

In Honour Giving Preference To One Another - Romans 12N

Hebrews 12:2 Looking unto Jesus the Author and Finisher of our faith; who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God.

John 13 Referred to Jesus washing the feet of His Disciples. V14 If I then, your Lord and Master, have washed your feet; ye also ought to wash one another's feet.

Mark 10:44 And whosoever of you will be the chiefest, shall be servant of all.

Romans 10:13 For whosoever shall call upon the Name of the Lord shall be saved.

2 Corinthians 6:2 (For He saith, I have heard thee in a time accepted, and in the day of salvation have I succoured thee: behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation.)

Romans 12:10 Be kindly affectionate to one another with brotherly love, in honor giving preference to one another;

Luke 18 Referred to the account of the Pharisee & the Publican.

2 Timothy 3:5 Having a form of godliness, but denying the power thereof: from such turn away.

Matthew 7:15 Beware of false prophets, which come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravening wolves.

Daniel 1:8 But Daniel purposed in his heart that he would not defile himself with the portion of the king's meat, nor with the wine which he drank: therefore he requested of the prince of the eunuchs that he might not defile himself.

1 Corinthians 6:19 What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, & ye are not your own?

1 Corinthians 6:7 Now therefore there is utterly a fault among you, because ye go to law one with another. Why do ye not rather take wrong? why do ye not rather suffer yourselves to be defrauded?

Mark 12:12 And they sought to lay hold on Him, but feared the people: for they knew that He had spoken the parable against them: and they left Him, and went their way.

Matthew 13:57 So they were offended at Him. But Jesus said to them, A prophet is not without honor except in his own country and in his own house.

Matthew 15:4 For God commanded, saying, Honor your father and your mother; and, He who curses father or mother, let him be put to death.

Exodus 20:12 Honour thy father and thy mother: that thy days may be long upon the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee.

Leviticus 19:32 Thou shalt rise up before the hoary head, and honour the face of the old man, and fear thy God: I am the LORD.

Matthew 15:5,6 But ye say, Whosoever shall say to his father or his mother, It is a gift (Corban), by whatsoever thou mightest be profited by me; 6 then he need not honor his father or mother. Thus you have made the commandment of God of no effect by your tradition.

Matthew 15:8 These people draw near to Me with their mouth, And honor Me with *their* lips, But their heart is far from Me.

Matthew 23:14 Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye devour widows' houses, and for a pretence make long prayer: therefore ye shall receive the greater damnation.

Matthew 19:19 Honor your father and *your* mother, and, You shall love your neighbor as yourself.

Mark 6:4 But Jesus said to them, A prophet is not without honor except in his own country, among his own relatives, and in his own house.

Mark 7:10 For Moses said, Honor your father and your mother; and, He who curses father or mother, let him be put to death.

Mark 10:19 You know the commandments: Do not commit adultery, Do not murder, Do not steal, Do not bear false witness, Do not defraud, Honor your father and your mother.

Luke 18:20 You know the commandments: Do not commit adultery, Do not murder, Do not steal, Do not bear false witness, Honor your father and your mother.

John 4:44 For Jesus Himself testified that a prophet has no honor in his own country.

Mark 6:5 And He could there do no mighty work, save that He laid his hands upon a few sick folk, and healed them.

John 5:23 that all should honor the Son just as they honor the Father. He who does not honor the Son does not honor the Father Who sent Him.

1 John 2:23 Whoever denies the Son does not have the Father either; he who acknowledges the Son has the Father also.

John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by Me.

Matthew 18:18 Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.

Revelation 19:11 Referred to Jesus' return.

John 5:44 How can you believe, who receive honor from one another, and do not seek the honor that *comes* from the only God?

John 8:49 Jesus answered, I do not have a demon; but I honor My Father, and you dishonor Me.

Luke 12:10 And whosoever shall speak a word against the Son of man, it shall be forgiven him: but unto him that blasphemeth against the Holy Ghost it shall not be forgiven.

John 12:49 For I have not spoken on My own authority; but the Father who sent Me gave Me a command, what I should say and what I should speak.

John 12:15,16 And when the chief priests and scribes saw the wonderful things that He did, and the children crying in the temple, and saying, Hosanna to the Son of David; they were sore displeased, 16 And said unto him, Hearest thou what these say? And Jesus saith unto them, Yea; have ye never read, Out of the mouth of babes and sucklings thou hast perfected praise?

John 8:54 Jesus answered, If I honor Myself, My honor is nothing. It is My Father who honors Me, of whom you say that He is your God.

John 12:26 If anyone serves Me, let him follow Me; and where I am, there My servant will be also. If anyone serves Me, him *My* Father will honor.

Mark 16:17,18 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.

Romans 2:7 eternal life to those who by patient continuance in doing good seek for glory, honor, and immortality;

Romans 2:10 but glory, honor, and peace to everyone who works what is good, to the Jew first and also to the Greek.

Romans 9:21 Does not the potter have power over the clay, from the same

lump to make one vessel for honor and another for dishonor?

Jeremiah 18 Referred to the account of the Potter & the clay.

Romans 12:10 *Be* kindly affectionate to one another with brotherly love, in honor giving preference to one another;

Romans 13:7 Render therefore to all their due: taxes to whom taxes *are due*, customs to whom customs, fear to whom fear, honor to whom honor.

1 Timothy 2:1,2 I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for all men; 2 For kings, and for all that are in authority; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty.

Ezekiel 45:8 In the land shall be his possession in Israel: and My princes shall no more oppress My people; and the rest of the land shall they give to the house of Israel according to their tribes.

1 Corinthians 12:23,24 And those *members* of the body which we think to be less honorable, on these we bestow greater honor; and our unpresentable *parts* have greater modesty, 24 but our presentable *parts* have no need. But God composed the body, having given greater honor to that *part* which lacks it,

2 Corinthians 6:8 by honor and dishonor, by evil report and good report; as deceivers, and *yet* true;

2 Corinthians 11 Referred to Paul's "in Perils list."

Acts 14:19 And there came thither certain Jews from Antioch and Iconium, who persuaded the people, and, having stoned Paul, drew him out of the city, supposing he had been dead. 20 Howbeit, as the disciples stood round about him, he rose up, and came into the city: and the next day he departed with Barnabas to Derbe.

Ephesians 6:2 Honor your father and mother, which is the first commandment with promise:

1 Thessalonians 4:4 that each of you should know how to possess his own vessel in sanctification and honor,

Galatians 5:22,23 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, 23 gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law.

1 Corinthians 6:19,20 What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own? 20 For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's.

1 Timothy 1:17 Now to the King eternal, immortal, invisible, to God Who alone is wise, *be* honor and glory forever and ever. Amen.

1 Timothy 5:3 Honor widows who are really widows.

1 Timothy 5:17 Let the elders who rule well be counted worthy of double honor, especially those who labor in the word and doctrine.

2 Timothy 2:15 Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the Word of Truth.

Jude 1:3 Beloved, when I gave all diligence to write unto you of the common salvation, it was needful for me to write unto you, and exhort you that ye should earnestly contend for the faith which was once delivered unto the saints.

1 Timothy 6:1 Let as many bondservants (slaves) as are under the yoke count their own masters worthy of all honor, so that the Name of God and *His* doctrine may not be blasphemed.

2 Samuel 12:14 Howbeit, because by this deed thou hast given great occasion to the enemies of the LORD to blaspheme, the child also that is born unto thee shall surely die.

1 Timothy 6:16 Who alone has immortality, dwelling in unapproachable light, Whom no man has seen or can see, to Whom *be* honor and everlasting power. Amen.

2 Timothy 2:20,21 But in a great house there are not only vessels of gold and silver, but also of wood and clay, some for honor and some for dishonor. 21 Therefore if anyone cleanses himself from the latter, he will be a vessel for honor, sanctified and useful for the Master, prepared for every good work.

1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Hebrews 2:7 You have made Him a little lower than the angels; You have crowned Him with glory & honor, & set Him over the works of Your hands.

Hebrews 2:9 But we see Jesus, Who was made a little lower than the angels, for the suffering of death crowned with glory and honor, that He, by the grace of God, might taste death for everyone.

Matthew 10:28 And fear not them which kill the body, but are not able to kill the soul: but rather fear Him which is able to destroy both soul and body in hell.

Ephesians 1:13 In whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that Holy Spirit of promise,

2 Corinthians 5:8 We are confident, I say, and willing rather to be absent from the body, and to be present with the Lord.

Hebrews 3:3 For this One has been counted worthy of more glory than Moses, inasmuch as He who built the house has more honor than the house.

Mark 9:7 And there was a cloud that overshadowed them: and a voice came

out of the cloud, saying, This is my beloved Son: hear him.

Romans 14:5 One man esteemeth one day above another: another esteemeth every day alike. Let every man be fully persuaded in his own mind.

Hebrews 5:4 And no man takes this honor to himself, but he who is called by God, just as Aaron *was*.

1 Corinthians 3:12,13 Now if any man build upon this foundation gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, stubble; **13** Every man's work shall be made manifest: for the day shall declare it, because it shall be revealed by fire; and the fire shall try every man's work of what sort it is.

1 Peter 1:7 that the genuineness of your faith, *being* much more precious than gold that perishes, though it is tested by fire, may be found to praise, honor, and glory at the revelation of Jesus Christ,

Romans 12:18 If it be possible, as much as lieth in you, live peaceably with all men.

1 Peter 2:17 Honor all *people*. Love the brotherhood. Fear God. Honor the king.

1 Peter 3:7 Husbands, likewise, dwell with *them* with understanding, giving honor to the wife, as to the weaker vessel, and as *being* heirs together of the grace of life, that your prayers may not be hindered.

2 Peter 1:17 For He received from God the Father honor and glory when such a voice came to Him from the Excellent Glory: This is My beloved Son, in Whom I am well pleased.

Revelation 4:9 Whenever the living creatures give glory and honor and thanks to Him who sits on the throne, who lives forever and ever,

Revelation 4:11 You are worthy, O Lord, To receive glory and honor and power; For You created all things, And by Your will they exist and were created.

Revelation 5:12,13 saying with a loud voice: Worthy is the Lamb who was slain To receive power and riches and wisdom, And strength and honor and glory and blessing! **13** And every creature which is in heaven and on the earth and under the earth and such as are in the sea, and all that are in them, I heard saying: Blessing and honor and glory and power *Be* to Him who sits on the throne, And to the Lamb, forever and ever!

Revelation 7:12 saying: Amen! Blessing and glory and wisdom, Thanksgiving and honor and power and might, *Be* to our God forever and ever. Amen.

Revelation 19:1 After these things I heard a loud voice of a great multitude in heaven, saying, Alleluia! Salvation and glory and honor and power *belong* to the Lord our God!

Revelation 21:24 And the nations of those who are saved shall walk in its light, and the kings of the earth bring their glory and honor into it.

Revelation 21:26 And they shall bring the glory and the honor of the nations into it.

Strong's #4285 proegeomai pro-ay-geh'-om-a-hee AV-prefer 1; 1) to go before and show the way, to go before and lead, to go before as a leader.

James 2:1-7 My brethren, do not hold the faith of our Lord Jesus Christ, *the Lord* of glory, with partiality. 2 For if there should come into your assembly a man with gold rings, in fine apparel, and there should also come in a poor man in filthy clothes, 3 and you pay attention to the one wearing the fine clothes and say to him, You sit here in a good place, and say to the poor man, You stand there, or, Sit here at my footstool, 4 have you not shown partiality among yourselves, and become judges with evil thoughts? 5 Listen, my beloved brethren: Has God not chosen the poor of this world *to be* rich in faith and heirs of the kingdom which He promised to those who love Him? 6 But you have dishonored the poor man. Do not the rich oppress you and drag you into the courts? 7 Do they not blaspheme that noble Name by which you are called?

Strong's #4382 prosopolepsia pros-o-pol-ape-see'-ah AV-respect of persons 4; 1) respect of persons 2) partiality 2a) the fault of one who when called on to give judgment has respect of the outward circumstances of man and not to their intrinsic merits, and so prefers, as the more worthy, one who is rich, high born, or powerful, to another who does not have these qualities. (favoritism)

Proverbs 24:23 These things also belong to the wise. It is not good to have respect of persons in judgment.

Romans 2:11 For there is no partiality with God.

Ephesians 6:9 And you, masters, do the same things to them, giving up threatening, knowing that your own Master also is in heaven, and there is no partiality with Him.

Colossians 3:25 But he who does wrong will be repaid for what he has done, and there is no partiality.

James 2:1 My brethren, do not hold the faith of our Lord Jesus Christ, *the Lord* of glory, with partiality.
