- Romans 12 Referred to the gifts of the Holy Spirit given out.
- Romans 12:13 distributing to the needs of the saints, given to hospitality.
- Summarized of Salvation by Jesus.
- James 2 Referred to James' writings on Faith versus Works.
- Romans 1:7 To all that be in Rome, beloved of God, called to be saints: Grace to you and peace from God our Father, and the Lord Jesus Christ.
- Mark 14:7,8 For ye have the poor with you always, and whensoever ye will ye may do them good: but Me ye have not always. 8 She hath done what she could: she is come aforehand to anoint My body to the burying.
- 1 Timothy 5:8 But if any provide not for his own, and specially for those of his own house, he hath denied the faith, and is worse than an infidel.
- Genesis 2:22 And the rib, which the LORD God had taken from man, made he a woman, and brought her unto the man.
- Daniel 1:8 Daniel purposed in his heart that he would not defile himself with the portion of the king's meat, nor with the wine which he drank: therefore he requested of the prince of the eunuchs that he might not defile himself.
- Luke 22:31,32 And the Lord said, Simon, Simon, behold, Satan hath desired to have you, that he may sift you as wheat: 32 But I have prayed for thee, that thy faith fail not: and when thou art converted, strengthen thy brethren.
- Matthew 24:12 because iniquity shall abound the love of many shall wax cold.
- Colossians 3:23 whatever ye do, do it heartily, as to the Lord, & not unto men;
- Strongs #2841 koinoneo *koy-no-neh'-o* AV-be partaker 5, communicate 2, distribute 1; 8 1) to come into communion or fellowship with, to become a sharer, be made a partner 2) to enter into fellowship, join one's self to an associate, make one's self a sharer or partner.
- Romans 12:13 distributing to the needs of the saints, given to hospitality.
- Romans 15:27 It pleased them indeed, and they are their debtors. For if the Gentiles have been partakers <2841> of their spiritual things, their duty is also to minister to them in material things.
- Galatians 6:6 Let him who is taught the Word share <2841> in all good things with him who teaches.
- Luke 10:7 remain in the same house, eating and drinking such things as they give, for the laborer is worthy of his wages. Do not go from house to house.
- Philippians 4:15 Now you Philippians know also that in the beginning of the Gospel, when I departed from Macedonia, no church shared with <2841> me concerning giving and receiving but you only.
- Acts 20:34 Yea, ye yourselves know, that these hands have ministered unto my necessities, and to them that were with me.
- Acts 18:3 And because he was of the same craft, he abode with them, and

- wrought: for by their occupation they were tentmakers.
- 1 Timothy 5:22 Do not lay hands on anyone hastily, nor share <2841> in other people's sins; keep yourself pure.
- 1 Timothy 3 Referred to the Religious Leaders qualifications. V6 Not a novice, lest being lifted up with pride he fall into the condemnation of the devil.
- Romans 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.
- Romans 8:29 For whom He did foreknow, He also did predestinate to be conformed to the Image of his Son, that He might be the firstborn among many brethren.
- Leviticus 18&20 Referred to God's laws on morality.
- Galatians 6:1 Brethren, if a man is overtaken in any trespass, you who are spiritual restore such a one in a spirit of gentleness, considering yourself lest you also be tempted.
- Hebrews 2:14 Inasmuch then as the children have partaken <2841> of flesh and blood, He Himself likewise shared in the same, that through death He might destroy him who had the power of death, that is, the devil,
- 1 Peter 4:13 but rejoice to the extent that you partake <2841> of Christ's sufferings, that when His glory is revealed, you may also be glad with exceeding joy.
- John 15:20 Remember the word that I said to you, A servant is not greater than his master. If they persecuted Me, they will also persecute you. If they kept My Word, they will keep yours also.
- 2 Corinthians 11 Referred to Paul's "in Perils list".
- 1 Thessalonians 5:18 In every thing give thanks: ...
- 2 Corinthians 12:9 And He said to me, My grace is sufficient for you, for My strength is made perfect in weakness. Therefore most gladly I will rather boast in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me.
- 2 John 1:10,11 If there come any unto you, and bring not this doctrine, receive him not into your house, neither bid him God speed: 11 for he who greets him shares <2841> in his evil deeds.
- Strongs #5532 chreia *khri'-ah* AV-need 25, need + 2192 14, necessity 3, use 2, needful 1, necessary 1, business 1, lack 1, wants 1; 49 1) necessity, need 2) duty, business.
- Matthew 6:8 Therefore do not be like them. For your Father knows the things you have <u>need</u> of <5532> before you ask Him.
- Matthew 6:11 Give us this day our daily bread.
- Matthew 21:3 And if anyone says anything to you, you shall say, The Lord has <u>need <5532></u> of them, and immediately he will send them.
- Mark 2:25 But He said to them, Have you never read what David did when he was in <u>need <5532></u> and hungry, he and those with him:

- 1 Samuel 21:3 Summarized of David getting showbread & Saul killing priests.
- Luke 9:11 But when the multitudes knew *it*, they followed Him; and He received them and spoke to them about the kingdom of God, and healed those who had need <5532> of healing.
- Matthew 4:23-25 And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing all kinds of sickness and all kinds of disease among the people. 24 Then His fame went throughout all Syria; and they brought to Him all sick people who were afflicted with various diseases and torments, and those who were demonpossessed, epileptics, and paralytics; and He healed them. 25 Great multitudes followed Him, from Galilee, and from Decapolis, Jerusalem, Judea, and beyond the Jordan.
- In the Gospel of Mark, more people are healed by deliverance than healing.
- James 5:14 Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord:
- Mark 16:17 And these signs will follow those who believe: In My Name they will cast out demons; they will speak with new tongues;
- Leviticus 14:2 This shall be the law of the leper in the day of his cleansing: He shall be brought unto the priest:
- Luke 10:42 But one thing is <u>needed <5532></u>, and Mary has chosen that good part, which will not be taken away from her.
- John 2:25 and had no <u>need <5532></u> that anyone should testify of man, for He knew what was in man.
- John 13:10 Jesus said to him, He who is bathed <u>needs <5532></u> only to wash his feet, but is completely clean; and you are clean, but not all of you.
- John 13:8,9 Peter said to Him, You shall never wash my feet! Jesus answered him, If I do not wash you, you have no part with Me. 9 Simon Peter said to Him, Lord, not my feet only, but also my hands and my head!
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- John 5&8 Referred to that Jesus said "Go & sin no more"
- John 13:29 For some thought, because Judas had the money box, that Jesus had said to him, Buy *those things* we <u>need <5532></u> for the feast, or that he should give something to the poor.
- John 16:30 Now we are sure that You know all things, and have no <u>need</u> <5532> that anyone should question You. By this we believe that You came forth from God.
- Acts 2:45 and sold their possessions and goods, and divided them among all, as anyone had need <5532>.
- Acts 4:35 and laid *them* at the apostles' feet; and they distributed to each as anyone had need <5532>.
- Mark 10 Referred to the Rich young Ruler & his riches.

- Romans 12:13 distributing to the <u>needs</u> of the saints, given to hospitality.
- Ephesians 4:28 Let him who stole steal no longer, but rather let him labor, working with *his* hands what is good, that he may have something to give him who has <u>need <5532></u>.
- Matthew 13:55 Is this not the carpenter's son? Is not His mother called Mary? And His brothers James, Joses, Simon, and Judas?
- Philippians 2:25 Yet I considered it necessary to send to you Epaphroditus, my brother, fellow worker, and fellow soldier, but your messenger and the one who ministered to my <u>need</u> <5532>;
- Philippians 4:19 And my God shall supply all your <u>need <5532></u> according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus.
- James 4:3 Ye ask, and receive not, because ye ask amiss, that ye may consume it upon your lusts.
- 1 Thessalonians 4:9 But concerning brotherly love you have no <u>need <5532></u> that I should write to you, for you yourselves are taught by God to love one another;
- Titus 3:14 And let our *people* also learn to maintain good works, to *meet* urgent needs <5532>, that they may not be unfruitful.
- Hebrews 10:36 For you have <u>need <5532></u> of endurance, so that after you have done the will of God, you may receive the promise:
- 1 John 2:27 But the anointing which you have received from Him abides in you, and you do not <u>need <5532></u> that anyone teach you; but as the same anointing teaches you concerning all things, and is true, and is not a lie, and just as it has taught you, you will abide in Him.
- 1 John 3:17 whoever has this world's goods, & sees his brother in <u>need</u> <<u>5532</u>, & shuts up his heart from him, how does the love of God abide in him?
- Revelation 3:17 Because you say, I am rich, have become wealthy, and have <a href="need"><u>need</u><a href="need"><u>15532</u></a> of nothing, and do not know that you are wretched, miserable, poor, blind, and naked,
- Revelation 21:23 The city had no <u>need <5532></u> of the sun or of the moon to shine in it, for the glory of God illuminated it. The Lamb *is* its light.
- Revelation 22:5 There shall be no night there: They <u>need <5532></u> no lamp nor light of the sun, for the Lord God gives them light. And they shall reign forever and ever.
- Strongs #40 hagios hag'-ee-os AV-Holy 161, saints 61, Holy One 4, misc 3; 229 Holy, characteristic of God, separated to God, worthy of veneration 1) Its highest application is to God himself, in his purity, majesty and glory. {Luk 1:49 John 17:11 Rev 4:8} 1a) Of things and places which have a claim to reverence as sacred to God, e.g. the Temple: {Mt 24:15 Heb 9:1} 1b) Of persons employed by him, as angels: {1Th 3:13} prophets, {Luk 1:70} apostles, {Eph 3:5} 2) Applied to persons as separated to God's service: 2a) Of Christ: {Mr 1:24 Act 4:30} 2b) Of Christians: {Act 9:13 Rom 1:7 Heb 6:10 Rev

- Leviticus 11:45 For I am the LORD that bringeth you up out of the land of Egypt, to be your God: ye shall therefore be Holy, for I am Holy.
- Matthew 5:48 Be ye therefore perfect, even as your Father which is in heaven is perfect.
- Matthew 4:23-25, Matthew 5 Referred to Jesus ministering to the people.
- Matthew 27:52-54 and the graves were opened; and many bodies of the <u>saints <40></u> who had fallen asleep were raised; 53 And came out of the graves after his resurrection, and went into the holy city, and appeared unto many. 54 Now when the centurion, and they that were with him, watching Jesus, saw the earthquake, and those things that were done, they feared greatly, saying, Truly this was the Son of God.
- Acts 4:32-37 V32,33 Now the multitude of those who believed were of one heart and one soul; neither did anyone say that any of the things he possessed was his own, but they had all things in common. 33 And with great power the apostles gave witness to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus. And great grace was upon them all.
- Romans 15:19 Through mighty signs and wonders, by the power of the Spirit of God; so that from Jerusalem, and round about unto Illyricum, I have fully preached the gospel of Christ.
- Mark 16:20 And they went forth, and preached every where, the Lord working with them, and confirming the word with signs following. Amen.
- Mark 9:28,29 And when He had come into the house, His disciples asked Him privately, Why could we not cast it out? 29 So He said to them, This kind can come out by nothing but prayer and fasting.
- Acts 4:34,35 Nor was there anyone among them who lacked; for all who were possessors of lands or houses sold them, and brought the proceeds of the things that were sold, 35 and laid *them* at the apostles' feet; and they distributed to each as anyone had need.
- John 13:34,35 A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another; as I have loved you, that you also love one another. 35 By this all will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another.
- Acts 4:36,37 Joses, who was also named Barnabas by the apostles (which is translated Son of Encouragement), a Levite of the country of Cyprus, 37 having land, sold *it*, and brought the money and laid *it* at the apostles' feet. Summarized of Barnabus ministering with Paul & later with Mark.
- Matthew 7:5 Thou hypocrite, first cast out the beam out of thine own eye; and then shalt thou see clearly to cast out the mote out of thy brother's eye.
