The Gift Of Exhortation - Romans 12F

- John 16:23 And in that day ye shall ask Me nothing. Verily, verily, I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall ask the Father in My Name, He will give it you.
- 2 Corinthians 12:9 And He said unto me, My grace is sufficient for thee: for My strength is made perfect in weakness. Most gladly therefore will I rather glory in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me.
- 1 Corinthians 12 Referred to the similar chapter on the Gifts of the Holy Spirit.
- Acts 8:9,21 But there was a certain man, called Simon, which beforetime in the same city used sorcery, and bewitched the people of Samaria, giving out that himself was some great one: 21 Thou hast neither part nor lot in this matter: for thy heart is not right in the sight of God.
- Ephesians 1:13 In Whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the Word of Truth, the Gospel of your salvation: in Whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that Holy Spirit of promise,
- Romans 12:8 he who exhorts, in exhortation; he who gives, with liberality; he who leads, with diligence; he who shows mercy, with cheerfulness.
- Summarized of Jesus having compassion on those who came to Him for help. Matthew 23 Referred to Jesus' 8 Woes (curses) on the religious leaders.
- Matthew 18:18 Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.
- Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;

- Numbers 14:22 Because all those men which have seen My glory, and My miracles, which I did in Egypt and in the wilderness, and have tempted Me now these ten times, and have not hearkened to My voice;

- Galatians 6:1 Brethren, if a man be overtaken in a fault, ye which are spiritual, restore such an one in the spirit of meekness; considering thyself, lest thou also be tempted.

- Jeremiah 23:1 Woe be unto the pastors that destroy and scatter the sheep of My pasture! saith the LORD.
- Ezekiel 34:2 Son of man, prophesy against the shepherds of Israel, prophesy, and say unto them, Thus saith the Lord GOD unto the shepherds; Woe be

to the shepherds of Israel that do feed themselves! should not the shepherds feed the flocks?

Referred to the warnings of God to the pastors who afflict the flock.

Luke 3:18 And with many other exhortations He preached to the people.

Luke 1 Summarized of John the Baptist's miraculous birth.

Acts 2:40 And with many other words he testified and <u>exhorted</u> them, saying, Be saved from this perverse generation.

Referred to some of Peter's failings & forgiveness by Jesus.

Acts 13:15 And after the reading of the Law and the Prophets, the rulers of the synagogue sent to them, saying, Men *and* brethren, if you have any word of <u>exhortation</u> for the people, say on.

Acts 13:46 Then Paul and Barnabas waxed bold, and said, It was necessary that the Word of God should first have been spoken to you: but seeing ye put it from you (Jews), and judge yourselves unworthy of everlasting life, lo, we turn to the Gentiles.

Matthew quotes of Old Testament prophesy fulfilled in Jesus.

Acts 14:22 strengthening the souls of the disciples, <u>exhorting</u> them to continue in the faith, and saying, We must through many tribulations enter the kingdom of God.

Hebrews 11 Referred to God's Hall of Faith.

John 15:20 Remember the Word that I said unto you, The servant is not greater than his lord. If they have persecuted Me, they will also persecute you; if they have kept My saying, they will keep yours also.

John 17:15 I pray not that thou shouldest take them out of the world, but that thou shouldest keep them from the evil.

Matthew 24:12 And because iniquity shall abound, the love of many shall wax cold.

Acts 15:32 Now Judas and Silas, themselves being prophets also, <u>exhorted</u> and strengthened the brethren with many words.

Acts 18:27 And when he desired to cross to Achaia, the brethren wrote, exhorting the disciples to receive him; and when he arrived, he greatly helped those who had believed through grace;

- Acts 18:26 And he began to speak boldly in the synagogue: whom when Aquila and Priscilla had heard, they took him unto them, and expounded unto him the way of God more perfectly.
- Acts 9:26,27 And when Saul was come to Jerusalem, he assayed to join himself to the disciples: but they were all afraid of him, and believed not that he was a disciple. 27 But Barnabas took him, and brought him to the apostles, and declared unto them how he had seen the Lord in the way, and that he had spoken to him, and how he had preached boldly at Damascus in the name of Jesus.
- Romans 12:8 he who <u>exhorts</u>, in <u>exhortation</u>; he who gives, with liberality; he who leads, with diligence; he who shows mercy, with cheerfulness.
- 1 Corinthians 14:3,4 But he who prophesies speaks edification and exhortation and comfort to men. 4 He that speaketh in an unknown tongue edifieth himself; but he that prophesieth edifieth the church.
- 1 Corinthians 14:29 Let the prophets speak two or three, and let the other judge.
- 1 Kings 22:22 And the LORD said unto him, Wherewith? And he said, I will go forth, and I will be a lying spirit in the mouth of all his prophets. And he said, Thou shalt persuade him, and prevail also: go forth, and do so.
- 2 Corinthians 11:15 Therefore it is no great thing if his (satan's) ministers also be transformed as the ministers of righteousness; whose end shall be according to their works.
- 2 Corinthians 8:17 For he not only accepted the <u>exhortation</u>, but being more diligent, he went to you of his own accord.
- 2 Corinthians 9:5 Therefore I thought it necessary to <u>exhort</u> the brethren to go to you ahead of time, and prepare your generous gift beforehand, which *you had* previously promised, that it may be ready as *a matter of* generosity and not as a grudging obligation.
- 1 Corinthians 16:2 Upon the first day of the week let every one of you lay by him in store, as God hath prospered him, that there be no gatherings when I come.
- 2 Corinthians 9:7 Every man according as he purposeth in his heart, so let him give; not grudgingly, or of necessity: for God loveth a cheerful giver.
- 1 Thessalonians 2:3 For our <u>exhortation</u> *did* not *come* from error or uncleanness, nor *was it* in deceit.
- Matthew 7:15 Beware of false prophets, which come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravening wolves.
- 1 Thessalonians 2:11 as you know how we <u>exhorted</u>, and comforted, and charged every one of you, as a father *does* his own children,
- 1 Thessalonians 4:1 Finally then, brethren, we urge and exhort in the Lord

- Jesus that you should abound more and more, just as you received from us how you ought to walk and to please God;
- Acts 9:31 Then the churches throughout all Judea, Galilee, and Samaria had peace and were edified. And walking in the fear of the Lord and in the comfort of the Holy Spirit, they were multiplied.
- Acts 20:34 Yea, ye yourselves know, that these hands have ministered unto my necessities, and to them that were with me.
- 1 Thessalonians 5:14 Now we <u>exhort</u> you, brethren, warn those who are unruly, comfort the fainthearted, uphold the weak, be patient with all.
- 1 Corinthians 14:40 Let all things be done decently and in order.
- Galatians 5 Referred to the fruit of the Spirit.
- 2 Thessalonians 3:12 Now those who are such we command and <u>exhort</u> through our Lord Jesus Christ that they work in quietness and eat their own bread.
- 1 Timothy 2:1,2 Therefore I <u>exhort</u> first of all that supplications, prayers, intercessions, *and* giving of thanks be made for all men, 2 For kings, and for all that are in authority; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty.
- Matthew 16:19 And I will give unto thee the keys of the kingdom of heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.
- Mark 3:27 No man can enter into a strong man's house, and spoil his goods, except he will first bind the strong man; and then he will spoil his house.
- 1 Timothy 4:13 Till I come, give attention to reading, to <u>exhortation</u>, to doctrine.
- Jude Referred to Judes admonition against those with false doctrine.
- 1 Timothy 5:1 Do not rebuke an older man, but <u>exhort</u> *him* as a father, younger men as brothers,
- 1 Timothy 5:19 Against an elder receive not an accusation, but before two or three witnesses.
- 1 Timothy 6:2 And those who have believing masters, let them not despise *them* because they are brethren, but rather serve *them* because those who are benefited are believers and beloved. Teach and <u>exhort</u> these things.
- 2 Timothy 4:2 Preach the Word! Be ready in season *and* out of season. Convince, rebuke, <u>exhort</u>, with all longsuffering and teaching.
- Deuteronomy 18:9-14 When thou art come into the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee, thou shalt not learn to do after the abominations of those nations. ...
- Jeremiah 3:15 And I will give you pastors according to mine heart, which

- shall feed you with knowledge and understanding.
- Titus 1:9 holding fast the faithful Word as he has been taught, that he may be able, by sound doctrine, both to exhort and convict those who contradict.
- Titus 3:10 A man that is an heretick after the first and second admonition reject;
- Titus 2:6 Likewise exhort the young men to be sober-minded,
- Titus 2:9 <u>Exhort</u> bondservants to be obedient to their own masters, to be well pleasing in all *things*, not answering back,
- Colossians 3:23 And whatsoever ye do, do it heartily, as to the Lord, and not unto men;
- Titus 2:15 Speak these things, <u>exhort</u>, and rebuke with all authority. Let no one despise you.
- Hebrews 3:13 but <u>exhort</u> one another daily, while it is called Today, lest any of you be hardened through the deceitfulness of sin.
- Hebrews 10:25 not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as *is* the manner of some, but <u>exhorting</u> *one another*, and so much the more as you see the Day approaching.
- Matthew 18:20 For where two or three are gathered together in My Name, there am I in the midst of them.
- Hebrews 12:5 And you have forgotten the <u>exhortation</u> which speaks to you as to sons: My son, do not despise the chastening of the LORD, Nor be discouraged when you are rebuked by Him;
- Hebrews 13:22 And I appeal to you, brethren, bear with the word of <u>exhortation</u>, for I have written to you in few words.
- 1 Peter 5:1 The elders who are among you I <u>exhort</u>, I who am a fellow elder and a witness of the sufferings of Christ, and also a partaker of the glory that will be revealed:
- 1 Peter 5:12 By Silvanus, our faithful brother as I consider him, I have written to you briefly, <u>exhorting</u> and testifying that this is the true grace of God in which you stand.
- Jude 1:3 Beloved, while I was very diligent to write to you concerning our common salvation, I found it necessary to write to you <u>exhorting you to contend earnestly for the faith</u> which was once for all delivered to the saints.
