- Hebrews 9:27 And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment:
- 2 Corinthians 11:4 For if he that cometh preacheth another Jesus, whom we have not preached, or if ye receive another spirit, which ye have not received, or another gospel, which ye have not accepted, ye might well bear with him.
- John 15:26 But when the Comforter is come, whom I will send unto you from the Father, even the Spirit of truth, which proceedeth from the Father, he shall testify of me:
- John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by Me.
- Romans 11:2 God hath not cast away His people which He foreknew. Wot ye not what the scripture saith of Elias? how he maketh intercession to God against Israel, saying,
- Matthew 7:21 Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven.
- 2 Corinthians 13:5 Examine yourselves, whether ye be in the faith; prove your own selves. Know ye not your own selves, how that Jesus Christ is in you, except ye be reprobates?
- Matthew 7:15 Beware of false prophets, which come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravening wolves.
- Galatians 3:1 O foolish Galatians, who hath bewitched you, that ye should not obey the truth, before whose eyes Jesus Christ hath been evidently set forth, crucified among you?
- Hebrews 6:6 If they shall fall away, to renew them again unto repentance; seeing they crucify to themselves the Son of God afresh, and put Him to an open shame.
- 2 Corinthians 5:8 We are confident, I say, and willing rather to be absent from the body, and to be present with the Lord.
- Philippians 1:23 For I am in a strait betwixt two, having a desire to depart, and to be with Christ; which is far better:
- Romans 11:5-7 (NKJV) 5 Even so then, at this present time there is a remnant according to the election of grace.
- John 3:17 For God sent not His Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through Him might be saved.
- John 16:8 And when He is come, He will reprove the world of sin, and of

- righteousness, and of judgment:
- Romans 8:29 For whom he did foreknow, he also did predestinate to be conformed to the image of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brethren.
- Summarized of Judas' choice to follow Jesus or Satan.
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents & scorpions, & over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- John 6:70 Jesus answered them, Have not I chosen you twelve, and one of you is a devil?
- Jeremiah 18 referred to potter clay
- Romans 10:13 For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.
- Acts 17:30 And the times of this ignorance God winked at; but now commandeth all men every where to repent:
- Acts 16:30,31 And brought them out, and said, Sirs, what must I do to be saved? 31 And they said, Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved, and thy house.
- Ezra 9:8 And now for a little while <u>grace</u> has been *shown* from the LORD our God, to leave us a <u>remnant</u> to escape, and to give us a peg in His Holy Place, that our God may enlighten our eyes and give us a measure of revival in our bondage.
- Romans 11:5 Even so then, at this present time there is a <u>remnant</u> according to the election of <u>grace</u>.
- Romans 8:11 But if the Spirit of Him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, He that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by His Spirit that dwelleth in you.
- Romans 11:6 And if by grace, then *it is* no longer of works; otherwise grace is no longer grace. But if *it is* of works, it is no longer grace; otherwise work is no longer work.
- **Genesis 4 Summarized of Cain & Abel.**
- Ephesians 2:8,9 For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: 9 Not of works, lest any man should boast.
- Strongs #2041 ergon er'-gon AV-work 152, deed 22, doing 1, labour 1; 176 1) business, employment, that which any one is occupied 1a) that which one undertakes to do, enterprise, undertaking 2) any product whatever, any thing accomplished by hand, art, industry, or mind 3) an act, deed, thing done: the idea of working is emphasised in opp. to that which is less than work.
- Isaiah 64:6 But we are all as an unclean thing, and all our righteousnesses are as filthy rags; and we all do fade as a leaf; and our iniquities, like the wind, have taken us away.

- The devil busy taking people from mount Sion & the freedom in JC to Mount Sinai & the bondage of the law.
- Galatians 5:3 For I testify again to every man that is circumcised, that he is a debtor to do the whole law.
- Galatians 5:1 Stand fast therefore in the liberty wherewith Christ hath made us free, and be not entangled again with the yoke of bondage.
- Summarized of Salvation by Jesus.
- Genesis 12:1 Now the LORD had said unto Abram, Get thee out of thy country, and from thy kindred, and from thy father's house, unto a land that I will shew thee:
- 2 Corinthians 4:4 In whom the god of this world hath blinded the minds of them which believe not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, Who is the Image of God, should shine unto them.
- Numbers14:11 And the LORD said unto Moses, How long will this people provoke me? and how long will it be ere they believe me, for all the signs which I have shewed among them?
- John 10:38 But if I do, though ye believe not Me, believe the works: that ye may know, and believe, that the Father is in Me, and I in Him.
- John 15:24 If I had not done among them the works which none other man did, they had not had sin: but now have they both seen and hated both Me and My Father.
- John 16:8 And when He is come, He will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment:
- 1 John 4:19 We love Him, because He first loved us.
- Summarized of Forgiveness by Jesus.
- Romans 14:5 One man esteemeth one day above another: another esteemeth every day alike. Let every man be fully persuaded in his own mind. 6 He that regardeth the day, regardeth it unto the Lord; and he that regardeth not the day, to the Lord he doth not regard it. He that eateth, eateth to the Lord, for he giveth God thanks; and he that eateth not, to the Lord he eateth not, and giveth God thanks.
- Romans 11:7 What then? Israel has not obtained what it seeks; but the elect have obtained it, and the rest were blinded.
- Israel watched for the Conquering King & missed Jesus the suffering Servant.
- Revelation 10:11 Referred to Jesus' return.
- Luke 3:8 Bring forth therefore fruits worthy of repentance, and begin not to say within yourselves, We have Abraham to our father: for I say unto you, That God is able of these stones to raise up children unto Abraham.
- John 3:7 Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again.
- Romans 10:9,10,13 That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus,

- and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised Him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. 10 For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. 13 For whosoever shall call upon the Name of the Lord shall be saved.
- Luke 8 Summarized of the parable of the sower of the seed. V12 Those by the way side are they that hear; then cometh the devil, and taketh away the word out of their hearts, lest they should believe and be saved.
- 2 Corinthians 6:2 (For he saith, I have heard thee in a time accepted, and in the day of salvation have I succoured thee: behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation.)
- Romans 4:4 Now to him who <u>works</u>, the wages are not counted as <u>grace</u> but as debt.
- Romans 11:6 And if by <u>grace</u>, then *it is* no longer of <u>works</u>; otherwise <u>grace</u> is no longer <u>grace</u>. But if *it is* of <u>works</u>, it is no longer <u>grace</u>; otherwise work is no longer work.
- 2 Timothy 1:9 Who has saved us and called *us* with a Holy calling, not according to our <u>works</u>, but according to His Own purpose and <u>grace</u> which was given to us in Christ Jesus before time began,
- 2 Timothy 1:6-9 Wherefore I put thee in remembrance that thou stir up the gift of God, which is in thee by the putting on of my hands. 7 For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind. 8 Be not thou therefore ashamed of the testimony of our Lord, nor of me His prisoner: but be thou partaker of the afflictions of the gospel according to the power of God; 9 Who hath saved us, and called *us* with an Holy calling, not according to our works, but according to His Own purpose and grace, which was given us in Christ Jesus before the world began,
- Romans 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.
- Jonah Referred to Jonah in the belly of the fish.
- 2 Timothy 1:10 But is now made manifest by the appearing of our Saviour Jesus Christ, Who hath abolished death, and hath brought life and immortality to light through the gospel:
- 2 Corinthians 5:21 For He hath made Him to be sin for us, Who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in Him.
- John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.
- Summarized of salvation by Jesus.
- Numbers 22:12 And God said unto Balaam, Thou shalt not go with them; thou

- shalt not curse the people: for they are blessed.
- Deuteronomy 23:5 Nevertheless the LORD thy God would not hearken unto Balaam; but the LORD thy God turned the curse into a blessing unto thee, because the LORD thy God loved thee.
- 2 Timothy 1:11,12 Whereunto I am appointed a preacher, and an apostle, and a teacher of the Gentiles. 12 For the which cause I also suffer these things: nevertheless I am not ashamed: for I know Whom I have believed, and am persuaded that He is able to keep that which I have committed unto Him against that day.
- Job 1:21,22 And said, Naked came I out of my mother's womb, and naked shall I return thither: the LORD gave, and the LORD hath taken away; blessed be the Name of the LORD. 22 In all this Job sinned not, nor charged God foolishly.
- 2 Timothy 1:13,14 Hold fast the form of sound words, which thou hast heard of me, in faith and love which is in Christ Jesus. 14 That good thing which was committed unto thee keep by the Holy Ghost which dwelleth in us.
- Romans 8:26 Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered.
- Romans 8:34 Who is he that condemneth? It is Christ that died, yea rather, that is risen again, who is even at the right hand of God, who also maketh intercession for us.
- John 14:26 But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you.
- Acts 1&2 Compaired difference with the infilling/baptism of the Holy Spirit.
- John Gill Romans 11:7 Israel hath not obtained that which he seeketh for; that is, carnal Israel, the body and bulk of that people; who sought for life and righteousness by their obedience to the law, and which they in general were in quest of, and pursuit after, but did not obtain, though, some of them might imagine they did; for the thing was impracticable and impossible, no life nor righteousness are ever to be had by the law of works; they did not obtain life and righteousness, because they sought them in a wrong place and in a wrong way; they sought them not by faith in Christ Jesus, where they are only to be had, but by their own works, which fall abundantly short of procuring them for them:
- Matthew 11:28 Come unto Me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.
- Ezra 9:13 And after all that is come upon us for our evil deeds, and for our great trespass, seeing that thou our God hast punished us less than our iniquities deserve, and hast given us such deliverance as this;

- Hebrews 12:6 For whom the Lord loveth He chasteneth, and scourgeth every son whom He receiveth.
- Psalms 94:21 They gather together against the <u>life</u> of the <u>righteous</u>, And condemn innocent blood.
- Proverbs 10:11 The mouth of the <u>righteous</u> is a well of <u>life</u>, But violence covers the mouth of the wicked.
- Genesis 4:8 And Cain talked with Abel his brother: and it came to pass, when they were in the field, that Cain rose up against Abel his brother, and slew him.
- Proverbs 10:16 The labor of the <u>righteous</u> *leads* to <u>life</u>, The wages of the wicked to sin.
- Proverbs 11:19 As <u>righteousness</u> *leads* to <u>life</u>, So he who pursues evil pursues it to his own death.
- Revelation 10:11 Referred to Jesus' return.
- Proverbs 11:30 The fruit of the <u>righteous</u> is a tree of <u>life</u>, And he who wins souls is wise.
- Proverbs 12:10 A <u>righteous</u> man regards the <u>life</u> of his animal, But the tender mercies of the wicked *are* cruel.
- Proverbs 12:28 In the way of <u>righteousness</u> is <u>life</u>, and in *its* pathway *there is* no death.
- Isaiah 35:8 And an highway shall be there, and a way, and it shall be called The way of holiness; the unclean shall not pass over it; but it shall be for those: the wayfaring men, though fools, shall not err therein.
- Proverbs 21:21 He who follows <u>righteousness</u> and mercy finds <u>life</u>, <u>righteousness</u>, and honor.
- Ecclesiastes 7:15 I have seen everything in my days of vanity: There is a just *man* who perishes in his <u>righteousness</u>, And there is a wicked *man* who prolongs *life* in his wickedness.
- Ecclesiastes 1:2 Vanity of vanities, saith the Preacher, vanity of vanities; all is vanity.
- Acts 27:24 Saying, Fear not, Paul; thou must be brought before Caesar: and, lo, God hath given thee all them that sail with thee.
- Ezekiel 13:22 Because with lies you have made the heart of the <u>righteous</u> sad, whom I have not made sad; and you have strengthened the hands of the wicked, so that he does not turn from his wicked way to save his <u>life</u>.
- Ezekiel 13:20,22 Wherefore thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, I am against your pillows, wherewith ye there hunt the souls to make them fly, and I will tear them from your arms, and will let the souls go, even the souls that ye hunt to make them fly. 21 Your kerchiefs also will I tear, and deliver my people out of your hand, and they shall be no more in your hand to be hunted; and ye shall know that I am the LORD.

- Romans 6:23 For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.
- Luke 18 Referred to the parable of the Pharisee & Publican.
- Matthew 25:46 And these will go away into everlasting punishment, but the <u>righteous</u> into eternal <u>life</u>.
- Strongs #166 aionios ahee-o'-nee-os AV-eternal 42, everlasting 25, the world began + 5550 2, since the world began + 5550 1, for ever 1; 71
- Luke 1:75 In Holiness and <u>righteousness</u> before Him all the days of our <u>life</u>.
- Galatians 3:21 *Is* the law then against the promises of God? Certainly not! For if there had been a law given which could have given <u>life</u>, truly righteousness would have been by the law.
- Genesis 2:17 But of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, thou shalt not eat of it: for in the day that thou eatest thereof thou shalt surely die.
- Genesis 3:10 And he said, I heard thy voice in the garden, and I was afraid, because I was naked; and I hid myself.
- Romans 5:17 For if by the one man's offense death reigned through the one, much more those who receive abundance of grace and of the gift of <u>righteousness</u> will reign in <u>life</u> through the One, Jesus Christ.)
- Romans 5:18 Therefore, as through one man's offense *judgment came* to all men, resulting in condemnation, even so through one Man's <u>righteous</u> act *the free gift came* to all men, resulting in justification of <u>life</u>.
- Romans 5:21 so that as sin reigned in death, even so grace might reign through <u>righteousness</u> to eternal <u>life</u> through Jesus Christ our Lord.
- Romans 8:10 And if Christ *is* in you, the body *is* dead because of sin, but the Spirit *is* life because of righteousness.
- 2 Corinthians 4:3,4 But if our gospel be hid, it is hid to them that are lost: 4 In whom the god of this world hath blinded the minds of them which believe not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine unto them.
- Ephesians 2:2 Wherein in time past ye walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that now worketh in the children of disobedience:
- Matthew 5:20 For I say unto you, That except your righteousness shall exceed *the righteousness* of the scribes and Pharisees, ye shall in no case enter into the kingdom of heaven.
