To Humble Thee - Deuteronomy 8

- Job 1&2 Referred to Job's testings by the devil & God's limits.
- Jonah 2:9 But I will sacrifice unto Tee with the voice of thanksgiving; I will pay that I have vowed. Salvation is of the LORD.
- Numbers 12:3 (Now the man Moses was very meek, above all the men which were upon the face of the earth.)
- Matthew 11:29 Take My yoke upon you, and learn of Me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls.
- Hebrews 12:4-11 Ye have not yet resisted unto blood, striving against sin. 5
 And ye have forgotten the exhortation which speaketh unto you as unto children, My son, despise not thou the chastening of the Lord, nor faint when thou art rebuked of Him: 6 For whom the Lord loveth He chasteneth, and scourgeth every son whom He receiveth. 7 If ye endure chastening, God dealeth with you as with sons; for what son is he whom the father chasteneth not? 8 But if ye be without chastisement, whereof all are partakers, then are ye bastards, and not sons. 9 Furthermore we have had fathers of our flesh which corrected us, and we gave them reverence: shall we not much rather be in subjection unto the Father of spirits, and live? 10 For they verily for a few days chastened us after their own pleasure; but he for our profit, that we might be partakers of his Holiness. 11 Now no chastening for the present seemeth to be joyous, but grievous: nevertheless afterward it yieldeth the peaceable fruit of righteousness unto them which are exercised thereby.
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;
- Matthew 18:18 Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.
- Romans 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.
- Referred to the Judges of Israelites turning from God & being judged, then repenting & God freeing them, but increasing the judgment each time.
- Deuteronomy 8:1-20 (AV) & (NKJV)

 Deuteronomy 8:1 (AV) All the commandment
- Deuteronomy 8:1 (AV) All the commandments which I command thee this day shall ye observe to do, that ye may live, and multiply, and go in and possess the land which the LORD sware unto your fathers.

- Deuteronomy 8:1 (NKJV) Every commandment which I command you today you must be careful to observe, that you may live and multiply, and go in and possess the land of which the LORD swore to your fathers.
- **Exodus 20 Referred to God giving the 10 Commandments.**
- **Exodus 32 Referred to the golden calf sin.**
- Numbers 14:11 And the LORD said unto Moses, How long will this people provoke me? and how long will it be ere they believe me, for all the signs which I have shewed among them?
- Genesis 2:17 But of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, thou shalt not eat of it: for in the day that thou eatest thereof thou shalt surely die.
- Acts 15:20 But that we write unto them, that they abstain from pollutions of idols, and from fornication, and from things strangled, and from blood.
- Deuteronomy 8:2 (AV) And thou shalt remember all the way which the LORD thy God led thee these forty years in the wilderness, to humble thee, and to prove thee, to know what was in thine heart, whether thou wouldest keep His commandments, or no.
- Deuteronomy 8:2 (NKJV) And you shall remember that the LORD your God led you all the way these forty years in the wilderness, to humble you *and* test you, to know what *was* in your heart, whether you would keep His commandments or not.
- Exodus 13:21 And the LORD went before them by day in a pillar of a cloud, to lead them the way; and by night in a pillar of fire, to give them light; to go by day and night:
- Summarized of the murmurings of the Israelites in the wilderness.
- Luke 18 Referred to the parable of the Pharisee & the Publican.
- 1 Corinthians 12:31 But covet earnestly the best gifts: and yet shew I unto you a more excellent way.
- Job 1:21,22 21 And said, Naked came I out of my mother's womb, and naked shall I return thither: the LORD gave, and the LORD hath taken away; blessed be the name of the LORD. 22 In all this Job sinned not, nor charged God foolishly.
- Job 2:9 Then said his wife unto him, Dost thou still retain thine integrity? curse God, and die.
- Deuteronomy 8:3 (AV) And He humbled thee, and suffered thee to hunger, and fed thee with manna, which thou knewest not, neither did thy fathers know; that He might make thee know that man doth not live by bread only, but by every *Word* that proceedeth out of the mouth of the LORD doth man live.
- Deuteronomy 8:3 (NKJV) So He humbled you, allowed you to hunger, and fed you with manna which you did not know nor did your fathers know, that He might make you know that man shall not live by bread alone; but man lives

- by every Word that proceeds from the mouth of the LORD.
- Exodus 32:10,12 Now therefore let me alone, that my wrath may wax hot against them, and that I may consume them: and I will make of thee a great nation. 12 Wherefore should the Egyptians speak, and say, For mischief did he bring them out, to slay them in the mountains, and to consume them from the face of the earth? Turn from thy fierce wrath, and repent of this evil against thy people.
- Summarized of God providing food for Israel in the wilderness.
- Joshua 3:15 And as they that bare the ark were come unto Jordan, and the feet of the priests that bare the ark were dipped in the brim of the water, (for Jordan overfloweth all his banks all the time of harvest,)
- John 6:48 I am that bread of life.
- Deuteronomy 8:4 (AV) Thy raiment waxed not old upon thee, neither did thy foot swell, these forty years.
- Deuteronomy 8:4 (NKJV) Your garments did not wear out on you, nor did your foot swell these forty years.
- Deuteronomy 8:5 (AV) Thou shalt also consider in thine heart, that, as a man chasteneth his son, so the LORD thy God chasteneth thee.
- Deuteronomy 8:5 (NKJV) You should know in your heart that as a man chastens his son, so the LORD your God chastens you.
- John 10:10 The thief (devil) cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.
- Deuteronomy 8:6 (AV) Therefore thou shalt keep the commandments of the LORD thy God, to walk in His ways, and to fear Him.
- Deuteronomy 8:6 (NKJV) Therefore you shall keep the commandments of the LORD your God, to walk in His ways and to fear Him.
- Matthew 7:14 Because strait is the gate, and narrow is the way, which leadeth unto life, and few there be that find it.
- Philippians 2:12 Wherefore, my beloved, as ye have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling.
- Ephesians 4:30 And grieve not the holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption.
- Exodus 20:5 Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for I the LORD thy God am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation of them that hate Me;
- Nehemiah 9:2 And the seed of Israel separated themselves from all strangers, and stood and confessed their sins, and the iniquities of their fathers.

- Isaiah 6 Referred to Isaiah's vision of God.
- Romans 10:17 So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the Word of God.
- Deuteronomy 8:7 (AV) For the LORD thy God bringeth thee into a good land, a land of brooks of water, of fountains and depths that spring out of valleys and hills;
- Deuteronomy 8:7 (NKJV) For the LORD your God is bringing you into a good land, a land of brooks of water, of fountains and springs, that flow out of valleys and hills;
- Deuteronomy 8:8 (AV) A land of wheat, and barley, and vines, and fig trees, and pomegranates; a land of oil olive, and honey;
- Deuteronomy 8:8 (NKJV) a land of wheat and barley, of vines and fig trees and pomegranates, a land of olive oil and honey;
- Exodus 3:8 And I am come down to deliver them out of the hand of the Egyptians, and to bring them up out of that land unto a good land and a large, unto a land flowing with milk and honey; unto the place of the Canaanites, and the Hittites, and the Amorites, and the Perizzites, and the Hivites, and the Jebusites.
- Deuteronomy 8:9 (AV) A land wherein thou shalt eat bread without scarceness, thou shalt not lack any *thing* in it; a land whose stones *are* iron, and out of whose hills thou mayest dig brass.
- Deuteronomy 8:9 (NKJV) a land in which you will eat bread without scarcity, in which you will lack nothing; a land whose stones *are* iron and out of whose hills you can dig copper.
- Deuteronomy 8:10 (AV) When thou hast eaten and art full, then thou shalt bless the LORD thy God for the good land which He hath given thee.
- Deuteronomy 8:10 (NKJV) When you have eaten and are full, then you shall bless the LORD your God for the good land which He has given you.
- Matthew 26:26 And as they were eating, Jesus took bread, and blessed it, and brake it, and gave it to the disciples, and said, Take, eat; this is My body.
- Luke 21:34 And take heed to yourselves, lest at any time your hearts be overcharged with surfeiting, and drunkenness, and cares of this life, and so that day come upon you unawares.
- Luke 12:48 But he that knew not, and did commit things worthy of stripes, shall be beaten with few stripes. For unto whomsoever much is given, of him shall be much required: and to whom men have committed much, of him they will ask the more.
- Deuteronomy 8:11 (AV) Beware that thou forget not the LORD thy God, in not keeping His commandments, and His judgments, and His statutes, which I command thee this day:

- Deuteronomy 8:11 (NKJV) Beware that you do not forget the LORD your God by not keeping His commandments, His judgments, and His statutes which I command you today,
- Deuteronomy 8:12 (AV) Lest *when* thou hast eaten and art full, and hast built goodly houses, and dwelt *therein*;
- Deuteronomy 8:12 (NKJV) lest when you have eaten and are full, and have built beautiful houses and dwell in them;
- Deuteronomy 8:13 (AV) And *when* thy herds and thy flocks multiply, and thy silver and thy gold is multiplied, and all that thou hast is multiplied;
- Deuteronomy 8:13 (NKJV) and *when* your herds and your flocks multiply, and your silver and your gold are multiplied, and all that you have is multiplied; Genesis 30 Referred to Jacob's herds multiplying.
- John 6:26 Jesus answered them and said, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Ye seek me, not because ye saw the miracles, but because ye did eat of the loaves, and were filled.
- Deuteronomy 8:14 (AV) Then thine heart be lifted up, and thou forget the LORD thy God, which brought thee forth out of the land of Egypt, from the house of bondage;
- Deuteronomy 8:14 (NKJV) when your heart is lifted up, and you forget the LORD your God who brought you out of the land of Egypt, from the house of bondage;
- Daniel 4 Referred to Nebuchadnezzar heart is lifted up in pride.
- Daniel 5 Referred to Belshazzar & God dealing with him.
- Leviticus 26 Referred to God increasing judgment against sinful Israel.
- Jeremiah 18 Referred to the account of the Potter & the clay.
- Exodus 7:14 And the LORD said unto Moses, Pharaoh's heart is hardened, he refuseth to let the people go.
- Deuteronomy 8:15 (AV) Who led thee through that great and terrible wilderness, wherein were fiery serpents, and scorpions, and drought, where there was no water; who brought thee forth water out of the rock of flint;
- Deuteronomy 8:15 (NKJV) who led you through that great and terrible wilderness, *in which were* fiery serpents and scorpions and thirsty land where there was no water; who brought water for you out of the flinty rock;
- Exodus 12:12 For I will pass through the land of Egypt this night, and will smite all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, both man and beast; and against all the gods of Egypt I will execute judgment: I am the LORD.
- Summarized of God dealing with sinful Israel in the wilderness.
- Exodus 15:26 And said, If thou wilt diligently hearken to the voice of the LORD thy God, and wilt do that which is right in His sight, and wilt give ear

- to His commandments, and keep all His statutes, I will put none of these diseases upon thee, which I have brought upon the Egyptians: for I am the LORD that healeth thee.
- Deuteronomy 7:15 And the LORD will take away from thee all sickness, and will put none of the evil diseases of Egypt, which thou knowest, upon thee; but will lay them upon all them that hate thee.
- Deuteronomy 8:16 (AV) Who fed thee in the wilderness with manna, which thy fathers knew not, that he might humble thee, and that he might prove thee, to do thee good at thy latter end;
- Deuteronomy 8:16 (NKJV) who fed you in the wilderness with manna, which your fathers did not know, that He might humble you and that He might test you, to do you good in the end —
- Ephesians 6:4 And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.
- Deuteronomy 8:17 (AV) And thou say in thine heart, My power and the might of *mine* hand hath gotten me this wealth.
- Deuteronomy 8:17 (NKJV) then you say in your heart, My power and the might of my hand have gained me this wealth.
- Daniel 4:30 The king spake, and said, Is not this great Babylon, that I have built for the house of the kingdom by the might of my power, and for the honour of my majesty?
- Deuteronomy 8:18 (AV) But thou shalt remember the LORD thy God: for *it is* He that giveth thee power to get wealth, that He may establish His covenant which He sware unto thy fathers, as *it is* this day.
- Deuteronomy 8:18 (NKJV) And you shall remember the LORD your God, for *it* is He who gives you power to get wealth, that He may establish His covenant which He swore to your fathers, as *it is* this day.
- 1 Chronicles 4:10 And Jabez called on the God of Israel, saying, Oh that thou wouldest bless me indeed, and enlarge my coast, and that thine hand might be with me, and that thou wouldest keep me from evil, that it may not grieve me! And God granted him that which he requested. (Miss-used)
- James 4:3 Ye ask, and receive not, because ye ask amiss, that ye may consume it upon your lusts.
- Exodus 6:7 And I will take you to Me for a people, and I will be to you a God: and ye shall know that I am the LORD your God, which bringeth you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians.
- Deuteronomy 8:19 (AV) And it shall be, if thou do at all forget the LORD thy God, and walk after other gods, and serve them, and worship them, I testify against you this day that ye shall surely perish.
- Deuteronomy 8:19 (NKJV) Then it shall be, if you by any means forget the LORD your God, and follow other gods, and serve them and worship them,

- I testify against you this day that you shall surely perish.
- Exodus 20:5 Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for I the LORD thy God am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation of them that hate me;
- Exodus 34:14 For thou shalt worship no other god: for the LORD, whose name is Jealous, is a jealous God:
- Genesis 2:17 But of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, thou shalt not eat of it: for in the day that thou eatest thereof thou shalt surely die.
- 1 Corinthians 11:28,30 But let a man examine himself, and so let him eat of that bread, and drink of that cup. 30 For this cause many are weak and sickly among you, and many sleep.
- Isaiah 8:19 And when they shall say unto you, Seek unto them that have familiar spirits, and unto wizards that peep, and that mutter: should not a people seek unto their God? for the living to the dead?
- Deuteronomy 8:20 (AV) As the nations which the LORD destroyeth before your face, so shall ye perish; because ye would not be obedient unto the voice of the LORD your God.
- Deuteronomy 8:20 (NKJV) As the nations which the LORD destroys before you, so you shall perish, because you would not be obedient to the voice of the LORD your God.
- Deuteronomy 18:9-14 When thou art come into the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee, thou shalt not learn to do after the abominations of those nations. 10 There shall not be found among you any one that maketh his son or his daughter to pass through the fire, or that useth divination, or an observer of times, or an enchanter, or a witch, 11 Or a charmer, or a consulter with familiar spirits, or a wizard, or a necromancer. 12 For all that do these things are an abomination unto the LORD: and because of these abominations the LORD thy God doth drive them out from before thee. 13 Thou shalt be perfect with the LORD thy God. 14 For these nations, which thou shalt possess, hearkened unto observers of times, and unto diviners: but as for thee, the LORD thy God hath not suffered thee so to do.
- 1 Corinthians 12:31 But covet earnestly the best gifts: and yet shew I unto you a more excellent way.
