- John 13:5 After that, He poured water into a basin and began to wash the disciples' feet, and to wipe them with the towel with which He was girded.
- John 13:35 By this all will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another.
- 2 Corinthians 9:7 So let each one give as he purposes in his heart, not grudgingly or of necessity; for God loves a cheerful giver.
- Romans 12:7 or ministry, *let us use it* in *our* ministering; he who teaches, in teaching;
- Summarized of many Biblical Doctrines excused away in modern churches.
- James 5:14 Is anyone among you sick? Let him call for the elders of the church, and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the Name of the Lord.
- John 16:7 Nevertheless I tell you the truth. It is to your advantage that I go away; for if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you; but if I depart, I will send Him to you.
- Genesis 3 Summarized of the fall of mankind.
- John 13:34,35 A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another; as I have loved you, that you also love one another. 35 By this all will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another.
- John 21:21 Peter seeing him said to Jesus, Lord, and what shall this man do? Romans 12:2 And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by
- the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.
- Romans 8:29 For whom He foreknew, He also predestined to be conformed to the Image of His Son, that He might be the firstborn among many brethren.
- Strongs #1248 diakonia dee-ak-on-ee'-ah AV-ministry 16, ministration 6, ministering 3, misc 9; 34 1) service, ministering, esp. of those who execute the commands of others 2) of those who by the command of God proclaim and promote religion among men 2a) of the office of Moses 2b) of the office of the apostles and its administration 2c) of the office of prophets, evangelists, elders etc. 3) the ministration of those who render to others the offices of Christian affection esp. those who help meet need by either collecting or distributing of charities 4) the office of the deacon in the church 5) the service of those who prepare and present food.
- Exodus 20 Summarized of the 10 Commandments. The first table was on their relationship with God. The second table was on their relationship with mankind.

- Matthew 5-7 The Beatitudes are Jesus' New Testament equivalent of the 10 Commandments.
- Isaiah 35:8 A highway shall be there, and a road, And it shall be called the Highway of Holiness. The unclean shall not pass over it, But it shall be for others. Whoever walks the road, although a fool, Shall not go astray.
- Luke 10:40 But Martha was distracted with much serving <1248>, and she approached Him and said, Lord, do You not care that my sister has left me to serve alone? Therefore tell her to help me. 42 But one thing is needed, and Mary has chosen that good part, which will not be taken away from her.
- Acts 1:17 for he was numbered with us and obtained a part in this ministry <1248>.
- Mark 16:17 And these signs will follow those who believe: In My Name they will cast out demons; they will speak with new tongues;
- Acts 19 Referred to 7 sons of Sceva false exorcists.
- Acts 1:25 to take part in this ministry <1248> and apostleship from which Judas by transgression fell, that he might go to his own place.
- Acts 9 Referred to Jesus calling Saul to be Paul the apostle.
- Acts 6:1 Now in those days, when *the number of* the disciples was multiplying, there arose a complaint against the Hebrews by the Hellenists (Greeks), because their widows were neglected in the daily distribution <1248>.
- Acts 4:34,35 Neither was there any among them that lacked: for as many as were possessors of lands or houses sold them, and brought the prices of the things that were sold, 35 And laid them down at the apostles' feet: and distribution was made unto every man according as he had need.
- Acts 6:4 but we will give ourselves continually to prayer and to the ministry <1248> of the Word.
- Acts 6:3 Therefore, brethren, seek out from among you seven men of good reputation, full of the Holy Spirit and wisdom, whom we may appoint over this business;
- Luke 18 Referred to the persistant widow. V1 Then He spoke a parable to them, that men always ought to pray and not lose heart,
- Deuteronomy 3:25,26 referred to when God tells Moses "No, & quit asking".
- 2 Corinthians 12:7-9 And lest I should be exalted above measure by the abundance of the revelations, a thorn in the flesh was given to me, a messenger of Satan to buffet me, lest I be exalted above measure. 8 Concerning this thing I pleaded with the Lord three times that it might depart from me. 9 And He said to me, My grace is sufficient for you, for My strength is made perfect in weakness. Therefore most gladly I will rather boast in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me.

- Acts 11:29 Then the disciples, each according to his ability, determined to send relief <1248> to the brethren dwelling in Judea.
- Acts 12:25 And Barnabas and Saul returned from Jerusalem when they had fulfilled *their* ministry <1248>, and they also took with them John whose surname was Mark.
- Acts 20:24 But none of these things move me; nor do I count my life dear to myself, so that I may finish my race with joy, and the ministry <1248> which I received from the Lord Jesus, to testify to the gospel of the grace of God.
- Acts 17:23 For as I passed by, and beheld your devotions, I found an altar with this inscription, TO THE UNKNOWN GOD. Whom therefore ye ignorantly worship, him declare I unto you.
- Acts 21:19 When he had greeted them, he told in detail those things which God had done among the Gentiles through his ministry <1248>.
- 1 Corinthians 6:19,20 What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own? 20 For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's.
- Acts 20:34 Yes, you yourselves know that these hands have provided for my necessities, and for those who were with me.
- Romans 11:13 For I speak to you Gentiles; inasmuch as I am an apostle to the Gentiles, I magnify my ministry <1248>,
- 2 Corinthians 11:30 If I must boast, I will boast in the things which concern my infirmity.
- Romans 12:7 or ministry <1248>, let us use it in our ministering <1248>; he who teaches, in teaching;
- Romans 15:31 that I may be delivered from those in Judea who do not believe, and that my service <1248> for Jerusalem may be acceptable to the saints,
- Romans 10:9,10 that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. 10 For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.
- 1 Corinthians 12:5 There are differences of ministries <1248>, but the same Lord.
- 1 Corinthians 12:4 There are diversities of gifts, but the same Spirit.1 Corinthians 16:15 I urge you, brethren you know the household of Stephanas, that it is the firstfruits of Achaia, and *that* they have devoted themselves to the ministry <1248> of the saints —
- 1 Corinthians 16:15 (AV) I beseech you, brethren, (ye know the house of Stephanas, that it is the firstfruits of Achaia, and that they have addicted

themselves to the ministry <1248> of the saints,)

- Strongs #5021 tasso *tas'-so* AV-appoint 3, ordain 2, set 1, determine 1, addict 1; 8 1) to put in order, to station 1a) to place in a certain order, to arrange, to assign a place, to appoint 1a1) to assign (appoint) a thing to one 1b) to appoint, ordain, order 1b1) to appoint on one's own responsibility or authority 1b2) to appoint mutually, i.e. agree upon.
- 2 Corinthians 3:7-9 But if the ministry <1248> of death, written and engraved on stones, was glorious, so that the children of Israel could not look steadily at the face of Moses because of the glory of his countenance, which glory was passing away, 8 how will the ministry <1248> of the Spirit not be more glorious?
- Matthew 23 Referred to Jesus cursing the religious leaders. V24 Ye blind guides, which strain at a gnat, and swallow a camel.

Referred to Jesus cleaning out the Temple twice.

- Mark 11:17 Then He taught, saying to them, Is it not written, My house shall be called a house of prayer for all nations? But you have made it a den of thieves.
- 2 Corinthians 3:9 For if the ministry <1248> of condemnation *had* glory, the ministry <1248> of righteousness exceeds much more in glory.
- 2 Corinthians 4:1 Therefore, since we have this ministry <1248>, as we have received mercy, we do not lose heart.
- 2 Corinthians 4:4 In whom the god of this world hath blinded the minds of them which believe not, lest the light of the glorious Gospel of Christ, Who is the Image of God, should shine unto them.
- Ephesians 6:12 For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places.
- 2 Corinthians 10:4 For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal but mighty in God for pulling down strongholds,
- Ezekiel 13:17-23 Likewise, son of man, set your face against the daughters of your people, who prophesy out of their own heart; prophesy against them, 18 and say, Thus says the Lord GOD: Woe to the women who sew magic charms on their sleeves and make veils for the heads of people of every height to hunt souls! Will you hunt the souls of My people, and keep yourselves alive? 19 And will you profane Me among My people for handfuls of barley and for pieces of bread, killing people who should not die, and keeping people alive who should not live, by your lying to My people who listen to lies? 20 Therefore thus says the Lord GOD: Behold, I am against your magic charms by which you hunt souls there like birds. I will tear them from your arms, and let the souls go, the souls you hunt like birds. 21 I will also tear off your veils and deliver My people out of your

hand, and they shall no longer be as prey in your hand. Then you shall know that I am the LORD. 22 Because with lies you have made the heart of the righteous sad, whom I have not made sad; and you have strengthened the hands of the wicked, so that he does not turn from his wicked way to save his life. 23 Therefore you shall no longer envision futility nor practice divination; for I will deliver My people out of your hand, and you shall know that I am the LORD.

- Ezekiel 45:8 In the land shall be his possession in Israel: and My princes shall no more oppress My people; and the rest of the land shall they give to the house of Israel according to their tribes.
- Proverbs 22:22,23 Rob not the poor, because he is poor: neither oppress the afflicted in the gate: 23 For the LORD will plead their cause, and spoil the soul of those that spoiled them.
- 1 Samuel 2:10 The adversaries of the LORD shall be broken to pieces; out of heaven shall He thunder upon them: the LORD shall judge the ends of the earth; and He shall give strength unto His king, and exalt the horn of His anointed.
- 1 John 2:1 My little children, these things I write to you, so that you may not sin. And if anyone sins, we have an Advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous.
- Romans 8:34 Who is he who condemns? It is Christ who died, and furthermore is also risen, who is even at the right hand of God, who also makes intercession for us.
- Hebrews 7:25 Wherefore He is able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by Him, seeing He ever liveth to make intercession for them.
- 2 Corinthians 5:18 Now all things *are* of God, who has reconciled us to Himself through Jesus Christ, and has given us the ministry <1248> of reconciliation.
- Revelation 3:20 Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears My voice and opens the door, I will come in to him and dine with him, and he with Me.
- 2 Corinthians 6:3 We give no offense in anything, that our ministry <1248> may not be blamed.
- 2 Corinthians 8:4 imploring us with much urgency that we would receive the gift and the fellowship of the ministering <1248> to the saints.
- 2 Corinthians 9:1 Now concerning the ministering <1248> to the saints, it is superfluous for me to write to you;
- James 2:15,16 If a brother or sister is naked and destitute of daily food, 16 and one of you says to them, Depart in peace, be warmed and filled, but you do not give them the things which are needed for the body, what does

- it profit?
- 2 Corinthians 9:12 For the administration <1248> of this service not only supplies the needs of the saints, but also is abounding through many thanksgivings to God,
- 2 Corinthians 9:13 while, through the proof of this ministry <1248>, they glorify God for the obedience of your confession to the gospel of Christ, and for *your* liberal sharing with them and all *men*,
- 2 Corinthians 11:8 I robbed other churches, taking wages *from them* to minister <1248> to you.
- 2 Corinthians 11 Referred to Paul's In Perils Chapter.
- Ephesians 4:12 for the equipping of the saints for the work of ministry <1248>, for the edifying of the body of Christ,
- Colossians 4:17 And say to Archippus, Take heed to the ministry <1248> which you have received in the Lord, that you may fulfill it.
- 1 Timothy 1:12 And I thank Christ Jesus our Lord Who has enabled me, because He counted me faithful, putting *me* into the ministry <1248>,
- 2 Timothy 4:5 But you be watchful in all things, endure afflictions, do the work of an evangelist, fulfill your ministry <1248>.
- 2 Timothy 1:6 Wherefore I put thee in remembrance that thou stir up the gift of God, which is in thee by the putting on of my hands.
- Luke 12:48 But he that knew not, and did commit things worthy of stripes, shall be beaten with few stripes. For unto whomsoever much is given, of him shall be much required: and to whom men have committed much, of him they will ask the more.
- 2 Timothy 4:11 Only Luke is with me. Get Mark and bring him with you, for he is useful to me for ministry <1248>.
- Acts 15:38 But Paul thought not good to take him (Mark) with them, who departed from them from Pamphylia, and went not with them to the work.
- Hebrews 1:14 Are they not all ministering spirits sent forth to minister <1248> for those who will inherit salvation?
- Revelation 2:19 I know your works, love, service <1248>, faith, and your patience; and as for your works, the last are more than the first.
- Hebrews 1:13,14 But to which of the angels said he at any time, Sit on my right hand, until I make thine enemies thy footstool? 14 Are they not all ministering spirits, sent forth to minister for them who shall be heirs of salvation?
