Patient In Tribulation - Romans 12R

- John 15:20 Remember the Word that I said unto you, The servant is not greater than his lord. If they have persecuted Me, they will also persecute you; if they have kept My saying, they will keep yours also.
- Revelation 13:17 And that no man might buy or sell, save he that had the mark, or the name of the beast, or the number of his name.
- Summarized of many in the early church were persecuted.
- 2 Corinthians 12:9 And He said unto me, My grace is sufficient for thee: for My strength is made perfect in weakness. Most gladly therefore will I rather glory in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me.
- Jesus was the best example for us.
- Hebrews 4:15 For we have not an high priest which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities; but was in all points tempted like as we are, yet without sin.
- Summarized of many of the temptations Jesus went through.
- Romans 12:12 rejoicing in hope, patient in tribulation, continuing steadfastly in prayer;
- Luke 23:34 Then said Jesus, Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do. And they parted his raiment, and cast lots.
- Mark 15:38 And the veil of the temple was rent in twain from the top to the bottom.
- Hebrews 12:2 Looking unto Jesus the Author and Finisher of our faith; Who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God.
- 1 John 2:1 My little children, these things write I unto you, that ye sin not.

 And if any man sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous:
- John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by Me.
- Matthew 24:4 And Jesus answered and said unto them, Take heed that no man deceive you.
- Strongs #5278 hupomeno hoop-om-en'-o AV-endure 11, take patiently 2, tarry behind 1, abide 1, patient 1, suffer 1; 17 1) to remain 1a) to tarry behind 2) to remain i.e. abide, not recede or flee 2a) to preserve: under misfortunes and trials to hold fast to one's faith in Christ 2b) to endure, bear bravely and calmly: ill treatments.
- Matthew 10:22 And you will be hated by all for My Name's sake. But he who endures <5278> to the end will be saved.
- 1 John 3:8 He that committeth sin is of the devil; for the devil sinneth from

- the beginning. For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that He might destroy the works of the devil.
- Matthew 24:13 But he who endures <5278> to the end shall be saved.
- Mark 13:13 And you will be hated by all for My Name's sake. But he who endures <5278> to the end shall be saved.
- Luke 2:43,46,47 When they had finished the days, as they returned, the Boy Jesus lingered behind <5278> in Jerusalem. And Joseph and His mother did not know *it*; 46 And it came to pass, that after three days they found him in the temple, sitting in the midst of the doctors, both hearing them, and asking them questions. 47 And all that heard Him were astonished at His understanding and answers.
- Acts 17:14 Then immediately the brethren sent Paul away, to go to the sea; but both Silas and Timothy remained <5278> there.
- Romans 12:12 rejoicing in hope, patient <5278> in tribulation, continuing steadfastly in prayer;
- 1 Corinthians 13:7 bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures <5278> all things.
- John 8 Summarized of the account of he woman caught in adultery. V11 She said, No man, Lord. And Jesus said unto her, Neither do I condemn thee: go, and sin no more.
- Romans 6:1 What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin, that grace may abound?
- Luke 4:12 And Jesus answering said unto him, It is said, Thou shalt not tempt the Lord thy God.
- 2 Timothy 2:10 Therefore I endure <5278> all things for the sake of the elect, that they also may obtain the salvation which is in Christ Jesus with eternal glory.
- Romans 14:21 It is good neither to eat flesh, nor to drink wine, nor any thing whereby thy brother stumbleth, or is offended, or is made weak.
- 2 Timothy 2:12 If we endure <5278>, We shall also reign with *Him*. If we deny *Him*, He also will deny us.
- Luke 8 Referred to the parable of the sower & the distractions to get people away from God.
- James 4:7 Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.
- Romans 8:29 For whom He did foreknow, He also did predestinate to be conformed to the image of His Son, that He might be the firstborn among many brethren.
- Romans 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.
- Hebrews 10:32 But recall the former days in which, after you were

- illuminated, you endured <5278> a great struggle with sufferings:
- Matthew 4 & Luke 4 Jesus rebutted the devil with the Word of God.
- Hebrews 4:12 For the word of God is quick, and powerful, and sharper than any twoedged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- Mark 16:15-18 And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. 16 He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned. 17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.
- Hebrews 12:2 looking unto Jesus, the author and finisher of *our* faith, who for the joy that was set before Him endured <5278> the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.
- Romans 10:13 For whosoever shall call upon the Name of the Lord shall be saved.
- Luke 23:42 And he said unto Jesus, Lord, remember me when Thou comest into Thy kingdom.
- Hebrews 12:3 For consider Him who endured <5278> such hostility from sinners against Himself, lest you become weary and discouraged in your souls.
- Hebrews 12:7 If you endure <5278> chastening, God deals with you as with sons; for what son is there whom a father does not chasten?
- James 1:12 Blessed *is* the man who endures <5278> temptation; for when he has been approved, he will receive the crown of life which the Lord has promised to those who love Him.
- 2 Corinthians 5:10 Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;
- Ephesians 6:16,17 Above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked. 17 And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the Word of God:
- James 5:11 Indeed we count them blessed who endure <5278>. You have heard of the perseverance of Job and seen the end *intended by* the Lord, that the Lord is very compassionate and merciful.
- Hebrews 11 Referred to God's hall fame.
- 1 Peter 2:20 For what credit *is it* if, when you are beaten for your faults, you

- take it patiently <5278>? But when you do good and suffer, if you take it patiently <5278>, this *is* commendable before God.
- Judges 7 Referred to Gideon's army.
- Matthew 10:23 But when they persecute you in this city, flee ye into another: for verily I say unto you, Ye shall not have gone over the cities of Israel, till the Son of man be come.
- Strongs #2347 thlipsis *thlip'-sis* AV-tribulation 21, affliction 17, trouble 3, anguish 1, persecution 1, burdened 1, to be afflicted + 1519 1; 45 1) a pressing, pressing together, pressure 2) metaph. oppression, affliction, tribulation, distress, straits.
- Matthew 13:21 yet he has no root in himself, but endures only for a while. For when tribulation <2347> or persecution arises because of the Word, immediately he stumbles.
- John 10:28,29 And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of My hand. 29 My Father, which gave them Me, is greater than all; and no man is able to pluck them out of My Father's hand.
- Referred to the religious leaders taking on Jesus & He rebutted them with the Word of God.
- Matthew 24:9 Then they will deliver you up to tribulation <2347> and kill you, and you will be hated by all nations for My Name's sake.
- Matthew 24:21 For then there will be great tribulation <2347>, such as has not been since the beginning of the world until this time, no, nor ever shall be.
- Matthew 24:29 Immediately after the tribulation <2347> of those days the sun will be darkened, and the moon will not give its light; the stars will fall from heaven, and the powers of the heavens will be shaken.
- Mark 4:17 and they have no root in themselves, and so endure only for a time. Afterward, when tribulation <2347> or persecution arises for the Word's sake, immediately they stumble.
- Revelation 6:14 And the heaven departed as a scroll when it is rolled together; and every mountain and island were moved out of their places.
- Exodus 10:22,23 And Moses stretched forth his hand toward heaven; and there was a thick darkness in all the land of Egypt three days: 23 They saw not one another, neither rose any from his place for three days: but all the children of Israel had light in their dwellings.
- Mark 13:19 For *in* those days there will be tribulation <2347>, such as has not been since the beginning of the creation which God created until this time, nor ever shall be.
- Mark 13:24 But in those days, after that tribulation <2347>, the sun will be darkened, and the moon will not give its light;
- John 16:21 A woman, when she is in labor, has sorrow because her hour has

- come; but as soon as she has given birth to the child, she no longer remembers the anguish <2347>, for joy that a human being has been born into the world.
- 1 Timothy 2:15 Notwithstanding she shall be saved in childbearing, if they continue in faith and charity and Holiness with sobriety.
- John 16:33 These things I have spoken to you, that in Me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation <2347>; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world.
- 1 Thessalonians 5:18 In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you.
- Acts 7:10,11 and delivered him out of all his troubles <2347>, and gave him favor and wisdom in the presence of Pharaoh, king of Egypt; and he made him governor over Egypt and all his house. 11 Now a famine and great trouble <2347> came over all the land of Egypt and Canaan, and our fathers found no sustenance.
- Acts 11:19 Now those who were scattered after the persecution <2347> that arose over Stephen traveled as far as Phoenicia, Cyprus, and Antioch, preaching the Word to no one but the Jews only.
- Hebrews 12:2 Looking unto Jesus the Author and Finisher of our faith; Who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God.
- Acts 14:22 strengthening the souls of the disciples, exhorting *them* to continue in the faith, and *saying*, We must through many tribulations <2347> enter the kingdom of God.

Summarized of David's tribulations.

Acts 20:23 except that the Holy Spirit testifies in every city, saying that chains and tribulations <2347> await me.

Summarized of Paul's tribulations.

- Acts 23:11 And the night following the Lord stood by him, and said, Be of good cheer, Paul: for as thou hast testified of Me in Jerusalem, so must thou bear witness also at Rome.
- Romans 2:9 tribulation <2347> and anguish, on every soul of man who does evil, of the Jew first and also of the Greek;
- Romans 5:3 And not only *that*, but we also glory in tribulations <2347>, knowing that tribulation <2347> produces perseverance;
- Romans 8:35,39 Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? *Shall* tribulation <2347>, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? 39 Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.
- Romans 12:12 rejoicing in hope, patient in tribulation <2347>, continuing steadfastly in prayer;
- 1 Corinthians 7:28 But even if you do marry, you have not sinned; and if a

- virgin marries, she has not sinned. Nevertheless such will have trouble <2347> in the flesh, but I would spare you.
- 2 Corinthians 1:3,4 Blessed be God, even the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of mercies, and the God of all comfort; 4 who comforts us in all our tribulation <2347>, that we may be able to comfort those who are in any trouble <2347>, with the comfort with which we ourselves are comforted by God.
- John 13:34,35 A new commandment I give unto you, That ye love one another; as I have loved you, that ye also love one another. 35 By this shall all men know that ye are My disciples, if ye have love one to another.
- Acts 2:44 And all that believed were together, and had all things common;
- 2 Corinthians 1:8 For we do not want you to be ignorant, brethren, of our trouble <2347> which came to us in Asia: that we were burdened beyond measure, above strength, so that we despaired even of life.
- Acts 14:19 And there came thither certain Jews from Antioch and Iconium, who persuaded the people, and, having stoned Paul, drew him out of the city, supposing he had been dead.
- 2 Corinthians 2:4 For out of much affliction <2347> and anguish of heart I wrote to you, with many tears, not that you should be grieved, but that you might know the love which I have so abundantly for you.
- Revelation 1:9 I, John, both your brother and companion in the tribulation <2347> and kingdom and patience of Jesus Christ, was on the island that is called Patmos for the Word of God and for the testimony of Jesus Christ.
- Revelation 2:9,10 I know your works, tribulation <2347>, and poverty (but you are rich); and *I know* the blasphemy of those who say they are Jews and are not, but *are* a synagogue of Satan. 10 Do not fear any of those things which you are about to suffer. Indeed, the devil is about to throw *some* of you into prison, that you may be tested, and you will have tribulation <2347> ten days. Be faithful until death, and I will give you the crown of life.
- Acts 16 Referred to Paul freed from prison.
- Acts 12 Referred to Peter freed from prison.
- Revelation 2:22 Indeed I will cast her into a sickbed, and those who commit adultery with her into great tribulation <2347>, unless they repent of their deeds.
- Revelation 7:14 And I said to him, Sir, you know. So he said to me, These are the ones who come out of the great tribulation <2347>, and washed their robes and made them white in the Blood of the Lamb.
- Hebrews 13:5 Let your conversation be without covetousness; and be content with such things as ye have: for He hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee.

More service Notes:

- 2 Corinthians 4:17 For our light affliction <2347>, which is but for a moment, is working for us a far more exceeding *and* eternal weight of glory,
- 2 Corinthians 6:4 But in all *things* we commend ourselves as ministers of God: in much patience, in tribulations <2347>, in needs, in distresses,
- 2 Corinthians 7:4 Great *is* my boldness of speech toward you, great *is* my boasting on your behalf. I am filled with comfort. I am exceedingly joyful in all our tribulation <2347>.
- 2 Corinthians 8:2 that in a great trial of affliction <2347> the abundance of their joy and their deep poverty abounded in the riches of their liberality.
- 2 Corinthians 8:13 For *I do* not *mean* that others should be eased and you burdened <2347>;
- Ephesians 3:13 Therefore I ask that you do not lose heart at my tribulations <2347> for you, which is your glory.
- Philippians 1:16 The former preach Christ from selfish ambition, not sincerely, supposing to add affliction <2347> to my chains;
- Philippians 4:14 Nevertheless you have done well that you shared in my distress <2347>.
- Colossians 1:24 I now rejoice in my sufferings for you, and fill up in my flesh what is lacking in the afflictions <2347> of Christ, for the sake of His body, which is the church,
- 1 Thessalonians 1:6 And you became followers of us and of the Lord, having received the word in much affliction <2347>, with joy of the Holy Spirit,
- 1 Thessalonians 3:3,7 that no one should be shaken by these afflictions <2347>; for you yourselves know that we are appointed to this. 7 therefore, brethren, in all our affliction <2347> and distress we were comforted concerning you by your faith.
- 2 Thessalonians 1:4,6 so that we ourselves boast of you among the churches of God for your patience and faith in all your persecutions and tribulations <2347> that you endure, 6 since it is a righteous thing with God to repay with tribulation <2347> those who trouble you,
- Hebrews 10:33 partly while you were made a spectacle both by reproaches and tribulations <2347>, and partly while you became companions of those who were so treated;
- James 1:27 Pure and undefiled religion before God and the Father is this: to visit orphans and widows in their trouble <2347>, and to keep oneself unspotted from the world.
