## **Continuing In Goodness - Romans 11D**

- Luke 4 Referred to Jesus overcoming all the devil's temptings.
- Matthew 12:28 But if I cast out demons by the Spirit of God, surely the kingdom of God has come upon you.
- Isaiah 6:9,10 And He said, Go, and tell this people: Keep on hearing, but do not understand; Keep on seeing, but do not perceive. 10 Make the heart of this people dull, And their ears heavy, And shut their eyes; Lest they see with their eyes, And hear with their ears, And understand with their heart, And return and be healed.

  Acts 9 Referred to Paul's conversion.
- Romans 8:29 For whom He foreknew, He also predestined to be conformed to the image of His Son, that He might be the firstborn among many brethren.
- Romans 11:16-24 (NKJV) V11 For if the firstfruit *is* Holy, the lump *is* also *Holy*; and if the root *is* Holy, so *are* the branches.
- John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by Me.
- John 10:38 But if I do, though ye believe not Me, believe the works: that ye may know, and believe, that the Father is in Me, and I in Him.
- John 15:24 If I had not done among them the works which none other man did, they had not had sin: but now have they both seen and hated both Me and My Father.
- Romans 11:17 And if some of the branches were broken off, and you, being a wild olive tree, were grafted in among them, and with them became a partaker of the root and fatness of the olive tree,
- Daniel 2:21 And He changeth the times and the seasons: He removeth kings, and setteth up kings: He giveth wisdom unto the wise, and knowledge to them that know understanding:
- Genesis 12:1 Now the LORD had said to Abram: Get out of your country, From your family And from your father's house, To a land that I will show you.
- James 2:23 And the Scripture was fulfilled which says, Abraham believed God, and it was accounted to him for righteousness. And he was called the friend of God.
- John 10:16 And other sheep I have which are not of this fold; them also I must bring, and they will hear My voice; and there will be one flock and one shepherd.
- Romans 10:13 For whoever shall call on the name of the Lord shall be saved. Matthew 24 Referred to Jesus warning of the end times.
- Galatians 3:26 For ye are all the children of God by faith in Christ Jesus.
- James 2:10,11 That at the Name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth; 11 And that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the

Father.

- Romans 11:18 do not boast against the branches. But if you do boast, remember that you do not support the root, but the root supports you.
- Galatians 6:14 But God forbid that I should glory, save in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, by whom the world is crucified unto me, and I unto the world.
- Matthew 14 Referred to Peter walking on water. V30,31 But when he saw that the wind was boisterous, he was afraid; and beginning to sink he cried out, saying, Lord, save me! 31 And immediately Jesus stretched out His hand and caught him, and said to him, O you of little faith, why did you doubt?
- Luke 8 Referred to Jesus setting the Gadarene Demoniac free.
- Romans 11:19 You will say then, Branches were broken off that I might be grafted in.
- Romans 11:20 Well *said*. Because of unbelief they were broken off, and you stand by faith. Do not be haughty, but fear.
- 2 Chronicles 33 Summarized of evil Manasseh repenting.
- Romans 11:21 For if God did not spare the natural branches, He may not spare you either.
- Referred to the Judges & Kings of Israelites turning from God & being judged, then repenting & God freeing them, etc.
- Amos 8:11 Behold, the days are coming, says the Lord GOD, That I will send a famine on the land, Not a famine of bread, Nor a thirst for water, But of hearing the words of the LORD.
- Romans 11:22 Therefore consider the goodness and severity of God: on those who fell, severity; but toward you, goodness, if you continue in *His* goodness. Otherwise you also will be cut off.
- Acts 11:23 Who, when he came, and had seen the grace of God, was glad, and exhorted them all, that with purpose of heart they would cleave unto the Lord.
- Romans 12:2 And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.
- Acts 13:22 And when he had removed him, he raised up unto them David to be their king; to whom also he gave testimony, and said, I have found David the son of Jesse, a man after mine own heart, which shall fulfil all my will.
- 2 Samuel 12:14 Howbeit, because by this deed thou hast given great occasion to the enemies of the LORD to blaspheme, the child also that is born unto thee shall surely die.
- Summarized how God judged David through his sons.
- Acts 5 Referred to Ananias & Sapphira's sinning & died.

- 1 Corinthians 11:28-30 But let a man examine himself, and so let him eat of that bread, and drink of that cup. 29 For he that eateth and drinketh unworthily, eateth and drinketh damnation to himself, not discerning the Lord's body. 30 For this cause many are weak and sickly among you, and many sleep.
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- Romans 11:23 And they also, if they do not continue in unbelief, will be grafted in, for God is able to graft them in again.
- John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, & to kill, & to destroy: I am come that they might have life, & that they might have it more abundantly. Jonah Referred to God making him willing to do God's will.
- Romans 11:24 For if you were cut out of the olive tree which is wild by nature, and were grafted contrary to nature into a cultivated olive tree, how much more will these, who *are* natural *branches*, be grafted into their own olive tree?
- Mark 12:24 And Jesus answering said unto them, Do ye not therefore err, because ye know not the scriptures, neither the power of God?
- Matthew 23:16-22 (AV) Woe unto you, ye blind guides, which say, Whosoever shall swear by the temple, it is nothing; but whosoever shall swear by the gold of the temple, he is a debtor! 17 Ye fools and blind: for whether is greater, the gold, or the temple that sanctifieth the gold? 18 And, Whosoever shall swear by the altar, it is nothing; but whosoever sweareth by the gift that is upon it, he is guilty. 19 Ye fools and blind: for whether is greater, the gift, or the altar that sanctifieth the gift? 20 Whoso therefore shall swear by the altar, sweareth by it, and by all things thereon. 21 And whoso shall swear by the temple, sweareth by it, and by Him that dwelleth therein. 22 And he that shall swear by heaven, sweareth by the throne of God, and by Him that sitteth thereon.
- Matthew 23:16-22 (NKJV) Woe to you, blind guides, who say, Whoever swears (makes an oath) by the temple, it is nothing; but whoever swears by the gold of the temple, he is obliged to perform it. 17 Fools and blind! For which is greater, the gold or the temple that sanctifies the gold? 18 And, Whoever swears by the altar, it is nothing; but whoever swears by the gift that is on it, he is obliged to perform it. 19 Fools and blind! For which is greater, the gift or the altar that sanctifies the gift? 20 Therefore he who swears by the altar, swears by it and by all things on it. 21 He who swears by the temple, swears by it and by Him who dwells in it. 22 And he who swears by heaven, swears by the throne of God and by Him who sits on it.
- Luke 13:1-9 (NKJV) There were present at that season some who told Him about the Galileans whose blood Pilate had mingled with their sacrifices. 2 And Jesus answered and said to them, Do you suppose that these

Galileans were worse sinners than all *other* Galileans, because they suffered such things? 3 I tell you, no; but unless you repent you will all likewise perish. 4 Or those eighteen on whom the tower in Siloam fell and killed them, do you think that they were worse sinners than all *other* men who dwelt in Jerusalem? 5 I tell you, no; but unless you repent you will all likewise perish. 6 He also spoke this parable: A certain *man* had a fig tree planted in his vineyard, and he came seeking fruit on it and found none. 7 Then he said to the keeper of his vineyard, Look, for three years I have come seeking fruit on this fig tree and find none. Cut it down; why does it use up the ground? 8 But he answered and said to him, Sir, let it alone this year also, until I dig around it and fertilize *it*. 9 And if it bears fruit, *well*. But if not, after that you can cut it down.

Referred to that Jesus ministered to Israel for 3 years.

- John 15:1-8 (NKJV) I am the true vine, and My Father is the vinedresser. 2

  Every branch in Me that does not bear fruit He takes away; and every branch that bears fruit He prunes (chastens), that it may bear more fruit. 3

  You are already clean because of the word which I have spoken to you. 4

  Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in Me. 5 I am the vine, you are the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing. 6 If anyone does not abide in Me, he is cast out as a branch and is withered; and they gather them and throw them into the fire, and they are burned. 7 If you abide in Me, and My Words abide in you, you will ask what you desire, and it shall be done for you. 8 By this My Father is glorified, that you bear much fruit; so you will be My disciples.
- Strongs #5544 chrestotes *khray-stot'-ace* AV-goodness 4, kindness 4, good 1, gentleness 1; 10 1) moral goodness, integrity 2) benignity, kindness.
- Strongs #19 agathosune *ag-ath-o-soo'-nay* AV-goodness 4; 1) uprightness of heart and life, goodness, kindness {2Thess 1:11; Gal 5:22; Rom 15:14; Eph 5:9}
- Romans 2:4 Or do you despise the riches of His goodness <5544>, forbearance, and longsuffering, not knowing that the goodness of God leads you to repentance?
- Romans 3:12 They have all turned aside; They have together become unprofitable; There is none who does good <5544>, no, not one.
- Romans 11:22 Therefore consider the goodness <5544> and severity of God: on those who fell, severity; but toward you, goodness <5544>, if you continue in *His* goodness <5544>. Otherwise you also will be cut off.
- 2 Corinthians 6:6 by purity, by knowledge, by longsuffering, by kindness <5544>, by the Holy Spirit, by sincere love,
- Galatians 5:22 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering,

- kindness <5544>, goodness, faithfulness,
- The Holy Spirit cleans us up on the inside then we do good to others.
- Ephesians 2:7 that in the ages to come He might show the exceeding riches of His grace in *His* kindness <5544> toward us in Christ Jesus.
- Colossians 3:12 Therefore, as *the* elect of God, Holy and beloved, put on tender mercies, kindness <5544>, humility, meekness, longsuffering;
- Titus 3:4 But when the kindness <5544> and the love of God our Savior toward man appeared,
- Isaiah 6 Referred to Isaiah's vision of God.
- **Exodus 3 Referred to Moses at the burning bush.**
- Matthew 13:58 Now He did not do many mighty works there because of their unbelief.
- Matthew 17:20 So Jesus said to them, Because of your <u>unbelief</u>; for assuredly, I say to you, if you <u>have faith</u> (in Jesus Christ) as a mustard seed, you will say to this mountain, Move from here to there, and it will move; and nothing will be impossible for you.
- Mark 6:6 And He marveled because of their <u>unbelief</u>. Then He went about the villages in a circuit, teaching.
- Mark 9:24 Immediately the father of the child cried out and said with tears, Lord, I believe; help my unbelief!
- Mark 16:14,17 Later He appeared to the eleven as they sat at the table; and He rebuked their <u>unbelief and hardness of heart</u>, because they <u>did not believe</u> those who had seen Him after He had risen. 17 And these signs shall follow them that <u>believe</u>; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;
- Romans 3:3 For what if some did <u>not believe</u>? Will their <u>unbelief</u> make the faithfulness of God without effect?
- Romans 4:20 He did not waver at the promise of God through <u>unbelief</u>, but was <u>strengthened in faith</u>, giving glory to God,
- Romans 11:20 Well *said*. Because of <u>unbelief</u> they were broken off, and you stand by faith. Do not be haughty, but fear.
- Romans 11:23 And they also, if they do not continue in <u>unbelief</u>, will be grafted in, for God is able to graft them in again.
- 1 Timothy 1:13 although I was formerly a blasphemer, a persecutor, and an insolent man; but I obtained mercy because I <u>did it ignorantly in unbelief</u>.
- Hebrews 3:12 Beware, brethren, lest there be in any of you an <u>evil heart of</u> unbelief in departing from the living God;
- Hebrews 3:19 So we see that they could not enter in because of <u>unbelief</u>.

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
