## When God Tingles The Ears - 1 Samuel 3B

- Referred to many times God tingled the ears of men the Deluge with Noah, the Tower of Babel, bringing Israel out of Egypt, the shoot out on Mount Carmel, the army blinded at Dothan, with many prophets, & finally Jesus risen from the dead.
- 1 Samuel 3:8-10 (AV) And the LORD called Samuel again the third time. And he arose and went to Eli, and said, Here am I; for thou didst call me. And Eli perceived that the LORD had called the child. 9 Therefore Eli said unto Samuel, Go, lie down: and it shall be, if he call thee, that thou shalt say, Speak, LORD; for thy servant heareth. 10 And the LORD came, and stood, and called as at other times, Samuel, Samuel. Then Samuel answered, Speak; for thy servant heareth.
- 1 Samuel 2:27 And there came a man of God unto Eli, and said unto him, Thus saith the LORD, Did I plainly appear unto the house of thy father, when they were in Egypt in Pharaoh's house?
- 2 Chronicles 7:14 If My people, which are called by My Name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.

(Summarized of King Manasseh worst king of Israel captured, repented, & relaesed to try to clean up the mess he had made.)
