## **The Gift Of Teaching - Romans 12E**

- Acts 8:18,19 And when Simon saw that through laying on of the apostles' hands the Holy Ghost was given, he offered them money, 19 Saying, Give me also this power, that on whomsoever I lay hands, he may receive the Holy Ghost.
- Mark 16:17,18 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.
- 1 Corinthians 12 Referred to a similar chapter on the Gifts of the Holy Spirit.
- 1 John 3:8 He that committeth sin is of the devil; for the devil sinneth from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that He might destroy the works of the devil.
- Romans 1:17 For therein is the righteousness of God revealed from faith to faith: as it is written, The just shall live by faith.
- Romans 12:7 or ministry, let us use it in our ministering; he who teaches, in teaching;
- Ephesians 2:8,9 For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: 9 Not of works, lest any man should boast.
- John 10:28,29 And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of My hand. 29 My Father, which gave them Me, is greater than all; and no man is able to pluck them out of My Father's hand.
- Luke 24:45 Then opened He their understanding, that they might understand the Scriptures,
- James 1:22 But be doers of the Word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves.
- Ephesians 6:4 And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.
- Strongs#1321 didasko *did-as'-ko* AV-teach 93, taught + 2258 4; 97 1) to teach 1a) to hold discourse with others in order to instruct them, deliver didactic discourses 1b) to be a teacher 1c) to discharge the office of a teacher, conduct one's self as a teacher 2) to teach one 2a) to impart instruction 2b) instill doctrine into one 2c) the thing taught or enjoined 2d) to explain or expound a thing 2f) to teach one something.
- Strongs#1319 didaskalia *did-as-kal-ee'-ah* AV-doctrine 19, teaching 1, learning 1; 21 1) teaching, instruction 2) teaching 2a) that which is taught, doctrine 2b) teachings, precepts.
- Proverbs 10:17 He who keeps instruction is in the way of life, But he who

- refuses correction goes astray.
- Proverbs 4:5 Get wisdom, get understanding: forget it not; neither decline from the words of my mouth.
- Jeremiah 5:3 O LORD, *are* not Your eyes on the truth? You have stricken them, But they have not grieved; You have consumed them, But they have <u>refused to receive correction</u>. They have made their faces harder than rock; They have <u>refused</u> to return.
- Leviticus 26 Referred to God increasing judgment as Israel sinns more.
- Genesis 3 Referred to rebellion against Godly authority in the sin & fall of mankind.
- Hebrews 13:8 Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever.
- Exodus 4:12 Now therefore, go, and I will be with your mouth and <u>teach</u> you what you shall say.
- Exodus 4:15 Now you shall speak to him and put the words in his mouth. And I will be with your mouth and with his mouth, and I will <u>teach</u> you what you shall do.
- Exodus 4 Referred to God's 2 signs to Moses his staff to serpent & back & his hand made leprous & healed.
- Exodus 18:20 And you shall <u>teach them the statutes and the laws</u>, and show them the way in which they must walk and the work they must do.
- Exodus 20 Referred to the 10 Commandments God gave Moses to guide Israel.
- Exodus 24:12 Then the LORD said to Moses, Come up to Me on the mountain and be there; and I will give you tablets of stone, and the law and commandments which I have written, that you may <u>teach</u> them.
- Exodus 35:34 And He has put in his heart the <u>ability to teach</u>, *in* him and Aholiab the son of Ahisamach, of the tribe of Dan.
- Leviticus was written to guide the priests.
- Leviticus 10:11 and that you may <u>teach the children of Israel all the statutes</u> which the LORD has spoken to them by the hand of Moses.
- Leviticus 14:57 to <u>teach when *it is* unclean and when *it is* clean</u>. This *is* the law of leprosy.
- Acts 15:20 but that we write to them to abstain from things polluted by idols, from sexual immorality, from things strangled, and from blood.
- Romans 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.
- Deuteronomy 4:1 Now, O Israel, <u>listen to the statutes and the judgments</u> which I teach you to observe, that you may live, and go in and possess the land which the LORD God of your fathers is giving you.
- 2 Kings 23:24 Moreover the workers with familiar spirits, and the wizards, and the images, and the idols, and all the abominations that were spied in

- the land of Judah and in Jerusalem, did Josiah put away, that he might perform the Words of the Law which were written in the Book (Deuteronomy) that Hilkiah the priest found in the house of the LORD.
- Deuteronomy 4:9 Only take heed to yourself, and diligently keep yourself, lest you forget the things your eyes have seen, and lest they depart from your heart all the days of your life. And <u>teach them to your children and your grandchildren</u>,
- Exodus 16:4 Then said the LORD unto Moses, Behold, I will rain bread from heaven for you; and the people shall go out and gather a certain rate every day, that I may prove them, whether they will walk in My law, or no.
- Deuteronomy 4:10 *especially concerning* the day you stood before the LORD your God in Horeb, when the LORD said to me, Gather the people to Me, and I will let them hear My words, that they may learn to fear Me all the days they live on the earth, and *that* they may <u>teach</u> their children.
- Exodus 20:18,19 And all the people saw the thunderings, and the lightnings, and the noise of the trumpet, and the mountain smoking: and when the people saw it, they removed, and stood afar off. 19 And they said unto Moses, Speak thou with us, and we will hear: but let not God speak with us, lest we die.
- Genesis 3:10 And he said, I heard thy voice in the garden, and I was afraid, because I was naked; and I hid myself.
- Deuteronomy 4:14 And the LORD commanded me at that time to <u>teach you</u> <u>statutes and judgments</u>, that you might observe them in the land which you cross over to possess.
- Deuteronomy 5:31 But as for you, stand here by Me, and I will speak to you all the <u>commandments</u>, the statutes, and the judgments which you shall <u>teach them</u>, that they may observe *them* in the land which I am giving them to possess.
- Deuteronomy 6:1 Now this *is* the commandment, *and these are* the statutes and judgments which the <u>LORD your God has commanded to teach you</u>, that you may observe *them* in the land which you are crossing over to possess,
- Deuteronomy 6:7 You shall <u>teach them diligently to your children</u>, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, when you walk by the way, when you lie down, and when you rise up.
- Deuteronomy 11:19 You shall <u>teach them to your children</u>, speaking of them when you sit in your house, when you walk by the way, when you lie down, and when you rise up.
- Deuteronomy 20:18 <u>lest they teach you to do according to all their</u>
  <u>abominations which they have done for their gods, and you sin against the</u>
  LORD your God.
- Ephesians 6:4 And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring

- them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.
- Deuteronomy 24:8 Take heed in an outbreak of leprosy, that you carefully observe and do according to all that the <u>priests</u>, the <u>Levites</u>, shall teach you; just as I commanded them, so you shall be careful to do.
- Matthew 8:4 And Jesus saith unto him, See thou tell no man; but go thy way, shew thyself to the priest, and offer the gift that Moses commanded, for a testimony unto them.
- Deuteronomy 31:19 Now therefore, write down this song for yourselves, and <u>teach it to the children of Israel</u>; put it in their mouths, that this song may be a witness for Me against the children of Israel.
- Deuteronomy 32:2 Let my <u>teaching</u> drop as the rain, My speech distill as the dew, As raindrops on the tender herb, And as showers on the grass.
- Deuteronomy 33:10 <u>They shall teach Jacob Your judgments, And Israel Your law</u>. They shall put incense before You, And a whole burnt sacrifice on Your altar.
- Matthew 4:23 And <u>Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their</u>
  <u>synagogues, preaching the gospel of the kingdom</u>, and healing all kinds of sickness and all kinds of disease among the people.
- Mark 7:13 Making the Word of God of none effect through your tradition, which ye have delivered: and many such like things do ye.
- Mark 12:24 And Jesus answering said unto them, Do ye not therefore err, because ye know not the scriptures, neither the power of God?
- John 15:24 If I had not done among them the works which none other man did, they had not had sin: but now have they both seen and hated both Me and My Father.
- Matthew 5:19 Whoever therefore breaks one of the least of these commandments, and <u>teaches</u> men so, shall be called least in the kingdom of heaven; but whoever does and <u>teaches</u> them, he shall be called great in the kingdom of heaven.
- 1 Samuel 2 Summarized of the sins of Eli's sons the priests.
- Matthew 7:28 And so it was, when Jesus had ended these sayings, that the <u>people were astonished at His teaching</u>,
- Matthew 9:35 Then Jesus went about all the cities and villages, <u>teaching in</u> <u>their synagogues</u>, <u>preaching the gospel of the kingdom</u>, and healing every sickness and every disease among the people.
- Matthew 11:1 Now it came to pass, when Jesus finished commanding His twelve disciples, that He departed from there to <u>teach and to preach in their cities</u>.
- Matthew 15:9 And in vain they worship Me, <u>Teaching as doctrines the</u> <u>commandments of men</u>.
- Matthew 7:21 Not every one that saith unto Me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of My Father which is in

heaven.

- Matthew 21:23 Now when He came into the temple, the chief priests and the elders of the people confronted Him as <u>He was teaching</u>, and said, By what authority are You doing these things? And who gave You this authority?
- Matthew 22:33 And when the multitudes heard *this*, they were <u>astonished at His teaching</u>.
- Matthew 26:55 In that hour Jesus said to the multitudes, Have you come out, as against a robber, with swords and clubs to take Me? <u>I sat daily with you, teaching in the temple</u>, and you did not seize Me.
- Luke 22:2 And the chief priests and scribes sought how they might kill him; for they feared the people.
- Matthew 28:20 <u>teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you</u>; and lo, I am with you always, *even* to the end of the age. Amen.
- Mark 16:17,18 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.
- Mark 1:22 And they were <u>astonished at His teaching</u>, for He taught them as <u>one having authority</u>, and not as the scribes.
- Mark 4:1 And again <u>He began to teach</u> by the sea. And a great multitude was gathered to Him, so that He got into a boat and sat *in it* on the sea; and the whole multitude was on the land facing the sea.
- Mark 4:2 Then He taught them many things by parables, and said to them in <u>His teaching</u>:
- Referred to many parables Jesus used to teach the people.
- Mark 6:2 And when the Sabbath had come, <u>He began to teach in the</u>
  <u>synagogue</u>. And many hearing *Him* were astonished, saying, Where *did* this
  Man *get* these things? And what wisdom *is* this which is given to Him, that
  such mighty works are performed by His hands!
- Mark 6:6 And He marveled because of their unbelief. Then He went about the villages in a circuit, <u>teaching</u>.
- Mark 6:5 And He could there do no mighty work, save that he laid his hands upon a few sick folk, and healed them.
- Mark 6:34 And Jesus, when He came out, saw a great multitude and was moved with compassion for them, because they were like sheep not having a shepherd. So He began to teach them many things.
- Mark 7:7 And in vain they worship Me, <u>Teaching as doctrines the</u> commandments of men.
- Mark 8:31 And He began to <u>teach</u> them that the Son of Man must suffer many things, and be rejected by the elders and chief priests and scribes, and be killed, and after three days rise again.

- Mark 11:18 And the scribes and chief priests heard it and sought how they might destroy Him; for they feared Him, because all the <u>people were</u> astonished at His teaching.
- Mark 12:38 Then He said to them in <u>His teaching</u>, Beware of the scribes, who desire to go around in long robes, *love* greetings in the marketplaces,
- Mark 14:49 I was daily with you in the temple teaching, and you did not seize Me. But the Scriptures must be fulfilled.
- Luke 4:31 Then He went down to Capernaum, a city of Galilee, and was <u>teaching them on the Sabbaths</u>.
- Luke 4:32 And they were astonished at His teaching, for His Word was with authority.
- Referred to Jesus quoting Isaiah 61.
- Luke 11:1 Now it came to pass, as He was praying in a certain place, when He ceased, *that* one of His disciples said to Him, <u>Lord, teach us to pray</u>, as John also taught his disciples.
- Luke 12:12 For the <u>Holy Spirit will teach you</u> in that very hour what you ought to say.
- Luke 13:10 Now He was teaching in one of the synagogues on the Sabbath.
- Luke 13:22 And He went through the cities and villages, <u>teaching</u>, and journeying toward Jerusalem.
- Luke 19:47 And <u>He was teaching daily in the temple</u>. But the chief priests, the scribes, and the leaders of the people sought to destroy Him,
- Luke 21:37 And in the daytime He was teaching in the temple, but at night He went out and stayed on the mountain called Olivet. (to Pray with God)
- Luke 23:5 But they were the more fierce, saying, He stirs up the people, <u>teaching</u> throughout all Judea, beginning from Galilee to this place.
- John 7:35 Then the Jews said among themselves, Where does He intend to go that we shall not find Him? Does He intend to go to the Dispersion among the Greeks and <u>teach</u> the Greeks?
- John 4 Referred to Jesus teaching the woman at the well.
- John 9:34 They answered and said to him, You were completely born in sins, and are you <u>teaching</u> us? And they cast him out.
- John 14:26 But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, Whom the Father will send in My Name, He will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all things that I said to you.
- Mark 16:15 And He said to them, Go into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature.
