

The Gift Of Cheerful Mercy - Romans 121

Proverbs 31 Referred to the Virtuous Woman.

John 10:10 The thief comes not, but for to steal, & to kill, & to destroy: I am come that they might have life, & that they might have it more abundantly.

1 Timothy 5:8 But if any provide not for his own, and specially for those of his own house, he hath denied the faith, and is worse than an infidel.

Romans 12:6 Having then gifts differing according to the grace that is given to us, whether prophecy, let us prophesy according to the proportion of faith;

Romans 12:8 he who exhorts, in exhortation; he who gives, with liberality; he who leads, with diligence; he who shows mercy, with cheerfulness.

Ephesians 6:4 And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.

Romans 8:29 For whom He did foreknow, He also did predestinate to be conformed to the Image of His Son, that He might be the firstborn among many brethren.

Romans 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

Matthew 4:23-25 And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing all kinds of sickness and all kinds of disease among the people. 24 Then His fame went throughout all Syria; and they brought to Him all sick people who were afflicted with various diseases and torments, and those who were demon-possessed, epileptics, and paralytics; and He healed them. 25 Great multitudes followed Him: from Galilee, and from Decapolis, Jerusalem, Judea, and beyond the Jordan.

Luke 18 Referred to the parable of the Pharisee & the Publican.

Matthew 5:7 Blessed *are* the merciful, For they shall obtain mercy <1653>.

Matthew 9:27 When Jesus departed from there, two blind men followed Him, crying out and saying, Son of David, have mercy <1653> on us!

Mark 10 Referred to Blind Bart crying for help from Jesus.

Matthew 15:22 And behold, a woman of Canaan came from that region and cried out to Him, saying, Have mercy <1653> on me, O Lord, Son of David! My daughter is severely demon-possessed.

Matthew 17:15 Lord, have mercy <1653> on my son, for he is an epileptic and

suffers severely; for he often falls into the fire and often into the water.
Matthew 18:33 Should you not also have had compassion <1653> on your fellow servant, just as I had pity <1653> on you?
Matthew 18 Summarized of the account of the servants desiring mercy.
Matthew 5:38,39 Ye have heard that it hath been said, An eye for an eye, and a tooth for a tooth: 39 But I say unto you, That ye resist not evil: but whosoever shall smite thee on thy right cheek, turn to him the other also.
Matthew 20:30,31 And behold, two blind men sitting by the road, when they heard that Jesus was passing by, cried out, saying, Have mercy <1653> on us, O Lord, Son of David! 31 Then the multitude warned them that they should be quiet; but they cried out all the more, saying, Have mercy <1653> on us, O Lord, Son of David!
Luke 18 Referred to the persistent widow account.
Mark 5:19 However, Jesus did not permit him, but said to him, Go home to your friends, and tell them what great things the Lord has done for you, and how He has had compassion <1653> on you.
Hebrews 13:8 Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever.
Mark 10:49 And Jesus stood still, & commanded him to be called. And they call the blind man, saying unto him, Be of good comfort, rise; He calls thee.
Mark 10:47,48 And when he heard that it was Jesus of Nazareth, he began to cry out and say, Jesus, Son of David, have mercy <1653> on me! 48 Then many warned him to be quiet; but he cried out all the more, Son of David, have mercy <1653> on me!
Luke 16:24 Then he cried and said, Father Abraham, have mercy <1653> on me, and send Lazarus that he may dip the tip of his finger in water and cool my tongue; for I am tormented in this flame.
Revelation 20:15 And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire.
2 Corinthians 6:2 For He says: In an acceptable time I have heard you, And in the day of salvation I have helped you. Behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation.
1 Timothy 2:5 For there is one God, and one Mediator between God and men, the Man Christ Jesus;
John 2:5 His mother said to the servants, Whatever He says to you, do it.
John 14:6 Jesus said to him, I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.
Luke 17:13 And they lifted up *their* voices and said, Jesus, Master, have mercy <1653> on us!
Luke 18:38,39 he cried out, saying, Jesus, Son of David, have mercy <1653> on me! 39 Then those who went before warned him that he should be quiet; but he cried out all the more, Son of David, have mercy <1653> on me!
Romans 9:15,16 For He says to Moses, I will have mercy <1653> on whomever

I will have mercy, and I will have compassion on whomever I will have compassion. 16 So then *it is* not of him who wills, nor of him who runs, but of God who shows mercy <1653>.

Romans 9:18 Therefore He has mercy <1653> on whom He wills, and whom He wills He hardens.

Romans 11:30-32 For as you were once disobedient to God, yet have now obtained mercy <1653> through their disobedience, 31 even so these also have now been disobedient, that through the mercy <1653> shown you they also may obtain mercy. 32 For God has committed them all to disobedience, that He might have mercy <1653> on all.

Romans 10:13 For whosoever shall call upon the Name of the Lord shall be saved.

Acts 17:30 And the times of this ignorance God winked at; but now commandeth all men every where to repent:

1 John 4:19 We love Him because He first loved us.

Jeremiah 24:7 And I will give them an heart to know Me, that I am the LORD: and they shall be My people, and I will be their God: for they shall return unto Me with their whole heart.

Referred to many rulers God revealed Himself to yet not turning to God.

Hebrews 3:8 Harden not your hearts, as in the provocation, in the day of temptation in the wilderness:

Revelation 3:20 Behold, I stand at the door & knock. If anyone hears My voice & opens the door, I will come in to him and dine with him, and he with Me.

Luke 14 & Matthew 22 Referred to the excuses why to not come to Jesus.

Romans 12:8 he who exhorts, in exhortation; he who gives, with liberality; he who leads, with diligence; he who shows mercy <1653>, with cheerfulness.

1 Corinthians 7:25 Now concerning virgins: I have no commandment from the Lord; yet I give judgment as one whom the Lord in His mercy <1653> has made trustworthy.

2 Corinthians 4:1 Therefore, since we have this ministry, as we have received mercy <1653>, we do not lose heart.

Luke 22:32 But I have prayed for thee, that thy faith fail not: and when thou art converted, strengthen thy brethren.

Philippians 2:27 For indeed he was sick almost unto death; but God had mercy <1653> on him, and not only on him but on me also, lest I should have sorrow upon sorrow.

1 Timothy 1:13 although I was formerly a blasphemer, a persecutor, and an insolent man; but I obtained mercy <1653> because I did *it* ignorantly in unbelief.

2 Corinthians 11:4 For if he that cometh preacheth another Jesus, whom we have not preached, or if ye receive another spirit, which ye have not received, or another gospel, which ye have not accepted, ye might well

bear with him.

Acts 9 Referred to the conversion of Paul.

1 Timothy 1:16 However, for this reason I obtained mercy <1653>, that in me first Jesus Christ might show all longsuffering, as a pattern to those who are going to believe on Him for everlasting life.

2 Corinthians 12:7-9 And lest I should be exalted above measure by the abundance of the revelations, a thorn in the flesh was given to me, a messenger of Satan to buffet me, lest I be exalted above measure. **8** Concerning this thing I pleaded with the Lord three times that it might depart from me. **9** And He said to me, My grace is sufficient for you, for My strength is made perfect in weakness. Therefore most gladly I will rather boast in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me.

Job Referred to Job's testings.

Psalms 31:15 My times are in Your hand; Deliver me from the hand of my enemies, And from those who persecute me.

1 Peter 2:10 who once *were* not a people but *are* now the people of God, who had not obtained mercy <1653> but now have obtained mercy.

Jude 1:22 And on some have compassion <1653>, making a distinction;

Strongs #2432 hilarotes hil-ar-ot'-ace AV-cheerfulness 1; 1) cheerfulness, readiness of mind.

Exodus 7:3 And I will harden Pharaoh's heart, and multiply My signs and My wonders in the land of Egypt.

Matthew 5 Referred to versions using Blessed versus Happy.

Judges 9:13 But the vine said to them, Should I cease my new wine, Which cheers *both* God and men, And go to sway over trees?

Ruth 3:7 And after Boaz had eaten and drunk, and his heart was cheerful, he went to lie down at the end of the heap of grain; and she came softly, uncovered his feet, and lay down.

1 Kings 21:7 Then Jezebel his wife said to him, You now exercise authority over Israel! Arise, eat food, and let your heart be cheerful; I will give you the vineyard of Naboth the Jezreelite.

Proverbs 15:13 A merry heart makes a cheerful countenance, But by sorrow of the heart the spirit is broken.

Ecclesiastes 11:9 Rejoice, O young man, in your youth, & let your heart cheer you in the days of your youth; Walk in the ways of your heart, & in the sight of your eyes; But know that for all these God will bring you into judgment.

Zechariah 8:19 Thus says the LORD of hosts: The fast of the fourth *month*, The fast of the fifth, The fast of the seventh, And the fast of the tenth, Shall be joy and gladness and cheerful feasts For the house of Judah. Therefore love truth and peace.

Exodus 23:14 Three times you shall keep a feast to Me in the year:

Matthew 9:2 Then behold, they brought to Him a paralytic lying on a bed.

When Jesus saw their faith, He said to the paralytic, Son, be of good cheer;

your sins are forgiven you.

Matthew 9:22 But Jesus turned around, and when He saw her He said, Be of good cheer, daughter; your faith has made you well. And the woman was made well from that hour.

Matthew 14:27 But immediately Jesus spoke to them, saying, Be of good cheer! It is I; do not be afraid.

Mark 6:50 for they all saw Him and were troubled. But immediately He talked with them and said to them, Be of good cheer! It is I; do not be afraid.

Mark 10:49 Jesus stood still & commanded him to be called. Then they called the blind man, saying to him, Be of good cheer. Rise, He is calling you.

Mark 10:48 Then many warned him to be quiet; but he cried out all the more, Son of David, have mercy <1653> on me!

Luke 8:48 And He said to her, Daughter, be of good cheer; your faith has made you well. Go in peace.

Matthew 10:28 And do not fear those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul. But rather fear Him who is able to destroy both soul and body in hell.

John 16:33 These things I have spoken to you, that in Me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world.

Romans 8:34 Who is he who condemns? It is Christ who died, and furthermore is also risen, who is even at the right hand of God, Who also makes intercession for us.

Acts 23:11 But the following night the Lord stood by him and said, Be of good cheer, Paul; for as you have testified for Me in Jerusalem, so you must also bear witness at Rome.

Acts 24:10 Then Paul, after the governor had nodded to him to speak, answered: Inasmuch as I know that you have been for many years a judge of this nation, I do the more cheerfully answer for myself,

Romans 12:8 he who exhorts, in exhortation; he who gives, with liberality; he who leads, with diligence; he who shows mercy, with cheerfulness.

2 Corinthians 9:7 So let each one give as he purposes in his heart, not grudgingly or of necessity; for God loves a cheerful giver.

James 5:13,14 Is anyone among you suffering? Let him pray. Is anyone cheerful? Let him sing psalms. 14 Is anyone among you sick? Let him call for the elders of the church, and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the Name of the Lord.

Hebrews 12:2 looking unto Jesus, the Author and Finisher of our faith, Who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.

Luke 10:25-37 And behold, a certain lawyer stood up and tested Him, saying, Teacher, what shall I do to inherit eternal life? 26 He said to him, What is written in the law? What is your reading of it? 27 So he answered and said,

You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your strength, and with all your mind, and your neighbor as yourself.

Deuteronomy 6:5 And thou shalt love the LORD thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy might. Leviticus 19:18 Thou shalt not avenge, nor bear any grudge against the children of thy people, but thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself: I am the LORD.

James 2:20 But wilt thou know, O vain man, that faith without works is dead?

Exodus 20 Summarized of the 10 Commandments. The first table was on their relationship with God & the second was on their relationship with mankind.

Matthew 10:37 He who loves father or mother more than Me is not worthy of Me. And he who loves son or daughter more than Me is not worthy of Me.

Luke 10:28-37 And He said to him, You have answered rightly; do this and you will live. 29 But he, wanting to justify himself, said to Jesus, And who is my neighbor? 30 Then Jesus answered and said: A certain *man* went down from Jerusalem to Jericho, and fell among thieves, who stripped him of his clothing, wounded *him*, and departed, leaving *him* half dead. 31 Now by chance a certain priest came down that road. And when he saw him, he passed by on the other side. 32 Likewise a Levite, when he arrived at the place, came and looked, and passed by on the other side. 33 But a certain Samaritan, as he journeyed, came where he was. And when he saw him, he had compassion. 34 So he went to *him* and bandaged his wounds, pouring on oil and wine; and he set him on his own animal, brought him to an inn, and took care of him. 35 On the next day, when he departed, he took out two denarii, gave *them* to the innkeeper, and said to him, Take care of him; and whatever more you spend, when I come again, I will repay you. 36 So which of these three do you think was neighbor to him who fell among the thieves? 37 And he said, He who showed mercy on him. Then Jesus said to him, Go and do likewise.

Matthew 10:8 Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out devils: freely ye have received, freely give.

Luke 9 & 10 Referred to Jesus sending the disciples out to minister to the people & cast out demons.

Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;
