- 1 Corinthians 12 Referred to the similar chapter on the Gifts of the Holy Spirit.
- Mark 16:15-18 And He said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. 16 He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned. 17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.
- Romans 8:29 For whom He did foreknow, He also did predestinate to be conformed to the Image of His Son, that He might be the firstborn among many brethren.
- Acts 8:11 And to him they had regard, because that of long time he had bewitched them with sorceries.
- **Exodus 20 Referred to the 10 Commandments.**
- Romans 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.
- Romans 12:9 Let love be without hypocrisy. Abhor what is evil. Cling to what is good.
- Matthew 11:28-30 Come unto Me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. 29 Take My yoke upon you, and learn of Me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls. 30 For My yoke is easy, and my burden is light.
- Mark 5:18 And when He was come into the ship, he that had been possessed with the devil prayed Him that he might be with Him.

Genesis 2:17 But of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, thou shalt not eat of it: for in the day that thou eatest thereof thou shalt surely die.

Genesis 3 Referred to the fall of mankind.

Matthew 4 Summarized of Jesus' temptations.

- Leviticus Referred to the laws for the priests & Levites.
- Exodus 30:21 So they shall wash their hands and their feet, that they die not: and it shall be a statute for ever to them, even to him and to his seed throughout their generations.
- Leviticus 16:34 And this shall be an everlasting statute unto you, to make an atonement for the children of Israel for all their sins once a year. And he did as the LORD commanded Moses.
- Leviticus 20:23 And you shall not walk in the statutes of the nation which I am casting out before you; for they commit all these things, and therefore I abhor them.
- Referred to the apostles, Daniel, Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego standing for God.
- Leviticus 26:11 I will set My tabernacle among you, and My soul shall not abhor you.
- Exodus 13:21 And the LORD went before them by day in a pillar of a cloud, to lead them the way; and by night in a pillar of fire, to give them light; to go by day and night:
- John 3:16 For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life.
- Leviticus 26 Referred to this being God's 7 times more judgment as Israel sinned more.
- Leviticus 26:30 I will destroy your high places, cut down your incense altars, and cast your carcasses on the lifeless forms of your idols; and My soul shall abhor you.
- Psalms 115:4-7 Their idols are silver and gold, the work of men's hands. 5 They have mouths, but they speak not: eyes have they, but they see not: 6 They have ears, but they hear not: noses have they, but they smell not: 7 They have hands, but they handle not: feet have they, but they walk not: neither speak they through their throat.
- Deuteronomy 6:5 And thou shalt love the LORD thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy might.
- Matthew 10:37 He who loves father or mother more than Me is not worthy of Me. And he who loves son or daughter more than Me is not worthy of Me.
- Leviticus 26:44 Yet for all that, when they are in the land of their enemies, <u>I will not cast them away, nor shall I abhor them</u>, to utterly destroy them and break My covenant with them; for I *am* the LORD their God.
- Exodus 12:12 For I will pass through the land of Egypt this night, and will

- smite all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, both man and beast; and against all the gods of Egypt I will execute judgment: I am the LORD.
- Numbers 14:22 because all these men who have seen My glory and the signs which I did in Egypt and in the wilderness, and have put Me to the test now these ten times, and have not heeded My voice,
- Deuteronomy 7:26 (NKJV) Nor shall you bring an abomination into your house, lest you be doomed to destruction like it. You shall utterly detest it and utterly abhor it, for it is an accursed thing.
- 1 Samuel 4 Summarized of Israel conquered & the Ark captured.
- 2 Kings 18:35 Who are they among all the gods of the countries, that have delivered their country out of mine hand, that the LORD should deliver Jerusalem out of mine hand?
- Deuteronomy 7:26 (AV) Neither shalt thou bring an abomination into thine house, lest thou be a cursed thing like it: but thou shalt utterly detest it, and thou shalt utterly abhor it; for it is a cursed thing.
- Joshua 7:11,12 Israel hath sinned, and they have also transgressed my covenant which I commanded them: for they have even taken of the accursed thing, and have also stolen, and dissembled also, and they have put it even among their own stuff. 12 Therefore the children of Israel could not stand before their enemies, but turned their backs before their enemies, because they were accursed: neither will I be with you any more, except ye destroy the accursed from among you.
- Ezra 9:7 Since the days of our fathers have we been in a great trespass unto this day; and for our iniquities have we, our kings, and our priests, been delivered into the hand of the kings of the lands, to the sword, to captivity, and to a spoil, and to confusion of face, as it is this day.
- Deuteronomy 23:7 You shall not abhor an Edomite, for he *is* your brother.

 You shall not abhor an Egyptian, because you were an alien in his land.
- Acts 13:22 And when He had removed him, He raised up for them David as king, to whom also He gave testimony and said, I have found David the son of Jesse, a man after My own heart, who will do all My will.
- 2 Samuel 11 Referred to the sins of David & Bathsheba.
- 2 Samuel 12 Referred to Nathan confronting David.
- Psalms 51 Referred to David repenting.
- 1 Samuel 27:12 So Achish believed David, saying, He has made his people Israel utterly abhor him; therefore he will be my servant forever.
- Job 9:31 Yet You will plunge me into the pit, And my own clothes will abhor me.
- 2 Corinthians 12:7-9 And lest I should be exalted above measure by the abundance of the revelations, a thorn in the flesh was given to me, a

- messenger of Satan to buffet me, lest I be exalted above measure. 8 Concerning this thing I pleaded with the Lord three times that it might depart from me. 9 And He said to me, My grace is sufficient for you, for My strength is made perfect in weakness. Therefore most gladly I will rather boast in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me.
- Job 19:19 All my close friends abhor me, And those whom I love have turned against me.
- Job 30:10 They abhor me, they keep far from me; They do not hesitate to spit in my face.
- Matthew 26:67 Then they spat in His face and beat Him; and others struck Him with the palms of their hands,
- John 3:16 For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life.
- Job 42:6 Therefore <u>I abhor *myself*</u>, And repent in dust and ashes.
- Job 37-39 Referred to God's retort to Job.
- Job 38:4 Where wast thou when I laid the foundations of the earth? declare, if thou hast understanding.
- Psalms 36:4 He devises wickedness on his bed; He sets himself in a way that is not good; He does not abhor evil.
- Genesis 6:5 And GOD saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually.
- Psalms 119:163 I hate and <u>abhor lying</u>, *But* I love Your law.
- John 8:44 Ye are of your father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it.
- Matthew 5:17 Think not that I am come to destroy the law, or the prophets: I am not come to destroy, but to fulfil.
- Matthew 5:18 For verily I say unto you, Till heaven and earth pass, one jot or one tittle shall in no wise pass from the law, till all be fulfilled.
- Proverbs 24:24 He who says to the wicked, You *are* righteous, Him the people will curse; <u>Nations will abhor him</u>.
- Ezekiel 45:8 In the land shall be his possession in Israel: and My princes shall no more oppress My people; and the rest of the land shall they give to the house of Israel according to their tribes.
- Proverbs 22:22,23 Rob not the poor, because he is poor: neither oppress the afflicted in the gate: 23 For the LORD will plead their cause, and

- spoil the soul of those that spoiled them.
- Matthew 18:18 Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.
- 1 Timothy 2:1,2 I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for all men; 2 For kings, and for all that are in authority; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty.

- Amos 6:8 The Lord GOD has sworn by Himself, The LORD God of hosts says: <u>I abhor the pride of Jacob</u>, And hate his palaces; Therefore I will deliver up *the* city And all that is in it.
- Micah 3:9 Now hear this, You heads of the house of Jacob And rulers of the house of Israel, Who abhor justice And pervert all equity,
- Romans 2:22 You who say, Do not commit adultery, do you commit adultery? You who abhor idols, do you rob temples?
- Matthew 12:39 But he answered and said unto them, An evil and adulterous generation seeketh after a sign; and there shall no sign be given to it, but the sign of the prophet Jonas:
- Romans 12:9 *Let* love *be* without hypocrisy. Abhor what is evil. Cling to what is good.
- Acts 15:20 but that we write to them to <u>abstain from</u> things polluted by idols, from sexual immorality, from things strangled, and from blood.
