Bless And Not Curse - Romans 12V

- Leviticus 24:20 fracture for fracture, eye for eye, tooth for tooth; as he has caused disfigurement of a man, so shall it be done to him. (OT)
- Matthew 5:38,39,44 You have heard that it was said, An eye for an eye and a tooth for a tooth. 39 But I tell you not to resist an evil person. But whoever slaps you on your right cheek, turn the other to him also. 44 But I say to you, love your enemies, bless those who curse you, do good to those who hate you, and pray for those who spitefully use you and persecute you,
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give you the authority to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- Proverbs 22:22,23 Rob not the poor, because he is poor: neither oppress the afflicted in the gate: 23 For the LORD will plead their cause, and spoil the soul of those that spoiled them.
- Ezekiel 45:8 In the land shall be his possession in Israel: and My princes shall no more oppress My people; and the rest of the land shall they give to the house of Israel according to their tribes.
- Luke 4 Jesus responded to the devils' temptations with Scripture.

- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- Matthew 6:12,14,15 And forgive us our debts, As we forgive our debtors. 14 For if you forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. 15 But if you do not forgive men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.

- Hebrews 12:7 If you endure chastening, God deals with you as with sons; for what son is there whom a father does not chasten?
- Jeremiah 18 Referred to the potter molding the clay.
- Matthew 5:4 Blessed are those who mourn, For they shall be comforted.
- John 14:26 But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost, Whom the Father will send in My Name, He shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you.
- Matthew 5:5 Blessed are the meek, For they shall inherit the earth.
- Numbers 12:3 (Now the man Moses was very meek, above all the men which

- were upon the face of the earth.)
- Exodus 34:28 So he was there with the LORD forty days and forty nights; he neither ate bread nor drank water. And He wrote on the tablets the words of the covenant, the Ten Commandments.
- Matthew 5:6 Blessed *are* those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, For they shall be filled.

- Luke 9:54,55 And when His disciples James and John saw this, they said,

- Lord, do You want us to command fire to come down from heaven and consume them, just as Elijah did? 55 But He turned and rebuked them, and said, You do not know what manner of spirit you are of.
- Matthew 5:44 But I say to you, love your enemies, bless those who curse <2672> you, do good to those who hate you, and pray for those who spitefully use you and persecute you,
- Psalms 35:13 But as for me, when they were sick, My clothing was sackcloth; I humbled myself with fasting; & my prayer would return to my own heart.
- Matthew 25:41 Then He will also say to those on the left hand, Depart from Me, you cursed <2672>, into the everlasting fire prepared for the devil and his angels: 46 And these will go away into everlasting <166> punishment, but the righteous into eternal <166> life.
- Strongs #166 aionios ahee-o'-nee-os AV-eternal 42, everlasting 25, for ever 1; 71 1) without beginning and end, that which always has been and always will be 2) without beginning 3) without end, never to cease, everlasting
- Luke 16:26 And beside all this, between us and you there is a great gulf fixed: so that they which would pass from hence to you cannot; neither can they pass to us, that would come from thence.
- Mark 11:21 And Peter, remembering, said to Him, Rabbi, look! The fig tree which You cursed <2672> has withered away.
- Luke 13 Summarized of the tree bearing no fruit.
- Luke 6:28 bless those who curse <2672> you, and pray for those who spitefully use you.
- Romans 12:14 Bless those who persecute you; bless and do not curse <2672>. James 3:9 With it we bless our God and Father, and with it we curse <2672> men, who have been made in the similitude of God.
- 1 Samuel 19:1 And Saul spake to Jonathan his son, and to all his servants, that they should kill David.
- 1 Samuel 26:1-25 V1-8 Now the Ziphites came to Saul at Gibeah, saying, Is David not hiding in the hill of Hachilah, opposite Jeshimon? 2 Then Saul arose and went down to the Wilderness of Ziph, having three thousand chosen men of Israel with him, to seek David in the Wilderness of Ziph. 3 And Saul encamped in the hill of Hachilah, which is opposite Jeshimon, by the road. But David stayed in the wilderness, and he saw that Saul came after him into the wilderness. 4 David therefore sent out spies, and understood that Saul had indeed come. 5 So David arose and came to the place where Saul had encamped. And David saw the place where Saul lay, and Abner the son of Ner, the commander of his army. Now Saul lay within the camp, with the people encamped all around him. 6 Then David answered, and said to Ahimelech the Hittite and to Abishai the son of Zeruiah, brother of Joab, saying, Who will go down with me to Saul in the camp? And Abishai said, I will go down with you. 7 So David and Abishai came to the

people by night; and there Saul lay sleeping within the camp, with his spear stuck in the ground by his head. And Abner and the people lay all around him. 8 Then Abishai said to David, God has delivered your enemy into your hand this day. Now therefore, please, let me strike him at once with the spear, right to the earth; and I will not have to strike him a second time! Judges 4 Summarized of Sisera killed by Jael.

- 1 Samuel 26:9-11 And David said to Abishai, Do not destroy him; for who can stretch out his hand against the LORD'S anointed, and be guiltless? 10 David said furthermore, *As* the LORD lives, the LORD shall strike him, or his day shall come to die, or he shall go out to battle and perish. 11 The LORD forbid that I should stretch out my hand against the LORD'S anointed. But please, take now the spear and the jug of water that *are* by his head, and let us go.
- Luke 4:3 And the devil said to Him, If You are the Son of God, command this stone to become bread.
- 1 Samuel 26:12-19 So David took the spear and the jug of water by Saul's head, & they got away; & no man saw it or knew it or awoke. For they were all asleep, because a deep sleep from the LORD had fallen on them. 13 Now David went over to the other side, and stood on the top of a hill afar off, a great distance being between them. 14 And David called out to the people and to Abner the son of Ner, saying, Do you not answer, Abner? Then Abner answered and said, Who are you, calling out to the king? 15 So David said to Abner, *Are* you not a man? And who *is* like you in Israel? Why then have you not guarded your lord the king? For one of the people came in to destroy your lord the king. 16 This thing that you have done is not good. As the LORD lives, you deserve to die, because you have not guarded your master, the LORD'S anointed. And now see where the king's spear is, and the jug of water that was by his head. 17 Then Saul knew David's voice. & said, Is that your voice, my son David? And David said, It is my voice, my lord, O king. 18 And he said, Why does my lord thus pursue his servant? For what have I done, or what evil *is* in my hand? 19 Now therefore, please, let my lord the king hear the words of his servant: If the LORD has stirred you up against me, let Him accept an offering. But if it is the children of men, may they be cursed before the LORD, for they have driven me out this day from sharing in the inheritance of the LORD, saying, Go, serve other gods.

Daniel 10 Referred to the battle in the heavenlies.

- Ephesians 6:12 For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places.
- Luke 23:32-43 There were also two others, criminals, led with Him to be put to death. 33 And when they had come to the place called Calvary, there they crucified Him, and the criminals, one on the right hand and the other

on the left. 34 Then Jesus said, Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they do. And they divided His garments and cast lots.

Summarized of salvation by Jesus.

- 1 Corinthians 15:19 If in this life only we have hope in Christ, we are of all men most miserable.
- 2 Kings 2:14 And he took the mantle of Elijah that fell from him, and smote the waters, and said, Where is the LORD God of Elijah? and when he also had smitten the waters, they parted hither and thither: and Elisha went over.
- 2 Kings 2:23,24 Then he went up from there to Bethel; and as he was going up the road, some youths came from the city & mocked him, & said to him, Go up, you baldhead! Go up, you baldhead! 24 So he turned around and looked at them, & pronounced a curse on them in the Name of the LORD. And two female bears came out of the woods and mauled forty-two of the youths.
- 2 Kings 6:13-23 V13-16 So he said, Go and see where he *is*, that I may send and get him. And it was told him, saying, Surely *he is* in Dothan. 14 Therefore he sent horses and chariots and a great army there, and they came by night and surrounded the city. 15 And when the servant of the man of God arose early and went out, there was an army, surrounding the city with horses and chariots. And his servant said to him, Alas, my master! What shall we do? 16 So he answered, Do not fear, for those who *are* with us *are* more than those who *are* with them.
- Hebrews 1:14 Are they not all ministering spirits, sent forth to minister for them who shall be heirs of salvation?
- 2 Kings 6:17,18 And Elisha prayed, and said, LORD, I pray, open his eyes that he may see. Then the LORD opened the eyes of the young man, and he saw. And behold, the mountain was full of horses and chariots of fire all around Elisha. 18 So when the Syrians came down to him, Elisha prayed to the LORD, and said, Strike this people, I pray, with blindness. And He struck them with blindness according to the word of Elisha.
- 2 Kings 1 Referred to Elijah calling down fire from heaven.
- 2 Kings 6:19-23 Now Elisha said to them, This is not the way, nor is this the city. Follow me, and I will bring you to the man whom you seek. But he led them to Samaria. 20 So it was, when they had come to Samaria, that Elisha said, LORD, open the eyes of these men, that they may see. And the LORD opened their eyes, and they saw; and there they were, inside Samaria! 21 Now when the king of Israel saw them, he said to Elisha, My father, shall I kill them? Shall I kill them? 22 But he answered, You shall not kill them. Would you kill those whom you have taken captive with your sword and your bow? Set food and water before them, that they may eat and drink and go to their master. 23 Then he prepared a great feast for them; and after they ate and drank, he sent them away and they went to their master. So the bands of Syrian raiders came no more into the land of Israel.

Acts 13:8-11 But Elymas the sorcerer (for so his name is translated) withstood them, seeking to turn the proconsul away from the faith. 9 Then Saul, who also is called Paul, filled with the Holy Spirit, looked intently at him 10 and said, 0 full of all deceit and all fraud, you son of the devil, you enemy of all righteousness, will you not cease perverting the straight ways of the Lord? 11 And now, indeed, the hand of the Lord is upon you, and you shall be blind, not seeing the sun for a time. And immediately a dark mist fell on him, and he went around seeking someone to lead him by the hand. More service Notes.

- 1 Samuel 26:20-25 So now, do not let my blood fall to the earth before the face of the LORD. For the king of Israel has come out to seek a flea, as when one hunts a partridge in the mountains. 21 Then Saul said, I have sinned. Return, my son David. For I will harm you no more, because my life was precious in your eyes this day. Indeed I have played the fool and erred exceedingly. 22 And David answered and said, Here is the king's spear. Let one of the young men come over and get it. 23 May the LORD repay every man for his righteousness and his faithfulness; for the LORD delivered you into my hand today, but I would not stretch out my hand against the LORD'S anointed. 24 And indeed, as your life was valued much this day in my eyes, so let my life be valued much in the eyes of the LORD, and let Him deliver me out of all tribulation. 25 Then Saul said to David, May you be blessed, my son David! You shall both do great things and also still prevail. So David went on his way, and Saul returned to his place.
- Luke 23:35-43 And the people stood looking on. But even the rulers with them sneered, saying, He saved others; let Him save Himself if He is the Christ, the chosen of God. 36 The soldiers also mocked Him, coming and offering Him sour wine, 37 and saying, If You are the King of the Jews, save Yourself. 38 And an inscription also was written over Him in letters of Greek, Latin, and Hebrew: THIS IS THE KING OF THE JEWS. 39 Then one of the criminals who were hanged blasphemed Him, saying, If You are the Christ, save Yourself and us. 40 But the other, answering, rebuked him, saying, Do you not even fear God, seeing you are under the same condemnation? 41 And we indeed justly, for we receive the due reward of our deeds; but this Man has done nothing wrong. 42 Then he said to Jesus, Lord, remember me when You come into Your kingdom. 43 And Jesus said to him, Assuredly, I say to you, today you will be with Me in Paradise.
