

## **The Gift Of Giving - Romans 12G**

**Matthew 4:23-25** And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing all manner of sickness and all manner of disease among the people. 24 And His fame went throughout all Syria: and they brought unto Him all sick people that were taken with divers diseases and torments, and those which were possessed with devils, and those which were lunatick, and those that had the palsy; and He healed them. 25 And there followed Him great multitudes of people from Galilee, and from Decapolis, and from Jerusalem, and from Judaea, and from beyond Jordan.

**Matthew 10:16** Behold, I send you forth as sheep in the midst of wolves: be ye therefore wise as serpents, and harmless as doves.

**Romans 12:8** he who exhorts, in exhortation; he who gives, with liberality; he who leads, with diligence; he who shows mercy, with cheerfulness.

**John 3:16** For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.

**Ephesians 1:7** In Whom we have redemption through His Blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His grace;

**John 16:7** Nevertheless I tell you the truth; It is expedient for you that I go away: for if I go not away, the Comforter will not come unto you; but if I depart, I will send Him unto you.

**Matthew 5:45** That ye may be the children of your Father which is in heaven: for he maketh his sun to rise on the evil and on the good, and sendeth rain on the just and on the unjust.

**Matthew 10** Referred to blind Bartimaeus begging & following Jesus when He came by.

**Acts 20:35** I have shown you in every way, by laboring like this, that you must support the weak. And remember the Words of the Lord Jesus, that He said, It is more blessed to give than to receive.

**2 Corinthians 9:7** So let each one give as he purposes in his heart, not grudgingly or of necessity; for God loves a cheerful giver.

**Matthew 10:8** Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out demons. Freely you have received, freely give.

**Matthew 8:4** And Jesus saith unto him, See thou tell no man; but go thy way, shew thyself to the priest, and offer the gift that Moses commanded, for a testimony unto them.

**Ezekiel 13:19** And will ye pollute me among my people for handfuls of barley

**and for pieces of bread, to slay the souls that should not die, and to save the souls alive that should not live, by your lying to my people that hear your lies?**

**Mark 16:17,18 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.**

**Matthew 6:13 And do not lead us into temptation, But deliver us from the evil one. For Yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. Amen.**

**Luke 21:2-4 And he saw also a certain poor widow casting in thither two mites. 3 And he said, Of a truth I say unto you, that this poor widow hath cast in more than they all: 4 For all these have of their abundance cast in unto the offerings of God: but she of her penury hath cast in all the living that she had.**

**Matthew 7:15 Beware of false prophets, which come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravening wolves.**

**Strong's #3330 metadidomi *met-ad-id'-o-mee* AV-impart 3, give 2; 5 1) to impart.**

**Strong's #572 haplotēs *hap-lot'-ace* AV-simplicity 3, singleness 2, liberality 1, bountifulness 1, liberty 1; 8 1) singleness, simplicity, sincerity, mental honesty 1a) the virtue of one who is free from pretence and hypocrisy 2) not self seeking, openness of heart manifesting itself by generosity.**

**Luke 3:11 He answered and said to them, He who has two tunics, let him give <3330> to him who has none; and he who has food, let him do likewise.**

**Romans 1:11 For I long to see you, that I may impart <3330> to you some spiritual gift, so that you may be established —**

**Acts 20:34 Yea, ye yourselves know, that these hands have ministered unto my necessities, and to them that were with me.**

**Romans 12:8 he who exhorts, in exhortation; he who gives <3330>, with liberality; he who leads, with diligence; he who shows mercy, with cheerfulness.**

**Ephesians 4:28 Let him who stole steal no longer, but rather let him labor, working with *his* hands what is good, that he may have something to give <3330> him who has need.**

**Exodus 20:15 Thou shalt not steal.**

**Colossians 3:23 And whatsoever ye do, do it heartily, as to the Lord, and not unto men;**

**1 Thessalonians 2:8 So, affectionately longing for you, we were well pleased to impart <3330> to you not only the Gospel of God, but also our own lives, because you had become dear to us.**

**Acts 23:16** And when Paul's sister's son heard of their lying in wait, he went and entered into the castle, and told Paul.

**Romans 12:8** he who exhorts, in exhortation; he who gives, with liberality <572>; he who leads, with diligence; he who shows mercy, with cheerfulness.

**2 Corinthians 1:12** For our boasting is this: the testimony of our conscience that we conducted ourselves in the world in simplicity <572> and godly sincerity, not with fleshly wisdom but by the grace of God, and more abundantly toward you.

**Matthew 11:29** Take My yoke upon you, and learn of me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls.

**2 Corinthians 8:2** that in a great trial of affliction the abundance of their joy and their deep poverty abounded in the riches of their liberality <572>.

**Nehemiah 8:10** Then he said to them, Go your way, eat the fat, drink the sweet, and send portions to those for whom nothing is prepared; for this day is holy to our LORD. Do not sorrow, for the joy of the LORD is your strength.

**2 Corinthians 12:9** And He said to me, My grace is sufficient for you, for My strength is made perfect in weakness. Therefore most gladly I will rather boast in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me.

**2 Corinthians 9:11** while *you are* enriched in everything for all liberality <572>, which causes thanksgiving through us to God.

Referred to Job helping the less fortunate.

**2 Corinthians 9:13** while, through the proof of this ministry, they glorify God for the obedience of your confession to the Gospel of Christ, and for *your* liberal <572> sharing with them and all *men*,

**2 Corinthians 11:3** But I fear, lest somehow, as the serpent deceived Eve by his craftiness, so your minds may be corrupted from the simplicity <572> that is in Christ.

Summarized some modern deceptions.

**John 10:28,29** And I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; neither shall anyone snatch them out of My hand. 29 My Father, who has given them to Me, is greater than all; and no one is able to snatch them out of My Father's hand.

**Romans 10:9,10** that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. 10 For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

**Luke 24:45** Then opened he their understanding, that they might understand the Scriptures,

**James 1:23,24** For if anyone is a hearer of the Word and not a doer, he is like

**a man observing his natural face in a mirror; 24 for he observes himself, goes away, and immediately forgets what kind of man he was.**

**Ephesians 6:5 Bondservants, be obedient to those who are your masters according to the flesh, with fear and trembling, in sincerity <572> of heart, as to Christ;**

**Matthew 10:37 He who loves father or mother more than Me is not worthy of Me. And he who loves son or daughter more than Me is not worthy of Me.**

**1 Corinthians 10:27,28 If any of those who do not believe invites you to dinner, and you desire to go, eat whatever is set before you, asking no question for conscience' sake. 28 But if anyone says to you, This was offered to idols, do not eat it for the sake of the one who told you, and for conscience' sake; for the earth is the LORD'S, and all its fullness.**

**1 Corinthians 10:14 Wherefore, my dearly beloved, flee from idolatry.**

**Colossians 3:22 Bondservants, obey in all things your masters according to the flesh, not with eyeservice, as men-pleasers, but in sincerity <572> of heart, fearing God.**

**Matthew 5:42 Give to him who asks you, and from him who wants to borrow from you do not turn away.**

**Matthew 6:11 Give us this day our daily bread.**

**Leviticus 19:13 Thou shalt not defraud thy neighbour, neither rob him: the wages of him that is hired shall not abide with thee all night until the morning.**

**Matthew 7:6 Do not give what is holy to the dogs; nor cast your pearls before swine, lest they trample them under their feet, and turn and tear you in pieces.**

**Jeremiah 24:7 And I will give them an heart to know Me, that I am the LORD: and they shall be My people, and I will be their God: for they shall return unto Me with their whole heart.**

**Matthew 7:7 Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you.**

**Revelation 3:8 I know your works. See, I have set before you an open door, and no one can shut it; for you have a little strength, have kept My word, and have not denied My name.**

**Matthew 7:9 Or what man is there among you who, if his son asks for bread, will give him a stone?**

**Matthew 7:11 If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father who is in heaven give good things to those who ask Him!**

**Matthew 6:8 Be not ye therefore like unto them: for your Father knoweth what things ye have need of, before ye ask him.**

**Deuteronomy 3:25-26 I pray, let me cross over and see the good land beyond**

the Jordan, those pleasant mountains, and Lebanon. 26 But the LORD was angry with me on your account, and would not listen to me. So the LORD said to me: Enough of that! Speak no more to Me of this matter.

**Matthew 9:8** Now when the multitudes saw *it*, they marveled and glorified God, who had given such power to men.

**Matthew 10:8** Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out demons. Freely you have received, freely give.

**Matthew 10:19** But when they deliver you up, do not worry about how or what you should speak. For it will be given to you in that hour what you should speak;

**Matthew 10:42** And whoever gives one of these little ones only a cup of cold *water* in the name of a disciple, assuredly, I say to you, he shall by no means lose his reward.

**Matthew 11:28** Come to Me, all *you* who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.

**Matthew 13:11,12** He answered and said to them, Because it has been given to you to know the mysteries of the kingdom of heaven, but to them it has not been given.

**Matthew 13:12** For whoever has, to him more will be given, and he will have abundance; but whoever does not have, even what he has will be taken away from him.

**Matthew 14:16** But Jesus said to them, They do not need to go away. You give them something to eat.

**Matthew 16:4** A wicked and adulterous generation seeks after a sign, and no sign shall be given to it except the sign of the prophet Jonah. And He left them and departed.

**Matthew 16:19** And I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven, and whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven.

**Mark 16:17,18** And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.

**Luke 10:19** Behold, I give you the authority to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

**More Service Notes:**

**Matthew 16:26** For what profit is it to a man if he gains the whole world, and loses his own soul? Or what will a man give in exchange for his soul?

**Matthew 17:27** Nevertheless, lest we offend them, go to the sea, cast in a hook, and take the fish that comes up first. And when you have opened its

mouth, you will find a piece of money; take that and give it to them for Me and you.

Matthew 19:11 But He said to them, All cannot accept this saying, but only *those* to whom it has been given:

Matthew 19:21 Jesus said to him, If you want to be perfect, go, sell what you have and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven; and come, follow Me.

Matthew 20:4 and said to them, You also go into the vineyard, and whatever is right I will give you. So they went.

Matthew 20:8 So when evening had come, the owner of the vineyard said to his steward, Call the laborers and give them *their* wages, beginning with the last to the first.

Matthew 20:14 Take *what is yours* and go your way. I wish to give to this last man *the same* as to you.

Matthew 20:23 So He said to them, You will indeed drink My cup, and be baptized with the baptism that I am baptized with; but to sit on My right hand and on My left is not Mine to give, but *it is for those* for whom it is prepared by My Father.

Matthew 20:28 just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many.

Matthew 21:43 Therefore I say to you, the kingdom of God will be taken from you and given to a nation bearing the fruits of it.

Matthew 24:45 Who then is a faithful and wise servant, whom his master made ruler over his household, to give them food in due season?

Matthew 25:8 And the foolish said to the wise, Give us *some* of your oil, for our lamps are going out.

Matthew 25:28,29 Therefore take the talent from him, and give *it* to him who has ten talents. 29 For to everyone who has, more will be given, and he will have abundance; but from him who does not have, even what he has will be taken away.

Matthew 25:37 Then the righteous will answer Him, saying, Lord, when did we see You hungry and feed *You*, or thirsty and give *You* drink?

Matthew 26:9 For this fragrant oil might have been sold for much and given to *the* poor.

Matthew 28:18 And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth.
