## Here Am I - 1 Samuel 3A

Summarized of the situation in Israel & in the priests at that time.

- 1 Samuel 1:27,28 For this child I prayed; and the LORD hath given me my petition which I asked of him: 28 Therefore also I have lent him to the LORD; as long as he liveth he shall be lent to the LORD. And he worshipped the LORD there.
- 1 Samuel 2:21 And the LORD visited Hannah, so that she conceived, and bare three sons and two daughters. And the child Samuel grew before the LORD.
- 1 Samuel 3:1-10 (AV) & (NKJV)
- 1 Samuel 3:1 (AV) And the child Samuel ministered unto the LORD before Eli. And the Word of the LORD was precious in those days; *there was* no open vision.
- 1 Samuel 3:1 (NKJV) Then the boy Samuel ministered to the LORD before Eli. And the Word of the LORD was rare in those days; *there was* no widespread revelation.
- Amos 8:11-14 (AV) Behold, the days come, saith the Lord GOD, that I will send a famine in the land, not a famine of bread, nor a thirst for water, but of hearing the Words of the LORD: 12 And they shall wander from sea to sea, and from the north even to the east, they shall run to and fro to seek the Word of the LORD, and shall not find it. 13 In that day shall the fair virgins and young men faint for thirst. 14 They that swear by the sin of Samaria, and say, Thy god, O Dan, liveth; and, The manner of Beersheba liveth; even they shall fall, and never rise up again.
- John 7:38 He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water.
- John 4:14 But whosoever drinketh of the water that I shall give him shall never thirst; but the water that I shall give him shall be in him a well of water springing up into everlasting life.
- 1 Kings 18 Referred to the shoot-out on Mount Carmel.
- Exodus 33:11 And the LORD spake unto Moses face to face, as a man speaketh unto his friend. And he turned again into the camp: but his servant Joshua, the son of Nun, a young man, departed not out of the tabernacle.
- Judges 4:4 And Deborah, a prophetess, the wife of Lapidoth, she judged Israel at that time.

- Judges 4 Summarized of Deborah & Barrak. V9 And she said, I will surely go with thee: notwithstanding the journey that thou takest shall not be for thine honour; for the LORD shall sell Sisera into the hand of a woman. And Deborah arose, and went with Barak to Kedesh.
- Judges 6:8 That the LORD sent a prophet unto the children of Israel, which said unto them, Thus saith the LORD God of Israel, I brought you up from Egypt, and brought you forth out of the house of bondage;
- 1 Samuel 3:2 (AV) And it came to pass at that time, when Eli *was* laid down in his place, and his eyes began to wax dim, *that* he could not see;
- 1 Samuel 3:2 (NKJV) And it came to pass at that time, while Eli *was* lying down in his place, and when his eyes had begun to grow so dim that he could not see.
- Deuteronomy 34:7 And Moses was an hundred and twenty years old when he died: his eye was not dim, nor his natural force abated.
- 1 Samuel 3:3 (AV) And ere the lamp of God went out in the temple of the LORD, where the ark of God was, and Samuel was laid down to sleep;
- 1 Samuel 3:3 (NKJV) and before the lamp of God went out in the tabernacle of the LORD where the ark of God *was*, and while Samuel was lying down,
- 1 Samuel 3:4 (AV) That the LORD called Samuel: and he answered, Here *am* I.
- 1 Samuel 3:4 (NKJV) that the LORD called Samuel. And he answered, Here I am!
- 1 Samuel 3:5 (AV) And he ran unto Eli, and said, Here *am* I; for thou calledst me. And he said, I called not; lie down again. And he went and lay down.
- 1 Samuel 3:5 (NKJV) So he ran to Eli and said, Here I am, for you called me. And he said, I did not call; lie down again. And he went and lay down.
- Acts 9 Referred to Jesus calling Saul.
- Acts 22:9 And they that were with me saw indeed the light, and were afraid; but they heard not the voice of Him that spake to me.
- John 12:28 Father, glorify Thy Name. Then came there a voice from heaven, saying, I have both glorified it, and will glorify it again. 29 The people therefore, that stood by, and heard it, said that it thundered: others said, An angel spake to him.
- 1 Samuel 3:6 (AV) And the LORD called yet again, Samuel. And Samuel arose and went to Eli, and said, Here *am* I; for thou didst call me. And he answered, I called not, my son; lie down again.
- 1 Samuel 3:6 (NKJV) Then the LORD called yet again, Samuel! So Samuel arose and went to Eli, and said, Here I am, for you called me. He

- answered, I did not call, my son; lie down again.
- 1 Samuel 3:7 (AV) Now Samuel did not yet know the LORD, neither was the Word of the LORD yet revealed unto him.
- 1 Samuel 3:7 (NKJV) (Now Samuel did not yet know the LORD, nor was the Word of the LORD yet revealed to him.)
- 2 Corinthians 11:4 For if he that cometh preacheth another Jesus, whom we have not preached, or if ye receive another spirit, which ye have not received, or another gospel, which ye have not accepted, ye might well bear with him.
- 1 Timothy 2:5 For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus;
- Summarized of many Godly men in the Old Testament who saw Jesus & John in the Revelation.
- John 3:7 Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again.
- John 3:16 For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.
- Acts 17:30 And the times of this ignorance God winked at; but now commandeth all men every where to repent:
- Isaiah 6:9,10 And he said, Go, and tell this people, Hear ye indeed, but understand not; and see ye indeed, but perceive not. 10 Make the heart of this people fat, and make their ears heavy, and shut their eyes; lest they see with their eyes, and hear with their ears, and understand with their heart, and convert, and be healed.

- 1 Samuel 3:8 (NKJV) And the LORD called Samuel again the third time.

  Then he arose and went to Eli, and said, Here I am, for you did call me.

  Then Eli perceived that the LORD had called the boy.
- John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by Me.
- 1 Samuel 3:9 (AV) Therefore Eli said unto Samuel, Go, lie down: and it shall be, if he call thee, that thou shalt say, Speak, LORD; for thy servant heareth. So Samuel went and lay down in his place.
- 1 Samuel 3:9 (NKJV) Therefore Eli said to Samuel, Go, lie down; and it shall be, if He calls you, that you must say, Speak, LORD, for Your servant hears. So Samuel went and lay down in his place.
- Numbers 12:3 (Now the man Moses was very meek, above all the men

- which were upon the face of the earth.)
- 1 Samuel 3:10 (AV) And the LORD came, and stood, and called as at other times, Samuel, Samuel. Then Samuel answered, Speak; for thy servant heareth.
- 1 Samuel 3:10 (NKJV) Now the LORD came and stood and called as at other times, Samuel! Samuel! And Samuel answered, Speak, for Your servant hears.
- Isaiah 1 Referred to the heavens opened for Isaiah to see God.
- 1 Samuel 2:27 And there came a man of God unto Eli, and said unto him, Thus saith the LORD, Did I plainly appear unto the house of thy father, when they were in Egypt in Pharaoh's house?
- 2 Kings 22 Summarized of Josiah repenting & cleaning up Judah & Israel. V20 Behold therefore, I will gather thee unto thy fathers, and thou shalt be gathered into thy grave in peace; and thine eyes shall not see all the evil which I will bring upon this place. And they brought the king word again.
- Hebrews 12:7 If ye endure chastening, God dealeth with you as with sons; for what son is he whom the father chasteneth not?
- Genesis 22:7 And Isaac spake unto Abraham his father, and said, My father: and he said, <u>Here am I</u>, my son. And he said, <u>Behold the fire and the wood: but where *is* the lamb for a burnt offering?</u>
- Summarized of Abraham's faith tested.
- Genesis 22:11 And the angel of the LORD called unto him out of heaven, and said, Abraham, Abraham: and he said, Here *am* I.
- Hebrews 11:19 Accounting that God was able to raise him up, even from the dead; from whence also he received him in a figure.
- Genesis 27:1 And it came to pass, that when Isaac was old, and his eyes were dim, so that he could not see, he called Esau his eldest son, and said unto him, My son: and he said unto him, Behold, <u>here am</u> <u>I</u>.
- Genesis 27:18,22 And he came unto his father, and said, My father: and he said, Here <u>am</u> !; who art thou, my son? 22 And Jacob went near unto Isaac his father; and he felt him, and said, The voice is Jacob's voice, but the hands are the hands of Esau.
- Genesis 31:11 And the angel of God spake unto me in a dream, *saying*, Jacob: And I said, <u>Here am I</u>.
- Genesis 37:13 And Israel said unto Joseph, Do not thy brethren feed *the flock* in Shechem? come, and I will send thee unto them. And he said to him, Here *am I*.
- Genesis 46:2,3 And God spake unto Israel in the visions of the night, and

- said, Jacob, Jacob. And he said, <u>Here am</u> I. 3 And he said, I am God, the God of thy father: fear not to go down into Egypt; for I will there make of thee a great nation:
- Exodus 3:4 And when the LORD saw that he turned aside to see, God called unto him out of the midst of the bush, and said, Moses, Moses. And he said, Here <u>am</u> I.
- 1 Samuel 3:4-6,8 That the LORD called Samuel: and he answered, Here am I. 5 And he ran unto Eli, and said, Here am I; for thou calledst me. And he said, I called not; lie down again. And he went and lay down. 6 And the LORD called yet again, Samuel. And Samuel arose and went to Eli, and said, Here am I; for thou didst call me. And he answered, I called not, my son; lie down again. 8 And the LORD called Samuel again the third time. And he arose and went to Eli, and said, Here am I; for thou didst call me. And Eli perceived that the LORD had called the child.
- 1 Samuel 3:16,17 Then Eli called Samuel, and said, Samuel, my son. And he answered, <u>Here am I</u>. 17 And he said, What is the thing that the LORD hath said unto thee? I pray thee hide it not from me: God do so to thee, and more also, if thou hide any thing from me of all the things that he said unto thee.
- 2 Samuel 1:7 And when he looked behind him, he saw me, and called unto me. And I answered, <u>Here am I</u>.
- 2 Samuel 15:26 But if he thus say, I have no delight in thee; behold, <u>here</u> <u>am</u> <u>I</u>, let him do to me as seemeth good unto him.
- Isaiah 6:8 Also I heard the voice of the Lord, saying, Whom shall I send, and who will go for us? Then said I, <u>Here am I; send me</u>.
- Luke 14:17-19 And sent his servant at supper time to say to them that were bidden, Come; for all things are now ready. 18 And they all with one consent began to make excuse. The first said unto him, I have bought a piece of ground, and I must needs go and see it: I pray thee have me excused. 19 And another said, I have bought five yoke of oxen, and I go to prove them: I pray thee have me excused.
- Ephesians 5:23 For the husband is the head of the wife, even as Christ is the head of the church: and he is the saviour of the body.
- 2 Corinthians 9:7 Every man according as he purposeth in his heart, so let him give; not grudgingly, or of necessity: for God loveth a cheerful giver.
- Malachi 1:8 And if ye offer the blind for sacrifice, is it not evil? and if ye offer the lame and sick, is it not evil? offer it now unto thy governor; will he be pleased with thee, or accept thy person? saith the LORD of hosts.
- Deuteronomy 18:4 The firstfruit also of thy corn, of thy wine, and of thine

- oil, and the first of the fleece of thy sheep, shalt thou give him.
- 1 Samuel 3:7 Now Samuel did not yet <u>know the LORD</u>, neither was the Word of the LORD yet revealed unto him.
- Acts 18:25,26 This man (Apollos) was instructed in the way of the Lord; and being fervent in the spirit, he spake and taught diligently the things of the Lord, knowing only the baptism of John. 26 And he began to speak boldly in the synagogue: whom when Aquila and Priscilla had heard, they took him unto them, and expounded unto him the way of God more perfectly.
- Isaiah 19:21 And the LORD shall be known to Egypt, and the <u>Egyptians shall</u> know the <u>LORD</u> in that day, and shall do sacrifice and oblation; yea, they shall vow a vow unto the LORD, and perform *it*.
- Jeremiah 31:34 And they shall teach no more every man his neighbour, and every man his brother, saying, <u>Know the LORD: for they shall all know me</u>, from the least of them unto the greatest of them, saith the LORD: for I will forgive their iniquity, and I will remember their sin no more.
- Hosea 2:20 I will even betroth thee unto Me in faithfulness: and thou shalt know the LORD.
- Matthew 6:13 And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil: For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, for ever. Amen.
