## Which Spirit Is In The Prophet - 2 Peter 1

- Hebrews 5:14 But strong meat belongeth to them that are of full age, even those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.
- 2 Corinthians 2:11 lest Satan should take advantage of us; for we are not ignorant of his devices.
- Matthew 23 Referred to Jesus addressing this crowd.
- Deuteronomy 18:20 But the prophet who presumes to speak a word in My Name, which I have not commanded him to speak, or who speaks in the name of other gods, that prophet shall die.
- 1 Corinthians 14:29 Let 2 or 3 prophets speak, and let the others judge.
- 2 Peter 1:21 for prophecy never came by the will of man, but Holy men of God spoke as they were moved by the Holy Spirit.
- Jeremiah 23:16 Thus says the LORD of hosts: Do not listen to the words of the prophets who prophesy to you. They make you worthless; They speak a vision of their own heart, Not from the mouth of the LORD.
- Exodus 30:20 When they go into the tabernacle of meeting, or when they come near the altar to minister, to burn an offering made by fire to the LORD, they shall wash with water, lest they die.
- Leviticus 11:45 For I am the LORD that bringeth you up out of the land of Egypt, to be your God: ye shall therefore be Holy, for I am Holy.
- James 4:8 Draw near to God and He will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners; and purify your hearts, you double-minded.
- Numbers 11:25,26 Then the LORD came down in the cloud, and spoke to him, and took of the <u>Spirit</u> that was upon him, and placed the same upon the seventy elders; and it happened, when the <u>Spirit</u> rested upon them, that they <u>prophesied</u>, although they never did so again. 26 But two men had remained in the camp: the name of one was Eldad, and the name of the other Medad. And the <u>Spirit</u> rested upon them. Now they were among those listed, but who had not gone out to the tabernacle; yet they <u>prophesied</u> in the camp.
- Numbers 11:28,29 So Joshua the son of Nun, Moses' assistant, one of his choice men, answered and said, Moses my lord, forbid them! 29 Then Moses said to him, Are you zealous for my sake? Oh, that all the LORD'S people were prophets and that the LORD would put His Spirit upon them!
- Mark 9:38-40 Now John answered Him, saying, Teacher, we saw someone who does not follow us casting out demons in Your name, and we forbade him because he does not follow us. 39 But Jesus said, Do not forbid him,

- for no one who works a miracle in My Name can soon afterward speak evil of Me. 40 For he who is not against us is on our side.
- Ephesians 1:13 In Him you also trusted, after you heard the Word of Truth, the gospel of your salvation; in whom also, having believed, you were sealed with the Holy Spirit of promise,
- Acts 2 Referred to the indwelling of the Holy Spirit.
- 1 Samuel 10:6 Then the <u>Spirit</u> of the LORD will come upon you, and you will <u>prophesy</u> with them and be turned into another man.
- Deuteronomy 17:17-19 Neither shall he multiply wives to himself, that his heart turn not away: neither shall he greatly multiply to himself silver and gold. 18 And it shall be, when he sitteth upon the throne of his kingdom, that he shall write him a copy of this law in a book out of that which is before the priests the Levites: 19 And it shall be with him, and he shall read therein all the days of his life: that he may learn to fear the LORD his God, to keep all the words of this law and these statutes, to do them:
- 1 Kings 11:3,4 And he (Solomon) had seven hundred wives, princesses, and three hundred concubines: and his wives turned away his heart.
- Acts 13:22 And when He had removed him, He raised up unto them David to be their king; to whom also He gave testimony, and said, I have found David the son of Jesse, a man after Mine Own heart, which shall fulfil all My will.
- 1 Samuel 10:10 When they came there to the hill, there was a group of <u>prophets</u> to meet him; then the <u>Spirit</u> of God came upon him, and he <u>prophesied</u> among them.
- 1 Samuel 18:10 And it happened on the next day that the distressing (evil) spirit from God came upon Saul, and he prophesied inside the house. So David played music with his hand, as at other times; but there was a spear in Saul's hand.
- 1 Samuel 16:14 But the Spirit of the LORD departed from Saul, and an evil (distressing) spirit from the LORD troubled him.
- Referred to Saul trying to kill David many times.
- 1 Samuel 19:20 Then Saul sent messengers to take David. And when they saw the group of <u>prophets</u> <u>prophesying</u>, and Samuel standing *as* leader over them, the <u>Spirit</u> of God came upon the messengers of Saul, and they also prophesied.
- Acts 5:3,5 But Peter said, Ananias, why hath Satan filled thine heart to lie to the Holy Ghost, and to keep back part of the price of the land? 5 And Ananias hearing these words fell down, and gave up the ghost: and great fear came on all them that heard these things.
- 1 Samuel 19:23 So he (Saul) went there to Naioth in Ramah. Then the Spirit

of God was upon him also, and he went on and <u>prophesied</u> until he came to Naioth in Ramah.

Summarized to David's sin with Bathsheba & God's judgment.

- 1 Kings 22:20-22 And the LORD said, Who will persuade Ahab to go up, that he may fall at Ramoth Gilead? So one spoke in this manner, and another spoke in that manner. 21 Then a spirit came forward and stood before the LORD, and said, I will persuade him. 22 The LORD said to him, In what way? So he said, I will go out and be a lying spirit in the mouth of all his prophets. And the LORD said, You shall persuade him, and also prevail. Go out and do so.
- 1 Kings 18:40 And Elijah said unto them, Take the (450) prophets of Baal; let not one of them escape. And they took them: and Elijah brought them down to the brook Kishon, and slew them there.
- 1 Samuel 8:5,7 And said unto him, Behold, thou art old, and thy sons walk not in thy ways: now make us a king to judge us like all the nations. 7 And the LORD said unto Samuel, Hearken unto the voice of the people in all that they say unto thee: for they have not rejected thee, but they have rejected Me, that I should not reign over them.
- 1 Kings 22:23 Therefore look! The LORD has put a lying <u>spirit</u> in the mouth of all these <u>prophets</u> of yours, & the LORD has declared disaster against you.
- 1 Kings 22:7,8 And Jehoshaphat said, Is there not still a prophet of the LORD here, that we may inquire of Him? 8 So the king of Israel said to Jehoshaphat, There is still one man, Micaiah the son of Imlah, by whom we may inquire of the LORD; but I hate him, because he does not prophesy good concerning me, but evil. And Jehoshaphat said, Let not the king say such things!
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents & scorpions, & over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- 2 Kings 2:15 Now when the sons of the <u>prophets</u> who *were* from Jericho saw him, they said, The <u>spirit</u> of Elijah rests on Elisha. And they came to meet him, and bowed to the ground before him.
- 2 Kings 2:9 And so it was, when they had crossed over, that Elijah said to Elisha, Ask! What may I do for you, before I am taken away from you? Elisha said, Please let a double portion of your spirit be upon me.
- 2 Chronicles 18:21,22 So he said, I will go out and be a lying spirit in the mouth of all his prophets. And the LORD said, You shall persuade him and also prevail; go out and do so. 22 Therefore look! The LORD has put a lying spirit in the mouth of these prophets of yours, and the LORD has declared disaster against you.

Nehemiah 9:30 Yet for many years You had patience with them, And testified

- against them by Your <u>Spirit</u> in Your <u>prophets</u>. Yet they would not listen; Therefore You gave them into the hand of the peoples of the lands.
- Leviticus 26 Referred to God's final judgment of foreign invaders.
- Isaiah 29:10 For the LORD has poured out on you The <u>spirit</u> of deep sleep, And has closed your eyes, namely, the <u>prophets</u>; And He has covered your heads, *namely*, the seers.
- Jesus quoted from Isaiah more than any other Old Testament book.
- Esther 7:8 Then the king returned out of the palace garden into the place of the banquet of wine; and Haman was fallen upon the bed whereon Esther was. Then said the king, Will he force the queen also before me in the house? As the word went out of the king's mouth, they covered Haman's face.
- Ezekiel 13:3 Thus says the Lord GOD: Woe to the foolish <u>prophets</u>, who follow their own <u>spirit</u> and have seen nothing!
- Matthew 23:16 Woe unto you, ye blind guides, which say, Whosoever shall swear by the temple, it is nothing; but whosoever shall swear by the gold of the temple, he is a debtor! 17 Ye fools and blind: for whether is greater, the gold, or the temple that sanctifieth the gold?
- Hosea 9:7 The days of punishment have come; The days of recompense (payback) have come. Israel knows! The <u>prophet</u> is a fool, The <u>spiritual</u> man is insane, Because of the greatness of your iniquity and great enmity.
- Ezekiel 33:6 But if the watchman see the sword come, and blow not the trumpet, and the people be not warned; if the sword come, and take any person from among them, he is taken away in his iniquity; but his blood will I require at the watchman's hand.
- Joel 2:28 And it shall come to pass afterward That I will pour out My <u>Spirit</u> on all flesh; Your sons and your daughters shall <u>prophesy</u>, Your old men shall dream dreams, Your young men shall see visions.
- Romans 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.
- Romans 8:29 For whom He did foreknow, He also did predestinate to be conformed to the Image of His Son, that He might be the firstborn among many brethren.
- Matthew 24:30 And then shall appear the sign of the Son of man in heaven: and then shall all the tribes of the earth mourn, and they shall see the Son of man coming in the clouds of heaven with power and great glory.
- 1 Corinthians 1:2 2 Unto the church of God which is at Corinth, to them that are sanctified in Christ Jesus, called to be saints, with all that in every place call upon the Name of Jesus Christ our Lord, both theirs and ours:

- Micah 2:11 If a man should walk in a false <u>spirit</u> And speak a lie, *saying*, I will <u>prophesy</u> to you of wine and drink, Even he would be the prattler of this people.
- Zechariah 7:12 Yes, they made their hearts like flint, refusing to hear the law and the Words which the LORD of hosts had sent by His <u>Spirit</u> through the former <u>prophets</u>. Thus great wrath came from the LORD of hosts.
- Jeremiah 24:7 And I will give them an heart to know Me, that I am the LORD: and they shall be My people, and I will be their God: for they shall return unto Me with their whole heart.
- 1 Kings 18:37 Hear me, O LORD, hear me, that this people may know that Thou art the LORD God, and that Thou hast turned their heart back again.
- Zechariah 13:2 It shall be in that day, says the LORD of hosts, *that* I will cut off the names of the idols from the land, and they shall no longer be remembered. I will also cause the <u>prophets</u> and the unclean <u>spirit</u> to depart from the land.
- Exodus 12:12 For I will pass through the land of Egypt this night, and will smite all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, both man and beast; and against all the gods of Egypt I will execute judgment: I am the LORD.
- Luke 1:67 Now his father Zacharias was filled with the Holy <u>Spirit</u>, and <u>prophesied</u>, saying:
- Acts 2:17 And it shall come to pass in the last days, says God, That I will pour out of My <u>Spirit</u> on all flesh; Your sons & your daughters shall <u>prophesy</u>, Your young men shall see visions, Your old men shall dream dreams.
- Acts 2:18 And on My menservants and on My maidservants I will pour out My Spirit in those days; And they shall prophesy.
- Acts 19:6 And when Paul had laid hands on them, the Holy <u>Spirit</u> came upon them, and they spoke with tongues and prophesied.
- 2 Corinthians 11:4 For if he who comes preaches another Jesus whom we have not preached, or if you receive a different spirit which you have not received, or a different gospel which you have not accepted, you may well put up with it!
- Acts 28:25 So when they did not agree among themselves, they departed after Paul had said one word: The Holy <u>Spirit</u> spoke rightly through Isaiah the <u>prophet</u> to our fathers,
- 1 Corinthians 12:10 to another the working of miracles, to another <u>prophecy</u>, to another discerning of <u>spirits</u>, to another *different* kinds of tongues, to another the interpretation of tongues.
- 1 Corinthians 12:31 But earnestly desire the best gifts. And yet I show you a more excellent way.
- 1 Corinthians 13:2 And though I have the gift of prophecy, and understand all

- mysteries and all knowledge, and though I have all faith, so that I could remove mountains, but have not love, I am nothing.
- 1 Corinthians 14:1 Pursue love, and desire <u>spiritual</u> *gifts*, but especially that you may <u>prophesy</u>.
- 1 Corinthians 14:32 & the spirits of the prophets are subject to the prophets.
- 2 Corinthians 10:5 Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;
- 1 Corinthians 14:37 If anyone thinks himself to be a <u>prophet</u> or <u>spiritual</u>, let him acknowledge that the things which I write to you are the commandments of the Lord.
- Ephesians 3:5 which in other ages was not made known to the sons of men, as it has now been revealed by the <u>Spirit</u> to His Holy apostles & <u>prophets</u>:
- Luke 12:48 But he who did not know, yet committed things deserving of stripes, shall be beaten with few. For everyone to whom much is given, from him much will be required; and to whom much has been committed, of him they will ask the more.
- 2 Peter 1:21 for <u>prophecy</u> never came by the will of man, but Holy men of God spoke *as they were* moved by the Holy <u>Spirit</u>.
- 1 John 4:1 Beloved, do not believe every <u>spirit</u>, but test the <u>spirits</u>, whether they are of God; because many false <u>prophets</u> have gone out into the world.
- Mark 16:17 And these signs will follow those who believe: In My name they will cast out demons; they will speak with new tongues;
- Matthew 7:15 Beware of false prophets, who come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravenous wolves.
- Revelation 16:13 And I saw three unclean <u>spirits</u> like frogs *coming* out of the mouth of the dragon, out of the mouth of the beast, and out of the mouth of the false prophet.
- Revelation 19:10 And I fell at his feet to worship him. But he said to me, See that you do not do that! I am your fellow servant, and of your brethren who have the testimony of Jesus. Worship God! For the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy.
- Ephesians 2:8,9 For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, 9 not of works, lest anyone should boast.
