- Matthew 23 Referred to Jesus warning of the ungodly leaders.
- Luke 11:23 He that is not with Me is against Me: and he that gathereth not with Me scattereth.
- Matthew 7:15 Beware of false prophets, which come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravening wolves.
- Summarized of many in the New Testament leaders warning of the ungodly pretending to be godly.
- Leviticus 26 Referred to God increasing punishment as Israel sinned more.
- 1 Samuel 2:25-36 (AV) & (NKJV)
- 1 Samuel 2:25 (AV) If one man sin against another, the judge shall judge him: but if a man sin against the LORD, who shall intreat for him?

 Notwithstanding they hearkened not unto the voice of their father, because the LORD would slay them.
- 1 Samuel 2:25 (NKJV) If one man sins against another, God will judge him. But if a man sins against the LORD, who will intercede for him?

 Nevertheless they did not heed the voice of their father, because the LORD desired to kill them.
- Luke 8 Summarized of Jesus setting the Gadarene Demoniac free from the demons. V29 (For He had commanded the unclean spirit to come out of the man. For oftentimes it had caught him: and he was kept bound with chains and in fetters; and he brake the bands, and was driven of the devil into the wilderness.)
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- 1 Samuel 2:10 The adversaries of the LORD shall be broken to pieces; out of heaven shall He thunder upon them: the LORD shall judge the ends of the earth; and He shall give strength unto His king, and exalt the horn of His anointed.
- 1 Samuel 2:26 (AV) And the child Samuel grew on, and was in favour both with the LORD, and also with men.
- 1 Samuel 2:26 (NKJV) And the child Samuel grew in stature, and in favor both with the LORD and men.
- 1 Samuel 1 Summarized of young Samuel prepared to take over the priesthood.
- saul > David

- 1 Samuel 18:14 And David behaved himself wisely in all his ways; and the LORD was with him.
- 1 Kings 13 Summarized of the prophet sent to Jeroboam prophesying of Josiah.
- 1 Samuel 2:27 (AV) And there came a man of God unto Eli, and said unto him, Thus saith the LORD, Did I plainly appear unto the house of thy father, when they were in Egypt in Pharaoh's house?
- 1 Samuel 2:27 (NKJV) Then a man of God came to Eli and said to him, Thus says the LORD: Did I not clearly reveal Myself to the house of your father when they were in Egypt in Pharaoh's house?
- Exodus 8 Summarized of the plague of lice. V19 Then the magicians said unto Pharaoh, This is the finger of God: and Pharaoh's heart was hardened, and he hearkened not unto them; as the LORD had said.
- 1 Samuel 2:28 (AV) And did I choose him out of all the tribes of Israel *to be* my priest, to offer upon mine altar, to burn incense, to wear an ephod before me? and did I give unto the house of thy father all the offerings made by fire of the children of Israel?
- 1 Samuel 2:28 (NKJV) Did I not choose him out of all the tribes of Israel to be My priest, to offer upon My altar, to burn incense, and to wear an ephod before Me? And did I not give to the house of your father all the offerings of the children of Israel made by fire?
- Summarized of God choosing the house of Levi for the priests & providing for them.
- 1 Samuel 2:29 (AV) Wherefore kick ye at My sacrifice and at Mine offering, which I have commanded *in My* habitation; and honourest thy sons above Me, to make yourselves fat with the chiefest of all the offerings of Israel My people?
- 1 Samuel 2:29 (NKJV) Why do you kick at My sacrifice and My offering which I have commanded *in My* dwelling place, and honor your sons more than Me, to make yourselves fat with the best of all the offerings of Israel My people?
- Summarized the sins of Hophni and Phinehas.
- Matthew 10:37 He that loveth father or mother more than me is not worthy of me: and he that loveth son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me.
- 1 Timothy 3 Referred to the New Testament standards for Religious Leaders.
- Luke 12:48 But he that knew not, and did commit things worthy of stripes, shall be beaten with few stripes. For unto whomsoever much is given, of him shall be much required: and to whom men have committed much, of him they will ask the more.
- 1 Samuel 4:18 And it came to pass, when he made mention of the ark of God, that he (Eli) fell from off the seat backward by the side of the gate, and his

- neck brake, and he died: for he was an old man, and heavy. And he had judged Israel forty years.
- 1 Samuel 2:30 (AV) Wherefore the LORD God of Israel saith, I said indeed that thy house, and the house of thy father, should walk before Me for ever: but now the LORD saith, Be it far from Me; for them that honour Me I will honour, and they that despise Me shall be lightly esteemed.
- 1 Samuel 2:30 (NKJV) Therefore the LORD God of Israel says: I said indeed that your house and the house of your father would walk before Me forever. But now the LORD says: Far be it from Me; for those who honor Me I will honor, and those who despise Me shall be lightly esteemed.

- Exodus 28:43 And they shall be upon Aaron, and upon his sons, when they come in unto the tabernacle of the congregation, or when they come near unto the altar to minister in the Holy place; that they bear not iniquity, and die: it shall be a statute for ever unto him and his seed after him.
- Matthew 26:67 Then did they spit in his face, and buffeted him; and others smote him with the palms of their hands,
- 1 Peter 4:17 For the time is come that judgment must begin at the house of God: and if it first begin at us, what shall the end be of them that obey not the gospel of God?
- Mark 9:47 And if thine eye offend thee, pluck it out: it is better for thee to enter into the kingdom of God with one eye, than having two eyes to be cast into hell fire: (Symbolism)
- 2 Kings 5:25,27 But he went in, and stood before his master. And Elisha said unto him, Whence comest thou, Gehazi? And he said, Thy servant went no whither. 27 The leprosy therefore of Naaman shall cleave unto thee, and unto thy seed for ever. And he went out from his presence a leper as white as snow.
- 1 Samuel 2:31 (AV) Behold, the days come, that I will cut off thine arm, and the arm of thy father's house, that there shall not be an old man in thine house.
- 1 Samuel 2:31 (NKJV) Behold, the days are coming that I will cut off your arm and the arm of your father's house, so that there will not be an old man in your house.
- 1 Samuel 2:32 (AV) And thou shalt see an enemy in My habitation, in all the

- wealth which God shall give Israel: and there shall not be an old man in thine house for ever.
- 1 Samuel 2:32 (NKJV) And you will see an enemy *in My* dwelling place, *despite* all the good which God does for Israel. And there shall not be an old man in your house forever.
- Ezra 9:7 Since the days of our fathers have we been in a great trespass unto this day; and for our iniquities have we, our kings, and our priests, been delivered into the hand of the kings of the lands, to the sword, to captivity, and to a spoil, and to confusion of face, as it is this day.
- Matthew 27:25 Then answered all the people, and said, His blood be on us, and on our children.
- 1 Samuel 2:33 (AV) And the man of thine, *whom* I shall not cut off from Mine altar, *shall be* to consume thine eyes, and to grieve thine heart: and all the increase of thine house shall die in the flower of their age.
- 1 Samuel 2:33 (NKJV) But any of your men whom I do not cut off from My altar shall consume your eyes and grieve your heart. And all the descendants of your house shall die in the flower of their age.
- 1 Samuel 2:34 (AV) And this *shall be* a sign unto thee, that shall come upon thy two sons, on Hophni and Phinehas; in one day they shall die both of them.
- 1 Samuel 2:34 (NKJV) Now this *shall be* a sign to you that will come upon your two sons, on Hophni and Phinehas: in one day they shall die, both of them.
- Numbers 16 Summarized of Korah & rebels sinning against God. V30 But if the LORD make a new thing, and the earth open her mouth, and swallow them up, with all that appertain unto them, and they go down quick into the pit; then ye shall understand that these men have provoked the LORD.
- 1 Samuel 2:35 (AV) And I will raise Me up a faithful priest, *that* shall do according to *that* which *is* in Mine heart and in My mind: and I will build him a sure house; and he shall walk before Mine anointed for ever.
- 1 Samuel 2:35 (NKJV) Then I will raise up for Myself a faithful priest *who* shall do according to what *is* in My heart and in My mind. I will build him a sure house, and he shall walk before My anointed forever.
- Referred to Ezra building up the temple & Nehemiah building up the wall of Jerusalem.
- Ezekiel 11:19 And I will give them one heart, and I will put a new spirit within you; and I will take the stony heart out of their flesh, and will give them an heart of flesh:
- Ephesians 1:13 In whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that holy Spirit of promise,

- 1 Samuel 2:36 (AV) And it shall come to pass, *that* every one that is left in thine house shall come *and* crouch to him for a piece of silver and a morsel of bread, and shall say, Put me, I pray thee, into one of the priests' offices, that I may eat a piece of bread.
- 1 Samuel 2:36 (NKJV) And it shall come to pass that everyone who is left in your house will come *and* bow down to him for a piece of silver and a morsel of bread, and say, Please, put me in one of the priestly positions, that I may eat a piece of bread.
- 1 Samuel 22:21 And Abiathar shewed David that Saul had slain the LORD'S priests.
- Deuteronomy 32:15 But Jeshurun waxed fat, and <u>kicked</u>: thou art waxen fat, thou art grown thick, thou art covered *with fatness*; then he forsook God *which* made him, and lightly esteemed the Rock of his salvation.
- 1 Samuel 2:29 Wherefore <u>kick</u> ye at My sacrifice and at Mine offering, which I have commanded *in My* habitation; and honourest thy sons above Me, to make yourselves fat with the chiefest of all the offerings of Israel My people?
- Acts 9:5 And he said, Who art thou, Lord? And the Lord said, I am Jesus whom thou persecutest: *it is* hard for thee to <u>kick</u> against the pricks.
- Acts 26:14 And when we were all fallen to the earth, I heard a voice speaking unto me, and saying in the Hebrew tongue, Saul, Saul, why persecutest thou Me? *it is* hard for thee to kick against the pricks.
- Genesis 3 Referred to the fall of mankind.
- Jeremiah 3:15 And I will give you pastors according to mine heart, which shall feed you with knowledge and understanding.
- Leviticus 20:3 And I will set My face against that man, and will cut him off from among his people; because he hath given of his seed unto Molech, to defile My sanctuary, and to <u>profane</u> My <u>Holy</u> Name.
- Referred to Jesus cleaning out the temple twice. Saying unto them, It is written, My house is the house of prayer: but ye have made it a den of thieves.
- Exodus 20:13 Thou shalt not kill.
- Jeremiah 1:5 Before I formed you in the womb I knew you; Before you were born I sanctified you; I ordained you a prophet to the nations.
- Leviticus 21:6 They shall be <u>Holy</u> unto their God, and not <u>profane</u> the Name of their God: for the offerings of the LORD made by fire, *and* the bread of their God, they do offer: therefore they shall be Holy.
- 1 Peter 1:16 Because it is written, Be ye Holy; for I am Holy.
- Leviticus 21:7 They shall not take a wife *that is* a whore, or <u>profane</u>; neither shall they take a woman put away from her husband: for he *is* <u>Holy</u> unto his God.

- 1 Timothy 3 Referred to God's standards for the wife of God's leaders.
- Leviticus 22:2 Speak unto Aaron and to his sons, that they separate themselves from the <u>Holy</u> things of the children of Israel, and that they <u>profane</u> not My <u>Holy</u> Name *in those things* which they Hallow unto Me: I am the LORD.
- Exodus 30:21 So they shall wash their hands and their feet, that they die not: and it shall be a statute for ever to them, even to him and to his seed throughout their generations.
- Leviticus 10 Referred to Aaron's sons killed profaning the Lord.
- Leviticus 22:15 And they shall not <u>profane</u> the <u>Holy</u> things of the children of Israel, which they offer unto the LORD;
- Leviticus 22:32 Neither shall ye <u>profane</u> My <u>Holy</u> Name; but I will be hallowed among the children of Israel: I *am* the LORD which hallow you,
- Ezekiel 22:26 Her priests have violated My law, and have profaned Mine <u>Holy</u> things: they have put no difference between the <u>Holy</u> and <u>profane</u>, neither have they shewed *difference* between the unclean and the clean, and have hid their eyes from My sabbaths, and I am profaned among them.
- Ezekiel 8 Referred to God showing the evil done in God's temple.
- Luke 4 Referred to the temptations of Jesus.
- Hebrews 10:12 But this man, after he had offered one sacrifice for sins for ever, sat down on the right hand of God;
- Matthew 12:12 How much then is a man better than a sheep? Wherefore it is lawful to do well on the sabbath days.
- Mark 2:27 And He said unto them, The sabbath was made for man, and not man for the sabbath:
- Ezekiel 44:23 And they shall teach My people *the difference* between the <u>Holy</u> and <u>profane</u>, and cause them to discern between the unclean and the clean.
- Amos 2:7 That pant after the dust of the earth on the head of the poor, and turn aside the way of the meek: and a man and his father will go in unto the *same* maid, to <u>profane My Holy Name</u>:
- 1 Peter 1:16 Because it is written, Be ye Holy; for I am Holy.
- 1 John 3:3 And every man that hath this hope in Him purifieth himself, even as He is pure.
