## Not Lagging In Diligence - Romans 120

- Referred to Jesus helping those who came to Him for help including Blind Bart & the Gadarene Demoniac.
- Matthew 15:30 And great multitudes came unto Him, having with them those that were lame, blind, dumb, maimed, and many others, and cast them down at Jesus' feet; and He healed them:
- Romans 10:13 For whosoever shall call upon the Name of the Lord shall be saved.
- Matthew 11:28 Come unto Me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.
- Hebrews 13:8 Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever.
- Romans 12:2 And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.
- Romans 8:29 For whom He foreknew, He also predestined to be conformed to the Image of His Son, that He might be the firstborn among many brethren.
- Romans 12:11 not lagging in diligence, fervent in spirit, serving the Lord;
- James 4:17 Therefore, to him who knows to do good and does not do it, to him it is sin.
- Ezekiel 45:8 In the land shall be his possession in Israel: and My princes shall no more oppress My people; and the rest of the land shall they give to the house of Israel according to their tribes.
- Proverbs 22:22,23 Rob not the poor, because he is poor: neither oppress the afflicted in the gate: 23 For the LORD will plead their cause, and spoil the soul of those that spoiled them.
- Isaiah 19 Referred to bad leaders.
- Strongs #3636 okneros ok-nay-ros' AV-slothful 2, grievous 1; 3 1) sluggish, slothful, backward.
- Matthew 25:26 But his lord answered and said to him, You wicked and lazy <3636> (slothful) servant, you knew that I reap where I have not sown, and gather where I have not scattered seed.
- Romans 12:11 not lagging <3636> in diligence, fervent in spirit, serving the Lord;
- Philippians 3:1 Finally, my brethren, rejoice in the Lord. For me to write the same things to you *is* not tedious <3636>, but for you *it is* safe.
- James 1:25 But he who looks into the perfect law of liberty and continues in it, and is not a forgetful hearer but a doer of the work, this one will be blessed in what he does.
- Strongs #4710 spoude spoo-day' AV-diligence 5, haste 2, business 1, care 1, forwardness 1, earnest care 1, carefulness 1; 12 1) haste, with haste 2)

- earnestness, diligence 2a) earnestness in accomplishing, promoting, or striving after anything 2b) to give all diligence, interest one's self most earnestly.
- 1 Timothy 2:1,2 I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for all men; 2 For kings, and for all that are in authority; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty.
- 2 Corinthians 10:4 (For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;)
- Matthew 18:18 Assuredly, I say to you, whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven.
- Mark 3:27 No one can enter a strong man's house and plunder his goods, unless he first binds the strong man. And then he will plunder his house.
- Psalms 23:3A He restores my soul.
- Judges 16:16 And it came to pass, when she pressed him daily with her words, and urged him, so that his soul was vexed unto death;
- Mark 6:25 Immediately she came in with haste <4710> to the king and asked, saying, I want you to give me at once the head of John the Baptist on a platter.
- 1 Kings 2 Summarized of Adonijah asking for Abishag & his demise.
- Luke 1:39 Now Mary arose in those days and went into the hill country with haste <4710>, to a city of Judah,
- Romans 12:8 he who exhorts, in exhortation; he who gives, with liberality; he who leads, with diligence <4710>; he who shows mercy, with cheerfulness.
- Luke 12:48 But he who did not know, yet committed things deserving of stripes, shall be beaten with few. For everyone to whom much is given, from him much will be required; and to whom much has been committed, of him they will ask the more.
- Romans 12:11 not lagging in diligence <4710>, fervent in spirit, serving the Lord;
- 2 Corinthians 7:11 For observe this very thing, that you sorrowed in a godly manner: What diligence <4710> it produced in you, what clearing of yourselves, what indignation, what fear, what vehement desire, what zeal, what vindication! In all things you proved yourselves to be clear in this matter.
- 1 Corinthians 14 Referred to Paul's guidance for the use of the Gifts of the Holy Spirit.
- 2 Corinthians 7:12 Therefore, although I wrote to you, *I did* not *do it* for the sake of him who had done the wrong, nor for the sake of him who suffered wrong, but that our care <4710> for you in the sight of God might appear to you.
- 2 Corinthians 8:7 But as you abound in everything, in faith, in speech, in

- knowledge, in all diligence <4710>, and in your love for us, *see* that you abound in this grace also.
- Matthew 3:2 And (John Baptist) saying, Repent ye: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.
- Luke 10 Referred to the Parable of the Good Samaritan versus the religious leaders.
- 2 Corinthians 8:8 I speak not by commandment, but I am testing the sincerity of your love by the diligence <4710> of others.
- Job 1&2 Referred to Job's testings.
- Luke 4 Referred to Jesus tested in the wilderness.
- 2 Corinthians 8:16 But thanks *be* to God Who puts the same earnest care <4710> for you into the heart of Titus.
- 1 Samuel 10:9 And it was so, that when he had turned his back to go from Samuel, God gave him another heart: and all those signs came to pass that day.
- Hebrews 6:11 And we desire that each one of you show the same diligence to the full assurance of hope until the end,
- John 17:15 I pray not that thou shouldest take them out of the world, but that thou shouldest keep them from the evil.
- Matthew 24:12 And because lawlessness will abound, the love of many will grow cold.
- 2 Peter 1:5 But also for this very reason, giving all diligence <4710>, add to your faith virtue, to virtue knowledge,
- 2 Corinthians 5:14 For the love of Christ compels us, because we judge thus: that if One died for all, then all died;
- Genesis 3:5 For God doth know that in the day ye eat thereof, then your eyes shall be opened, and ye shall be as gods, knowing good and evil.
- Matthew 11:28 Come unto Me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.
- Jude 1:3 Beloved, while I was very diligent <4710> to write to you concerning our common salvation, I found it necessary to write to you exhorting you to contend earnestly for the faith which was once for all delivered to the saints.
- John 10:28,29 And I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; neither shall anyone snatch them out of My hand. 29 My Father, who has given them to Me, is greater than all; and no one is able to snatch them out of My Father's hand.
- Romans 6:1,2 What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin, that grace may abound? 2 God forbid. How shall we, that are dead to sin, live any longer therein?
- Luke 7:47 Therefore I say to you, her sins, which are many, are forgiven, for she loved much. But to whom little is forgiven, the same loves little.

1 Samuel 15:22 Then Samuel said: Has the LORD as great delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices, As in obeying the voice of the LORD? Behold, to obey is better than sacrifice, And to heed than the fat of rams.

Exodus 20:14 Thou shalt not commit adultery.

I will tear them from your arms, and let the souls go, the souls you hunt like birds. 21 I will also tear off your veils and deliver My people out of your hand, and they shall no longer be as prey in your hand. Then you shall know that I am the LORD. 22 Because with lies you have made the heart of the righteous sad, whom I have not made sad; and you have strengthened the hands of the wicked, so that he does not turn from his wicked way to save his life. 23 Therefore you shall no longer envision futility nor practice divination; for I will deliver My people out of your hand, and you shall know that I am the LORD.

Mark 16:6 But when he saw Jesus afar off, he ran and worshipped Him,

- Matthew 14:30 But when he saw that the wind was boisterous, he was afraid; and beginning to sink he cried out, saying, Lord, save me!
- Luke 15:17 But when he came to himself, he said, How many of my father's hired servants have bread enough and to spare, and I perish with hunger!
- Daniel 4:34 And at the end of the days I Nebuchadnezzar lifted up mine eyes unto heaven, and mine understanding returned unto me, and I blessed the Most High, and I praised and honoured Him that liveth for ever, Whose dominion is an everlasting dominion, and His kingdom is from generation to generation:
- Mark 12:41 And Jesus sat over against the treasury, and beheld how the people cast money into the treasury: and many that were rich cast in much.
- Matthew 6:5 And when thou prayest, thou shalt not be as the hypocrites are: for they love to pray standing in the synagogues and in the corners of the streets, that they may be seen of men. Verily I say unto you, They have their reward.
- Mark 12:42 And there came a certain poor widow, and she threw in two mites, which make a farthing.
- Luke 18 Summarized of the rich young ruler coming to Jesus.
- 1 Timothy 6:10 For the love of money is the root of all evil: which while some coveted after, they have erred from the faith, and pierced themselves through with many sorrows.
- Mark 12:43,44 And He called *unto Him* His disciples, and saith unto them, Verily I say unto you, That this poor widow hath cast more in, than all they which have cast into the treasury: 44 For all *they* did cast in of their abundance; but she of her want did cast in all that she had, *even* all her living.
- 1 Kings 17:1-16 And Elijah the Tishbite, who was of the inhabitants of Gilead, said unto Ahab, As the LORD God of Israel liveth, before Whom I stand, there shall not be dew nor rain these years, but according to my word. 2 And the Word of the LORD came unto him, saying, 3 Get thee hence, and turn thee eastward, and hide thyself by the brook Cherith, that is before Jordan. 4 And it shall be, that thou shalt drink of the brook; and I have commanded the ravens to feed thee there. 5 So he went and did according unto the Word of the LORD: for he went and dwelt by the brook Cherith, that is before Jordan. 6 And the ravens brought him bread and flesh in the morning, and bread and flesh in the evening; and he drank of the brook. 7 And it came to pass after a while, that the brook dried up, because there had been no rain in the land. 8 And the Word of the LORD came unto him, saying, 9 Arise, get thee to Zarephath, which belongeth to Zidon, (under Jezebel's Father's nose) and dwell there: behold, I have commanded a widow woman there to sustain thee. 10 So he arose and went to

Zarephath. And when he came to the gate of the city, behold, the widow woman was there gathering of sticks: and he called to her, and said, Fetch me, I pray thee, a little water in a vessel, that I may drink. 11 And as she was going to fetch it, he called to her, and said, Bring me, I pray thee, a morsel of bread in thine hand. 12 And she said, As the LORD thy God liveth, I have not a cake, but an handful of meal in a barrel, and a little oil in a cruse: and, behold, I am gathering two sticks, that I may go in and dress it for me and my son, that we may eat it, and die. 13 And Elijah said unto her, Fear not; go and do as thou hast said: but make me thereof a little cake first, and bring it unto me, and after make for thee and for thy son. 14 For thus saith the LORD God of Israel, The barrel of meal shall not waste, neither shall the cruse of oil fail, until the day that the LORD sendeth rain upon the earth. 15 And she went and did according to the saying of Elijah: and she, and he, and her house, did eat many days. 16 And the barrel of meal wasted not, neither did the cruse of oil fail, according to the Word of the LORD, which he spake by Elijah.

1 Kings 17:17-24 And it came to pass after these things, *that* the son of the woman, the mistress of the house, fell sick; and his sickness was so sore, that there was no breath left in him. 18 And she said unto Elijah, What have I to do with thee, O thou man of God? art thou come unto me to call my sin to remembrance, and to slay my son? 19 And he said unto her, Give me thy son. And he took him out of her bosom, and carried him up into a loft, where he abode, and laid him upon his own bed. 20 And he cried unto the LORD, and said, O LORD my God, hast Thou also brought evil upon the widow with whom I sojourn, by slaving her son? 21 And he stretched himself upon the child three times, and cried unto the LORD, and said, O LORD my God, I pray Thee, let this child's soul come into him again. 22 And the LORD heard the voice of Elijah; and the soul of the child came into him again, and he revived. 23 And Elijah took the child, and brought him down out of the chamber into the house, and delivered him unto his mother: and Elijah said, See, thy son liveth. 24 And the woman said to Elijah, Now by this I know that thou art a man of God, and that the Word of the LORD in thy mouth *is* truth.
