Do Not Destroy Other Believers - Romans 14C

- 2 Corinthians 11:26 In journeyings often, in perils of waters, in perils of robbers, in perils by mine own countrymen, in perils by the heathen, in perils in the city, in perils in the wilderness, in perils in the sea, in perils among false brethren;
- Romans 14:21 It is good neither to eat flesh, nor to drink wine, nor any thing whereby thy brother stumbleth, or is offended, or is made weak.
- Romans 12:3 For I say, through the grace given to me, to everyone who is among you, not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think, but to think soberly, as God has dealt to each one a measure of faith.
- Galatians 5:23 gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law.
- John 13:34,35 A new commandment I give to ou, that you love one another; as I have loved you, that you also love one another. 35 By this all will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another.
- Romans 14:1 Receive one who is weak in the faith, *but* not to disputes over doubtful things.
- 1 Chronicles 12:16,17 And there came of the children of Benjamin and Judah to the hold unto David. 17 And David went out to meet them, and answered and said unto them, If ye be come peaceably unto me to help me, mine heart shall be knit unto you: but if ye be come to betray me to mine enemies, seeing there is no wrong in mine hands, the God of our fathers look thereon, and rebuke it.
- Romans 14:10-23 But why do you judge your brother? Or why do you show contempt for your brother? For we shall all stand before the judgment seat of Christ.
- Mark 16:15,17,18 15 And He said to them, Go into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature. 17 And these signs will follow those who believe: In My Name they will cast out demons; they will speak with new tongues; 18 they will take up serpents; and if they drink anything deadly, it will by no means hurt them; they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover.
- Romans 12:18 If it is possible, as much as depends on you, live peaceably with all men.

- John 10:10 The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly.
- Strongs #1848 exoutheneo *ex-oo-then-eh'-o* AV-despise 6, set at nought 3, esteem least 1, contemptible 1; 11 1) to make of no account, despise utterly.
- Luke 15:17,20 But when he came to himself, he said, 'How many of my father's hired servants have bread enough and to spare, and I perish with hunger! 20 And he arose and came to his father. But when he was still a great way off, his father saw him and had compassion, and ran and fell on his neck and kissed him.
- John 11:44 And he who had died came out bound hand and foot with graveclothes, and his face was wrapped with a cloth. Jesus said to them, Loose him, and let him go.
- Matthew 5:7 Blessed are the merciful: for they shall obtain mercy.
- Romans 14:11 For it is written: *As* I live, says the LORD, Every knee shall bow to Me, And every tongue shall confess to God.
- Psalms 72:11 Yes, all kings shall fall down before Him; All nations shall serve Him.
- Isaiah 45:23 I have sworn by Myself; The Word has gone out of My mouth *in* righteousness, And shall not return, That to Me every knee shall bow, Every tongue shall take an oath.
- Philippians 2:10,11 that at the Name of Jesus every knee should bow, of those in heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth, 11 and that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.
- Revelation 5:14 Then the four living creatures said, Amen! And the twenty-four elders fell down and worshiped Him who lives forever and ever.
- Romans 14:12 So then each of us shall give account of himself to God. Matthew 25 Referred to the parable of the talents.
- Matthew 12:36 But I say to you that for every idle word men may speak, they will give account of it in the day of judgment.
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our

- sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- Romans 14:13 Therefore let us not judge one another anymore, but rather resolve this, not to put a stumbling block or a cause to fall in *our* brother's way.
- Ephesians 6:10-18 Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might. 11 Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. 12 For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places. 13 Therefore take up the whole armor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand. 14 Stand therefore, having girded your waist with truth, having put on the breastplate of righteousness, 15 and having shod your feet with the preparation of the gospel of peace; 16 above all, taking the shield of faith with which you will be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked one. 17 And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the Word of God; 18 praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, being watchful to this end with all perseverance and supplication for all the saints,
- Galatians 6:1 Brethren, if a man is overtaken in any trespass, you who are spiritual restore such a one in a spirit of gentleness, considering yourself lest you also be tempted.
- Leviticus 19:14 You shall not curse the deaf, nor put a stumbling block before the blind, but shall fear your God: I am the LORD.
- Matthew 6:34 Therefore do not worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will worry about its own things. Sufficient for the day is its own trouble.
- Romans 14:14 I know and am convinced by the Lord Jesus that *there is* nothing unclean of itself; but to him who considers anything to be unclean, to him *it is* unclean.
- Acts 10:13 And a voice came to him, Rise, Peter; kill and eat. 14 But Peter said, Not so, Lord! For I have never eaten anything common or unclean. 15 And a voice spoke to him again the second time, What God has cleansed you must not call common.
- Galatians 3:28 There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor free, there is neither male nor female; for you are all one in Christ Jesus.
- Matthew 12:30 He who is not with Me is against Me, and he who does not gather with Me scatters abroad.
- Romans 14:15 Yet if your brother is grieved because of *your* food, you are no longer walking in love. Do not destroy with your food the one for whom Christ died.
- Romans 13:12 The night is far spent, the day is at hand. Therefore let us

cast off the works of darkness, and let us put on the armor of light.

Romans 14:16 Therefore do not let your good be spoken of as evil;

- 1 Thessalonians 5:22 Abstain from all appearance of evil.
- 2 Samuel 12:14 Howbeit, because by this deed thou hast given great occasion to the enemies of the LORD to blaspheme, the child also that is born unto thee shall surely die.
- 1 Samuel 15:22 Then Samuel said: Has the LORD as great delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices, As in obeying the voice of the LORD? Behold, to obey is better than sacrifice, And to heed than the fat of rams.
- Romans 14:17 for the kingdom of God is not eating and drinking, but righteousness and peace and joy in the Holy Spirit.
- John 16:8 And when He has come, He will convict the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment:
- Romans 3:23 for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,
- Philippians 4:7 and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.
- Matthew 5:9 Blessed are the peacemakers, For they shall be called sons of God.
- Exodus 20 Referred to the 10 Commandments versus matthew 5 the Beatitudes.
- 2 Corinthians 5:14 For the love of Christ compels us, because we judge thus: that if One died for all, then all died;
- Nehemiah 8:10 Then he said to them, Go your way, eat the fat, drink the sweet, and send portions to those for whom nothing is prepared; for this day is holy to our LORD. Do not sorrow, for the joy of the LORD is your strength.
- Mark 8 & Luke 8 Referred to the Gadarene Demoniac.
- Joshua 7 Referred to Achan's sin causing others to die.
- 1 Samuel 8:5,9 And said unto him, Behold, thou art old, and thy sons walk not in thy ways: now make us a king to judge us like all the nations. 9 Now therefore hearken unto their voice: howbeit yet protest solemnly unto them, and shew them the manner of the king that shall reign over them.
- Ezra 9:7 Since the days of our fathers have we been in a great trespass unto this day; and for our iniquities have we, our kings, and our priests, been delivered into the hand of the kings of the lands, to the sword, to captivity, and to a spoil, and to confusion of face, as it is this day.
- Romans 14:18 For he who serves Christ in these things *is* acceptable to God and approved by men.
- Genesis 18 Referred to Abraham pleading with Jesus for the righteous.
- Ezekiel 22:30 So I sought for a man among them who would make a wall, and stand in the gap before Me on behalf of the land, that I should not

- destroy it; but I found no one.
- 1 Timothy 3:7 Moreover he must have a good report of them which are without; lest he fall into reproach and the snare of the devil.
- Matthew 5:16 Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven.
- Romans 14:19 Therefore let us pursue the things *which make* for peace and the things by which one may edify another.
- Matthew 4:23-25 And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing all kinds of sickness and all kinds of disease among the people. 24 Then His fame went throughout all Syria; and they brought to Him all sick people who were afflicted with various diseases and torments, and those who were demon-possessed, epileptics, and paralytics; and He healed them. 25 Great multitudes followed Him: from Galilee, and from Decapolis, Jerusalem, Judea, and beyond the Jordan.
- Acts 8:9 But there was a certain man called Simon, who previously practiced sorcery in the city and astonished the people of Samaria, claiming that he was someone great,
- Romans 14:20-22 Do not destroy the work of God for the sake of food. All things indeed *are* pure, but *it is* evil for the man who eats with offense. 21 *It is* good neither to eat meat nor drink wine nor *do anything* by which your brother stumbles or is offended or is made weak. 22 Do you have faith? Have *it* to yourself before God. Happy *is* he who does not condemn himself in what he approves.
- Matthew 14:19 Then He commanded the multitudes to sit down on the grass. And He took the five loaves and the two fish, and looking up to heaven, He blessed and broke and gave the loaves to the disciples; and the disciples gave to the multitudes.
- Luke 4 Summarized of Jesus tempted but replies V4 But Jesus answered him, saying, It is written, Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word of God.
- Romans 14:23 But he who doubts is condemned if he eats, because *he does* not *eat* from faith; for whatever *is* not from faith is sin.
- James 1:6,8 But let him ask in faith, nothing wavering. For he that wavereth is like a wave of the sea driven with the wind and tossed. 8 A double minded man is unstable in all his ways.
