## **Prophecy - Godly Or Not - Romans 12C**

- Numbers 22-24 Referred to Balaam prophet or sorcerer.
- Referred to many Godly prophets in the Old Testament.
- Deuteronomy 13:1,3 If there arise among you a prophet, or a dreamer of dreams, and giveth thee a sign or a wonder, 3 Thou shalt not hearken unto the words of that prophet, or that dreamer of dreams: for the LORD your God proveth you, to know whether ye love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul.
- Revelation 2:14 But I have a few things against thee, because thou hast there them that hold the doctrine of Balaam, who taught Balac to cast a stumblingblock before the children of Israel, to eat things sacrificed unto idols, and to commit fornication. (Numbers 25)
- Deuteronomy 18:9-14 When thou art come into the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee, thou shalt not learn to do after the abominations of those nations. ...
- Exodus 20:5 Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for I the LORD thy God am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation of them that hate me;
- 2 Timothy 2:15 Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the Word of Truth.
- Romans 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.
- Romans 12:6 Having then gifts differing according to the grace that is given to us, let us use them: if prophecy, let us prophesy in proportion to our faith;
- 1 Corinthians 12:31 But covet earnestly the best gifts: and yet shew I unto you a more excellent way.
- Acts 20:34 Yea, ye yourselves know, that these hands have ministered unto my necessities, and to them that were with me.
- Matthew 25 Referred to the parable of the Talents the one talent was burried.
- Exodus 33:11 And the LORD spake unto Moses face to face, as a man speaketh unto his friend. And he turned again into the camp: but his servant Joshua, the son of Nun, a young man, departed not out of the tabernacle.
- Summarized of ungodly prophetic activities.

- Deuteronomy 18:9-14 When thou art come into the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee, thou shalt not learn to do after the abominations of those nations. 10 There shall not be found among you any one that maketh his son or his daughter to pass through the fire, or that useth divination, or an observer of times, or an enchanter, or a witch, 11 Or a charmer, or a consulter with familiar spirits, or a wizard, or a necromancer. ...
- Mark 5:9 And He asked him, What is thy name? And he answered, saying, My name is Legion: for we are many.
- Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;
- 1 Corinthians 14:29 Let the prophets speak two or three, and let the other judge.
- 1 Peter 5:8 Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour:
- Strongs #4394 propheteia *prof-ay-ti'-ah* AV-prophecy 16, prophesying 3; 19 1) prophecy 1a) a discourse emanating from Divine inspiration and declaring the purposes of God, whether by reproving and admonishing the wicked, or comforting the afflicted, or revealing things hidden; esp. by foretelling future events 1b) Used in the NT of the utterance of OT prophets 1b1) of the prediction of events relating to Christ's kingdom and its speedy triumph, together with the consolations and admonitions pertaining to it, the spirit of prophecy, the Divine mind, to which the prophetic faculty is due 1b2) of the endowment and speech of the Christian teachers called prophets 1b3) the gifts and utterances of these prophets, esp. of the predictions of the works of which, set apart to teach the gospel, will accomplish for the kingdom of Christ.
- 2 Kings 6:12 And one of his servants said, None, my lord, O king: but Elisha, the prophet that is in Israel, telleth the king of Israel the words that thou speakest in thy bedchamber.
- Strongs #2596 kata *kat-ah'* AV-according to 107, after 61, against 58, in 36, by 27, daily + 2250 15, as 11, misc 165; 480 1) down from, through out 2) according to, toward, along.
- Matthew 25 Referred to the parable of the Talents how the talents were used.
- Romans 14:12 So then every one of us shall give account of himself to God. Matthew 25:19 After a long time the lord of those servants cometh, and reckoneth with them.
- Matthew 13:14 And in them the prophecy <4394> of Isaiah is fulfilled, which says: Hearing you will hear and shall not understand, And seeing you will see and not perceive;

- Acts 16:14 And a certain woman named Lydia, a seller of purple, of the city of Thyatira, which worshipped God, heard us: whose heart the Lord opened, that she attended unto the things which were spoken of Paul.
- Jeremiah 24:7 And I will give them an heart to know Me, that I am the LORD: and they shall be My people, and I will be their God: for they shall return unto Me with their whole heart.
- Romans 12:6 Having then gifts differing according to the grace that is given to us, *let us use them*: if prophecy <4394>, *let us prophesy* in proportion to our faith;
- 1 Corinthians 12:10 to another the working of miracles, to another prophecy <4394>, to another discerning of spirits, to another *different* kinds of tongues, to another the interpretation of tongues.
- Matthew 10:16 Behold, I send you forth as sheep in the midst of wolves: be ye therefore wise as serpents, and harmless as doves.
- Hebrews 5:14 But strong meat belongeth to them that are of full age, even those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.
- Matthew 12:29 Or else how can one enter into a strong man's house, and spoil his goods, except he first bind the strong man? and then he will spoil his house. (Mark 3:27)
- Matthew 16:19 And I will give unto thee the keys of the kingdom of heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven. (Matthew 18:18)
- Genesis 11:9 Therefore is the name of it called Babel; because the LORD did there confound the language of all the earth: and from thence did the LORD scatter them abroad upon the face of all the earth.
- 1 Corinthians 14:5 I would that ye all spake with tongues, but rather that ye prophesied: for greater is he that prophesieth than he that speaketh with tongues, except he interpret, that the church may receive edifying.
- 1 Corinthians 13:2 And though I have *the gift of* prophecy <4394>, and understand all mysteries and all knowledge, and though I have all faith, so that I could remove mountains, but have not love, I am nothing.
- Matthew 17:20 And Jesus said unto them, Because of your unbelief: for verily I say unto you, If ye have faith as a grain of mustard seed, ye shall say unto this mountain, Remove hence to yonder place; and it shall remove; and nothing shall be impossible unto you.
- 1 Corinthians 13:8 Love never fails. But whether *there are* prophecies <4394>, they will fail; whether *there are* tongues, they will cease; whether *there is* knowledge, it will vanish away.

- 1 Corinthians 14:6 But now, brethren, if I come to you speaking with tongues, what shall I profit you unless I speak to you either by revelation, by knowledge, by prophesying <4394>, or by teaching?
- 1 Corinthians 14:19 Yet in the church I had rather speak five words with my understanding, that by my voice I might teach others also, than ten thousand words in an unknown tongue.
- Acts 2:4-6 And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance. 5 And there were dwelling at Jerusalem Jews, devout men, out of every nation under heaven. 6 Now when this was noised abroad, the multitude came together, and were confounded, because that every man heard them speak in his own language.
- 1 Corinthians 14:22 Therefore tongues are for a sign, not to those who believe but to unbelievers; but prophesying <4394> is not for unbelievers but for those who believe.
- Jeremiah 23:21 I have not sent these prophets, yet they ran: I have not spoken to them, yet they prophesied.
- 1 Thessalonians 5:20 Do not despise prophecies <4394>.
- 1 Timothy 1:18 This charge I commit to you, son Timothy, according to the prophecies <4394> previously made concerning you, that by them you may wage the good warfare,
- Acts 11:23 Who, when he came, and had seen the grace of God, was glad, and exhorted them all, that with purpose of heart they would cleave unto the Lord.
- Ephesians 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.
- 2 Corinthians 10:4 (For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;)
- 1 John 3:8 He that committeth sin is of the devil; for the devil sinneth from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that he might destroy the works of the devil.
- 1 Timothy 4:14 Do not neglect the gift that is in you, which was given to you by prophecy <4394> with the laying on of the hands of the eldership.

Numbers 11 Referred to 70 elders prophesying.

Genesis 6 Summarized of Noah preaching & building the ark.

2 Peter 2:8 (For that righteous man (Lot) dwelling among them, in seeing and hearing, vexed his righteous soul from day to day with their unlawful deeds;)

Psalms 3A He restoreth my soul.

- Ephesians 6:4 And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.
- 2 Peter 1:20,21 knowing this first, that no prophecy <4394> of Scripture is of any private interpretation, 21 for prophecy <4394> never came by the will of man, but Holy men of God spoke as they were moved by the Holy Spirit.
- 2 Timothy 3:16 All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness:
- John 6:56 He that eateth my flesh, and drinketh my blood, dwelleth in me, and I in him. (Miss-used)
- John 6:63 It is the spirit that quickeneth; the flesh profiteth nothing: the words that I speak unto you, they are spirit, and they are life.
- Revelation 1:3 Blessed *is* he who reads and those who hear the words of this prophecy <4394>, and keep those things which are written in it; for the time *is* near.
- Deuteronomy 18:9-14 When thou art come into the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee, thou shalt not learn to do after the abominations of those nations. 10 There shall not be found among you any one that maketh his son or his daughter to pass through the fire, or that useth divination, or an observer of times, or an enchanter, or a witch, 11 Or a charmer, or a consulter with familiar spirits, or a wizard, or a necromancer. ...
- Revelation 11:6 These have power to shut heaven, so that no rain falls in the days of their prophecy <4394>; and they have power over waters to turn them to blood, and to strike the earth with all plagues, as often as they desire.
- Jonah 3:4 And Jonah began to enter into the city a day's journey, and he cried, and said, Yet forty days, and Nineveh shall be overthrown. (Repent)
- Revelation 19:10 And I fell at his feet to worship him. But he said to me, See that you do not do that! I am your fellow servant, and of your brethren who have the testimony of Jesus. Worship God! For the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy <4394>.
- Revelation 22:7 Behold, I am coming quickly! Blessed *is* he who keeps the Words of the prophecy <4394> of this book.
- Revelation 22:10 And he said to me, Do not seal the Words of the prophecy <4394> of this Book, for the time is at hand.
- Revelation 22:18,19 For I testify to everyone who hears the words of the prophecy <4394> of this Book: If anyone adds to these things, God will add to him the plagues that are written in this Book; 19 and if anyone takes away from the Words of the Book of this prophecy <4394>, God shall take away his part from the Book of Life, from the Holy city, and *from* the things which are written in this Book.

- Acts 15:20 But that we write unto them, that they abstain from pollutions of idols, and from fornication, and from things strangled, and from blood.
- Lamentations 2:14 Your prophets have seen for you false and deceptive visions; They have not uncovered your iniquity, To bring back your captives, But have envisioned for you <u>false prophecies</u> and delusions.
- Jeremiah 44 Summarized of God's answer to Israelites wanting to go to Egypt.
- Strongs #07723 shav' shawv or shav shav AV-vain 22, vanity 22, false 5, lying 2, falsely 1, lies 1; 53 1) emptiness, vanity, falsehood 1a) emptiness, nothingness, vanity 1b) emptiness of speech, lying 1c) worthlessness (of conduct).
- Strongs #04864 mas'eth *mas-ayth'* AV-burden 3, mess 3, collection 2, flame 2, gifts 1, oblations 1, reward 1, sign 1, lifting up 1; 15 1) uprising, utterance, burden, portion, uplifting 1a) that which rises, uprising, uplifting, signal, rising 1b) utterance, oracle 1c) burden 1d) portion, present, largesse, gift, contribution, offering, tribute.
- Strongs #05030 nabiy' *naw-bee'* AV-prophet 312, prophecy 1, them that prophesy 1, prophet + <u>0376</u> 1, variant 1; 316 1) spokesman, speaker, prophet 1a) prophet 1b) false prophet 1c) heathen prophet.
- Strongs #5578 pseudoprophetes *syoo-dop-rof-ay'-tace* AV-false prophet 11; 1) one who, acting the part of a divinely inspired prophet, utters falsehoods under the name of Divine prophecies 2) a false prophet.
- Jesus warns of false prophets.
- Matthew 7:15 <u>Beware of false prophets, who come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravenous wolves.</u>
- Matthew 24:11 Then many false prophets will rise up and deceive many.
- Matthew 24:24 For <u>false christs and false prophets will rise and show great</u> signs and wonders to deceive, if possible, even the elect.
- Strongs #5580 pseudochristos psyoo-dokh'-ris-tos AV-false Christ 2; 1) a false Christ (or Messiah) 2) one who falsely lays claim to the name and office of the Messiah.
- Acts 8:9 But there was a certain man, called Simon, which beforetime in the same city used sorcery, and bewitched the people of Samaria, giving out that himself was some great one:
- 1 Corinthians 1:2 Unto the church of God which is at Corinth, to them that are sanctified in Christ Jesus, called to be saints, with all that in every place call upon the name of Jesus Christ our Lord, both theirs and ours: (All believers are saints.)
- Mark 13:22 For <u>false christs and false prophets will rise and show signs and</u> wonders to deceive, if possible, even the elect.

- Deuteronomy 19:15 One witness shall not rise up against a man for any iniquity, or for any sin, in any sin that he sinneth: at the mouth of two witnesses, or at the mouth of three witnesses, shall the matter be established.
- Luke 6:26 Woe to you when all men speak well of you, For so did their fathers to the <u>false prophets</u>.
- Acts 13:6 Now when they had gone through the island to Paphos, they found a certain sorcerer, a <u>false prophet</u>, a Jew whose name *was* Bar-Jesus,
- 2 Peter 2:1 But there were also <u>false prophets</u> among the people, even as there will be <u>false teachers</u> among you, who will secretly bring in destructive heresies, even denying the Lord who bought them, *and* bring on themselves swift destruction.
- Strongs #5572 pseudodidaskalos psyoo-dod-id-as'-kal-os AV-false teacher 1; 1) a false teacher.
- Mark 9:7 And there was a cloud that overshadowed them: and a voice came out of the cloud, saying, This is My beloved Son: hear Him.
- Matthew 3:17 And Io a voice from heaven, saying, This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.
- 1 John 4:1 Beloved, <u>do not believe every spirit</u>, <u>but test the spirits</u>, <u>whether they are of God</u>; because many <u>false prophets</u> have gone out into the world.
- Revelation 16:13 And I saw three unclean spirits like frogs *coming* out of the mouth of the dragon, out of the mouth of the beast, and out of the mouth of the <u>false prophet</u>.
- Revelation 19:20 Then the beast was captured, and with him the <u>false</u>
  <u>prophet</u> who worked signs in his presence, by which he deceived those
  who received the mark of the beast and those who worshiped his image.
  These two were cast alive into the lake of fire burning with brimstone.
- Revelation 20:10 The devil, who deceived them, was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone where the beast and the <u>false prophet</u> are. And they will be tormented day and night forever and ever.
- 1 Kings 13 Summarized of the account of the man of God versus the old prophet.
- 1 Peter 1:25 But the Word of the Lord endureth for ever. And this is the Word which by the gospel is preached unto you.
