

Rejoice And Weep - Romans 12W

Luke 15:9 And when she has found it, she calls her friends and neighbors together, saying, Rejoice with me, for I have found the piece which I lost!

Matthew 9:36 But when he saw the multitudes, he was moved with compassion on them, because they fainted, and were scattered abroad, as sheep having no shepherd.

John 2:1 And the third day there was a marriage in Cana of Galilee; and the mother of Jesus was there:

Luke 19:17-20 Then the seventy returned with joy, saying, Lord, even the demons are subject to us in Your Name. 18 And He said to them, I saw Satan fall like lightning from heaven. 19 Behold, I give you the authority to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt you. 20 Nevertheless do not rejoice in this, that the spirits are subject to you, but rather rejoice because your names are written in heaven.

Mark 16:17 And these signs will follow those who believe: In My Name they will cast out demons; they will speak with new tongues;

Romans 12:15 Rejoice with those who rejoice, & weep with those who weep.

John 3:16 For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.

Summarized of Salvation by Jesus.

1 Corinthians 6:19,20 Or do you not know that your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you, whom you have from God, and you are not your own? 20 For you were bought at a price; therefore glorify God in your body and in your spirit, which are God's.

John 16:8 And when He is come, He will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment:

1 John 4:19 We love Him, because He first loved us.

Luke 10 Referred to the Good Samaritan helping the injured man.

Luke 17 Referred to the 10 lepers healed & just 1 Samaritan thanked Jesus.

Mark 7 Summarized of the Syrophenician woman asking Jesus to cast the devil out of her daughter. **Luke 18** Referred to the persistent widow.

2 Kings 2 Elisha cursing & she bears killing 42 children.

2 Kings 6 Referred to Elisha asking for temporary blindness on the enemy.

1 Kings 1 Referred to Elijah calling down fireballs from heaven.

Strong's #5463 *khah'-ee-ro* AV-rejoice 42, be glad 14, joy 5, hail 5, greeting 3, God speed 2, all hail 1, joyfully 1, farewell 1; 74 1) to rejoice, be glad 2) to rejoice exceedingly 3) to be well, thrive 4) in salutations, hail! 5) at the beginning of letters: to give one greeting, salute.

Strong's #2799 *klaio klah'-yo* AV-weep 39, bewail 1; 40 1) to mourn, weep, lament 1a) weeping as the sign of pain and grief for the thing signified (i.e.

for the pain and grief) 1b) of those who mourn for the dead 2) to weep for, mourn for, bewail, one.

1 Thessalonians 5:18 in everything give thanks; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you.

John 16:20 Most assuredly, I say to you that you will weep and lament, but the world will rejoice; and you will be sorrowful, but your sorrow will be turned into joy.

John 15:20 Remember the word that I said to you, A servant is not greater than his master. If they persecuted Me, they will also persecute you. If they kept My Word, they will keep yours also.

Revelation 11:8,10,12 And their dead bodies will lie in the street of the great city which spiritually is called Sodom and Egypt, where also our Lord was crucified. 10 And those who dwell on the earth will rejoice over them, make merry, and send gifts to one another, because these two prophets tormented those who dwell on the earth. 12 And they heard a loud voice from heaven saying to them, Come up here. And they ascended to heaven in a cloud, and their enemies saw them.

John 16:19-22 Now Jesus knew that they desired to ask Him, and He said to them, Are you inquiring among yourselves about what I said, A little while, and you will not see Me; and again a little while, and you will see Me?

John 14:3 And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am, there you may be also.

John 16:20 assuredly, I say to you that you will weep & lament, but the world will rejoice; & you will be sorrowful, but your sorrow will be turned into joy.

Mark 16 Referred to the ladies seeing the resurrected Jesus.

Revelation 19:11 Now I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse. And He who sat on him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness He judges and makes war.

John 16:21 A woman, when she is in labor, has sorrow because her hour has come; but as soon as she has given birth to the child, she no longer remembers the anguish, for joy that a human being has been born into the world.

1 Timothy 2:15 Nevertheless she will be saved in childbearing if they continue in faith, love, and Holiness, with self-control.

John 16:22 Therefore you now have sorrow; but I will see you again and your heart will rejoice, and your joy no one will take from you.

Romans 10:13 For whoever calls on the name of the LORD shall be saved.

Exodus 14:13 And Moses said unto the people, Fear ye not, stand still, & see the salvation of the LORD, which he will shew to you to day: for the Egyptians whom ye have seen to day, ye shall see them again no more for ever.

Numbers 14:4 And they said one to another, Let us make a captain, and let us return into Egypt.

Exodus 15:1-21 - V1 Then Moses and the children of Israel sang this song to

the LORD, and spoke, saying: I will sing to the LORD, For He has triumphed gloriously! The horse and its rider He has thrown into the sea!

Referred to many of David's Psalms of rejoicing in the Lord.

Matthew 9 Referred to the woman healed of years of bleeding.

Exodus 15:2 The LORD *is* my strength & song, & He has become my salvation; He *is* my God, and I will praise Him; My father's God, and I will exalt Him.

Daniel 10 Referred to the spiritual battle in the heavenlies.

2 Kings 6 Referred to Elisha & the battle in the heavenlies.

Luke 10:19 I give you the authority to trample on serpents & scorpions, & over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

Mark 16:17,18 And these signs will follow those who believe: In My Name they will cast out demons; they will speak with new tongues; 18 they will take up serpents; and if they drink anything deadly, it will by no means hurt them; they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover.

Ephesians 6:12 For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places.

Daniel 5 Referred to God writing the message to Belshazzar.

Exodus 15:3-9 The LORD *is* a man of war; The LORD *is* His Name. 4 Pharaoh's chariots and his army He has cast into the sea; His chosen captains also are drowned in the Red Sea. 5 The depths have covered them; They sank to the bottom like a stone. 6 Your right hand, O LORD, has become glorious in power; Your right hand, O LORD, has dashed the enemy in pieces. 7 And in the greatness of Your excellence You have overthrown those who rose against You; You sent forth Your wrath; It consumed them like stubble. 8 And with the blast of Your nostrils The waters were gathered together; The floods stood upright like a heap; The depths congealed in the heart of the sea. 9 The enemy said, I will pursue, I will overtake, I will divide the spoil; My desire shall be satisfied on them. I will draw my sword, My hand shall destroy them.

Isaiah 14 Referred to the devil's 5 I will's.

Exodus 15:10-14 You blew with Your wind, The sea covered them; They sank like lead in the mighty waters. 11 Who *is* like You O LORD among the gods? Who *is* like You, glorious in holiness, Fearful in praises, doing wonders? 12 You stretched out Your right hand; The earth swallowed them. 13 You in Your mercy have led forth The people whom You have redeemed; You have guided *them* in Your strength To Your Holy Habitation. 14 The people will hear *and* be afraid; Sorrow will take hold of the inhabitants of Philistia.

Joshua 2:9 And she said unto the men, I know that the LORD hath given you the land, and that your terror is fallen upon us, and that all the inhabitants of the land faint because of you.

Esther 9:3 And all the rulers of the provinces, and the lieutenants, and the deputies, and officers of the king, helped the Jews; because the fear of

Mordecai fell upon them.

Exodus 15:15-21 Then the chiefs of Edom will be dismayed; The mighty men of Moab, Trembling will take hold of them; All the inhabitants of Canaan will melt away. 16 Fear and dread will fall on them; By the greatness of Your arm They will be *as still as a stone*, Till Your people pass over, O LORD, Till the people pass over Whom You have purchased. 17 You will bring them in and plant them In the mountain of Your inheritance, *In the place, O LORD, which You have made For Your own dwelling, The sanctuary, O Lord, which Your hands have established.* 18 The LORD shall reign forever and ever. 19 For the horses of Pharaoh went with his chariots and his horsemen into the sea, and the LORD brought back the waters of the sea upon them. But the children of Israel went on dry *land* in the midst of the sea. 20 Then Miriam the prophetess, the sister of Aaron, took the timbrel in her hand; and all the women went out after her with timbrels and with dances. 21 And Miriam answered them: Sing to the LORD, For He has triumphed gloriously! The horse and its rider He has thrown into the sea!

Jeremiah Referred to the captivity of Jerusalem including Daniel & friends & the skilled people.

Psalms 137:1-9 - V1 By the rivers of Babylon, There we sat down, yea, we wept when we remembered Zion.

2 Kings 19:31 For out of Jerusalem shall go forth a remnant, and they that escape out of mount Zion: the zeal of the LORD of hosts shall do this.

Psalms 137:2 We hung our harps Upon the willows in the midst of it. 3 For there those who carried us away captive asked of us a song, & those who plundered us *requested* mirth, *Saying*, Sing us *one* of the songs of Zion!

Leviticus 26 Referred to God dealing with sinful Israel more as they rebelled.

Genesis 10 Referred to God dealing with Sodom & Gomorrah.

Psalms 137:4-8 How shall we sing the LORD'S song In a foreign land? 5 If I forget you, O Jerusalem, Let my right hand forget *its skill*! 6 If I do not remember you, Let my tongue cling to the roof of my mouth, If I do not exalt Jerusalem Above my chief joy. 7 Remember, O LORD, against the sons of Edom The day of Jerusalem, Who said, Raze *it*, raze *it*, To its very foundation! 8 O daughter of Babylon, who are to be destroyed, Happy the one who repays you as you have served us!

Romans 12:19 Beloved, do not avenge yourselves, but rather give place to wrath; for it is written, Vengeance is Mine, I will repay, says the Lord.

Psalms 137:9 Happy the one who takes and dashes Your little ones against the rock!

Romans 12:20 Therefore if thine enemy hunger, feed him; if he thirst, give him drink: for in so doing thou shalt heap coals of fire on his head.

1 Thessalonians 5:15 See that none render evil for evil unto any man; but ever follow that which is good, both among yourselves, and to all men.

Luke 6:28 bless those who curse you, & pray for those who spitefully use you.
Hebrews 13:5 Let your conduct be without covetousness; be content with such things as you have. For He Himself has said, I will never leave you nor forsake you.

Romans 8:38,39 For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, 39 Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

2 Corinthians 1:3,4 Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of mercies and God of all comfort, 4 who comforts us in all our tribulation, that we may be able to comfort those who are in any trouble, with the comfort with which we ourselves are comforted by God.

1 Chronicles 16:1-8 So they brought the ark of God, and set it in the midst of the tabernacle that David had erected for it. Then they offered burnt offerings and peace offerings before God. 2 And when David had finished offering the burnt offerings and the peace offerings, he blessed the people in the name of the LORD. 3 Then he distributed to everyone of Israel, both man & woman, to everyone a loaf of bread, a piece *of meat*, and a cake of raisins. 4 And he appointed some of the Levites to minister before the ark of the LORD, to commemorate, to thank, & to praise the LORD God of Israel: 5 Asaph the chief & next to him Zechariah, *then* Jeiel, Shemiramoth, Jehiel, Mattithiah, Eliab, Benaiah, and Obed-Edom: Jeiel with stringed instruments and harps, but Asaph made music with cymbals; 6 Benaiah and Jahaziel the priests regularly *blew* the trumpets before the ark of the covenant of God. 7 On that day David first delivered *this psalm* into the hand of Asaph and his brethren, to thank the LORD: 8 Oh, give thanks to the LORD! Call upon His Name; Make known His deeds among the peoples!

Acts 16 Referred to Paul & Silas singing in the dungeon.

1 Chronicles 16:9-43 Sing to Him, sing psalms to Him; Talk of all His wondrous works! 10 Glory in His Holy Name; Let the hearts of those rejoice who seek the LORD! 11 Seek the LORD and His strength; Seek His face evermore! 12 Remember His marvelous works which He has done, His wonders, and the judgments of His mouth, 13 O seed of Israel His servant, You children of Jacob, His chosen ones! 14 He *is* the LORD our God; His judgments *are* in all the earth. 15 Remember His covenant forever, The word which He commanded, for a thousand generations, 16 *The covenant which* He made with Abraham, And His oath to Isaac, 17 And confirmed it to Jacob for a statute, To Israel *for* an everlasting covenant, 18 Saying, To you I will give the land of Canaan As the allotment of your inheritance, 19 When you were few in number, Indeed very few, and strangers in it. 20 When they went from one nation to another, And from *one* kingdom to another people, 21 He permitted no man to do them wrong; Yes, He rebuked kings for their sakes,

22 Saying, Do not touch My anointed ones, And do My prophets no harm. 23 Sing to the LORD, all the earth; Proclaim the good news of His salvation from day to day. 24 Declare His glory among the nations, His wonders among all peoples. 25 For the LORD *is* great and greatly to be praised; He *is* also to be feared above all gods. 26 For all the gods of the peoples *are* idols, But the LORD made the heavens. 27 Honor and majesty *are* before Him; Strength and gladness are in His place. 28 Give to the LORD, O families of the peoples, Give to the LORD glory and strength. 29 Give to the LORD the glory *due* His Name; Bring an offering, and come before Him. Oh, worship the LORD in the beauty of Holiness! 30 Tremble before Him, all the earth. The world also is firmly established, It shall not be moved. 31 Let the heavens rejoice, and let the earth be glad; And let them say among the nations, The LORD reigns. 32 Let the sea roar, and all its fullness; Let the field rejoice, and all that *is* in it. 33 Then the trees of the woods shall rejoice before the LORD, For He is coming to judge the earth. 34 Oh, give thanks to the LORD, for *He is* good! For His mercy *endures* forever. (Psalms 136) 35 And say, Save us, O God of our salvation; Gather us together, and deliver us from the Gentiles, To give thanks to Your Holy Name, To triumph in Your praise. 36 Blessed *be* the LORD God of Israel From everlasting to everlasting! And all the people said, Amen! and praised the LORD. 37 So he left Asaph and his brothers there before the ark of the covenant of the LORD to minister before the ark regularly, as every day's work required; 38 and Obed-Edom with his sixty-eight brethren, including Obed-Edom the son of Jeduthun, and Hosah, *to be* gatekeepers; 39 and Zadok the priest and his brethren the priests, before the tabernacle of the LORD at the high place that *was* at Gibeon, 40 to offer burnt offerings to the LORD on the altar of burnt offering regularly morning and evening, and *to do* according to all that is written in the Law of the LORD which He commanded Israel; 41 and with them Heman and Jeduthun and the rest who were chosen, who were designated by name, to give thanks to the LORD, because His mercy *endures* forever; 42 and with them Heman and Jeduthun, to sound aloud with trumpets and cymbals and the musical instruments of God. Now the sons of Jeduthun *were* gatekeepers. 43 Then all the people departed, every man to his house; and David returned to bless his house.

Referred to David running for his life from Saul for years before.

Acts 13:22 And when He had removed him, He raised up for them David as king, to whom also He gave testimony and said, I have found David the son of Jesse, a man after My own heart, who will do all My will.
