and saw none but the woman, he said unto her, Woman, where are those thine accusers? hath no man condemned thee? 11 She said, No man, Lord. And Jesus said unto her, Neither do I condemn thee: go, and sin no more.
- John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more

- abundantly.
- 1 Kings 19:10 So he said, I have been <u>very zealous for the LORD God</u> of hosts; for the children of Israel have forsaken Your covenant, torn down Your altars, and killed Your prophets with the sword. I alone am left; and they seek to take my life.
- 1 Kings 19:14 And he said, I have been <u>very zealous for the LORD God</u> of hosts; because the children of Israel have forsaken Your covenant, torn down Your altars, and killed Your prophets with the sword. I alone am left; and they seek to take my life.
- Matthew 5:17 Think not that I am come to destroy the law, or the prophets: I am not come to destroy, but to fulfil.
- Mark 16:9 Now when Jesus was risen early the first day of the week, he appeared first to Mary Magdalene, out of whom he had cast seven devils.
- 2 Kings 10:16 Then he said, Come with me, and see my <u>zeal for the LORD</u>. So they had him ride in his chariot.
- 2 Kings 19:31 For out of Jerusalem shall go a remnant, And those who escape from Mount Zion. The <u>zeal of the LORD</u> of hosts will do this. Summarized of God dealing with Sinacerib.
- Proverbs 23:17 Do not let your heart envy sinners, But <u>be zealous</u> for the fear of the LORD all the day;
- Revelation 20:15 And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire.
- Isaiah 9:7 Of the increase of *His* government and peace *There will be* no end, Upon the throne of David and over His kingdom, To order it and establish it with judgment and justice From that time forward, even forever. The <u>zeal of the LORD</u> of hosts will perform this.
- John 9:4 I must work the works of him that sent me, while it is day: the night cometh, when no man can work.
- 2 Corinthians 6:2 (For He saith, I have heard thee in a time accepted, and in the day of salvation have I succoured thee: behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation.)
- Isaiah 37:32 For out of Jerusalem shall go a remnant, And those who escape from Mount Zion. The <u>zeal of the LORD</u> of hosts will do this.
- Mark 13:14 But when ye shall see the abomination of desolation, spoken of by Daniel the prophet, standing where it ought not, (let him that readeth understand,) then let them that be in Judaea flee to the mountains:
- Isaiah 42:13 The <u>LORD</u> shall go forth like a mighty man; He shall <u>stir up *His* zeal</u> like a man of war. He shall cry out, yes, shout aloud; He shall prevail against His enemies.

- Ezekiel 5:13 Thus shall My anger be spent, and I will cause My fury to rest upon them, and I will be avenged; and they shall know that I, the <u>LORD</u>, have spoken *it* in My <u>zeal</u>, when I have spent My fury upon them.
- 1 Peter 4:17 For the time is come that judgment must begin at the house of God: and if it first begin at us, what shall the end be of them that obey not the gospel of God?
- Joel 2:18 Then the <u>LORD will be zealous</u> for His land, And pity His people. Zechariah 1:14 So the angel who spoke with me said to me, Proclaim,
- saying, Thus says the <u>LORD</u> of hosts: <u>I am zealous for Jerusalem and for</u> Zion with great zeal.
- 1 John 2:1 My little children, these things write I unto you, that ye sin not. And if any man sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous:
- Romans 8:34 Who is he that condemneth? It is Christ that died, yea rather, that is risen again, who is even at the right hand of God, who also maketh intercession for us.
- Zechariah 8:2 Thus says the <u>LORD</u> of hosts: <u>I am zealous for Zion with</u> <u>great zeal; With great fervor I am zealous</u> for her.
- Acts 21:20 And when they heard *it*, they glorified the <u>Lord</u>. And they said to him, You see, brother, how many myriads of Jews there are who have believed, and they are all <u>zealous for the law</u>;
- Acts 22:3 I am indeed a Jew, born in Tarsus of Cilicia, but brought up in this city at the feet of Gamaliel, taught according to the strictness of our fathers' law, and was <u>zealous toward God</u> as you all are today.
- Romans 10:2 For I bear them witness that they have a <u>zeal for God</u>, but not according to knowledge.
- 2 Corinthians 7:11 For observe this very thing, that you sorrowed in a godly manner: What diligence it produced in you, what clearing of yourselves, what indignation, what fear, what vehement desire, what zeal, what vindication! In all things you proved yourselves to be clear in this matter.
- 1 Samuel 2 Referred to God dealing with the sins of Hophni and Phinehas.
