- Eben-ezer Easton's BD Stone of help, the memorial stone set up by Samuel to commemorate the divine assistance to Israel in their great battle against the Philistines, whom they totally routed 1Sa 7:7-12 at Aphek, in the neighbourhood of Mizpeh, in Benjamin, near the western entrance of the pass of Beth-horon. On this very battle-field, twenty years before, the Philistines routed the Israelites, and slew of the army in the field about

four thousand men <u>1Sam 4:1,2</u> here, and at 1Sam 5:1 called Eben-ezer by anticipation). In this extremity the Israelites fetched the ark out of Shiloh and carried it into their camp. The Philistines a second time immediately attacked them, and smote them with a very great slaughter, for there fell of Israel thirty thousand footmen. And the ark of God was taken 1Sam 4:10 And now in the same place the Philistines are vanquished, and the memorial stone is erected by Samuel (q.v.). The spot where the stone was erected was somewhere between Mizpeh and Shen. Some have identified it with the modern Beit Iksa, a conspicuous and prominent position, apparently answering all the necessary conditions; others with Dier Aban, 3 miles east of 'Ain Shems.

- Aphek Concise BD 1. Royal city of the Canaanites, the king of which was killed by Joshua, Jos 12:18: probably the same as APHEKAH in Jos 15:53. Not identified. 2. City in the north border of Asher, from which in the time of Joshua the inhabitants were not expelled. Jos 13:4; 19:30: called APHIK in Jud 1:31. Identified with *Afka* at the foot of the Lebanon between Baalbek and Byblus. 3. Place where the Philistines encamped when Israel was defeated. 1Sam 4:1,4. Where the Philistines encamped when Saul and Jonathan were killed, 1Sam 29:1. Perhaps the same as No. 3. 5. City, the wall of which falling killed 27,000 of the Syrians, 1Ki 20:26,30; 2Ki 13:17. It is identitied with *Fik*, 32° 47' N, 35° 41' E, on the great road between Damascus and Jerusalem.
- 1 Samuel 4:2 (AV) And the Philistines put themselves in array against Israel: and when they joined battle, Israel was smitten before the Philistines: and they slew of the army in the field about four thousand men.
- 1 Samuel 4:2 (NKJV) Then the Philistines put themselves in battle array against Israel. And when they joined battle, Israel was defeated by the Philistines, who killed about four thousand men of the army in the field.
- 1 Samuel 17 Referred to David versus Goliath.
- Joshua 7 Referred to Israel defeated in Ai because sin was in the camp.
- 1 Peter 5:8 Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour:
- 1 Samuel 4:3 (AV) And when the people were come into the camp, the elders of Israel said, Wherefore hath the LORD smitten us to day before the Philistines? Let us fetch the ark of the covenant of the LORD out of Shiloh unto us, that, when it cometh among us, it may save us out of the hand of our enemies.
- 1 Samuel 4:3 (NKJV) And when the people had come into the camp, the elders of Israel said, Why has the LORD defeated us today before the Philistines? Let us bring the ark of the covenant of the LORD from Shiloh to us, that when it comes among us it may save us from the hand of our enemies.

Referred to Nebuchadnezzar taking out Jerusalem.

Joshua 7 Referred to Joshua seeking the Lord when defeated at Ai.

- 1 Samuel 4:4 (AV) So the people sent to Shiloh, that they might bring from thence the ark of the covenant of the LORD of hosts, which dwelleth between the cherubims: and the two sons of Eli, Hophni and Phinehas, were there with the ark of the covenant of God.
- 1 Samuel 4:4 (NKJV) So the people sent to Shiloh, that they might bring from there the ark of the covenant of the LORD of hosts, who dwells *between* the cherubim. And the two sons of Eli, Hophni and Phinehas, *were* there with the ark of the covenant of God.

- 1 Samuel 4:6 (NKJV) Now when the Philistines heard the noise of the shout, they said, What *does* the sound of this great shout in the camp of the Hebrews *mean*? Then they understood that the ark of the LORD had come into the camp.
- 1 Samuel 4:7 (AV) And the Philistines were afraid, for they said, God is come into the camp. And they said, Woe unto us! for there hath not been such a thing heretofore.
- 1 Samuel 4:7 (NKJV) So the Philistines were afraid, for they said, God has come into the camp! And they said, Woe to us! For such a thing has never happened before.
- 1 Chronicles 13:10 And the anger of the LORD was kindled against Uzza, and He smote him, because he put his hand to the ark: and there he died before God.
- 2 Kings 19 Referred to Sennacherib challenging God & his defeat.
- 1 Samuel 17:45 Then said David to the Philistine, Thou comest to me with a

- sword, & with a spear, & with a shield: but I come to thee in the Name of the LORD of hosts, the God of the armies of Israel, Whom thou hast defied.
- 1 Samuel 4:8 (AV) Woe unto us! who shall deliver us out of the hand of these mighty Gods? these *are* the Gods that smote the Egyptians with all the plagues in the wilderness.
- 1 Samuel 4:8 (NKJV) Woe to us! Who will deliver us from the hand of these mighty gods? These *are* the gods who struck the Egyptians with all the plagues in the wilderness.
- 1 Samuel 4:9 (AV) Be strong, and quit yourselves like men, O ye Philistines, that ye be not servants unto the Hebrews, as they have been to you: quit yourselves like men, and fight.
- 1 Samuel 4:9 (NKJV) Be strong and conduct yourselves like men, you Philistines, that you do not become servants of the Hebrews, as they have been to you. Conduct yourselves like men, and fight!
- Joshua 10:25 And Joshua said unto them, Fear not, nor be dismayed, be strong and of good courage: for thus shall the LORD do to all your enemies against whom ye fight.
- Joshua 1:6 Be strong and of a good courage: for unto this people shalt thou divide for an inheritance the land, which I sware unto their fathers to give them.
- Judges 4 Summarized of Barak & Deborah.

- 1 Samuel 4:17 (AV) And the messenger answered and said, Israel is fled before the Philistines, and there hath been also a great slaughter among the people, and thy two sons also, Hophni and Phinehas, are dead, and the ark of God is taken.
- 1 Samuel 4:17 (NKJV) So the messenger answered and said, Israel has fled before the Philistines, and there has been a great slaughter among the people. Also your two sons, Hophni and Phinehas, are dead; and the ark of God has been captured.
- 1 Chronicles 10:13 So Saul died for his transgression which he committed against the LORD, even against the Word of the LORD, which he kept not, and also for asking counsel of one that had a familiar spirit, to enquire of it;

- Referred to the Judges of Israelites turning from God & being judged, then repenting & God freeing them, etc.
- Acts 5 Referred to God killing Ananias & Sapphirah for lying to the Holy Spirit.
- 1 Samuel 4:18 (AV) And it came to pass, when he made mention of the ark of God, that he fell from off the seat backward by the side of the gate, and his neck brake, and he died: for he was an old man, and heavy. And he had judged Israel forty years.
- 1 Samuel 4:18 (NKJV) Then it happened, when he made mention of the ark of God, that Eli fell off the seat backward by the side of the gate; and his neck was broken and he died, for the man was old and heavy. And he had judged Israel forty years.
- 1 Samuel 2:34 And this shall be a sign unto thee, that shall come upon thy two sons, on Hophni and Phinehas; in one day they shall die both of them.
- 1 Samuel 2:29 Wherefore kick ye at My sacrifice and at Mine offering, which I have commanded in My habitation; and honourest thy sons above Me, to make yourselves fat with the chiefest of all the offerings of Israel My people?
- Matthew 10:37 He that loveth father or mother more than Me is not worthy of Me: and he that loveth son or daughter more than Me is not worthy of Me.

- 1 samuel 25 Summarized of Abigail & Nabal (Fool).
- 1 Corinthians 15:33 Do not be deceived: Evil company corrupts good habits.
- 1 Samuel 4:20 (AV) And about the time of her death the women that stood by her said unto her, Fear not; for thou hast born a son. But she answered

- not, neither did she regard it.
- 1 Samuel 4:20 (NKJV) And about the time of her death the women who stood by her said to her, Do not fear, for you have borne a son. But she did not answer, nor did she regard *it*.
- 1 Samuel 4:21 (AV) And she named the child Ichabod, saying, The glory is departed from Israel: because the ark of God was taken, and because of her father in law and her husband.
- 1 Samuel 4:21 (NKJV) Then she named the child Ichabod, saying, <u>The glory has departed from Israel!</u> because the ark of God had been captured and because of her father-in-law and her husband.
- John 14:17 Even the Spirit of truth; Whom the world cannot receive, because it seeth Him not, neither knoweth Him: but ye know Him; for He dwelleth with you, and shall be in you.
- Ephesians 4:30 And grieve not the Holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption.
