Be Kindly Affectionate To One Another - Romans 12M

- Referred to Jesus lovingly ministering to the people that came to Him. Acts referred to that the Believers' love for each other drew others to Jesus.
- Romans 12 Summarized of the Gifts of the Holy Spirit & God's Commands.
- 1 Corinthians 12:31 But covet earnestly the best gifts: and yet shew I unto you a more excellent way.
- 1 John 3:8 He that committeth sin is of the devil; for the devil sinneth from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that He might destroy the works of the devil.
- Romans 12:10 Be <u>kindly affectionate</u> to one another with brotherly love, in honor giving preference to one another;
- Colossians 3:23 whatever ye do, do it heartily, as to the Lord, & not unto men; Matthew 25 Summarized to the parable of the Talents.
- 1 Timothy 5:8 But if any provide not for his own, and specially for those of his own house, he hath denied the faith, and is worse than an infidel.
- Galatians 3:28 There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither bond nor free, there is neither male nor female: for ye are all one in Christ Jesus.
- Mark 11:26 But if ye do not forgive, neither will your Father which is in heaven forgive your trespasses.
- John 14:27 Peace I leave with you, My peace I give unto you: not as the world giveth, give I unto you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.
- Mark 5 & Luke 8 Summarized of the Gadarene Demoniac set free by Jesus.
- Mark 5:15 And they come to Jesus, and see him that was possessed with the devil, and had the legion, sitting, and clothed, and in his right mind: and they were afraid.
- Summarized of Moses prepared by God. Numbers 12:3 (Now the man Moses was very meek, above all the men which were upon the face of the earth.)
- Romans 1 Referred to God describing sinful mankinds' descend into depravity.
- Romans 1:26 (AV) For this cause God gave them up unto <u>vile affections</u>: for even their women did change the natural use into that which is against nature:
- Romans 1:26 (NKJV) For this reason God gave them up to <u>vile passions</u>. For even their women exchanged the natural use for what is against nature.
- Romans 1:31 (AV) Without understanding, covenantbreakers, <u>without natural</u> <u>affection</u>, implacable, unmerciful: Romans 1:31 (NKJV) undiscerning, untrustworthy, <u>unloving</u>, unforgiving, unmerciful;
- John 13:34,35 A new commandment I give unto you, That <u>ye love one another;</u> as I have loved you, that <u>ye also love one another</u>. 35 By this shall all *men* know that ye are My disciples, if ye have love one to another.
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins,

and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

- 1 Chronicles 7:13,14 If I shut up heaven that there be no rain, or if I command the locusts to devour the land, or if I send pestilence among My people; 14 If My people, which are called by My Name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.
- Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;
- James 4:7 Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.
- Strongs #5387 philostorgos fil-os'-tor-gos AV-kindly affectioned 1; 1) the mutual love of parents and children and wives and husbands 2) loving affection, prone to love, loving tenderly 2a) chiefly of the reciprocal tenderness of parents and children.
- 1 Chronicles 29:3 Moreover, because I have set my affection on the house of my God, I have given to the house of my God, over & above all that I have prepared for the Holy House, my own special treasure of gold and silver:
- 1 Chronicles 22:9,10 Behold, a son shall be born to thee, who shall be a man of rest; and I will give him rest from all his enemies round about: for his name shall be Solomon, and I will give peace and quietness unto Israel in his days. 10 He shall build an house for My Name; and he shall be My son, and I will be his Father; and I will establish the throne of his kingdom over Israel for ever.
- 2 Samuel 15:6 And on this manner did Absalom to all Israel that came to the king for judgment: so Absalom stole the hearts of the men of Israel.
- Romans 12:10 *Be* kindly affectionate to one another with brotherly love, in honor giving preference to one another;
- 1 Corinthians 7:3 Let the husband render to his wife the <u>affection</u> due her, and likewise also the wife to her husband.
- God did not make woman from a hair to rule over Adam. God did not make woman from a toe-nail for Adam to rule over her. God made woman from a rib near Adam's heart to love her & work together with her.
- Ephesians 5:33 Nevertheless let every one of you in particular so <u>love</u> his wife even as himself; and the wife see that she reverence her husband.
- 2 Corinthians 6:12 You are not restricted by us, but you are restricted by your *own* affections.
- Galatians 5:22,23 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, 23 gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law.
- Numbers 22 Referred to Israelites falling for lusts of Balak's women.
- Referred to Samson falling for ungodly women.
- 2 Corinthians 7:15 And his affections are greater for you as he remembers the

- obedience of you all, how with fear and trembling you received him.
- Philippians 1:8 For God is my witness, how greatly I long for you all with the affection of Jesus Christ.
- Summarized of Paul & his understudies returning to the new Churches.
- Philippians 2:1 Therefore if *there is* any consolation in Christ, if any comfort of love, if any fellowship of the Spirit, if any affection and mercy,
- 1 John 4:19 We love Him, because He first loved us.
- Ezra 9:13 And after all that is come upon us for our evil deeds, and for our great trespass, seeing that thou our God hast punished us less than our iniquities deserve, and hast given us such deliverance as this;
- 1 Thessalonians 2:8 So, <u>affectionately longing</u> for you, we were well pleased to impart to you not only the gospel of God, but also our own lives, because you had become dear to us.

- 1 Corinthians 7:1-9 1,2 Now concerning the things whereof ye wrote unto me: *It is* good for a man not to touch a woman. 2 Nevertheless, *to avoid* fornication, let every man have his own wife, and let every woman have her own husband.
- Proverbs 18:22 Whoso findeth a wife findeth a good thing, and obtaineth favour of the LORD.
- 1 Corinthians 7:39 The wife is bound by the law as long as her husband liveth; but if her husband be dead, she is at liberty to be married to whom she will; only in the Lord.
- Genesis Referred to Adam & Eve made by God as husband & wife.
- Matthew 18:20 For where two or three are gathered together in My Name, there am I in the midst of them.
- Matthew 18:19 Again I say unto you, That if two of you shall agree on earth as touching any thing that they shall ask, it shall be done for them of My Father which is in heaven.
- 1 Corinthians 7:3 Let the husband render unto the wife due benevolence: and likewise also the wife unto the husband.
- Ephesians 6:4 And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.

1 Corinthians 7:4-7 The wife hath not power of her own body, but the husband: and likewise also the husband hath not power of his own body, but the wife. 5 Defraud ye not one the other, except it be with consent for a time, that ye may give yourselves to fasting and prayer; and come together again, that Satan tempt you not for your incontinency. 6 But I speak this by permission, and not of commandment. 7 For I would that all men were even as I myself. But every man hath his proper gift of God, one after this manner, and another after that.

Acts 9 Referred to Paul's Conversion.

- Matthew 10:37 He that loveth father or mother more than Me is not worthy of Me: and he that loveth son or daughter more than Me is not worthy of Me.
- Luke 16:13 No servant can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. Ye cannot serve God and mammon.
- 1 Samuel 2:29 Wherefore kick ye at My sacrifice and at Mine offering, which I have commanded in My habitation; and honourest thy sons above Me, to make yourselves fat with the chiefest of all the offerings of Israel My people?
- 1 Corinthians 12:11 But all these worketh that one and the selfsame Spirit, dividing to every man severally as He will.
- 1 Corinthians 7:8 I say therefore to the unmarried and widows, It is good for them if they abide even as I.
- 1 Corinthians 7:32-34 But I would have you without carefulness. He that is unmarried careth for the things that belong to the Lord, how he may please the Lord: 33 But he that is married careth for the things that are of the world, how he may please his wife. 34 There is difference also between a wife and a virgin. The unmarried woman careth for the things of the Lord, that she may be Holy both in body and in spirit: but she that is married careth for the things of the world, how she may please her husband.
- 1 Corinthians 7:9 But if they cannot contain, let them marry: for it is better to marry than to burn.
- 1 Peter 5:8 Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour:
