

Patience, Comfort And Hope - Romans 15B

1 Corinthians 13:13 And now abide faith, hope, love, these three; but the greatest of these is love.

Luke 18:8 I tell you that He will avenge them speedily. Nevertheless, when the Son of Man comes, will He really find faith on the earth?

Matthew 7:21 Not everyone who says to Me, Lord, Lord, shall enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father in heaven.

Romans 15:1 We then who are strong ought to bear with the scruples of the weak, and not to please ourselves.

Romans 15:3-12 (NKJV) For even Christ did not please Himself; but as it is written, The reproaches of those who reproached You fell on Me.

The Gospel of Matthew shows the Jews that Jesus Christ was the fulfilment of prophesy like Paul does here.

Hebrews 4:15 For we do not have a High Priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but was in all points tempted as we are, yet without sin.

1 John 2:23 Whosoever denieth the Son, the same hath not the Father: (but) he that acknowledgeth the Son hath the Father also.

1 Samuel 8:7,9 And the LORD said to Samuel, Heed the voice of the people in all that they say to you; for they have not rejected you, but they have rejected Me, that I should not reign over them. 9 Now therefore, heed their voice. However, you shall solemnly forewarn them, and show them the behavior of the king who will reign over them.

John 14:6 Jesus said to him, I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.

John 1:2,3 He (Jesus) was in the beginning with God. 3 All things were made through Him, and without Him nothing was made that was made.

Psalms 40:6-10 Sacrifice and offering You did not desire; My ears You have opened. Burnt offering and sin offering You did not require. 7 Then I said, Behold, I come; In the scroll of the Book *it is* written of me. 8 I delight to do Your will, O my God, And Your law *is* within my heart. 9 I have proclaimed the good news of righteousness In the great assembly; Indeed, I do not restrain my lips, O LORD, You Yourself know. 10 I have not hidden Your righteousness within my heart; I have declared Your faithfulness and Your salvation; I have not concealed Your lovingkindness and Your truth From the great assembly.

Matthew 22 Summarized of the questions of the seven brothers & 1 wife. V29 Jesus answered and said to them, You are mistaken, not knowing the Scriptures nor the power of God.

Romans 15:4 For whatever things were written before were written for our learning, that we through the patience and comfort of the Scriptures might have hope.

1 Timothy 3:6 not a novice, lest being puffed up with pride he fall into the same condemnation as the devil.

John 15:26 But when the Comforter is come, Whom I will send unto you from the Father, even the Spirit of Truth, which proceedeth from the Father, He shall testify of Me:

Leviticus 26 Referred to God dealing with sinful Israel.

Job 1:21 And he said: Naked I came from my mother's womb, And naked shall I return there. The LORD gave, and the LORD has taken away; Blessed be the Name of the LORD.

1 Corinthians 6:19 Or do you not know that your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit Who is in you, Whom you have from God, and you are not your own?

Revelation 19:11 Referred to Jesus' return.

Romans 5:1-5 (AV) Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ:

Romans 5:2 (AV) By whom also we have access by faith into this grace wherein we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God.

Romans 5:2 (NKJV) through whom also we have access by faith into this grace in which we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God.

Galatians 3:6 Even as Abraham believed God, and it was accounted to him for righteousness.

Daniel 3:17,18 If it be so, our God Whom we serve is able to deliver us from the burning fiery furnace, and He will deliver us out of thine hand, O king.
18 But if not, be it known unto thee, O king, that we will not serve thy gods, nor worship the golden image which thou hast set up.

Psalms 2:4 He who sits in the heavens shall laugh; The Lord shall hold them in derision.

Romans 5:3 (AV) And not only *so*, but we glory in tribulations also: knowing that tribulation worketh patience;

Romans 5:3 (NKJV) And not only *that*, but we also glory in tribulations, knowing that tribulation produces perseverance;

Romans 5:4 (AV) And patience, experience; and experience, hope:

Romans 5:4 (NKJV) and perseverance, character; and character, hope.

Daniel 9:2 in the first year of his reign I, Daniel, understood by the books the number of the years specified by the word of the LORD through Jeremiah the prophet, that He would accomplish seventy years in the desolations of

Jerusalem. 3 Then I set my face toward the Lord God to make request by prayer and supplications, with fasting, sackcloth, and ashes.

Ezra 1:2 Thus says Cyrus king of Persia: All the kingdoms of the earth the LORD God of heaven has given me. And He has commanded me to build Him a house at Jerusalem which is in Judah.

Romans 5:5 (AV) And hope maketh not ashamed; because the love of God is shed abroad in our hearts by the Holy Ghost which is given unto us.

Romans 5:5 (NKJV) Now hope does not disappoint, because the love of God has been poured out in our hearts by the Holy Spirit Who was given to us.

John 14:3 And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am, there you may be also.

Genesis 3 Referred to The downfall of mankind.

Luke 4 Jesus refuted the devil with It is written...

Daniel 4:16 Let his heart be changed from that of a man, Let him be given the heart of a beast, And let seven times pass over him.

Ephesians 4:30 And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption.

1 Thessalonians 5:19 Do not quench the Spirit.

Romans 15:5 Now may the God of patience and comfort grant you to be like-minded toward one another, according to Christ Jesus,

2 Timothy 4:3 For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine, but according to their own desires, because they have itching ears, they will heap up for themselves teachers;

Colossians 3:11 where there is neither Greek nor Jew, circumcised nor uncircumcised, barbarian, Scythian, slave nor free, but Christ is all and in all.

Revelation 13 Referred to the world control by the beast.

Revelation 17:13 These are of one mind, and they will give their power and authority to the beast.

1 Corinthians 2:16 For who has known the mind of the LORD that he may instruct Him? But we have the mind of Christ.

Ephesians 6:4 And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.

Romans 15:6,7 that you may with one mind *and* one mouth glorify the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ. 7 Therefore receive one another, just as Christ also received us, to the glory of God.

Acts 9:26,27 And when Saul had come to Jerusalem, he tried to join the disciples; but they were all afraid of him, and did not believe that he was a disciple. 27 But Barnabas took him and brought him to the apostles. And he declared to them how he had seen the Lord on the road, and that He had spoken to him, and how he had preached boldly at Damascus in the

Name of Jesus.

Romans 15:8,9 Now I say that Jesus Christ has become a servant to the circumcision for the Truth of God, to confirm the promises *made* to the fathers, 9 and that the Gentiles might glorify God for *His* mercy, as it is written: For this reason I will confess to You among the Gentiles, And sing to Your Name.

Acts 13:46 Then Paul and Barnabas waxed bold, and said, It was necessary that the Word of God should first have been spoken to you: but seeing ye put it from you (Jews), and judge yourselves unworthy of everlasting life, lo, we turn to the Gentiles.

Acts 10:15 And a voice spoke to him again the second time, What God has cleansed you must not call common.

Romans 15:10 And again he says: Rejoice, O Gentiles, with His people! 11 And again: Praise the LORD, all you Gentiles! Laud Him, all you peoples! 12 And again, Isaiah says: There shall be a root of Jesse; And He who shall rise to reign over the Gentiles, In Him the Gentiles shall hope.

Acts 9 Referred to Saul/Paul's vision of Jesus & his conversion.

John 4 Referred to the woman at the well saved.

Psalms 18:49 Therefore will I give thanks unto Thee, O LORD, among the heathen, and sing praises unto Thy Name.

Deuteronomy 32:43 Rejoice, O ye nations, *with* His people: for He will avenge the blood of His servants, and will render vengeance to His adversaries, and will be merciful unto His land, *and* to His people.

Psalms 117:1 O praise the LORD, all ye nations: praise Him, all ye people.

Isaiah 11:10 And in that day there shall be a Root of Jesse, which shall stand for an ensign of the people; to it shall the Gentiles seek: and his rest shall be glorious.

Psalms 31:24 Be of good courage, And He shall strengthen your heart, All you who hope in the LORD.

Psalms 33:18,22 Behold, the eye of the LORD is on those who fear Him, On those who hope in His mercy, 22 Let Your mercy, O LORD, be upon us, Just as we hope in You.

Psalms 38:15 For in You, O LORD, I hope; You will hear, O Lord my God.

Psalms 39:7 And now, Lord, what do I wait for? My hope is in You.

Psalms 42:5,11 Why are you cast down, O my soul? And *why* are you disquieted within me? Hope in God, for I shall yet praise Him *For* the help of His countenance.

1 Samuel 23 Referred to Saul chasing David around the mount.

Psalms 42:11 Why are you cast down, O my soul? And why are you disquieted within me? Hope in God; For I shall yet praise Him, The help of my countenance and my God.

Psalms 43:5 Why are you cast down, O my soul? And why are you disquieted within me? Hope in God; For I shall yet praise Him, The help of my countenance and my God.

Psalms 71:5 For You are my hope, O Lord GOD; *You are* my trust from my youth.

Psalms 78:7 That they may set their hope in God, And not forget the works of God, But keep His commandments;

Psalms 119:166 LORD, I hope for Your salvation, And I do Your commandments.

Ephesians 1:13 In Him you also trusted, after you heard the Word of Truth, the Gospel of your Salvation; in Whom also, having believed, you were sealed with the Holy Spirit of promise,

Psalms 130:5,7 I wait for the LORD, my soul waits, And in His Word I do hope.
7 O Israel, hope in the LORD; For with the LORD *there is* mercy, And with Him *is* abundant redemption.

1 Chronicles 21:13 And David said unto Gad, I am in a great strait: let me fall now into the hand of the LORD; for very great are his mercies: but let me not fall into the hand of man.

Psalms 131:3 O Israel, hope in the LORD From this time forth and forever.

Psalms 146:5 Happy *is he* who *has* the God of Jacob for his help, Whose hope *is* in the LORD his God,

Psalms 147:11 The LORD takes pleasure in those who fear Him, In those who hope in His mercy.

Acts 17:27 so that they should seek the Lord, in the hope that they might grope for Him and find Him, though He is not far from each one of us;

Acts 24:15 I have hope in God, which they themselves also accept, that there will be a resurrection of *the* dead, both of *the* just and *the* unjust.

Revelation 20:12,15 And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is the book of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works. 15 And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire.

1 Corinthians 16:7 For I do not wish to see you now on the way; but I hope to stay a while with you, if the Lord permits.

Ephesians 2:12 that at that time you were without Christ, being aliens from the commonwealth of Israel and strangers from the covenants of promise, having no hope and without God in the world.

2 Corinthians 4:4 whose minds the god of this age has blinded, who do not believe, lest the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine on them.

Colossians 1:27 To them God willed to make known what are the riches of

the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles: which is Christ in you, the hope of glory.

1 John 3:8 He who sins is of the devil, for the devil has sinned from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that He might destroy the works of the devil.

Luke 10:19 Behold, I give you the authority to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

Matthew 16:19 And I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven, and whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven.

Romans 13:12 The night is far spent, the day is at hand. Therefore let us cast off the works of darkness, and let us put on the armor of light.

Romans 16:20 And the God of peace will crush Satan under your feet shortly. The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you. Amen.

2 Corinthians 11 Referred to Paul's In Perils chapter.

Luke 8 Referred to the Seed in Good Ground that produced much fruit.

More Service Notes:

Isaiah 8:17 And I will wait on the LORD, Who hides His face from the house of Jacob; And I will hope in Him.

Jeremiah 3:23 Truly, in vain *is salvation hoped for* from the hills, *And from* the multitude of mountains; Truly, in the LORD our God *is* the salvation of Israel.

Jeremiah 17:7,13 Blessed *is* the man who trusts in the LORD, And whose hope is the LORD. 13 O LORD, the hope of Israel, All who forsake You shall be ashamed. Those who depart from Me Shall be written in the earth, Because they have forsaken the LORD, The fountain of living waters.

Jeremiah 29:11 For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says the LORD, thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope.

Jeremiah 31:17 There is hope in your future, says the LORD, That *your* children shall come back to their own border.

Jeremiah 50:7 All who found them have devoured them; And their adversaries said, We have not offended, Because they have sinned against the LORD, the habitation of justice, The LORD, the hope of their fathers.

Lamentations 3:24,26 The LORD *is* my portion, says my soul, Therefore I hope in Him! 26 *It is* good that *one* should hope and wait quietly For the salvation of the LORD.

Acts 26:6,7 And now I stand and am judged for the hope of the promise made by God to our fathers. 7 To this *promise* our twelve tribes, earnestly serving God night and day, hope to attain. For this hope's sake, King Agrippa, I am accused by the Jews.

Romans 5:2,5 through whom also we have access by faith into this grace in which we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God. 5 Now hope does not disappoint, because the love of God has been poured out in our hearts by the Holy Spirit who was given to us.

Romans 15:13 Now may the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, that you may abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.

1 Thessalonians 1:3 remembering without ceasing your work of faith, labor of love, and patience of hope in our Lord Jesus Christ in the sight of our God and Father,

1 Thessalonians 2:19 For what *is* our hope, or joy, or crown of rejoicing? *Is it* not even you in the presence of our Lord Jesus Christ at His coming?

2 Thessalonians 2:16 Now may our Lord Jesus Christ Himself, and our God and Father, who has loved us and given *us* everlasting consolation and good hope by grace,

1 Timothy 1:1 Paul, an apostle of Jesus Christ, by the commandment of God our Savior and the Lord Jesus Christ, our hope,

Titus 1:2 in hope of eternal life which God, who cannot lie, promised before time began,

Titus 2:13 looking for the blessed hope and glorious appearing of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ,

Hebrews 6:18 that by two immutable things, in which it *is* impossible for God to lie, we might have strong consolation, who have fled for refuge to lay hold of the hope set before *us*.

Hebrews 7:19 for the law made nothing perfect; on the other hand, *there is the* bringing in of a better hope, through which we draw near to God.

1 Peter 1:3,13,21 Blessed *be* the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who according to His abundant mercy has begotten us again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, 13 Therefore gird up the loins of your mind, be sober, and rest *your* hope fully upon the grace that is to be brought to you at the revelation of Jesus Christ; 21 who through Him believe in God, who raised Him from the dead and gave Him glory, so that your faith and hope are in God.

1 Peter 3:15 But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts, and always *be* ready to *give* a defense to everyone who asks you a reason for the hope that is in you, with meekness and fear;
