Gifts - Godly Or Not - Romans 12B

- 1 Kings 22:22 And the LORD said unto him, Wherewith? And he said, I will go forth, and I will be a lying spirit in the mouth of all his prophets. And he said, Thou shalt persuade him, and prevail also: go forth, and do so.
- Deuteronomy 18:9-14 When thou art come into the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee, thou shalt not learn to do after the abominations of those nations. ...
- John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.
- 1 Corinthians 12 Referred to the gifts of the Spirit.
- John 16:7 Nevertheless I tell you the truth; It is expedient for you that I go away: for if I go not away, the Comforter will not come unto you; but if I depart, I will send Him unto you.
- Romans 8:26 Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered.
- Acts 1&2 Compaired before & after receiving the Holy Spirit.
- Romans 12:6 Having then gifts differing according to the grace that is given to us, let us use them: if prophecy, let us prophesy in proportion to our faith;
- Exodus 31:3-5 And I have filled him with the spirit of God, in wisdom, and in understanding, and in knowledge, and in all manner of workmanship, 4 To devise cunning works, to work in gold, and in silver, and in brass, 5 And in cutting of stones, to set them, and in carving of timber, to work in all manner of workmanship.
- Matthew 25 Referred to the parable of the Talents.
- Ephesians 2:8,9 For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: 9 Not of works, lest any man should boast.
- 1 John 4:19 We love Him, because He first loved us.
- John 16:8 And when He is come, He will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment:
- 2 Corinthians 2:11 Lest Satan should get an advantage of us: for we are not ignorant of his devices.
- 1 Corinthians 14:1 Follow after charity, and desire spiritual gifts, but rather that ye may prophesy.
- Matthew 3:2 And saying, Repent ye: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.
- Matthew 4:17 From that time Jesus began to preach, and to say, Repent: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.

- Referred to many Old Testament Godly prophets.
- Jeremiah 44 Summarized the trickery of Israelites to him. V27 Behold, I will watch over them for evil, and not for good: and all the men of Judah that are in the land of Egypt shall be consumed by the sword and by the famine, until there be an end of them.
- Luke 17:5 And the apostles said unto the Lord, Increase our faith.
- Luke 11:1 And it came to pass, that, as he was praying in a certain place, when he ceased, one of his disciples said unto him, Lord, teach us to pray, as John also taught his disciples.
- Strongs #5486 charisma *khar'-is-mah* AV-gift 15, free gift 2; 17 1) a favour with which one receives without any merit of his own 2) the gift of Divine grace 3) the gift of faith, knowledge, Holiness, virtue 4) the economy of Divine grace, by which the pardon of sin and eternal salvation is appointed to sinners in consideration of the merits of Christ laid hold of by faith 5) grace or gifts denoting extraordinary powers, distinguishing certain Christians and enabling them to serve the church of Christ, the reception of which is due to the power of Divine grace operating on their souls by the Holy Spirit.
- 1 Corinthians 16:15 I beseech you, brethren, (ye know the house of Stephanas, that it is the firstfruits of Achaia, and that they have addicted themselves to the ministry of the saints,)
- Matthew 2:11 And when they had come into the house, they saw the young Child with Mary His mother, and fell down and worshiped Him. And when they had opened their treasures, they presented gifts to Him: gold, frankincense, and myrrh.
- Strongs #1435 doron *do'-ron* AV-gift 18, offering 1; 19 1) a gift, present 1a) gifts offered in expression of honour 1a1) of sacrifices and other gifts offered to God 1a2) of money cast into the treasury for the purposes of the temple and for the support of the poor 2) the offering of a gift or of gifts.
- Matthew 5:23,24 Therefore if you bring your gift to the altar, and there remember that your brother has something against you, 24 leave your gift there before the altar, and go your way. First be reconciled to your brother, and then come and offer your gift.
- Matthew 7:11 If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father Who is in heaven give good things to those who ask Him!
- Strongs #1390 doma dom'-ah AV-gift 4; 1) a gift.
- Matthew 8:4 And Jesus said to him, See that you tell no one; but go your way, show yourself to the priest, and offer the gift that Moses commanded, as a testimony to them.
- Matthew 15:5 But you say, Whoever says to his father or mother, Whatever

- profit you might have received from me is a gift to God
- Matthew 23:18,19 And, Whoever swears by the altar, it is nothing; but whoever swears by the <u>gift</u> that is on it, he is obliged *to perform it*. 19 Fools and blind! For which is greater, the <u>gift</u> or the altar that sanctifies the <u>gift</u>?
- Romans 1:11 For I long to see you, that I may impart to you some spiritual gift <5486>, so that you may be established
- Romans 12:5 So we, being many, are one body in Christ, and every one members one of another.
- Acts 8:9 But there was a certain man, called Simon, which beforetime in the same city used sorcery, and bewitched the people of Samaria, giving out that himself was some great one:
- Romans 5:15,16 But the free gift <5486> is not like the offense. For if by the one man's offense many died, much more the grace of God and the gift by the grace of the one Man, Jesus Christ, abounded to many.
- Ephesians 1:7 In Whom we have redemption through His Blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His grace;
- John 3:16 For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life.
- Romans 8:29 For whom he did foreknow, he also did predestinate to be conformed to the image of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brethren.
- Acts 8:18,19 And when Simon saw that through laying on of the apostles' hands the Holy Ghost was given, he offered them money, 19 Saying, Give me also this power, that on whomsoever I lay hands, he may receive the Holy Ghost.
- Romans 5:16 And the gift *is* not like *that which came* through the one who sinned. For the judgment *which came* from one *offense resulted* in condemnation, but the free gift <5486> which came from many offenses *resulted* in justification.
- Summarized of Jesus raised from the dead.
- John 14:3 And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, there ye may be also.
- 1 John 2:1 My little children, these things write I unto you, that ye sin not.

 And if any man sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous:
- Hebrews 7:25 Wherefore he is able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by him, seeing he ever liveth to make intercession for them.
- Romans 6:23 For the wages of sin *is* death, but the gift <5486> of God *is*

- eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.
- John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by Me.
- Revelation 19:11 Referred to Jesus' return.
- Revelation 6:16 And said to the mountains and rocks, Fall on us, and hide us from the face of Him that sitteth on the throne, and from the wrath of the Lamb:
- 2 Corinthians 6:2 (For He saith, I have heard thee in a time accepted, and in the day of salvation have I succoured thee: behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation.)
- Romans 11:29 For the gifts <5486> and the calling of God are irrevocable.
- John 10:28,29 And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of My hand. 29 My Father, which gave them Me, is greater than all; and no man is able to pluck them out of My Father's hand.
- Matthew 25:46 And these shall go away into everlasting punishment: but the righteous into life eternal.
- Matthew 25:31-33 When the Son of man shall come in His glory, and all the Holy angels with Him, then shall He sit upon the throne of his glory: 32 And before Him shall be gathered all nations: and he shall separate them one from another, as a shepherd divideth his sheep from the goats: 33 And He shall set the sheep on his right hand, but the goats on the left.
- Romans 12:6 Having then gifts <5486> differing according to the grace that is given to us, *let us use them*: if prophecy, *let us prophesy* in proportion to our faith;
- 1 Corinthians 14:27 If any man speak in an unknown tongue, let it be by two, or at the most by three, and that by course; and let one interpret. 29 Let the prophets speak two or three, and let the other judge.
- 1 Corinthians 1:7 so that you come short in no gift <5486>, eagerly waiting for the revelation of our Lord Jesus Christ,
- Acts 11:23 Who, when he came, and had seen the grace of God, was glad, and exhorted them all, that with purpose of heart they would cleave unto the Lord.
- Luke 9:49,50 And John answered and said, Master, we saw one casting out devils in Thy Name; and we forbad him, because he followeth not with us. 50 And Jesus said unto him, Forbid him not: for he that is not against us is for us.
- 1 Corinthians 7:7 For I wish that all men were even as I myself. But each one has his own gift <5486> from God, one in this manner and another in that.
- Ezra 7:10 For Ezra had prepared his heart to seek the law of the LORD, and to do it, and to teach in Israel statutes and judgments.

- Ephesians 6:18 Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints;
- Referred to Reese Howels Intercessor prayer battling in the heavenlies.
- Daniel 10 Referred to the spiritual battle in the heavenlies.
- Galatians 4:6 And because ye are sons, God hath sent forth the Spirit of his Son into your hearts, crying, Abba, Father.
- 1 Corinthians 12:4 There are diversities of gifts <5486>, but the same Spirit.
- 1 Corinthians 12:9 to another faith by the same Spirit, to another gifts <5486> of healings by the same Spirit,
- Luke 22:31,32 And the Lord said, Simon, Simon, behold, Satan hath desired to have you, that he may sift you as wheat: 32 But I have prayed for thee, that thy faith fail not: and when thou art converted, strengthen thy brethren.
- Acts 5:15 Insomuch that they brought forth the sick into the streets, and laid them on beds and couches, that at the least the shadow of Peter passing by might overshadow some of them.
- 1 Corinthians 12:28 And God has appointed these in the church: first apostles, second prophets, third teachers, after that miracles, then gifts <5486> of healings, helps, administrations, varieties of tongues.
- Mark 9:38,39 And John answered Him, saying, Master, we saw one casting out devils in Thy Name, and he followeth not us: and we forbad him, because he followeth not us. 39 But Jesus said, Forbid him not: for there is no man which shall do a miracle in My Name, that can lightly speak evil of Me.
- Matthew 4:23-25 And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing all manner of sickness and all manner of disease among the people. 24 And His fame went throughout all Syria: and they brought unto Him all sick people that were taken with divers diseases and torments, and those which were possessed with devils, and those which were lunatick, and those that had the palsy; and He healed them. 25 And there followed Him great multitudes of people from Galilee, and from Decapolis, and from Jerusalem, and from Judaea, and from beyond Jordan.
- Genesis 11:7 Go to, let us go down, and there confound their language, that they may not understand one another's speech. 8 So the LORD scattered them abroad from thence upon the face of all the earth: and they left off to build the city. 9 Therefore is the name of it called Babel; because the LORD did there confound the language of all the earth: and from thence did the LORD scatter them abroad upon the face of all the earth.
- 1 Corinthians 12:30,31 Do all have gifts <5486> of healings? Do all speak with

- tongues? Do all interpret? 31 But earnestly desire the best gifts <5486>. And yet I show you a more excellent way.
- 2 Corinthians 1:11 you also helping together in prayer for us, that thanks may be given by many persons on our behalf for the gift <5486> granted to us through many.
- 1 Timothy 4:14 Do not neglect the gift <5486> that is in you, which was given to you by prophecy with the laying on of the hands of the eldership.
- Joshua 18:3 And Joshua said unto the children of Israel, How long are ye slack to go to possess the land, which the LORD God of your fathers hath given you?
- 2 Timothy 1:6 Therefore I remind you to stir up the gift <5486> of God which is in you through the laying on of my hands.
- 1 Peter 4:10 As each one has received a gift <5486>, minister it to one another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God.
- 1 Corinthians 16:15 I beseech you, brethren, (ye know the house of Stephanas, that it is the firstfruits of Achaia, and that they have addicted themselves to the ministry of the saints,)
