- Romans 8:29 For whom He foreknew, He also predestined to be conformed to the Image of His Son, that He might be the firstborn among many brethren. Romans 12 Summarized of the Gifts of the Holy Spirit & commandments here. Genesis 2:16,17 the LORD God commanded the man, saying, Of every tree of the garden you may freely eat; 17 but of the tree of the knowledge of good & evil you shall not eat, for in the day that you eat of it you shall surely die.
