Summarized of Savlation by Jesus.

Luke 23:21 But they cried, saying, Crucify Him, crucify Him.

Isaiah 6:9,10 And He said, Go, and tell this people, Hear ye indeed, but understand not; and see ye indeed, but perceive not. 10 Make the heart of this people fat, and make their ears heavy, and shut their eyes; lest they see with their eyes, and hear with their ears, and understand with their heart, and convert, and be healed.

Acts 9 Referred to Paul's conversion seeing Jesus.

- 1 Kings 18:37 Hear me, O LORD, hear me, that this people may know that Thou art the LORD God, and that Thou hast turned their heart back again.
- Daniel 7:4 The first was like a lion, and had eagle's wings: I beheld till the wings thereof were plucked, and it was lifted up from the earth, and made stand upon the feet as a man, and a man's heart was given to it.
- 2 Timothy 3:3 Without natural affection, trucebreakers, false accusers, incontinent, fierce, despisers of those that are good,
- John 16:8 And when He is come, He will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment:
- 1 John 4:19 We love Him, because He first loved us.
- Romans 11:25-36 (NKJV) V25 For I do not desire, brethren, that you should be ignorant of this mystery, lest you should be wise in your own opinion, that blindness in part has happened to Israel until the fullness of the Gentiles has come in.
- Acts 7:56 And said, Behold, I see the heavens opened, and the Son of man standing on the right hand of God.
- John 8:36 If the Son therefore shall make you free, ye shall be free indeed.
- John 10:38 But if I do, though ye believe not Me, believe the works: that ye may know, and believe, that the Father is in Me, and I in Him.
- John 15:24 If I had not done among them the works which none other man did, they had not had sin: but now have they both seen and hated both Me and My Father.
- Luke 8 Referred to the different types of seed growth.
- Romans 10:13 For whoever shall call on the Name of the Lord shall be saved.
- Romans 11:25 (AV) For I would not, brethren, that ye should be ignorant of this mystery, lest ye should be wise in your own conceits; that blindness in part is happened to Israel, until the fulness of the Gentiles be come in.
- Ephesians 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.

- Romans 11:26,27 (NKJV) And so all Israel will be saved, as it is written: The Deliverer will come out of Zion, And He will turn away ungodliness from Jacob; 27 For this *is* My covenant with them, When I take away their sins.
- Joel 2:32 And it shall come to pass *That* whoever calls on the Name of the LORD Shall be saved. For in Mount <u>Zion</u> and in Jerusalem there shall be <u>deliverance</u>, As the LORD has said, Among the remnant whom the LORD calls.
- Obadiah 1:17 But on Mount <u>Zion</u> there shall be <u>deliverance</u>, And there shall be holiness; The house of Jacob shall possess their possessions.
- Romans 11:26 (NKJV) And so all Israel will be saved, as it is written: The Deliverer will come out of Zion, And He will turn away ungodliness from Jacob:
- Leviticus 20:26 And ye shall be Holy unto Me: for I the LORD am Holy, and have severed you from other people, that ye should be Mine.
- 1 John 3:3 And every man that hath this hope in Him purifieth himself, even as He is pure.
- Summarized of the false accusations against Jesus.
- Matthew 26:63,64 But Jesus held His peace. And the high priest answered and said unto Him, I adjure Thee by the Living God, that Thou tell us whether Thou be the Christ, the Son of God. 64 Jesus saith unto him, Thou hast said: nevertheless I say unto you, Hereafter shall ye see the Son of Man sitting on the right hand of power, and coming in the clouds of heaven.
- Romans 11:27 For this *is* My covenant with them, when I take away their sins.
- Matthew 16:24 Then said Jesus unto His disciples, If any man will come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow Me.
- Mark 10:52 And Jesus said unto him (Blind Bart), Go thy way; thy faith hath made thee whole. And immediately he received his sight, and followed Jesus in the way.
- Mark 5:18,19 And when He was come into the ship, he that had been possessed with the devil prayed Him that he might be with Him. 19 Howbeit Jesus suffered him not, but saith unto him, Go home to thy friends, and tell them how great things the Lord hath done for thee, and hath had compassion on thee.
- John 4 Referred to the woman at the well bringing people to Jesus.
- 2 Corinthians 1:22 Who hath also sealed us, and given the earnest of the Spirit in our hearts.
- 2 Corinthians 5:8 We are confident, I say, and willing rather to be absent from the body, and to be present with the Lord.
- Matthew 25:46 And these shall go away into everlasting punishment: but the

- righteous into life eternal. (Both Strongs #166)
- 2 Corinthians 6:2 (For He saith, I have heard thee in a time accepted, and in the day of salvation have I succoured thee: behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation.)
- Romans 11:28,29 Concerning the gospel *they are* enemies for your sake, but concerning the election *they are* beloved for the sake of the fathers. 29 For the gifts and the calling of God *are* irrevocable.
- Acts 17:30 And the times of this ignorance God winked at; but now commandeth all men every where to repent:
- Matthew 11:28 Come unto Me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.
- Romans 6:23 For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.
- Matthew 27:17,21,25 Therefore when they were gathered together, Pilate said unto them, Whom will ye that I release unto you? Barabbas, or Jesus which is called Christ? 21 The governor answered and said unto them, Whether of the twain will ye that I release unto you? They said, Barabbas. 25 Then answered all the people, and said, His Blood be on us, and on our children.
- Mark 7:25-30 For a certain woman, whose young daughter had an unclean spirit, heard of Him, and came and fell at His feet: 26 The woman was a Greek, a Syrophenician by nation; and she besought Him that he would cast forth the devil out of her daughter. 27 But Jesus said unto her, Let the children first be filled: for it is not meet to take the children's bread, and to cast it unto the dogs. 28 And she answered and said unto Him, Yes, Lord: yet the dogs under the table eat of the children's crumbs. 29 And He said unto her, For this saying go thy way; the devil is gone out of thy daughter. 30 And when she was come to her house, she found the devil gone out, and her daughter laid upon the bed.
- Romans 10:13 For whoever shall call on the Name of the Lord shall be saved.
- Ephesians 1:13 In Whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the Word of Truth, the gospel of your salvation: in Whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that Holy Spirit of promise,
- Romans 11:30 For as you were once disobedient to God, yet have now obtained mercy through their disobedience, 31 even so these also have now been disobedient, that through the mercy shown you they also may obtain mercy.
- Revelation 7:4 And I heard the number of them which were sealed: and there were sealed an hundred and forty and four thousand of all the tribes of the children of Israel.
- Ezra 9:13 And after all that is come upon us for our evil deeds, and for our

- great trespass, seeing that Thou our God hast punished us less than our iniquities deserve, and hast given us such deliverance as this;
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- Romans 11:32 For God has committed them all to disobedience, that He might have mercy on all.
- Isaiah 6:9,10 And He said, Go, and tell this people, Hear ye indeed, but understand not; and see ye indeed, but perceive not. 10 Make the heart of this people fat, and make their ears heavy, and shut their eyes; lest they see with their eyes, and hear with their ears, and understand with their heart, and convert, and be healed.
- Romans 11:33 Oh, the depth of the riches both of the wisdom and knowledge of God! How unsearchable *are* His judgments & His ways past finding out!
- Isaiah 55:9 For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are Wy ways higher than your ways, and My thoughts than your thoughts.
- James 1:5 If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God, that giveth to all men liberally, and upbraideth not; and it shall be given him.
- Proverbs 2:6 For the LORD giveth wisdom: out of His mouth cometh knowledge and understanding.
- Luke 24:32 And they said one to another, Did not our heart burn within us, while He talked with us by the way, and while He opened to us the scriptures?
- Luke 8:11 Now the parable is this: The seed is the word of God. (Miss-used)
- Luke 23:34 Then said Jesus, Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do. And they parted His raiment, and cast lots.
- John 3:7 Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again.
- 2 Corinthians 6:2 (For He saith, I have heard thee in a time accepted, and in the day of salvation have I succoured thee: behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation.)
- Romans 6:23 For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.
- Romans 11:34 For who has known the mind of the LORD? Or who has become His counselor?
- Referred to David's counselors.
- 2 Chronicles 7:14 If My people, which are called by My Name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.
- Matthew 3:2 And (John Baptist) saying, Repent ye: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.
- Matthew 4:17 From that time Jesus began to preach, and to say, Repent: for

- the kingdom of heaven is at hand.
- Romans 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.
- Romans 11:35 Or who has first given to Him And it shall be repaid to him?

 Revelation 20:12 And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is the book of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works.
- Romans 11:36 For of Him and through Him and to Him *are* all things, to whom *be* glory forever. Amen.
- 1 John 3:8 He that committeth sin is of the devil; for the devil sinneth from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that He might destroy the works of the devil.
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents & scorpions, & over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- Mark 16:17,18 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.
- Matthew 12:40 For as Jonah was three days and three nights in the whale's belly; so shall the Son of Man be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth.
- Mark 16:9 Now when Jesus was risen early the first day of the week, He appeared first to Mary Magdalene, out of whom He had cast seven devils.
- John 14:3 And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto Myself; that where I am, there ye may be also.
- Strongs#50 agnoeo *ag-no-eh'-o* AV-be ignorant 7, ignorant 4, know not 4, understand not 3, ignorantly 2, unknown 2; 22 1) act. to be ignorant, not to know {Acts 13:27; 17:23; Rom 10:3; 2Pet 2:12} pass. not know or disregarded {1Cor 14:38} 2) not to understand, unknown {Mark 9:32; Luke 9:45} 3) to err or sin through mistake, to be wrong, spoken mildly of those who are not high handed or wilful transgressors {Heb 5:2}.
- Strongs #1438 heautou *heh-ow-too'* (including all other cases) AV-himself 110, themselves 57, yourselves 36, ourselves 20, his 19, their 15, itself 9, misc 73; 339 1) himself, herself, itself, themselves.
- Luke 18 Summarized of the parable of the Pharisee & the Publican. V14 I tell you, this man (the Publican) went down to his house justified rather than the other (the Pharisee): for every one that exalteth himself shall be abased; and he that humbleth himself shall be exalted.
- Luke 7:31-35 And the Lord said, Whereunto then shall I liken the men of this

- generation? and to what are they like? 32 They are like unto children sitting in the marketplace, and calling one to another, and saying, We have piped unto you, and ye have not danced; we have mourned to you, and ye have not wept. 33 For John the Baptist came neither eating bread nor drinking wine; and ye say, he hath a devil. 34 The Son of Man is come eating and drinking; and ye say, Behold a gluttonous man, and a winebibber, a friend of publicans and sinners! 35 But wisdom is justified of all her children.
- Mark 9:32 But they <u>did not understand</u> <50> this saying, and were afraid to ask Him.
- Luke 9:45 But they <u>did not understand</u> <50> this saying, and <u>it was hidden</u> <u>from them</u> so that they did not perceive it; and they were afraid to ask Him about this saying.
- John 16:These things have I spoken unto you in proverbs: but the time cometh, when I shall no more speak unto you in proverbs, but I shall shew you plainly of the Father.
- Acts 13:27 For those who dwell in Jerusalem, and their rulers, because they did not know <50> Him, nor even the voices of the Prophets which are read every Sabbath, have fulfilled *them* in condemning *Him*.
- Acts 17:23 for as I was passing through and considering the objects of your worship, I even found an altar with this inscription: TO THE UNKNOWN GOD. Therefore, the One Whom you worship without knowing <50>, Him I proclaim to you:
- Romans 1:13 Now I do not want you to be <u>unaware <50></u>, brethren, that I often planned to come to you (but was hindered until now), that I might have some fruit among you also, just as among the other Gentiles.
- Romans 2:4 Or do you despise the riches of His goodness, forbearance, and longsuffering, <u>not knowing <50></u> that the goodness of God leads you to repentance?
- Romans 6:3 Or do you <u>not know <50></u> that as many of us as were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into His death?
- Romans 7:1 Or do you <u>not know <50></u>, brethren (for I speak to those who know the law), that the law has dominion over a man as long as he lives?
- Romans 10:3 For they being <u>ignorant <50></u> of God's righteousness, and seeking to establish their own righteousness, have not submitted to the righteousness of God.
- Romans 11:25 For I do not desire, brethren, that you should be <u>ignorant <50></u> of this mystery, lest you should be wise in your own opinion, that blindness in part has happened to Israel until the fullness of the Gentiles has come in.
- 1 Corinthians 10:1 Moreover, brethren, I do not want you to be unaware <50>

- that all our fathers were under the cloud, all passed through the sea,
- 1 Corinthians 12:1 Now concerning spiritual *gifts*, brethren, I do not want you to be <u>ignorant</u> <50>:
- 1 Corinthians 14:38 But if anyone is <u>ignorant <50></u>, let him be <u>ignorant <50></u>.
- 1 Corinthians 12:31 But covet earnestly the best gifts: and yet shew I unto you a more excellent way.
- 2 Corinthians 1:8 For we do not want you to be <u>ignorant <50></u>, brethren, of our trouble which came to us in Asia: that we were burdened beyond measure, above strength, so that we despaired even of life.
- 2 Corinthians 2:11 lest Satan should take advantage of us; for we are not ignorant <50> of his devices.
- 2 Corinthians 6:9 as <u>unknown</u> <50>, and *yet* well known; as dying, and behold we live; as chastened, and *yet* not killed;
- Galatians 1:22 And I was <u>unknown <50></u> by face to the churches of Judea which *were* in Christ.
- 1 Thessalonians 4:13 But I do not want you to be <u>ignorant <50></u>, brethren, concerning those who have fallen asleep, lest you sorrow as others who have no hope.
- 1 Timothy 1:13 although I was formerly a blasphemer, a persecutor, and an insolent man; but I obtained mercy because I did *it* <u>ignorantly <50></u> in unbelief.
- Hebrews 5:2 He can have compassion on those who are <u>ignorant <50></u> and going astray, since he himself is also subject to weakness.
- 2 Peter 2:12 But these, like natural brute beasts made to be caught and destroyed, speak evil of the things they do <u>not understand</u> <50>, and will utterly perish in their own corruption,
- John 16:7 Nevertheless I tell you the truth; It is expedient for you that I go away: for if I go not away, the Comforter will not come unto you; but if I depart, I will send Him unto you.
- Acts 1&2 Compaired with & without the infilling of the Holy Spirit.
- 1 Corinthians 2:2 For I determined not to know any thing among you, save Jesus Christ, and Him crucified.
- Revelation 19:11 Referred to Jesus' return.
- Revelation 22:20 He which testifieth these things saith, Surely I come quickly. Amen. Even so, come, Lord Jesus.
