

Rejoicing In Hope - Romans 12Q

1 Timothy 1:1 Paul, an apostle of Jesus Christ by the commandment of God our Saviour, and Lord Jesus Christ, which is our hope;

John 14:3 And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto Myself; that where I am, there ye may be also.

Hebrews 13:8 Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever.

Romans 12:2 And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.

Romans 8:29 For whom He foreknew, He also predestined to be conformed to the image of His Son, that He might be the firstborn among many brethren.

Romans 12 Summarized of this chapter - Gifts of the Holy Spirit & commands.

John 15:20 Remember the Word that I said to you, A servant is not greater than his master. If they persecuted Me, they will also persecute you. If they kept My Word, they will keep yours also.

Job 1:21 And said, Naked came I out of my mother's womb, and naked shall I return thither: the LORD gave, and the LORD hath taken away; blessed be the name of the LORD.

Romans 12:12 rejoicing in hope, patient in tribulation, continuing steadfastly in prayer;

John 18:37 Pilate therefore said to Him, Are You a king then? Jesus answered, You say rightly that I am a king. For this cause I was born, and for this cause I have come into the world, that I should bear witness to the truth. Everyone who is of the truth hears My voice.

Revelation 19:11 Referred to Jesus' Return.

Revelation 22:20 He which testifieth these things saith, Surely I come quickly. Amen. Even so, come, Lord Jesus.

1 Kings 18:37 Hear me, O LORD, hear me, that this people may know that Thou art the LORD God, and that Thou hast turned their heart back again.

Daniel 7:4 The first was like a lion, and had eagle's wings: I beheld till the wings thereof were plucked, and it was lifted up from the earth, and made stand upon the feet as a man, and a man's heart was given to it.

Ezekiel 36:26 A new heart also will I give you, and a new spirit will I put within you: and I will take away the stony heart out of your flesh, and I will give you an heart of flesh.

Matthew 10:28 And fear not them which kill the body, but are not able to kill the soul: but rather fear Him which is able to destroy both soul and body in hell.

Revelation 20:10 And the devil that deceived them was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet are, and shall be

tormented day and night for ever and ever.

Luke 1 Referred to Mary's magnificate rejoicing of Jesus. V47 And my spirit has rejoiced in God my Savior.

1 Corinthians 13:13 And now abide faith, hope, love, these three; but the greatest of these is love.

1 Corinthians 15:19 If in this life only we have hope in Christ, we are of all men most miserable.

Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents & scorpions, & over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

Mark 16:17 And these signs will follow those who believe: In My Name they will cast out demons; they will speak with new tongues;

Luke 10:20 Notwithstanding in this rejoice not, that the spirits are subject unto you; but rather rejoice, because your names are written in heaven.

Psalms 9:2 I will be glad and rejoice in You; I will sing praise to Your name, O Most High.

Psalms 9:14 That I may tell of all Your praise In the gates of the daughter of Zion. I will rejoice in Your salvation.

Luke 16:24 And he cried and said, Father Abraham, have mercy on me, and send Lazarus, that he may dip the tip of his finger in water, and cool my tongue; for I am tormented in this flame.

Psalms 13:5 But I have trusted in Your mercy; My heart shall rejoice in Your salvation.

Psalms 136 every second line is: for His mercy endureth forever

Psalms 20:5 We will rejoice in your salvation, And in the Name of our God we will set up *our* banners! May the LORD fulfill all your petitions.

Psalms 31:7 I will be glad and rejoice in Your mercy, For You have considered my trouble; You have known my soul in adversities,

Psalms 33:1 Rejoice in the LORD, O you righteous! *For* praise from the upright is beautiful.

Mark 16:17,18 And these signs will follow those who believe: In My Name they will cast out demons; they will speak with new tongues; 18 they will take up serpents; and if they drink anything deadly, it will by no means hurt them; they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover.

Psalms 33:21 For our heart shall rejoice in Him, Because we have trusted in

His Holy Name.

Psalms 35:9 And my soul shall be joyful in the LORD; It shall rejoice in His salvation.

Psalms 63:11 But the king shall rejoice in God; Everyone who swears by Him shall glory; But the mouth of those who speak lies shall be stopped.

Psalms 66:6 He turned the sea into dry *land*; They went through the river on foot. There we will rejoice in Him.

Exodus 14:28 And the waters returned, and covered the chariots, and the horsemen, and all the host of Pharaoh that came into the sea after them; there remained not so much as one of them.

Exodus 8:1 And the LORD spoke to Moses, Go to Pharaoh and say to him, Thus says the LORD: Let My people go, that they may serve Me.

Psalms 85:6 Will You not revive us again, That Your people may rejoice in You?

2 Chronicles 20:22 And when they began to sing and to praise, the LORD set ambushments against the children of Ammon, Moab, and mount Seir, which were come against Judah; and they were smitten.

Psalms 89:12 The north and the south, You have created them; Tabor and Hermon rejoice in Your Name.

Matthew 21:15,16 And when the chief priests and scribes saw the wonderful things that he did, and the children crying in the temple, and saying, Hosanna to the Son of David; they were sore displeased, 16 And said unto him, Hearest thou what these say? And Jesus saith unto them, Yea; have ye never read, Out of the mouth of babes and sucklings thou hast perfected praise?

Isaiah 55:12 For ye shall go out with joy, and be led forth with peace: the mountains and the hills shall break forth before you into singing, and all the trees of the field shall clap their hands.

Psalms 97:12 Rejoice in the LORD, you righteous, And give thanks at the remembrance of His Holy Name.

Psalms 104:31 May the glory of the LORD endure forever; May the LORD rejoice in His works.

Psalms 106:5 That I may see the benefit of Your chosen ones, That I may rejoice in the gladness of Your nation, That I may glory with Your inheritance.

Psalms 119:14 I have rejoiced in the way of Your testimonies, As *much as* in all riches.

Psalms 149:2 Let Israel rejoice in their Maker; Let the children of Zion be joyful in their King.

The Gospel of Isaiah has much prophesy of Jesus'

Isaiah 6 Referred to Isaiah's vision of God.

Acts 9 Referred to Saul/Paul's vision of Jesus.

Isaiah 8:6 Inasmuch as these people refused The waters of Shiloah that flow softly, And rejoice in Rezin and in Remaliah's son;

Ezekiel 34:18 Seemeth it a small thing unto you to have eaten up the good pasture, but ye must tread down with your feet the residue of your pastures? and to have drunk of the deep waters, but ye must foul the residue with your feet?

Isaiah 13:3 I have commanded My sanctified ones; I have also called My mighty ones for My anger, Those who rejoice in My exaltation.

2 Samuel 23 Referred to David's 40 mighty men.

Joel 3:9 Proclaim ye this among the Gentiles; Prepare war, wake up the mighty men, let all the men of war draw near; let them come up:

Isaiah 25:9 And it will be said in that day: Behold, this *is* our God; We have waited for Him, and He will save us. This *is* the LORD; We have waited for Him; We will be glad and rejoice in His salvation.

John 16:7,13 Nevertheless I tell you the truth. It is to your advantage that I go away; for if I do not go away, the Helper (Comforter) will not come to you; but if I depart, I will send Him to you. 13 However, when He, the Spirit of truth, has come, He will guide you into all truth; for He will not speak on His own authority, but whatever He hears He will speak; and He will tell you things to come.

Mark 16:7 But go your way, tell His disciples and Peter that He goeth before you into Galilee: there shall ye see Him, as He said unto you.

Luke 10 Referred to the persistent widow.

Jeremiah 18:19 Give heed to me, O LORD, and hearken to the voice of them that contend with me.

Ephesians 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.

2 Corinthians 10:4 (For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;)

Matthew 16:19 And I will give unto thee the keys of the kingdom of heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.

Isaiah 29:19 The humble also shall increase *their* joy in the LORD, And the poor among men shall rejoice in the Holy One of Israel.

Matthew 19 Referred to the account of the rich young ruler. V23 Then Jesus said to His disciples, Assuredly, I say to you that it is hard for a rich man to enter the kingdom of heaven.

Isaiah 41:16 You shall winnow them, the wind shall carry them away, And the whirlwind shall scatter them; You shall rejoice in the LORD, *And* glory in the Holy One of Israel.

Isaiah 43:14 Thus says the LORD, your Redeemer, The Holy One of Israel: For

your sake I will send to Babylon, And bring them all down as fugitives, The Chaldeans, who rejoice in their ships.

2 Kings 19 Referred to God dealing with Sennacherib.

1 Kings 22:22 The LORD said to him, In what way? So he said, I will go out and be a lying spirit in the mouth of all his prophets. And the LORD said, You shall persuade him, and also prevail. Go out and do so.

1 Corinthians 14:29 Let the prophets speak two or three, and let the other judge.

Isaiah 61:7 Instead of your shame *you shall have double honor*, And *instead of* confusion they shall rejoice in their portion. Therefore in their land they shall possess double; Everlasting joy shall be theirs.

1 Thessalonians 5:18 In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you.

Isaiah 61:10 I will greatly rejoice in the LORD, My soul shall be joyful in my God; For He has clothed me with the garments of salvation, He has covered me with the robe of righteousness, As a bridegroom decks *himself* with ornaments, And as a bride adorns *herself* with her jewels.

Luke 4 Referred to Jesus reading this passage.

Matthew 3:17 And suddenly a voice came from heaven, saying, This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.

Luke 9:35 And a voice came out of the cloud, saying, This is My beloved Son. Hear Him!

Isaiah 65:19 I will rejoice in Jerusalem, And joy in My people; The voice of weeping shall no longer be heard in her, Nor the voice of crying.

2 Samuel 12:14 Howbeit, because by this deed thou hast given great occasion to the enemies of the LORD to blaspheme, the child also *that is* born unto thee shall surely die.

Luke 1:47 And my spirit has rejoiced in God my Savior.

Luke 6:23 Rejoice in that day and leap for joy! For indeed your reward *is* great in heaven, For in like manner their fathers did to the prophets.

Luke 10:20 Nevertheless do not rejoice in this, that the spirits are subject to you, but rather rejoice because your names are written in heaven.

Luke 10:17 And the seventy returned again with joy, saying, Lord, even the devils are subject unto us through Thy Name.

Luke 11:26 Then goeth he, and taketh to him seven other spirits more wicked than himself; and they enter in (the unsaved), and dwell there: and the last state of that man is worse than the first.

Luke 10:21 In that hour Jesus rejoiced in the Spirit and said, I thank You, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, that You have hidden these things from *the* wise and prudent and revealed them to babes. Even so, Father, for so it seemed good in Your sight.

Ephesians 1:13 In Him you also trusted, after you heard the Word of Truth,

the Gospel of your salvation; in Whom also, having believed, you were sealed with the Holy Spirit of promise,

Matthew 17:20 So Jesus said to them, Because of your unbelief; for assuredly, I say to you, if you have faith as a mustard seed, you will say to this mountain, Move from here to there, and it will move; and nothing will be impossible for you.

John 5:35 He was the burning and shining lamp, and you were willing for a time to rejoice in his light.

Matthew 3:5,6 Then went out to him (John Baptist) Jerusalem, and all Judaea, and all the region round about Jordan, 6 And were baptized of him in Jordan, confessing their sins.

Acts 19:1-4 And it came to pass, that, while Apollos was at Corinth, Paul having passed through the upper coasts came to Ephesus: and finding certain disciples, 2 He said unto them, Have ye received the Holy Ghost since ye believed? And they said unto him, We have not so much as heard whether there be any Holy Ghost. 3 And he said unto them, what then were ye baptized? And they said, Unto John's baptism. 4 Then said Paul, John verily baptized with the baptism of repentance, saying unto the people, that they should believe on him which should come after him, that is, on Christ Jesus.

Acts 7:41 And they made a calf in those days, offered sacrifices to the idol, and rejoiced in the works of their own hands.

Exodus 32 Summarized of the sin of the golden calf.

2 Kings 10 Referred to Jeroboam's golden calves.

Romans 5:2 through whom also we have access by faith into this grace in which we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God.

Mark 15:38 Then the veil of the temple was torn in two from top to bottom.

Romans 5:11 And not only *that*, but we also rejoice in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have now received the reconciliation.

Romans 12:12 rejoicing in hope, patient in tribulation, continuing steadfastly in prayer;

1 Corinthians 13:6 does not rejoice in iniquity, but rejoices in the truth;

Galatians 6:4 But let each one examine his own work, and then he will have rejoicing in himself alone, and not in another.

Philippians 2:16 holding fast the word of life, so that I may rejoice in the day of Christ that I have not run in vain or labored in vain.

2 Corinthians 5:8 We are confident, I say, and willing rather to be absent from the body, and to be present with the Lord.

Philippians 3:1 Finally, my brethren, rejoice in the Lord. For me to write the same things to you *is* not tedious, but for you *it is* safe.

Philippians 3:3 For we are the circumcision, who worship God in the Spirit, rejoice in Christ Jesus, and have no confidence in the flesh,

John 4:24 God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth.

Isaiah 64:6 But we are all as an unclean thing, and all our righteousnesses are as filthy rags; and we all do fade as a leaf; and our iniquities, like the wind, have taken us away.

Philippians 4:4 Rejoice in the Lord always. Again I will say, rejoice!

Philippians 4:10 But I rejoiced in the Lord greatly that now at last your care for me has flourished again; though you surely did care, but you lacked opportunity.

Colossians 1:24 I now rejoice in my sufferings for you, and fill up in my flesh what is lacking in the afflictions of Christ, for the sake of His body, which is the church,

2 Corinthians 12:7-9 And lest I should be exalted above measure by the abundance of the revelations, a thorn in the flesh was given to me, a messenger of Satan to buffet me, lest I be exalted above measure. 8 Concerning this thing I pleaded with the Lord three times that it might depart from me. 9 And He said to me, My grace is sufficient for you, for My strength is made perfect in weakness. Therefore most gladly I will rather boast in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me.

Luke 10:17-24 And the seventy returned again with joy, saying, Lord, even the devils are subject unto us through Thy Name. 18 And He said unto them, I beheld Satan as lightning fall from heaven. 19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you. 20 Notwithstanding in this rejoice not, that the spirits are subject unto you; but rather rejoice, because your names are written in heaven. 21 In that hour Jesus rejoiced in spirit, and said, I thank Thee, O Father, Lord of heaven and earth, that Thou hast hid these things from the wise and prudent, and hast revealed them unto babes: even so, Father; for so it seemed good in Thy sight. 22 All things are delivered to Me of My Father: and no man knoweth Who the Son is, but the Father; and Who the Father is, but the Son, and *He* to whom the Son will reveal *Him*. 23 And He turned Him unto *His* disciples, and said privately, Blessed *are* the eyes which see the things that ye see: 24 For I tell you, that many prophets and kings have desired to see those things which ye see, and have not seen *them*; and to hear those things which ye hear, and have not heard *them*.

Philippians 4:4 Rejoice in the Lord alway: and again I say, Rejoice.
